

1. **GEN 2:15** **The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden TO WORK IT and take care of it.**
2. **GEN 8:22** **"As long as the earth endures, SEEDTIME AND HARVEST, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night WILL NEVER CEASE."**
3. **GEN 12:1** **The LORD had said to Abram, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you. 2 "I will make you into a great nation and I WILL BLESS YOU; I WILL MAKE YOUR NAME GREAT, AND YOU WILL BE A BLESSING. 3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and ALL PEOPLES ON EARTH WILL BE BLESSED THROUGH YOU."**
4. **GEN 24:34** So he (Eleazer) said, "I am Abraham's servant. 35 **The LORD has blessed my master abundantly, and HE HAS BECOME WEALTHY. He has given him sheep and cattle, silver and gold, menservants and maidservants, and camels and donkeys.**
5. **GEN 26:1** Now **there was a famine in the land**—besides the earlier famine of Abraham's time—and Isaac went to Abimelech king of the Philistines in Gerar. 2 **The LORD appeared to Isaac and said, "DO NOT GO DOWN TO EGYPT; live in the land where I tell you to live. 3 Stay in this land for a while, and I will be with you and will bless you.** For to you and your descendants I will give all these lands and will confirm the oath I swore to your father Abraham. 4 I will make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and will give them all these lands, and **through your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed, 5 because Abraham obeyed me and kept my requirements, my commands, my decrees and my laws.**" 6 So Isaac stayed in Gerar. 12 **ISAAC PLANTED CROPS IN THAT LAND AND THE SAME YEAR REAPED A HUNDREDFOLD, because the LORD blessed him. 13 The man became rich, and his WEALTH continued to grow until he became VERY WEALTHY. 14 He had so many flocks and herds and servants that THE PHILISTINES ENVIED HIM.**
6. **GEN 30:43** **In this way THE MAN (JACOB) GREW EXCEEDINGLY PROSPEROUS and came to own large flocks, and maidservants and menservants, and camels and donkeys.**
7. **GEN 39:1** Now Joseph had been taken down to Egypt. Potiphar, an Egyptian who was one of Pharaoh's officials, the captain of the guard, bought him from the Ishmaelites who had taken him there. 2 **THE LORD WAS WITH JOSEPH AND HE PROSPERED, and he lived in the house of his Egyptian master. 3 When his master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD gave him success in everything he did, 4 Joseph found favor in his eyes and became his attendant. POTIPHAR PUT HIM IN CHARGE OF HIS HOUSEHOLD, and He Entrusted To His Care EVERYTHING HE OWNED. 5 From the time he put him in charge of his household and of all that he owned, the LORD blessed the household of the Egyptian because of Joseph. The blessing of the LORD was on everything Potiphar had, both in the house and in the field.**
8. **GEN 41:29** **SEVEN YEARS OF GREAT ABUNDANCE are coming throughout the land of Egypt, 30 but SEVEN YEARS OF FAMINE WILL FOLLOW THEM. Then all the abundance in Egypt will be forgotten, and the famine will ravage the land. 39 Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Since God has made all this known to you, there is no one so discerning and wise as you, 40 You shall be in charge of my palace, and all my people are to submit to your orders. Only with respect to the throne will I be greater than you." 47 During the seven years of abundance the land produced plentifully. 48 Joseph collected all the food produced in those seven years of abundance in Egypt and stored it in the cities. In each city he put the food grown in the fields surrounding it. 53 THE SEVEN YEARS OF ABUNDANCE IN EGYPT CAME TO AN END, 54 and the SEVEN YEARS OF FAMINE BEGAN, just as Joseph had said. There was famine in all the other lands, but in the whole land of Egypt there was food. 57 And all the countries came to Egypt to buy grain from Joseph, because the famine was severe in all the world.**
9. **EXO 22:7** **"If a man gives his neighbor silver or goods for safekeeping and they are stolen from the neighbor's house, THE THIEF, if he is caught, must pay back double.**
10. **EXO 22:25** **"If you lend money to one of my people among you who is needy, do not be like a moneylender; charge him no interest.**
11. **EXO 36:6** Then **Moses gave an order and they sent this word throughout the camp: "No man or woman is to make anything else as an offering for the sanctuary." And so the people were restrained from bringing more, 7 because what they already had was MORE THAN ENOUGH to do all the work. (of building the Tabernacle in the Wilderness)**
12. **LEV 19:13** **"Do not defraud your neighbor or rob him. "Do not hold back the wages of a hired man overnight.**

13. **LEV 25:23** "The land must not be sold permanently, because the land is mine and YOU are but aliens and my tenants. (stewards!)"
