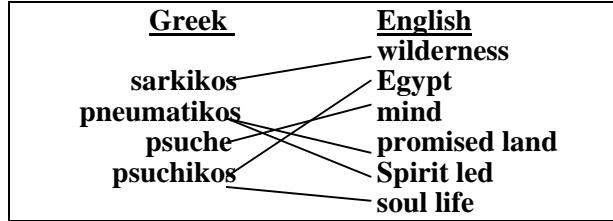
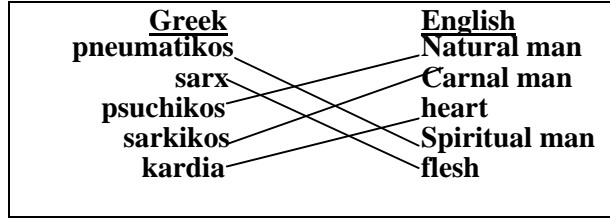

Questions: Natural, Carnal & Spiritual Man

1. Match the Greek words with their English meanings. Some may match more than once. One is already done.



- The Greek word for the **Natural Man** is psuchikos. **Strong's Number:** 5591
 The Greek word for the **Carnal Man** is sarkikos. **Strong's Number:** 4559
 The Greek word for the **Spiritual Man** is pneumatikos. **Strong's Number:** 4152
- The **Natural man** lives in Egypt, which is a type of the World.
 The **Carnal man** lives in the wilderness, under dominion of the flesh.
 The **Spiritual man** lives in the promised land, under dominion of the Spirit.
- The **"baby"**, **"child"** or **"immature"** Christian would be found in the wilderness.
 The **"adult"** or **"mature"** Christian would be found in the promised land.
 The **"flesh"** is composed of the unredeemed soul (psuche) and body (soma).
 The **"heart"** can be the human spirit or a combination of the spirit and the soul.
- JUD 17** But you, beloved, remember the words (rhemas) which were spoken before by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ: 18 how they told you that there would be mockers in the last time who would walk according to their own ungodly lusts. 19 These are sensual persons, who cause divisions, not having the Spirit. (NKJ)
 * **What is the Greek** word for the English word **'sensual'** above? Psuchikos – they are 'Natural Men'
 * **What is the Greek** word for the English word **'Spirit'** above? Pneuma – the Holy Spirit
- 1CO 2:12** Now we have received, not the **spirit of the world**, but the **Spirit who is from God**, that we might know the things that **have been** freely given to us by God. 13 These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 14 But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 15 But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one. 16 For "who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ. (NKJ)
- What** are the Greek words for the blanks in **verses 13 – 15** in Q6 above? Holy Spirit = Hagios pneuma; spiritual = pneumatikos; Natural man = psuchikos anthropos = the 'soul man'; Spirit = pneuma; spiritual = pneumatikos; mind = nous
- 1CO 3:1** And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ. 2 I fed you with milk and not with solid food; for until now you were not able to receive it, and even now you are still not able; 3 for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere (natural) men? (NKJ)
What is the Greek word for the 1st blank in **verse 1**? Spiritual = pneumatikos
What is the Greek word for the 2nd blank in **verse 1**? Carnal = sarkikos
What is the Greek word for the 1st 2 blanks in **verse 3**? Carnal = sarkikos
What is the Greek word for the 2nd 2 blanks in **verse 3**? Mere (natural) men = psuchikos anthropos
- ROM 7:14** For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am carnal, sold under sin. (NKJ)
What is the Greek in the 1st blank? Spiritual = pneumatikos In the 2nd? Carnal = sarkikos
- ROM 7:15** I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. 16 And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good. 17 As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. (NKJ)
- ROM 7:21** So I find this law at work: When I want to do good, evil is right there with me. 22 For in my inner man I delight in God's law; 23 but I see another law at work in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within my members. 24 What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? (NKJ)
- ROM 7:25** I thank God—through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin. (NKJ)
What is the Greek word for the blanks? mind= nous; flesh = sarx; sin = hamartia
- 1CO 15:44** it is sown a natural body (Gk= psuchikos soma), it is raised a spiritual body (Gk= pneumatikos soma). If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. 45 So it is written: "The first man Adam became a living soul" (Gk= zoe psuche); the last Adam, a life-giving spirit (Gk= zoepoieo pneuma). 46 The spiritual (Gk= pneumatikos) did not come first, but the natural (Gk= psuchikos), and after that the spiritual. (NIV)

