

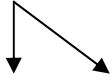
1-B Made in God's Image

2. **EIKON** = an image, figure, likeness.
1CO 15:49 And as we have borne the **image (eikon)** of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man.
3. **CHARAKTER** = the instrument used for engraving or carving; the mark stamped upon that instrument or wrought out on it. A mark or figure burned in (Lev. 13:28) or stamped on, an impression. The **exact expression** (the image) of any person or thing, marked likeness, precise reproduction in every respect, i.e. **facsimile**.
HEB 1:1 God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, 2 has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds; 3 who being the brightness of His glory and the express **image (character)** of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,
4. **SKIA** = shadow.
HEB 10:1 For the law, having a **shadow (skia)** of the good things to come, and not the very **image (eikon)** of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect.

Sperma = 1. from which a plant germinates; the seed i.e. the grain or kernel which contains within itself the germ of the future plants. 2. 15. **JAM 3:2** For we all stumble in many things. 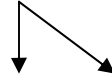