14. **LEV 26:3** "If you follow my decrees and are careful to obey my commands, 4 I will send you rain in its season, and the ground will yield its crops and the trees of the field their fruit. 5 Your threshing will continue until grape harvest and the grape harvest will continue until planting, and you will eat all the food you want and live in safety in your land. 6 "I will grant peace in the land, and you will lie down and no one will make you afraid. I will remove savage beasts from the land, and the sword will not pass through your country. 7 You will pursue your enemies, and they will fall by the sword before you. 8 Five of you will chase a hundred, and a hundred of you will chase ten thousand, and your enemies will fall by the sword before you. 9 "I will look on you with favor and make you fruitful and increase your numbers, and I will keep my covenant with you. 10 You will still be eating last year's harvest when you will have to move it out to make room for the new. 11 I will put my dwelling place among you, and I will not abhor you. 12 I will walk among you and be your God, and you will be my people. 13 I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt so that you would no longer be slaves to the Egyptians; I broke the bars of your yoke and enabled you to walk with heads held high.
15. **LEV 27:30** "A TITHE of everything from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, BELONGS TO THE LORD; IT IS HOLY TO THE LORD. 32 The entire TITHE of the herd and flock--every tenth animal that passes under the shepherd's rod--will be HOLY to the LORD.
16. **DEU 7:9** Know therefore that the LORD your God is God; **HE IS THE FAITHFUL GOD, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commands.**
17. **DEU 8:18** "And you shall remember the Lord your God, for IT IS HE WHO GIVES YOU POWER TO GET WEALTH, THAT HE MAY ESTABLISH HIS COVENANT which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.
18. **DEU 15:11** There will always be poor people in the land. Therefore I COMMAND YOU to be openhanded toward your brothers and toward the poor and needy in your land.
19. **DEU 23:20** You may charge a foreigner interest, but NOT a brother Israelite, so that the LORD your God may bless you in everything you put your hand to in the land you are entering to possess. 21 If you make a vow to the LORD your God, do not be slow to pay it, for the LORD your God will certainly demand it of you and you will be guilty of sin.
20. **DEU 26:1** When you have entered the land the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance and have taken possession of it and settled in it, 2 take some of the FIRSTFRUITS of all that you produce from the soil of the land the LORD your God is giving you and put them in a basket. Then go to the place the LORD your God will choose as a dwelling for his 13 Then SAY to the LORD your God: "I have removed from my house THE SACRED PORTION and have given it to the Levite, the alien, the fatherless and the widow, according to all you commanded. I have not turned aside from your commands nor have I forgotten any of them. 14 I have not eaten any of the sacred portion while I was in mourning, nor have I removed any of it while I was unclean, nor have I offered any of it to the dead. I have obeyed the LORD my God; I have done everything you commanded me. 15 LOOK DOWN FROM HEAVEN, YOUR HOLY DWELLING PLACE, AND BLESS YOUR PEOPLE ISRAEL AND THE LAND YOU HAVE GIVEN US AS YOU PROMISED ON OATH TO OUR FOREFATHERS, A LAND FLOWING WITH MILK AND HONEY."
21. **DEU 28:1** If you fully obey the LORD your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations on earth. 2 All these blessings will come upon you and accompany you if you obey the LORD your God: 3 You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country. 4 The fruit of your womb will be blessed, and the crops of your land and the young of your livestock—the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks. 5 Your basket and your kneading trough will be blessed. 6 You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out. 7 The LORD will grant that the enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you. They will come at you from one direction but flee from you in seven. 8 The LORD will send a blessing on your barns and on everything you put your hand to. The LORD your God will bless you in the land he is giving you. 9 The LORD will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways. 10 Then all the peoples on earth WILL SEE that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they will fear you. 11 The LORD will grant you ABUNDANT PROSPERITY—in the fruit of your womb, the young of your livestock and the crops of your ground—in the land he swore to your forefathers to give you. 12 The LORD will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many nations but will borrow from none. 13 The LORD will make you the head, not the tail. If you pay attention to the commands of the LORD your God that I give you this day and carefully

follow them, **you will always be at the top, never at the bottom.** **14 Do not turn aside from any of the commands I give you today, to the right or to the left,** following other gods and serving them.

