- The bible teaches that **man is triune, just as is God**. **What are the 3 parts of your being?** Give both the **English and Greek** names of each part:
 

<u>English</u>	<u>Greek</u>
<u>spirit</u>	<u>pneuma</u>
<u>soul</u>	<u>psuche</u>
<u>body</u>	<u>soma</u>
- Which part(s) of your being is (are) changed or saved at the New Birth?** My Sspirit  
 \* **Which part(s) of your being is (are) NOT saved at the New Birth?** My Soul & my Body
- What are the three functions or components of your spirit?** 1. Conscience, 2. Intuition & 3. Communion  
 \* **What are the three functions or components of your soul?** 1. Mind 2. Will & 3. Emotions  
 \* **What are the five ways or senses by which your body gathers information from its surroundings?**  
1. sight, 2. smell, 3. hearing, 4. touch and 5. smell = the five natural senses of the body
- In what part of your being does the Holy Spirit dwell** after you are saved or filled with the Holy Spirit?  
The Holy Spirit indwells my spirit man; EZE 11:19-20, 36:26-27, ROM 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with(in) our spirit that we are children of God, (NKJ) 1JO 5:10 He who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself; he who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that God has given of His Son. (NKJ)
- Write down a scripture & reference from the OT that shows the trinity of man:** GEN 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground (the body), and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life (His Spirit); and man became a living soul. (NKJ)
- Write down a scripture & reference from the NT that shows the trinity of man:** 1TH 5:23 May the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely. May your whole SPIRIT (pneuma), SOUL (psuche) and BODY (soma) be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. (NKJ)
- Write down a scripture & reference from the NT that proves that soul & spirit are NOT the same:**  
Heb 4:12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the DIVISION of soul (psuche) and spirit (pneuma), and of joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart. (NKJ)
- With my body**, I contact or operate in the physical or natural realm.  
 \* **With my soul**, I contact or operate in the intellectual or emotional realm.  
 \* **With my spirit**, I contact or operate in the spiritual realm.
- PRO 3:5** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding (reasoning or mind); 6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. (NKJ)  
 \* **Rephrase** this scripture in your own words: I am to trust or follow God by listening to His Spirit in my heart or spirit, NOT by reasoning things out in my mind intellectually. That is how He directs me.
- T F** In scripture, the **heart** can usually be equated with the human **spirit**.  
**T F** Faith in God and His Word arises in the **soul or mind** as we feed or meditate on the Word.  
**T F** Wisdom (Gk Sophia) from God is imparted into our **soul or mind** when we ask in Faith.  
**T F** The primary way God intends us to be led in all decisions is by our mind or reason (**ROM 8:14, PRO 3:5-6**).
- Write out **JOH 3:6**: That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. (NKJ)  
 \* **Can YOU discern spiritual matters by the flesh, such as through human reasoning?** No, No, No !!
- Just as we can enter into an earthly family in one of three ways, so also we enter into God's family.**  
 We are born of the Spirit, betrothed to the Lamb, and adopted by the Father.
- JOH 4:24** "God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." (NKJ)
- The tabernacle of Moses in the wilderness had three parts or compartments.** The outer court is a type of the human body, the holy place is a type of the human soul, and the holy of holies is a type of the human spirit.
- ROM 12:1** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (NKJ)

- \* **How** do we present our bodies as **living sacrifices unto God?** By living holy, a life separated from the world
16. **JAM 1:21** Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. (NKJ)  
 \* **Who** is this scripture written to? To Christian believers **Explain this scripture:** Once I am saved in spirit (the New Birth), I need to plant God's Word (rhemas) in my heart, doing the Word as it is revealed, which will transform my soul – my mind, will & emotions—into the likeness of God, in holiness.
17. When God does anything for us, He imparts it into our spirit, which then may work out into the rest of our being, into our soul and body.  
 \* **List** the **nine FRUIT of the Spirit** with reference: GAL 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. (NKJ)  
 \* **List** the **nine GIFTS of the Spirit** with reference: 1CO 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: 8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills. (NKJ)
18. I am a spirit(ual) being. I have a soul, and I live in a body. With my spirit, I commune with God. Other functions of my spirit are conscience and intuition.  
 \* Write out **PRO 20:27:** The spirit of a man is the lamp of the Lord, Searching all the inner depths of his heart. (NKJ)  
 \* **Explain** this scripture: The spirit of a man works with the Holy Spirit in a 2-way exchange, where the HS provides revelation (illumination), intuition, communion with God, conscience, Gifts of the Spirit, Fruit of the Spirit, etc.; the HS also discerns the spiritual state of a man & shows where he deviates from God's perfect plan.
19. **T F True knowledge or wisdom** comes by receiving the revelation of God in my heart, my spirit, by the Holy Spirit within me. **Maturity** comes by living this revelation out on the anvils of life.
20. **1CO 2:9** But as it is written: “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.” 10 But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. 11 For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. (NKJ)  
 \* **Where** within myself does God reveal anything? Within my heart (spirit) by the Holy Spirit within me
21. Define '**rationalism**': 1. Reliance on reason as the best guide for belief & action. 2. The theory that the exercise of reason, rather than experience, authority, or spiritual revelation, provides the primary basis for knowledge.  
 \* **Is this what the Bible teaches as the source of truth?** No. The Bible teaches that the authority of the Word of God and revelation from the Spirit of God are the primary bases for knowledge or truth, and that man's reason CANNOT be relied upon to reveal truth, especially in spiritual matters.  
 \* Write out **PRO 14:12:** There is a way that seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death. (NKJ)
22. **T F** The **conscience** is the **voice of the human spirit**, telling us when we are in or out of God's will.  
**T F** The **mind and conscience** are **defiled** through unbelief, and are therefore unreliable. (**TIT 1:15**)  
**T F** The **conscience** is seared and made unusable by **lies and hypocrisy**. (**1TI 4:2**)  
**T F** The conscience is cleansed and renewed by repentance. (**HEB 9:14, 10:2**)  
**T F** A good conscience is necessary to wage spiritual warfare, to lead others and to keep one's faith from shipwreck. (**1TI 1:19, 3:9**)
23. Write out **ACT 24:16:** This being so, I myself always strive to have a conscience without offense toward God and men. (NKJ)  
 \* Write out **1TI 1:5:** Now the purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from sincere faith, (NKJ)  
 \* Write out **1TI 3:9:** holding the mystery of the faith with a pure conscience. (NKJ)  
 \* Write out **1TI 1:18-19:** 18 This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare, 19 having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the faith have suffered shipwreck, (NKJ)
24. **HEB 10:21** and having a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. (NKJ)  
 \* From this scripture, **what four elements are necessary for us to draw near AND HEAR from God:** 1. a true heart in full assurance of faith, 2. our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, 3. our bodies washed with pure water, and 4. holding fast the confession of our hope without wavering.
