- Write out **HEB 12:14**: Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord.
- Write out **1Pe 1:15-16**: but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy." (NKJ)
- T** **F** I do not have the power within myself to live a holy life.

T **F** God commands all believers everywhere to be holy, just as He is holy (**1PE 1:15-16**)

T **F** God never asks me to do anything that He will not also provide the power to do it.

T **F** Therefore, if I am to live holy, it will have to be by God's power within me, not by myself.

T **F** I receive that grace (power) to live in holiness entirely by faith that Jesus can live His life through me.
- EPH 2:8** For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works lest anyone should boast. (NKJ)

What is the Greek word for **grace**: charis **saved**: sozo **faith**: pistis

yourselves: humon **gift**:: charisma **Define the Greek word 'sozo'**: translated 'salvation' = to save, make or be whole, heal, keep safe and sound, to rescue from danger or destruction
- T** **F** **EPH 2:8-9** can be generalized to apply to **ANYTHING** we receive from God. Fill in the following blanks with personal, family, or business needs you want from God:

By grace am I sanctified **through faith**, **NOT** of my own effort or strength; it is a gift from God.

By grace am I healed **through faith**, **NOT** of my own effort or strength; it is a gift from God.

- Was** is humanly possible for Peter to Walk on water? no **Did** Peter walk on the water? yes

How did he do it? By grace, through faith in the Christ who told him to "come" out on the water

What caused him to sink? He took his eyes off Jesus, and began to look at the wind and the waves

How does this story relate to **EPH 2:8-9**? In his own power and ability, Peter could not walk on water. But he was able to do so as he looked to Jesus – in faith. As soon as he took his eyes off Jesus and began to look at the wind and the waves – the circumstances, his faith failed & he sank. Even then, Jesus reached out and saved him and kept him from falling. The same is true for us individually in our circumstances.
- Is it** humanly possible for you to live a holy life? Absolutely not **Can** you live a holy life? yes

How will you do it? By His grace, through faith in Him to live His holy life through me.
- The **Natural Man** (Greek psuchikos) does what comes naturally.

The **Carnal Man** (Greek sarkikos) does what is unnaturally.

The **Spiritual Man** (Greek pneumatikos) does what comes supernaturally.

Natural Man 1CO 2:14, JUD 17. Carnal Man 1CO 3:1-3, ROM 7:14. Spiritual Man 1CO 2:12-16, EPH 1:3.

- From **PRO 3:11-18**, discipline from man or God results in wisdom.

From **PRO 9:10**, the fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom.

From **JOB 28:28**, the fear of the LORD is wisdom.

From **ISA 33:5-6**, the fear of the LORD is the key to the LORD's treasure.

Write out **PRO 1:7**: The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, But fools despise wisdom & instruction.
- We** cannot have the character or image of Christ apart from the **PERSON** of Christ. He **IS** the Anointing. The Anointing **IS** Christ. The Anointing is the very presence of Christ, the person of Christ, Christ **IN** you, the hope of glory. What is the Gk word for Christ? Christos What does the word mean? The anointed one

When did Jesus become the Christ? At the Jordan River when He was baptized by John the Baptist

14. The most perfect manifestation of the **Holy Spirit** in a man can be found in Jesus Christ.
 The most perfect image of the **Father** in a man can be found in Jesus Christ.
 In **HEB 1:1-3**, what is the Greek word for **IMAGE**? charakter In **HEB 10:1**? eikon
Explain the difference between these words: eikon is a likeness, a figure, a similarity. Charakter is an exact reproduction in every respect; engraved, carved, stamped, or impressed upon to create an exact likeness.
15. **Both** the Holy Spirit and evil spirits manifest their character in a man or woman through anointing.
 Just as **Satan** works through people so also **God** works through people.
Both the Holy Spirit and evil spirits act as helpers, enabling us to **DO** what our hearts desire.
JOH 13:27 Now after the piece of bread, Satan entered him (Judas). Then Jesus said to him, "What you do, do quickly." (NKJ) *(Judas then betrayed Jesus into the hands of the Jews, who crucified Him)*
Write out ROM 12:21: Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
16. **EXO 31:12** 12 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 13 "Speak also to the children of Israel, saying: 'Surely My Sabbath you shall keep, for it is a sign between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I am the Lord who sanctifies you. (NKJ)
17. What does the **Sabbath** have to do with God sanctifying His people? The Sabbath was a day of REST after a week of work. So also sanctification allows us to REST in God's holiness rather than WORK at our own.
How do we keep the Sabbath now? By resting in God's FINISHED work, allowing Him to sanctify us, which is the infilling with the full anointing of His Presence, the fullness of the Holy Spirit. The Sabbath is a day of rest after a week of work. Sunday, the sign of the New Covenant, begins a week of GRACE.
4. **T F** It is possible for **inanimate objects**, such as cups or bowls, to be **holy** or **sanctified**.
T F **Sanctification** is the process or event of making someone or something holy.
What does **SANCTIFICATION** mean? The process of making something or someone HOLY, consecrated, hallowed, set apart for a specific purpose. To purify, dedicate, to prepare and appoint for a purpose.
Define HOLINESS: The Hebrew word for holy and sanctified are the SAME – qadash. To be consecrated, sanctified, separated, set apart, consecrated, hallowed, dedicated to service, etc.
18. **ROM 12:1** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, **holy**, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may **prove** what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (NKJ)
19. Read **1KI 18:23-38**. Notice that the true God answers by FIRE, which consumes the flesh on the altar. How does this story relate to **ROM 12:1** and to you? Consecration, which is putting my flesh on the altar, is my part. God's part is sanctification, which results in His holiness, is His refining FIRE that consumes the flesh. If I do my part of Consecration, God will do His part of Sanctification!
20. Write out **PSA 29:2**: Give unto the Lord the glory due to His name; Worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness
 Write out **PSA 96:9**: Oh, worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth.
From these verses, **how** are you to worship God? In the beauty of HIS holiness in me.
21. Write out **LUK 14:27**: "And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple. (NKJ)
LUK 9:23-24 Then He (Jesus) said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. 24 "For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. (NKJ)
 What is the Greek for **life**? psuche For **save**? sozo For **lose**? apollumi
 From **REV 9:11**, who is **Apollyon** and what does the word mean? "the Destroyer" – meaning Satan
22. **What** goes on the cross? my flesh How often do you put it there? every day of my life
Religion is hanging around the cross. Christianity is hanging ON the cross.
JOH 12:24-25 "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain. 25 "He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.
 What is the Greek for **loves**? phileo For the 1st & 2nd **life**? psuche For **lose**? apollumi For **hates**? miseo For **world**? kosmos For the 3rd **life**? zoe
23. The Natural Man (Greek psuchikos) is still in Egypt, in bondage to Satan.
 The Carnal Man (Greek sarkikos) has left Egypt, crossed the Red Sea, but is still in the Wilderness, in bondage to the flesh and its passions.
 The Spiritual Man (Greek pneumatikos) has crossed the Jordan, and is conquering enemies in the Promised Land. He has put to death the deeds of the flesh, and is living from victory to victory.
24. **Solomon**, the wisest man in the earth, summarized all that he learned in **ECC 12:13-14**. Write these verses out:
13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all.
14 For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil.
