## Questions: The Names of God

- What is the **FIRST Hebrew word** in the Bible that is translated "God"? Elohim This word is **Singular Plural**, but the verbs used with the word are always **Singular Plural** (*circle the answers*), except when the word is used for pagan gods. **Which part** of this word makes it plural? The --im ending
- What is the first OT verse** where this word is found? Genesis 1:1 About **how many times** can this word for God be found in the OT? 2,570 times **The singular form** of this word for God is El, which means Strong or Mighty. The **Arabic equivalent** for this singular form is Allah. The dual form of this word for God is Eloah, which is found mostly in the book of Job.
- What is the most common NAME** for God used in the OT? Yahweh (Jehovah) **How many times** is this name used in the OT? 6,823 times **How** is this name translated **in the KJV Bible** text? LORD – all caps
- What are the 4 Hebrew letters** for this most common **name** of God in the OT: hWhy or YHWH. **Write down** three proposed English pronunciations of this **Hebrew name**: Jehovah or Yahweh or Yahoowah. **What is the meaning** of the Hebrew name **YHWH** (hWhy)? I am that I am or I will be who I will be (see **EXO 3:14**). The related Hebrew verb **havah** (hWh) means to be.
- Which** of these three most common terms/names for God in the OT is **always** used in relation to God's covenant people Israel, but never with pagan peoples? Yahweh (YHWH, Jehovah) **Which** of the most common words / names for God can be used **either** in relation to Israel or to pagan peoples? Elohim, Eloah, El, Adonai

- Adonai** is used about 300 times in the Bible. When used of God it is always **Singular Plural** but when used of men, it is usually in the **Singular Plural** form (circle answer). **Verbs** used with Adonai as God are always **Singular Plural**. **Adonai** is usually translated Lord in the KJV Bible.
- Which** Old Testament word for God is usually translated **Lord** in the Bible (**capital L, small -ord**)? Adonai  
**Which** OT word for God is translated **LORD** in the Bible (**capital LORD**)? Jehovah (Yahweh) **Which** OT word for God or gods is translated **God or Gods** in the Bible? Elohim
- The most common Greek word** translated "**God**" in the NT is Theos, which is equivalent to the Hebrew Elohim, and occurs about 1,000 times in the NT. **The most common Greek word** translated "**Lord**" in the NT is Kurios, which occurs about 600 times in the NT.
- The **Hebrew equivalent** for the English name **Jesus** is Yeshua. **Write out** this name using Hebrew letters: h[Wvy or [Wvy Yashuah or Yashua The **Greek equivalent** for the English name **Jesus** is Iesous. **Write out this name** using Greek letters: Ihsou`" Iesous
- The **Greek term** for the English word **Christ** is Christos, while the **Hebrew term** for the English word **Christ** is Meschiah. The English translation for this Hebrew word is Messiah. These terms all mean The anointed one.
- How many times is the name Elohim <43032> found in Genesis Chapter 1?** 32 times  
\* **Which compound name for God can be found in GEN 17:1?** El Shaddai

15. **Jesus' Hebrew name YASHUA** (Strong's # 3444) can be found in several Old Testament scriptures, & is typically translated healing, salvation, deliverance, or victory.  
 \* **Give several examples** of OT scriptures using the Name **Yashua (Strong's # 3444)**: GEN 49:18; EXO 14:13, 15:1-2; DEU 32:15; ISA 2:1, 2SA 22:50, 1CH 16:23, 2CH 20:17, JOB 13:15, PSA 3:7, PSA 42:11, 44:4, 53:6, 62:1, 91:16, ISA 12:1, 26:1, 51:6, 52:7, 52:10, 59:16, 62:1, etc. 2CH 20:17 *Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the SALVATION (Yashua) of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.* (NKJ)

18. **Write out** the following scriptures using **actual Hebrew names**: PRO 18:10: *The name of YAHWEH is a strong tower; The righteous run to it and are safe.* (NKJ) GEN 4:26: *And as for Seth, to him also a son was born; and he named him Enosh. Then men began to call on the name of YAHWEH.* (NKJ) DEU 5:11: *'You shall not take the name of YAHWEH your God in vain, for YAHWEH not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.* (NKJ) PSA 116:13: *I will take up the cup of YAHSHUA (salvation), And call upon the name of YAHWEH.* (NKJ) JOE 2:32: *And it shall come to pass That whoever calls on the name of YAHWEH Shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, As the Lord has said, Among the remnant whom the Lord calls.* (NKJ) ISA 12:2: *Behold, EL is my YASHUA (salvation), I will trust and not be afraid; 'For YAH, YAHWEH, is my strength & song; He also has become my YAHSHUA (salvation).* (NKJ)
19. **T** **F** Whenever you see **'LORD'** in the **KJV Old Testament**, it corresponds to **'Yahweh'** in the Hebrew.  
**T** **F** Whenever you see **'Lord'** in the **KJV Old Testament**, it corresponds to **'Adonai'** in the Hebrew.  
**T** **F** Whenever you see **'God'** in the **KJV OT**, it corresponds to **'El, Eloah or Elohim'** in the Hebrew.  
**T** **F** Whenever you see **'God'** in the **KJV New Testament**, it corresponds to **'Theos'** in the Greek.  
**T** **F** Whenever you see **'Lord'** in the **KJV New Testament**, it corresponds to **'Kurios'** in the Greek.

20. **T** **F** **Bible names** typically convey meanings that add greatly to scripture interpretation and application.  
**T** **F** God's **NAME** in Hebrew is hWhy, which can be pronounced **Yahwah, Jehovah** and in other ways.  
**T** **F** Jesus' **NAME** in Hebrew is [wvy, which can be pronounced **Yahshua, Yeshuah** and in other ways.

For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever.* (NKJ) **What is the Hebrew word for 'salvation' here?** Strong's # 3444 = 'Yahshua'  
**Who IS this?** Yashua, who is Jesus the Messiah, IS Yahweh's Salvation !!!
22. Write out PRO 30:4: Who has ascended into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? WHAT IS HIS NAME, AND WHAT IS HIS SON'S NAME, IF YOU KNOW? (NKJ) \* **Now that you know about the names of God, YOU can answer this riddle from Solomon. What is the answer?** His name is YAHWEH, and His Son's name is YASHUA.
23. **Give scripture** showing that **Jesus IS the Father**: ISA 9:6 *For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.* (NKJ) JOH 14:8-11;