22. **DEU 30:19** This day I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you that **I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses.** **Now choose life,** so that you and your children may live 20 and that you may love the LORD your God, listen to his voice, and hold fast to him. **For the LORD is your life,** and he will give you many years in the land he swore to give to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.
23. **JOS 1:3** **I will give you every place where you set your foot,** as I promised Moses.
24. **JOS 1:8** **This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night,** that thou mayest observe to **do according to all that is written therein:** for **then thou shalt make thy way PROSPEROUS, and then thou shalt have GOOD SUCCESS.**
25. **1KI 2:1** When the time drew near for **David** to die, he **gave a charge to Solomon his son.** 2 "I am about to go the way of all the earth," he said. "So **be strong, show yourself a man,** 3 and **observe what the LORD your God requires: Walk in his ways, and keep his decrees and commands, his laws and requirements, as written in the Law of Moses, so that you may PROSPER in all you do and wherever you go.**

26. **1KI 10:1** **When the queen of Sheba heard about the fame of Solomon and his relation to the name of the LORD, she came to test him with hard questions.** 2 Arriving at Jerusalem with a very great caravan—with camels carrying spices, large quantities of gold, and precious stones—she came to Solomon and talked with him about all that she had on her mind. 3 **Solomon answered all her questions; nothing was too hard for the king to explain to her.** 4 **When the queen of Sheba saw all the wisdom of Solomon and the palace he had built,** 5 **the food on his table, the seating of his officials, the attending servants in their robes, his cupbearers, and the burnt offerings he made at the temple of the LORD, she was overwhelmed.** 6 **She said to the king,** "The report I heard in my own country about your achievements and your wisdom is true. 7 **But I did not believe these things until I came and saw with my own eyes. Indeed, not even half was told me; in wisdom and wealth you have far exceeded the report I heard.** 8 How happy your men must be! How happy your officials, who continually stand before you and hear your wisdom! 9 **Praise be to the LORD your God, who has delighted in you and placed you on the throne of Israel.** Because of the LORD's eternal love for Israel, he has made you king, to maintain justice and righteousness." 10 **And she gave the king 120 talents of gold, large quantities of spices, and precious stones.** Never again were so many spices brought in as those the queen of Sheba gave to King Solomon. 11 (Hiram's ships brought gold from Ophir; and from there they brought great cargoes of almugwood and precious stones. 12 The king used the almugwood to make supports for the temple of the LORD and for the royal palace, and to make harps and lyres for the musicians. So much almugwood has never been imported or seen since that day.) 13 King Solomon gave the queen of Sheba all she desired and asked for, besides what he had given her out of his royal bounty. Then she left and returned with her retinue to her own country. 14 **The weight of the gold that Solomon received yearly was 666 talents (about 1.75 million ounces -- worth about 550 million dollars),** 15 **not including the revenues from merchants and traders and from all the Arabian kings and the governors of the land.** 16 King Solomon made two hundred large shields of hammered gold; six hundred bekas of gold went into each shield. 17 He also made three hundred small shields of hammered gold, with three minas of gold in each shield. The king put them in the Palace of the Forest of Lebanon. 18 Then the king made a great throne inlaid with ivory and overlaid with fine gold. 19 The throne had six steps, and its back had a rounded top. On both sides of the seat were armrests, with a lion standing beside each of them. 20 Twelve lions stood on the six steps, one at either end of each step. Nothing like it had ever been made for any other kingdom. 21 **All King Solomon's goblets were gold, and all the household articles in the Palace of the Forest of Lebanon were pure gold. Nothing was made of silver, because silver was considered of little value in Solomon's days.** 22 **The king had a fleet of trading ships at sea along with the ships of Hiram. Once every three years it returned, carrying gold, silver and ivory, and apes and baboons.** 23 **King Solomon was greater in riches and wisdom than all the other kings of the earth.** 24 **The whole world sought audience with Solomon to hear the wisdom God had put in his heart.** 25 **Year after year, everyone who came brought a gift—articles of silver and gold, robes, weapons and spices, and horses and mules.** 26 **Solomon accumulated chariots and horses; he had fourteen hundred chariots and twelve thousand horses, which he kept in the chariot cities and also with him in Jerusalem.** 27 **The king made silver as common in Jerusalem as stones, and cedar as plentiful as sycamore-fig trees in the foothills.** 28 Solomon's horses were imported from Egypt and from Kue—the royal merchants purchased them from Kue. 29 They imported a chariot from Egypt for six hundred shekels of silver, and a horse for a hundred and fifty. They also exported them to all the kings of the Hittites and of the Arameans.

