1. **MATCH** the Greek words and their English meanings:

2. **MAT 27:11** Meanwhile Jesus stood before the governor, and the governor asked him, "Are you the King OF THE Jews?" "Yes, it is as you say," Jesus replied.
What is the acrostic for the Hebrew phrase "Jesus of Nazareth the King of the Jews"? YHWH (Jehovah)
Who is this acrostic name? Jesus Himself--The "I am", first revealed in the Old Testament
3. Write out **1CO 15:46**: However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual.
 Write out **ROM 2:28-29**: For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh; 29 but he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God.
Are you a Spiritual Jew? All Christians are spiritual Jews Are you a **Natural Jew**? Few are natural Jews
4. **ROM 9:6** But it is not that the word of God has taken no effect. For they are not all Israel who are of Israel, 7 nor are they all children because they are the seed of Abraham; but, "In Isaac your seed shall be called." 8 That is, those who are the children of the flesh, these are not the children of God; but the children of the promise are counted as the seed. (NKJ)
5. **Where** is Paul quoting from in verse 7? **GEN 21:12** But God said to Abraham, "Do not let it be displeasing in your sight because of the lad or because of your bondwoman. Whatever Sarah has said to you, listen to her voice; FOR IN ISAAC YOUR SEED SHALL BE CALLED. (NKJ)
What is the Greek word for "**seed**" in Paul's quote from Genesis? Sperma--seed
6. **GEN 22:17** That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies; 18 And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice. (KJV)
7. Who are the **sand seed** of Abraham? The natural, physical, or fleshy descendants of Abraham-- Natural Jews
 The **star seed**? The spiritual descendants of Abraham, after the FAITH of Abraham--the Spiritual Jews
Which are you? All Christians are starseed; spiritual seed or descendants of Abraham, & heirs of his promises
8. **HEB 11:11** By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised. 12 Therefore from one man, and him as good as dead, were born as many as the stars of the sky in multitude—innumerable as the sand which is by the seashore. (NKJ)
9. **Who ELSE** does the "**one man, and him as good as dead**" represent? Explain. Jesus is the ONE MAN and Him as good as dead, from whom are born BOTH the sandseed AND the starseed.
What is the Greek word here for "**seed**"? sperma--plant seed, semen, the children or offspring so produced
Does Sarah represent a type of **the Woman** in **GEN 3:15**? Sarah is one type of the woman whose seed will crush the seed of the serpent. The woman represents the CHURCH, the bride (EVE) of the second Adam.
10. **What** is the Hebrew term for the ceremony of circumcision? Brit Milah **What** does the term mean? To cut off the flesh (Brit = to cut, Milah = flesh) **When** is it done? On the 8th day after birth
When is the "eighth day of creation"? Corresponds to Sunday, the day after the Sabbath, which also corresponds to the time or day AFTER the millenium--The millenium is the 7th day, the Sabbath.
What is the name of the person who does the circumcision? Mohel **Who** does your circumcision? Jesus does our circumcision--cutting off the flesh **Give** scripture reference: COL 2:11-13
11. **COL 2:10** and you are complete **in Him**, who is the head of all principality and power. 11 **In Him** you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision **of Christ**, 12 buried **with Him** in baptism, in which you also were raised **with Him** through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. (NKJ)

12. **What** is the gematria of the Greek name of Jesus, **Jesus**? 888 **What** might this mean? Jesus is our Mohel--who circumcises us. This will be completed on the 8th creation day, after the millenium.
What day of the week is the "eighth day"? Sunday **What 2 Jewish feasts** occur on the "morrow after the Sabbath", i.e. the eighth day? The Feast of firstfruits (HaBikkurim) & The Feast of Pentecost (Shavuot)
13. At what age was **Abraham** circumcised? 99 years old **Give** reference: GEN 17:24
On this day, God changed his name from Abram "exalted father" to Abraham "father of a multitude"
 At what age was **Ishmael** circumcised? Age 13 years **Give** reference: GEN 17:25
Ishmael's name was changed to: From Ishmael ("God will hear) to Edom (derived from adam = "red, ruddy, red earth". Gen 25:30, 36:1,8, 19
When does a **Bar Mitzvah** occur & why? At age 13 years, when a child becomes aman, and submits himself to God's Law, is responsible to keep the law, and participates in community worship.
14. At what age was **Isaac** circumcised? At 8 days of age **Give** reference: GEN 21:3-4
When did Isaac receive his name? He was named Isaac ("laughter") at his circumcision on the 8th day
 At what age was **Jesus** circumcised? On the 8th day after His birth **Give** reference: LUK 2:21-23
When did Jesus receive His Name? On the day of His circumcision, the 8th day after His birth.
15. **Who** was the first Jew? Abraham,, who was circumcised after he believed God.
Who is the seed promised to Abraham and Sarah? Christ Jesus: GAL 3:16-18 (then thru v 29)
16. **When** was the nation of Israel "born"? When they left Egypt, let by Moses, towards the promised land
 On **What** Jewish feast did this occur? On Passover (Pesach), which marks the very day they left Egypt
 On **What** day of the week is this feast? Passover is always either a weekly or a special Sabbath
17. **When** was the nation of Israel 're-born'? When they received the Law at Mount Sinai thru Moses on Pentecost
 On **What** Jewish feast did this occur? On Pentecost (Shavuot), exactly 50 days after Passover
 On **What** day of the week is this feast? On a Sunday, the 8th day, the morrow after the 7th Sabbath
18. **ISA 66:7** Before she travailed, she brought forth; before her pain came, she was delivered of a male child. 8 Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? or shall a nation be born at once? for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children. 9 Shall I bring to the birth, and not cause to bring forth? saith the LORD: shall I cause to bring forth, and shut the womb? saith thy God. (KJV)

21. Write out **MAT 15:24**: But He answered & said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.
 Write out **GAL 3:29**: And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, & heirs according to the promise.
22. **MAT 5:17** "Do not think that I came to destroy the law or the prophets. I did not come to destroy (the Law) but to fulfill. 18 "For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled. (NKJ)
Write out **ROM 10:4**: For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes. (NKJ)
23. Write out **2CO 3:6**: who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life. (NKJ)
24. **ROM 7:1** Or do you not know, brethren (I speak to those who know the law), that the law has dominion over a man as long as he lives? 4 Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another— to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God. 5 For when we were in the flesh, the sinful passions which were aroused by the law were at work in our members to bear fruit to death. 6 But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter (of the law). (NKJ)
