* **What is the essence or spirit of all prophecy?** The testimony or revelation of Jesus

* **Where in the Bible** is the **crossing of the Red Sea** found? EXO 14:1-31 **How many chariots** did Pharaoh send in pursuit of the Hebrews? 600 of his best chariots, along with all the other chariots of Egypt (EXO 14:6)
- Where in the Bible** are the **seven feasts of the LORD** prescribed by God? Leviticus 23 **Name the seven feasts** in order: Passover (Pesach), Unleavened Bread (Hag HaMatzah), Firstfruits (Hag HaBikkurim), Pentecost (Shavuot), Trumpets (Rosh Hashanna), Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur), Tabernacles (Sukkot)
- Where in the Bible** is the story of **Daniel** in the **lion's den** found? DAN 6:1-28

Solomon, Pen name "The Preacher" ECC 1:12 **To whom** did God give **wisdom above all others**?
Solomon: 1KI 4:29 And God gave Solomon wisdom and exceedingly great understanding, and largeness of heart like the sand on the seashore. 30 Thus Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the men of the East and all the wisdom of Egypt. 31 For he was wiser than all men—than Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, Chalcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol; and his fame was in all the surrounding nations. 32 He spoke three thousand proverbs, and his songs were one thousand and five. 33 Also he spoke of trees, from the cedar tree of Lebanon even to the hyssop that springs out of the wall; he spoke also of animals, of birds, of creeping things, and of fish. 34 And men of all nations, from all the kings of the earth who had heard of his wisdom, came to hear the wisdom of Solomon. (NKJ)

What is the significance of that name? In Jerusalem, there was a tradition to let a condemned criminal go free at Passover. Pilate, at Jesus Trial, offered Jesus & Barabbas to the people to choose which one would go free, and which would be crucified. The people chose Jesus to be crucified, so that Barabbas, or "sons of the Father" go FREE while Jesus takes their place on the cross. This is a picture of His substitutionary death on the cross in our place – so the WE, condemned criminals, go FREE.

T **F** The Septuagint (**LXX**) is a **Greek translation** of the Old Testament from the Hebrew text. The translation was accomplished by 72 Hebrew scholars in about 70 days in about 250 B.C.

 * **What** does the name '**Melchizedek**' mean? 'King of Righteousness' **Who is Melchizedek a type of**?
Of Jesus Christ, who will reign as King of Kings from Jerusalem, the 'City of Peace'
