

**2-A****Rhema (Imparted to Spirit) & Logos (From Psuche)**

1. **MAT 4:4** Jesus answered, “It is written: ‘Man does not live on bread alone, but on every **rhema** that comes from the mouth of God.’”
2. **MAT 12:36-37** “But I say to you that for every idle **rhema** men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. 37 “For by your **rhemas** you will be justified, and by your **rhemas** you will be condemned.”
3. **LUK 1:37** “For with God **nothing (no rhema)** will be impossible.”
4. **LUK 1:38** Then Mary said, “Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your **rhema**.” And the angel departed from her.
5. **LUK 2:15** So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, “Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing (**rhema**) that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us.”
6. **LUK 5:5** But Simon answered and said to Him, “Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your **rhema** I will let down the net.”
7. **JOH 3:34** “For He whom God has sent speaks the **rhemas** of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure.
8. **JOH 6:63** “It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The **rhemas** that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.
9. **JOH 8:47** “He who is of God hears God’s **rhemas**; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God.”
10. **JOH 15:7-8** “If you abide in Me, and My **rhemas** abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. 8 “By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.
11. **ACT 10:44** (Cornelius) While Peter was still speaking these **rhemas**, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the **rhema**.
12. **ROM 10:8-10** But what does it say? “The **rhema** is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the **rhema** of faith which we preach): 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
13. **ROM 10:17** So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the **rhema** of God.
14. **EPH 5:25-27** Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26 that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the **rhema**, 27 that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.
15. **EPH 6:17** And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the **rhema** of God;
16. **HEB 1:3** who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the **rhema** of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,
17. **1PE 1:25** But the **rhema** of the Lord endures forever.” Now this is the **rhema** which by the gospel was preached to you.

## **2-A Epignosis (Imparted to Spirit) & Gnosis (From Psuche)**

1. **ROM 1:28** Furthermore, since they did not think it worthwhile to retain the **knowledge (epignosis)** of God, he gave them over to a depraved mind, to do what ought not to be done.
2. **ROM 3:20** Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the **knowledge (epignosis)** of sin.
3. **ROM 10:2** For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to **knowledge (epignosis)**.
4. **EPH 1:17** that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the **knowledge (epignosis)** of Him, 18 the eyes of your **understanding (epignosis)** being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power
5. **EPH 4:11** And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, 13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the **knowledge (epignosis)** of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; 14 that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting,
6. **PHI 1:9** And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in **knowledge (epignosis)** and depth of insight, 10 so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, 11 filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.
7. **COL 1:9** For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the **knowledge (epignosis)** of his will through all spiritual wisdom and **understanding (epignosis)**. 10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the **knowledge (epignosis)** of God, 11 being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully 12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light. 13 For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, 14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
8. **2TI 2:24** And the Lord's servant must not quarrel; instead, he must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. 25 Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a **knowledge (epignosis)** of the truth, 26 and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will.
9. **2TI 3:6** For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, 7 always learning and never able to come to the **knowledge (epignosis)** of the truth.
10. **PHM 6** I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full **understanding (epignosis)** of every good thing we have in Christ.
11. **2PE 1:2** Grace and peace be yours in abundance through the **knowledge (epignosis)** of God and of Jesus our Lord. 3 His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our **knowledge (epignosis)** of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. 4 Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires. 5 For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, **knowledge (gnosis)**; 6 and to **knowledge (gnosis)**, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; 7 and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. 8 For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your **knowledge (epignosis)** of our Lord Jesus Christ.