27. **1KI 17:8** Then **the word of the LORD came to him (Elijah):** 9 **"Go at once to Zarephath** of Sidon and stay there. **I have commanded a widow in that place to supply you with food.**" 10 So he went to Zarephath. **When he came to the town gate, a widow was there gathering sticks. He called to her and asked,** "Would you bring me a little water in a jar so I may have a drink?" 11 As she was going to get it, he

called, "And bring me, please, a piece of bread." 12 "As surely as the LORD your God lives," she replied, "I don't have any bread--only a handful of flour in a jar and a little oil in a jug. I am gathering a few sticks to take home and make a meal for myself and my son, that we may eat it--and die." 13 Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. But first make a small cake of bread for me from what you have and bring it to me, and then make something for yourself and your son. 14 For THIS is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: 'The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the LORD gives rain on the land.'" 15 She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. 16 For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, IN KEEPING WITH THE WORD OF THE LORD spoken by Elijah.

28. 2KI 4:1 The wife of a man from the company of the prophets cried out to Elisha, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that he revered the LORD. But now his creditor is coming to take my two boys as his slaves." 2 Elisha replied to her, "How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house (do you have any seed)?" "Your servant has nothing there at all," she said, "except a little oil." 3 Elisha said, "Go around and ASK ALL YOUR NEIGHBORS FOR EMPTY JARS. DON'T ASK FOR JUST A FEW. 4 Then go inside and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour oil into all the jars, and as each is filled, put it to one side." 5 She left him and afterward shut the door behind her and her sons. They brought the jars to her and SHE KEPT POURING. 6 When all the jars were full, she said to her son, "Bring me another one." But he replied, "There is not a jar left." Then the oil stopped flowing. 7 She went and told the man of God, and he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debts. You and your sons can live on what is left."
29. 1CH 29:11 Yours, O LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for EVERYTHING IN HEAVEN AND EARTH IS YOURS. Yours, O LORD, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all. 12 WEALTH and HONOR come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all.
30. 1CH 29:28 He (David) died at a good old age, having enjoyed LONG LIFE, WEALTH and HONOR. His son Solomon succeeded him as king.
31. 2CH 1:7 That night God appeared to Solomon and said to him, "Ask for whatever you want me to give you." 8 Solomon answered God, "You have shown great kindness to David my father and have made me king in his place. 9 Now, LORD God, let your promise to my father David be confirmed, for you have made me king over a people who are as numerous as the dust of the earth. 10 GIVE ME WISDOM AND KNOWLEDGE, that I may lead this people, for who is able to govern this great people of yours?" 11 God said to Solomon, "Since this is your heart's desire and you have not asked for WEALTH, riches or honor, nor for the death of your enemies, and since you have not asked for a long life but for wisdom and knowledge to govern my people over whom I have made you king, 12 therefore WISDOM AND KNOWLEDGE WILL BE GIVEN YOU. And I will also give you WEALTH, RICHES AND HONOR, such as no king who was before you ever had and none after you will have."
32. 2CH 18:1a Now JEHOSHAPHAT HAD GREAT WEALTH AND HONOR.....
33. 2CH 20:20 And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye PROSPER.
34. 2CH 26:4 And he (Uzziah = 'my strength is Jehovah) did that which was right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Amaziah did. 5 And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to PROSPER.
35. 2CH 31:4 He (Hezekiah = 'Jehovah has made me strong') ordered the people living in Jerusalem to give the portion due the priests and Levites so they could devote themselves to the Law of the LORD. 5 As soon as the order went out, the Israelites generously gave the firstfruits of their grain, new wine, oil and honey and all that the fields produced. They brought a great amount, a TITHE of everything. 6 The men of Israel and Judah who lived in the towns of Judah also brought a TITHE of their herds and flocks and a TITHE of the holy things dedicated to the LORD their God, and they piled them in heaps. 8 When Hezekiah and his officials came and saw the heaps, they praised the LORD and blessed his people Israel. 9 Hezekiah asked the priests and Levites about the heaps; 10 and Azariah the chief priest, from the family of Zadok, answered, "Since the people began to bring their contributions to the temple of the LORD, we have had enough to eat and plenty to spare, because the LORD has blessed his people, and this great amount is left over." 11 Hezekiah gave orders to prepare storerooms in the temple of the LORD, and this was done.
