Psalm 91:1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. 2 **I will SAY of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."** 3 Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. 4 He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart. 5 You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, 6 nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday. 7 A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you. 8 You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked. 9 **If you make the Most High your dwelling— even the LORD, who is my refuge—** 10 **then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent.** 11 **For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;** 12 they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone. 13 You will tread upon the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent. 14 **"Because he loves me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.** 15 He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. 16 With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation."

1. **EXO 14:19** Then **the angel of God,** who had been traveling in front of Israel's army, withdrew and went behind them. The pillar of cloud also moved from in front and stood behind them, 20 coming between the armies of Egypt and Israel. Throughout the night the cloud brought darkness to the one side and light to the other side; so neither went near the other all night long.
2. **EXO 23:20** **"See, I am sending an angel ahead of you to guard you along the way and to bring you to the place I have prepared.** 21 Pay attention to him and listen to what he says. Do not rebel against him; he will not forgive your rebellion, since my Name is in him. 22 If you listen carefully to what he says and do all that I say, I will be an enemy to your enemies and will oppose those who oppose you.
3. **DEU 1:30** **The LORD your God,** who is going before you, **will fight for you,** as he did for you in Egypt, before your very eyes,
4. **DEU 33:26** "There is no one like the God of Jeshurun, who rides on the heavens to help you and on the clouds in his majesty. 27 **The eternal God is your refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms. He will drive out your enemy before you, saying, 'Destroy him!'**
5. **2CH 20:17** **You will not have to fight this battle.** Take up your positions; **stand firm and see the deliverance the LORD will give you,** O Judah and Jerusalem. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the LORD will be with you."
6. **2CH 32:21** And **the LORD sent an angel, who annihilated all the fighting men and the leaders and officers in the camp** of the Assyrian king. So he withdrew to his own land in disgrace. And when he went into the temple of his god, some of his sons cut him down with the sword.

7. **JOB 5:17** **"Blessed is the man whom God corrects; so do not despise the discipline of the Almighty.** 18 For **he wounds, but he also binds up; he injures, but his hands also heal.** 19 From six calamities he will rescue you; in seven no harm will befall you. 20 In famine he will ransom you from death, and in battle from the stroke of the sword. 21 You will be protected from the lash of the tongue, and need not fear when destruction comes. 22 You will laugh at destruction and famine, and need not fear the beasts of the earth. 23 For you will have a covenant with the stones of the field, and the wild animals will be at peace with you. 24 You will know that your tent is secure; you will take stock of your property and find nothing missing. 25 You will know that your children will be many, and your descendants like the grass of the earth. 26 You will come to the grave in full vigor, like sheaves gathered in season. 27 **"We have examined this, and it is true. So hear it and apply it to yourself."**

8. **JOB 11:18** You will be secure, because there is hope; you will look about you and take your rest in safety. 19 You will lie down, with no one to make you afraid, and many will court your favor.
9. **PSA 4:8** **I will lie down and sleep in peace, for you alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety.**
10. **Psalm 17:8** Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings 9 from the wicked who assail me, from my mortal enemies who surround me.
11. **PSA 18:32** **It is God who arms me with strength and makes my way perfect.**
12. **PSA 25:14** **THE LORD CONFIDES IN THOSE WHO FEAR HIM; HE MAKES HIS COVENANT KNOWN TO THEM.**
13. **PSA 27:1** **The LORD is my light and my salvation - whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life - of whom shall I be afraid?** 2 When evil men advance against me to devour my flesh, when my enemies and my foes attack me, they will stumble and fall.
14. **PSA 31:19** **How great is your goodness, which you have stored up for those who fear you,** which you bestow in the sight of men on those who take refuge in you. 20 In the shelter of your presence you hide them from the intrigues of men; in your dwelling you keep them safe from accusing tongues.
15. **PSA 34:4** **I sought the LORD, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.** 7 The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them. **19 A righteous man may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all;** 20 he protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.

16. **PSA 46:1** **God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.**
17. **PSA 56:11** **in God I trust; I will not be afraid.** What can man do to me?
18. **PSA 97:10** **Let those who love the LORD hate evil, for he guards the lives of his faithful ones and delivers them from the hand of the wicked.**
19. **PSA 103:20** Praise the LORD, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word.
20. **PSA 107:20** **He sent forth his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave.**
21. **PSA 111:10** The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow his precepts have good understanding. To him belongs eternal praise.
22. **PSA 121:7** **The LORD will keep you from all harm - he will watch over your life; 8 the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.**
23. **PSA 125:2** As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds his people both now and forevermore.
24. **PRO 1:33** but whoever listens to me will live in safety and be at ease, without fear of harm."
25. **PRO 2:1** My son, **if you accept my words and store up my commands within you,** 2 turning your ear to wisdom and applying your heart to understanding, 3 and if you call out for insight and cry aloud for understanding, 4 and if you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure, 5 **then you will understand the fear of the LORD** and find the knowledge of God.
26. **PRO 3:24** **when you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your sleep will be sweet. 25 Have no fear of sudden disaster or of the ruin that overtakes the wicked, 26 for the LORD will be your confidence and will keep your foot from being snared.**
27. **PRO 18:10** **The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.**
28. **PRO 29:25** Fear of man will prove to be a snare, but **whoever trusts in the LORD is kept safe.**
29. **ISA 26:3** **You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you.** 4 Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD, the LORD, is the Rock eternal.
30. **ISA 41:10** **So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.**
31. **ISA 43:1** But now, this is what the LORD says - he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "**Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. 2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.**
32. **ISA 51:11** **The ransomed of the LORD will return. They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.**
33. **ISA 54:17** **NO weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you.** This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and this is their vindication from me," declares the LORD.
34. **Isaiah 66:24** "And they will go out and look upon the dead bodies of those who rebelled against me; their worm will not die, nor will their fire be quenched, and they will be loathsome to all mankind."
35. **MAL 4:2** But **for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings.** And you will go out and leap like calves released from the stall.
36. **MAT 18:10** "See that you do not look down on one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven.
37. **MAT 26:53** Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels?
38. **LUK 12:7** Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.
39. **ROM 8:31** What, then, shall we say in response to this? **If God is for us, who can be against us?**
40. **ROM 8:37** **No, in ALL these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.**
41. **ROM 16:20** **The God of peace will soon crush Satan under YOUR feet.** The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.
42. **1CO 10:13** No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And **God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.**
43. **2TH 3:3** But **the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.**
44. **2TI 1:7** For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.
45. **2TI 4:18** **The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom.** To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
46. **COL 2:15** And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.
47. **HEB 1:14** **Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?**
48. **HEB 2:18** **Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.**
49. **HEB 13:2** Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it.
50. **HEB 13:6** So **we SAY with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?"**
51. **IPE 3:12** For **the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil.**" 13 Who is going to harm you if you are eager to do good?
