John 14:10 "Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works." **Jesus here stated that it was the Father that was doing the work through his humanity. He did not have a split personality but simply expressed his union with the Father as the source of all his workings. Jesus also stated in Mark 10:17b,18; when a man stated to him, "Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life? Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God." Why did he say this? The simple truth is that he was only a man apart from the indwelling holy spirit of the Father. He was not born omnipotent into the womb of Mary. He was born a man and became a human being, helpless and without personal power of his own.**

In Acts 2:22-23 it states very clearly where Jesus's power to perform miracles came from; "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs which God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know-- , this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men." We see very plainly that all the works, wonders and signs Jesus did were performed by the Father working through the son. Jesus was the vessel, branch expression of the Father's power.

The Moon—His Chosen people reflecting His light to the world!
The Stars!—The sons of God!
The infinite star-studded Firmament—the unending Spirit World!

Floods—Increase of lies and deceptions carrying people away from the bedrock of truth!