36. 2CH 31:20 This is what Hezekiah did throughout Judah, doing what was good and right and faithful before the LORD his God. 21 IN EVERYTHING that he undertook in the service of God's temple and

**in obedience to the law and the commands, HE SOUGHT HIS GOD AND WORKED WHOLEHEARTEDLY. And so he PROSPERED.**

37. **NEH 2:20** Then answered I them, and said unto them, **The God of heaven, he will PROSPER us; therefore we his servants will arise and build;** but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem.
38. **JOB 8:7** **Your beginnings will seem humble, so prosperous will your future be.**
39. **JOB 36:11** **If they obey and serve him, they will spend the rest of their days in PROSPERITY and their years in contentment.**
40. **JOB 22:23** **If you return to the Almighty, you will be restored:** If you remove wickedness far from your tent 24 **and assign your nuggets to the dust, your gold of Ophir to the rocks in the ravines,** 25 **then THE ALMIGHTY WILL BE YOUR GOLD, THE CHOICEST SILVER FOR YOU.** 26 Surely then you will find delight in the Almighty and will lift up your face to God. 27 You will pray to him, and he will hear you, and you will fulfill your vows. 28 What you decide on will be done, and light will shine on your ways.
41. **JOB 42:12** **The LORD blessed the latter part of JOB's life more than the first. He had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, a thousand yoke of oxen and a thousand donkeys.** 13 **And he also had seven sons and three daughters.** 16 **After this, JOB lived a hundred and forty years; he saw his children and their children to the fourth generation.** 17 **And so he died, old and full of years.**
42. **PSA 1:1** **Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly,** nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. 2 **But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate DAY AND NIGHT.** 3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and **whatsoever he doeth shall PROSPER.** 4 The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away. 5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. 6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
43. **PSA 19:7** **The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul. The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple.** 8 **The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart.** The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes. 9 The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure and altogether righteous. 10 **They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold;** they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb. 11 By them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.
44. **PSA 23:1** The LORD is my shepherd, **I shall not be in want.**
45. **PSA 24:1** **The earth is the LORD'S, and everything in it,** the world, and all who live in it;
46. **PSA 34:10** The lions may grow weak and hungry, but **those who seek the LORD lack no good thing.**
47. **PSA 35:27** Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, **let them SAY CONTINUALLY, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the PROSPERITY of his servant.**
48. **PSA 37:4** **Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart.** 5 **Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him and he will do this:** 6 **He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun.**
49. **PSA 37:25** I have been young, and now am old; yet have **I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.** 26 He is ever merciful, and lendeth; and **his seed is blessed.**
50. **PSA 50:9** I have no need of a bull from your stall or of goats from your pens, 10 for **every animal of the forest is mine, and the cattle on a thousand hills.** 11 I know every bird in the mountains, and the creatures of the field are mine. 12 If I were hungry I would not tell you, for **the world is mine, and all that is in it.**
51. **PSA 62:10** Do not trust in oppression, Nor vainly hope in robbery; **If riches increase, Do not set your heart on them.**
52. **PSA 84:11** For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD bestows favor and honor; **no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless.**
53. **PSA 112:1** Praise the LORD! **Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, Who delights greatly in His commandments.** 2 His descendants will be mighty on earth; The generation of the upright will be blessed. 3 **WEALTH and RICHES will be in his house, And his righteousness endures forever.** 4 Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness; He is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous. 5 **Good will come to him who is generous and lends freely,** who conducts his affairs with justice. 6 **Surely he will never be shaken; a righteous man will be remembered forever.** 7 **He will have no fear of bad news;** his heart is steadfast, trusting in the LORD.
54. **PSA 126:5** **Those who sow in tears will reap with songs of joy. 6 He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing PRECIOUS SEED, shall DOUBTLESS come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him. (Your economic circumstances determine the value of the seeds you plant!)**
55. **PSA 127:1** **Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it:** except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain.

56. **PRO 3:9 Honor the LORD with your WEALTH, with the firstfruits of all your crops; 10 then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.**
57. **PRO 3:13** Blessed is the man who finds **wisdom**, the man who gains understanding, 14 for she **is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold**. 15 She is more precious than rubies; nothing you desire can compare with her. 16 **Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor**. 17 Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace. 18 She is a tree of life to those who embrace her; **those who lay hold of her will be blessed**.