15. **GAL 6:1** Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted. (NKJ) **Greek for 'spiritual'** = pneumatikos **Should** or can a carnal Christian (**Sarkikos**) restore a believer who sins? No. Only a Pneumatikos is qualified
16. **1CO 12:1** Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant. (NKJ) **Greek** for both blanks: pneumatikos (gifts is in italics in KJV & NKJ, indicating it was added by translators)
17. **COL 1:9** For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10 that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; (NKJ) **Greek for blanks:** knowledge = epignosis; spiritual = pneumatikos
18. **ROM 1:11** For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift, so that you may be established (NKJ) **Greek for blanks:** spiritual = pneumatikos; gift = charisma
19. **ROM 8:13** For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. 14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. (NKJ)
20. **T F** The **Natural Man** is unsaved, does not know Christ, and has no spiritual connection to God.
T F To the **Natural Man**, spiritual matters are foolishness, because they make no rational sense to the mind.
T F In OT typology, the **Natural Man** lives in slavery in Egypt under Pharaoh, representing those in the world under Satan, who are in bondage to sin.
T F The Greek term for the **Natural Man** is '**psuchikos**' (**psuche** = soul), showing that the highest aspect of his understanding is through the mind or soul. This man lives only by his 'wits' and natural senses.
T F The **Natural Man** is blinded to true spiritual reality, even the nature and operation of good and evil.
T F The **Natural Man's** approach to life is one of '**works**', either good or bad. He knows nothing of grace.
21. **T F** The **Carnal Man** has been born again by the Spirit, but is still living like a **Natural Man**, in the flesh.
T F The **Carnal Man** has not yet by the Spirit put to death the deeds or life of the flesh.
T F The **Carnal Man** is 'double-minded', serving God at times by Satan at other times.
T F In OT typology, the **Carnal Man** is still wandering around in the wilderness. God is trying to get him on into the promised land, which is holiness
T F The **Carnal Man** is a baby Christian, not yet matured into a full son of daughter of God.
T F The Greek term for **Carnal Man** is '**sarkikos**', from '**sarx**', the Greek word for '**flesh**'.
T F The **Carnal Man** is 'in Christ', but Christ has not as yet been fully formed in the **Carnal Man**.
22. **T F** The **Spiritual Man** is born of the Spirit and has by the Spirit crucified the flesh or sin nature in his life.
T F The **Spiritual Man** is no longer tossed to and fro by every wind of doctrine, but has matured spiritually.
T F In OT typology, the **Spiritual Man** is in the **Promised Land**, victorious over his enemies and advancing the purposes of God in the world.
T F The **Spiritual Man** lives in holiness, as God is holy.
T F The **Spiritual Man**, not the **Carnal Man**, is qualified to restore a believer caught in a sin.
T F The **Spiritual Man** is '**in Christ**', and Christ is also in the man.
T F The Greek term for **Spiritual Man** is '**pneumatikos**', from '**pneuma**', the Greek word for '**spirit**'.
23. **Write out JOH 14:26:** "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you ALL THINGS, and bring to your remembrance ALL THINGS that I said to you. (NKJ)
*** Write out 1JO 2:20:** But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know ALL THINGS. (NKJ)
*** Write out 1JO 2:27:** But the anointing (of the Holy Spirit) which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning ALL THINGS, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him. (NKJ)
*** 1CO 2:12-16** Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.13 These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.14 But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.15 But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one.16 For "who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" 24. **T F** The lusts of the flesh war against the soul. **Reference:** 1PE 2:11
T F The **Spiritual Man** has the mind of Christ. **Reference:** 1CO 2:16
T F The **Carnal Man** is double-minded, having **BOTH** the mind of the flesh and of the Spirit, and is therefore unstable in all he does. **Reference:** JAM 1:8
