

6-C Questions: In Christ Realities

1. **MATCH** the Greek words and their English meanings. Some words match more than once. One is already done as an example:

Greek	English
<i>christos</i>	Messiah
(<i>Heb</i>) <i>messiach</i>	Christ
<i>en</i>	moving into, toward
<i>ek, ex</i>	in, at rest within
<i>eis</i>	out of, away from

<i>kaleo</i>	a called-out assembly, church
<i>sperma</i>	body
<i>soma</i>	seed, semen

2. Write out **JOH 1:4**: IN HIM was life, and the life was the light of men.
3. **JOH 15:5** "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in me, and I in him, bears much **fruit**; for without Me you can do nothing. 6 "If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. 7 "If you abide in me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.
4. From **JOH 15:7** above, what is the **MAIN** way He abides in you? Through His WORD in us
Which bears the fruit, the vine or the branch? The branch Which are you? I am a branch
Can the branch bear fruit if it is not attached to the vine? No. Life & fruit come through the vine.
Does this fact meant anything to you? I must abide continually IN HIM to bear fruit & have life.
What are the **nine fruit (and scripture reference)** of the Spirit that you should bear while abiding in the vine? The FRUIT of the spirit are Love (agapao), joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, fathfulness, meekness, & self control. (GAL 5:22-23)
5. What did **Smith Wigglesworth** do and see as he was walking along the beach one day that illustrated to him how **YOU** can both abide **in Christ** and He also **IN YOU**? He threw a bottle into the ocean, And noted that the ocean filled the bottle, and yet the bottle was complete immersed in the ocean. This illustrated to him how we can abide IN HIM and He also IN US, both at the same time!
6. **HEB 4:14** Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession (confession).
What is the Greek word and its meaning for the last blank in this scripture? Homologeo--saying continually the same thing as the LOGOS, the Word of God.
HOW does this scripture apply to "in Christ" realities for me? I, too, should be continually saying the SAME thing as the Word of God. This is walking in AGREEMENT with Him, the Word.

12. Write out **JOS 1:8**: "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success."
13. **HOW** often are we to meditate on the Law (Word of God)? day & night = constantly !!!
WHERE is the Law (Word of God) while we meditate on it? In our mouths -- confessed constantly
WHAT must we do IN ADDITION to meditation on the Word? DO the Word (obey completely)
WHAT will be the final result? My way will become prosperous, good, and successful !!
14. **PSA 1:1** Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; 2 But his delight is in the Law of the LORD, And in His Law he meditates day and night. 3 He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.
15. **PSA 45:1** My heart is overflowing with a good theme; I recite my composition concerning the King; My tongue is the pen of a ready writer. 2 You are fairer than the sons of men; grace is poured upon Your lips; Therefore God has blessed You forever.
16. Onto **WHAT** does the tongue, as a pen, write? my heart **WHAT** is the function of that part of your being? to believe what is written on my heart by MY tongue; it then comes to pass. **WHY** must BOTH of these parts of your being agree with God's Word for these truths to become a reality in your life? Because what I believe with my heart and confess with my mouth comes to pass
17. **T F** **One** helpful way to experience personally the reality of the "**in Christ**" Bible truths is to constantly **CONFESS** what God's Word says of me "**in Christ**", or "**through Christ**", etc. My confession **MUST** line up with God's Word or I will not experience its **REALITY** in my life.
18. Write out **HEB 4:14**: Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our CONFESSIOIN.
Write out **HEB 3:1**: Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus,
What is the Gk word for "confess" in **HEB 14:4** and for "confession" in **HEB 3:1**? Homologea
What is the meaning of this Greek word? To SAY continually the SAME as the LOGOS.
19. Write out **ROM 8:1-2**: There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.
20. Write out **PHI 4:13**: I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.
Write out **PHI 4:19**: my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
Write out **COL 1:17**: And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.
21. Write out **COL 2:3**: in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
Write out **EPH 6:10**: Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.
Write out **EPH 3:12**: in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.
22. Write out **2TI 2:11**: This is a faithful saying: For if we died with Him, We shall also live with Him.
Write out **2TI 2:12**: If we endure, We shall also reign with Him. If we deny Him, He also will deny us.
Write out **2TI 2:13**: If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.
23. Write out **1JO 5:14**: Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.
Write out **GAL 2:20**: "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
Write out **HEB 7:25**: Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
24. **CLASS ASSIGNMENT**: Select 5-10 of the "in Him", etc. scriptures in the handout (see Q 20-23), and copy them onto small cards that you can carry in your pocket or purse. Tape then on mirrors, cabinets, your refrigerator, etc., and **MEMORIZE** them. **PERSONALIZE** them as you **Confess and meditate** on these truths **NIGHT AND DAY** to get them down in your spirit. Let your **TONGUE** be the pen of a ready writer on the tablet of your **HEART** (see Q # 15-16). Make this a **LIFE HABIT**. This practice will bless your life immeasurably.