58. **PRO 6:1** My son, **if you have put up security for your neighbor**, if you have struck hands in pledge for another, 2 **if you have been trapped by what you said, ensnared by the words of your mouth**, 3 **then do this, my son, to free yourself, since you have fallen into your neighbor's hands: Go and humble yourself; press your plea with your neighbor!** 4 Allow no sleep to your eyes, no slumber to your eyelids. 5 **Free yourself**, like a gazelle from the hand of the hunter, like a bird from the snare of the fowler.
59. **PRO 6:6 Go to the ant, you sluggard; consider its ways and be wise!** 7 It has no commander, no overseer or ruler, 8 yet **it stores its provisions in summer and gathers its food at harvest**.
60. **PRO 6:9** How long will you lie there, you sluggard? When will you get up from your sleep? 10 **A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to rest--** 11 **and poverty will come on you like a bandit and scarcity like an armed man**.
61. **PRO 6:30** People do not despise **a thief** If he steals to satisfy himself when he is starving. 31 Yet **when he is found, he must restore sevenfold**; He may have to give up all the substance of his house.
62. **PRO 8:17** I love those who love me, and those who seek me find me. 18 **With me are RICHES and HONOR, ENDURING WEALTH and PROSPERITY**. 19 My fruit is better than fine gold; what I yield surpasses choice silver. 20 I walk in the way of righteousness, along the paths of justice, 21 **bestowing WEALTH on those who love me and making their treasuries full**.
63. **PRO 10:4** Lazy hands make a man poor, but **diligent hands bring WEALTH**. 5 He who gathers crops in summer is a wise son, but he who sleeps during harvest is a disgraceful son.
64. **PRO 10:22 The blessing of the LORD brings WEALTH, and he adds no trouble to it**.
65. **PRO 10:24** What the wicked dreads will overtake him; what the righteous desire will be granted.
66. **PRO 11:15 He who puts up security for another will surely suffer**, but whoever refuses to strike hands in pledge is safe.
67. **PRO 11:24** One man gives freely, yet gains even more; another withholds unduly, but comes to poverty. 25 **A generous man will PROSPER; he who refreshes others will himself be refreshed**.
68. **PRO 12:24 Diligent hands will rule**, but laziness ends in slave labor.
69. **PRO 13:2 A man shall eat well by the fruit of his mouth**, But the soul of the unfaithful feeds on violence. 3 **He who guards his mouth preserves his life**, But he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction. 4 The soul of a lazy man desires, and has nothing; But **the soul of the diligent shall be made rich**.
70. **PRO 13:11 Dishonest money dwindles away, but he who gathers money little by little makes it grow**.
71. **PRO 13:21 Misfortune pursues the sinner, but PROSPERITY is the reward of the righteous**. 22 A good man leaves an inheritance for his children's children, **but a sinner's WEALTH is stored up for the righteous**.
72. **PRO 15:6 The house of the righteous contains great treasure**, but the income of the wicked brings them trouble.
73. **PRO 16:7** When a man's ways are pleasing to the LORD, he makes even his enemies live at peace with him.
74. **PRO 17:18** A man lacking in judgment strikes hands in pledge and puts up security for his neighbor.
75. **PRO 18:16 A gift opens the way for the giver and ushers him into the presence of the great**.
76. **PRO 19:6** Many curry favor with a ruler, and **everyone is the friend of a man who gives gifts**.
77. **PRO 19:17 He who is kind to the poor lends to the LORD, and he will reward him** for what he has done.
78. **PRO 21:5 The plans of the diligent lead to PROFIT as surely as haste leads to poverty**. 6 A fortune made by a lying tongue is a fleeting vapor and a deadly snare.
79. **PRO 21:14** A gift given in secret soothes anger, and a bribe concealed in the cloak pacifies great wrath.
80. **PRO 21:17 He who loves pleasure will become poor; whoever loves wine and oil will never be rich**.
81. **PRO 21:20** In the house of the wise are stores of choice food and oil, but **a foolish man devours (spends) all he has**.
82. **PRO 22:1 A good name is more desirable than great riches; to be esteemed is better than silver or gold**.
83. **PRO 22:3 A prudent man sees danger and takes refuge**, but the simple keep going and suffer for it. 4 **Humility and the fear of the LORD bring WEALTH and honor and life**.
