

2-A God's Word

PSALM 119:9 How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word. 10 I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. 11 I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. 16 I delight in your decrees; I will not neglect your word. 18 Open my eyes that I may see wonderful things in your law. 33 Teach me, O LORD, to follow your decrees; then I will keep them to the end. 34 Give me understanding, and I will keep your law and obey it with all my heart. 35 Direct me in the path of your commands, for there I find delight. 36 Turn my heart toward your statutes and not toward selfish gain. 37 Turn my eyes away from worthless things; preserve my life according to your word. 57 You are my portion, O LORD; I have promised to obey your words. 58 I have sought your face with all my heart; be gracious to me according to your promise. 59 I have considered my ways and have turned my steps to your statutes. 60 I will hasten and not delay to obey your commands. 89 Your word, O LORD, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens. 137 Righteous are you, O LORD, and your laws are right. 138 The statutes you have laid down are righteous; they are fully trustworthy.

1. **JOS 1:8** This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.
2. **PSA 1:2** But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.
3. **PSA 19:10** They (God's words) are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb.
4. **PSA 33:6** By the word of the LORD were the heavens made, their starry host by the breath of his mouth.
5. **PSA 45:1** My heart is stirred (overflowing) with a noble theme as I recite my verses for the king; my tongue is the pen of a skillful writer. (NIV)
6. **PRO 4:20** My son, pay attention to what I say; listen closely to my words. 21 Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; 22 for they are life to those who find them and health to a man's whole body.
7. **PRO 6:22** When you walk, they (God's words) will guide you; when you sleep, they will watch over you; when you awake, they will speak to you. 23 For these commands are a lamp, this teaching is a light, and the corrections of discipline are the way to life,
8. **PRO 30:5** "Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.
9. **2SA 23:2** "The Spirit of the LORD spoke through me; his word was on my tongue.
10. **1KI 8:56** "Praise be to the LORD, who has given rest to his people Israel just as he promised. Not one word has failed of all the good promises he gave through his servant Moses.
11. **ISA 8:20** To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, they have no light of dawn.
12. **ISA 28:9** Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts. 10 For precept (teaching of the word) must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little:
13. **ISA 50:4** The Sovereign LORD has given me an instructed tongue, to know the word that sustains the weary. He wakens me morning by morning, wakens my ear to listen like one being taught. 5 The Sovereign LORD has opened my ears, and I have not been rebellious; I have not drawn back.
14. **ISA 55:10** As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, 11 so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.
15. **JER 1:9** Then the LORD reached out his hand and touched my mouth and said to me, "Now, I have put my words in your mouth.
16. **JER 23:29** "Is not my word like fire," declares the LORD, "and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?"
17. **MAT 4:4** Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every WORD (rhema) that comes from the mouth of God.'"
18. **MAT 5:18** I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished. 35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.
19. **MAT 24:35** Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.
20. **JOH 5:39** You diligently study the Scriptures because you think that by them you possess eternal life. These are the Scriptures that testify about me,
21. **JOH 6:35** Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty.
22. **JOH 6:63** It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.

A QUOTE from Bill Subritzky: THIS is the Word of God. It is supernatural in origin, eternal in duration, inexpressible in value, infinite in scope, regenerative in power, infallible in authority, universal in interest, personal in application, inspired in totality. Read it through, write it down, pray it in, work it out, and then pass it on.

23. **JOH 8:31** To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching (my word), you are really my disciples. 32 Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
24. **JOH 15:3** You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you.
25. **ACT 4:31** After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.
26. **ACT 13:49** The word of the Lord spread through the whole region.
27. **ACT 18:11** So Paul stayed for a year and a half, teaching them the word of God.
28. **ACT 20:32** Now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.
29. **ROM 10:17** So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word (rhema) of God.
30. **2CO 1:20** For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.
31. **EPH 5:26** to make her (the church) holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word,
32. **EPH 6:17** Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word (rhema) of God.
33. **2TI 2:15** Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
34. **2TI 3:16** All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.
35. **2TI 4:2** Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction.
36. **HEB 1:3** who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, & upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,
37. **HEB 5:13** Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. 14 But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.
38. **HEB 4:12** For the word (logos) of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
39. **1PE 1:23** For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living & enduring word of God. 24 For, "All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall, 25 but the word of the Lord stands forever." And this is the word that was preached to you.
40. **1PE 2:2** As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: 3 If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious.
41. **2PE 1:4** Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.
42. **2PE 1:20** knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, 21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.
43. **1JO 5:9** We accept man's testimony, but God's testimony is greater because it is the testimony of God, which he has given about his Son. 10 Anyone who believes in the Son of God has this testimony in his heart. Anyone who does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because he has not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. (The New and Old Testaments)
44. **REV 1:3** Blessed is the one who reads the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, because the time is near.
45. **REV 1:16** In his right hand he held seven stars, and out of his mouth came a sharp double-edged sword. His face was like the sun shining in all its brilliance.
46. **REV 12:11** They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.
47. **REV 19:10** At this I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "Do not do it! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

We are to speak the word, believe the word, preach the word, pray the word, memorize the word, obey the word, honor the word, study the word, hear the word, listen to the word, eat the word, meditate on the word, heed the word, teach the word, publish the word, desire the word, do the word, rejoice in the word, hide the word in our hearts, delight in the word, long for the word, keep the word, set our hearts on the word, recount the word, consider the word, learn the word, hope in the word, love the word, walk in the word, practice the word, taste the word, accept the word, pant for the word, sing of the word, etc.

When we properly receive the word in us, it heals, cleanses, saves, preserves, strengthens, teaches, guides, directs, gives light, gives hope, creates, manifests, comforts, sanctifies, washes, grows, abides in us, etc.