84. **PRO 24:3** By wisdom a house is built, and through understanding it is established; 4 through knowledge its rooms are filled with rare and beautiful treasures.
85. **PRO 22:7** The rich rule over the poor, and **the borrower is servant to the lender**.

86. **PRO 22:29** **Do you see a man skilled in his work? He will serve before kings;** he will not serve before obscure men.
87. **PRO 23:4** **Do not wear yourself out to get rich; have the wisdom to show restraint.** 5 **Cast but a glance at riches, and they are gone, for they will surely sprout wings and fly off to the sky like an eagle.**
88. **PRO 24:30** I went past the field of the sluggard, past the vineyard of the man who lacks judgment; 31 thorns had come up everywhere, the ground was covered with weeds, and the stone wall was in ruins. 32 I applied my heart to what I observed and learned a lesson from what I saw: 33 **A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to rest—**34 **and poverty will come on you like a bandit and scarcity like an armed man.**
89. **PRO 27:23** **Be sure you know the condition of your flocks, give careful attention to your herds;** 24 **for riches do not endure forever, and a crown is not secure for all generations.**
90. **PRO 28:19** **He who works his land will have abundant food, but the one who chases fantasies will have his fill of poverty.** 20 **A faithful man will be richly blessed, but one eager to get rich will not go unpunished.** 21 **To show partiality is not good,** Because for a piece of bread a man will transgress. 22 **A man with an evil eye hastens after riches, And does not consider that poverty will come upon him.**
91. **ECC 3:1** **To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:** 2 A time to be born, and a time to die; **a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted;** 3 a time to kill and a time to heal, a time to tear down and a time to build, 4 a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance, 5 a time to scatter stones and a time to gather them, a time to embrace and a time to refrain, 6 a time to search and a time to give up, a time to keep and a time to throw away, 7 a time to tear and a time to mend, **a time to be silent and a time to speak,** 8 a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace. 9 **What does the worker gain from his toil?** 10 **I have seen the burden God has laid on men.** 11 He has made everything beautiful in its time. **He has also set eternity in the hearts of men; yet they cannot fathom what God has done from beginning to end.** 12 I know that **there is nothing better for men than to be happy and do good while they live.**
92. **ECC 5:18** Then I realized that it is good and proper for a man to eat and drink, and to find satisfaction in his toilsome labor under the sun during the few days of life God has given him--for this is his lot. 19 **Moreover, when God gives any man WEALTH and POSSESSIONS, and enables him to enjoy them, to accept his lot and be happy in his work--this is a gift of God.**
93. **ECC 5:10** **WHOEVER LOVES MONEY NEVER HAS MONEY ENOUGH;** **whoever loves wealth is never satisfied with his income.** This too is meaningless.
94. **ECC 9:16** So I said, "Wisdom is better than strength." But **the poor man's wisdom is despised, and his words are no longer heeded.**
95. **ECC 10:19** A feast is made for laughter, and wine makes life merry, but **MONEY IS THE ANSWER FOR EVERYTHING.**
96. **ECC 11:1** Cast your bread upon the waters, for after many days you will find it again.
97. **ECC 11:4** **Whoever watches the wind will not plant; whoever looks at the clouds will not reap.** 5 As you do not know the path of the wind, or how the body is formed in a mother's womb, so **you cannot understand the work of God,** the Maker of all things. 6 **Sow your seed in the morning, and at evening let not your hands be idle,** for you do not know which will succeed, whether this or that, or whether both will do equally well.
98. **ISA 1:19** **If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best from the land;**
99. **ISA 30:23** **He will also send you rain for the seed you sow in the ground,** and the food that comes from the land will be rich and plentiful. In that day your cattle will graze in broad meadows.
100. **ISA 33:15** **He who walks righteously and speaks what is right, who rejects gain from extortion and keeps his hand from accepting bribes, who stops his ears against plots of murder and shuts his eyes against contemplating evil—** 16 **this is the man who will dwell on the heights,** whose refuge will be the mountain fortress. **His bread will be supplied, and water will not fail him.**
101. **ISA 45:2** I will go before you and will level the mountains; I will break down gates of bronze and cut through bars of iron. 3 **I will give you the treasures of darkness, riches stored in secret places,** so that you may know that I am the LORD, the God of Israel, who summons you by name.
102. **ISA 48:17** Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; **I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to PROFIT, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.**
103. **ISA 55:8** "For **my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,**" declares the LORD. 9 "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts. 10 As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, 11 so is **my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.**

104. **ISA 58:6** “**Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke?** 7 **Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter— when you see the naked, to clothe him, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood?** 8 **Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear;** then your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of the LORD will be your rear guard. 9 **Then you will call, and the LORD will answer;** you will cry for help, and he will say: Here am I. “If you do away with the yoke of oppression, with the pointing finger and malicious talk, 10 and **if you spend yourselves in behalf of the hungry and satisfy the needs of the oppressed, then your light will rise in the darkness, and your night will become like the noonday.** 11 **The LORD will guide you always; he will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail.** 12 Your people will rebuild the ancient ruins and will raise up the age-old foundations; you will be called Repairer of Broken Walls, Restorer of Streets with Dwellings. 13 **“If you keep your feet from breaking the Sabbath and from doing as you please on my holy day,** if you call the Sabbath a delight and the LORD’s holy day honorable, and if you honor it by not going your own way and not doing as you please or speaking idle words, 14 **then you will find your joy in the LORD, and I will cause you to ride on the heights of the land and to feast on the inheritance of your father Jacob.**” The mouth of the LORD has spoken.
105. **JER 29:11** **For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to PROSPER you and not to harm you,** plans to give you hope and a future.
106. **HOS 4:6** **my people are destroyed from lack of knowledge.** “Because you have rejected knowledge, I also reject you as my priests; because you have ignored the law of your God, I also will ignore your children.
107. **JOE 2:21** Be not afraid, O land; be glad and rejoice. Surely the LORD has done great things. 22 Be not afraid, O wild animals, for the open pastures are becoming green. **The trees are bearing their fruit; the fig tree and the vine yield their riches.** 23 Be glad, O people of Zion, rejoice in the LORD your God, for he has given you the autumn rains in righteousness. **He sends you abundant showers, both autumn and spring rains,** as before. 24 **The threshing floors will be filled with grain; the vats will overflow with new wine and oil.** 25 **‘I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten—** the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm— my great army that I sent among you. 26 **You will have plenty to eat, until you are full, and you will praise the name of the LORD your God, who has worked wonders for you; never again will my people be shamed.** 27 Then you will know that I am in Israel, that I am the LORD your God, and that there is no other; never again will my people be shamed.
108. **HAB 2:2** Then the LORD replied: **“Write down the revelation and make it plain on tablets so that a herald may run with it.** 3 For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it; it will certainly come and will not delay.
109. **HAG 1:5** Now this is what **the LORD Almighty says: “GIVE CAREFUL THOUGHT TO YOUR WAYS.** 6 **You have planted much, but have harvested little. You eat, but never have enough. You drink, but never have your fill. You put on clothes, but are not warm. You earn wages, only to put them in a purse with holes in it.”** 7 This is what **the LORD Almighty says: “Give careful thought to your ways.** 8 **Go up into the mountains and bring down timber and build the house (of God), so that I may take pleasure in it and be honored,”** says the LORD. 9 **“You expected much, but see, it turned out to be little. What you brought home, I blew away. Why?”** declares the LORD Almighty. **“Because of MY HOUSE, which remains a ruin, while each of you is busy with his own house.** 10 Therefore, **because of you the heavens have withheld their dew and the earth its crops.** 11 **I called for a drought on the fields and the mountains, on the grain, the new wine, the oil and whatever the ground produces, on men and cattle, and on the labor of your hands.”**
110. **MAL 3:6** **“I the LORD do not change.** So you, O descendants of Jacob, are not destroyed. 7 Ever since the time of your forefathers you have turned away from my decrees and have not kept them. **Return to me, and I will return to you,**” says the LORD Almighty. **“But you ask, ‘How are we to return?’** 8 **“Will a man rob God? Yet you rob me. “But you ask, ‘How do we rob you?’ “In TITHES and OFFERINGS.** 9 **You are under a curse--the whole nation of you--because you are robbing me.** 10 **Bring the whole TITHE into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. TEST ME in this,**” says the LORD Almighty, **“and SEE IF I WILL NOT THROW OPEN THE FLOODGATES OF HEAVEN AND POUR OUT SO MUCH BLESSING THAT YOU WILL NOT HAVE ROOM ENOUGH FOR IT.** 11 **I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not cast their fruit,**” says the LORD Almighty.
