- EXO 13:1** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 **SANCTIFY (*qadash*) unto me all the firstborn, whatsoever openeth the womb among the children of Israel, both of man and of beast: it is mine.** 3 And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this place: there shall no leavened bread be eaten. (KJV)
- EXO 19:10** And the LORD said unto Moses, **Go unto the people, and SANCTIFY (*qadash*) them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes,** 11 **And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.** (KJV)
- EXO 19:22** And **let the priests also, which come near to the LORD, SANCTIFY (*qadash*) themselves,** lest the LORD break forth upon them. (KJV)
- See all of **EXO 29** – sanctification of Aaron and his sons as priests unto God.
- EXO 28:40** And for Aaron's sons thou shalt make **coats,** and thou shalt make for them **girdles,** and **bonnets** shalt thou make for them, for glory and for beauty. 41 **And thou shalt put them upon Aaron thy brother, and his sons with him; and shalt anoint them, and CONSECRATE (*male'*) them, and SANCTIFY (*qadash*) them, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office.** 42 And thou shalt make them **linen breeches** to cover their nakedness; from the loins even unto the thighs they shall reach: 43 **And they shall be upon Aaron, and upon his sons, when they come in unto the TABERNACLE of the congregation, or when they come near unto the altar to minister in the HOLY PLACE; that they bear not iniquity, and die: it shall be a statute for ever unto him and his seed after him.** (KJV)
- EXO 30:22** Moreover the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 23 Take thou also unto **thee principal spices,** of pure **myrrh** five hundred shekels, and of sweet **cinnamon** half so much, even two hundred and fifty shekels, and of sweet **calamus** two hundred and fifty shekels, 24 And of **cassia** five hundred shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary, and of **oil olive** an hin: 25 **And thou shalt make it an oil of holy ointment, an ointment compound after the art of the apothecary: it shall be AN HOLY ANOINTING OIL.** 26 **And thou shalt anoint the tabernacle of the congregation therewith, and the ark of the testimony,** 27 **And the table and all his vessels, and the candlestick and his vessels, and the altar of incense,** 28 **And the altar of burnt offering with all his vessels, and the laver and his foot.** 29 **And thou shalt SANCTIFY (*qadash*) them, that they may be most holy: whatsoever toucheth them shall be holy.** 30 **And thou shalt anoint Aaron and his sons, and consecrate them, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office.** 31 And thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel, saying, This shall be an holy anointing oil unto me throughout your generations. 32 **Upon man's flesh shall it not be poured,** neither shall ye make any other like it, after the composition of it: **it is HOLY (*godesh*), and it shall be HOLY (*godesh*) unto you.** 33 Whosoever compoundeth any like it, or whosoever putteth any of it upon a stranger, shall even be cut off from his people. (KJV)
- EXO 31:12** And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 13 "Speak also to the children of Israel, saying: '**Surely My Sabbaths you shall keep, for it is a sign between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I am the Lord who SANCTIFIES (*qadash*) you (Jehovah T.** 14 **'You shall keep the Sabbath, therefore, for it is HOLY (*godesh*) to you.** Everyone who profanes it shall surely be put to death; for whoever does any work on it, that person shall be cut off from among his people. 15 **'Work shall be done for six days, but the seventh is the Sabbath of REST, HOLY (*godesh*) to the Lord.** Whoever does any work on the Sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death. 16 'Therefore the children of Israel shall keep the Sabbath, to observe the Sabbath throughout their generations as a perpetual covenant. 17 'It is a sign between Me and the children of Israel forever; for in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, and on the seventh day He rested and was

refreshed.' ” 18 And **when He had made an end of speaking with him on Mount Sinai, He gave Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone, written with the finger of God.** (NKJ)

8. **EXO 40:1** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 **On the first day of the first month shalt thou set up the TABERNACLE of the tent of the congregation.** 3 And thou shalt put therein **the ark of the testimony,** and cover the ark with **the vail.** 4 And thou shalt bring in **the table,** and set in order the things that are to be set in order upon it; and thou shalt bring in **the candlestick,** and light the lamps thereof. 5 And thou shalt set **the altar of gold for the incense** before the ark of the testimony, and put the hanging of **the door to the tabernacle.** 6 And thou shalt set **the altar of the burnt offering** before the door of the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation. 7 And thou shalt set **the laver** between the tent of the congregation and the altar, and shalt put water therein. 8 And thou shalt set up the court round about, and hang up the hanging at the court gate. 9 And **thou shalt take the anointing oil, and anoint the tabernacle, and all that is therein, and shalt hallow it, and all the vessels thereof: and it shall be HOLY (qodash).** 10 And **thou shalt anoint the altar of the burnt offering, and all his vessels, and SANCTIFY (qodash) the altar: and it shall be an altar most HOLY (qodash).** 11 And **thou shalt anoint the laver and his foot, and SANCTIFY (qodash) it.** 12 And **thou shalt bring Aaron and his sons unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and wash them with water.** 13 And **thou shalt put upon Aaron the holy garments, and anoint him, and SANCTIFY (qodash) him; that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.** 14 And **thou shalt bring his sons, and clothe them with coats:** 15 And **thou shalt anoint them, as thou didst anoint their father, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office: for their anointing shall surely be an everlasting priesthood throughout their generations.** (KJV)
9. **LEV 8:1** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 **Take Aaron and his sons with him, and the garments, and the anointing oil, and a bullock for the sin offering, and two rams, and a basket of unleavened bread;** 3 And gather thou all the congregation together unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. 4 And Moses did as the LORD commanded him; and the assembly was gathered together unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. 5 And Moses said unto the congregation, This is the thing which the LORD commanded to be done. 6 And **Moses brought Aaron and his sons, and washed them with water.** 7 **And he put upon him the coat, and girded him with the girdle, and clothed him with the robe, and put the ephod upon him, and he girded him with the curious girdle of the ephod, and bound it unto him therewith.** 8 And **he put the breastplate upon him: also he put in the breastplate the Urim and the Thummim.** 9 And **he put the mitre upon his head; also upon the mitre, even upon his forefront, did he put the golden plate, the holy crown; as the LORD commanded Moses.** 10 And **Moses took the anointing oil, and anointed the tabernacle and all that was therein, and SANCTIFIED (qodash) them.** 11 And **he sprinkled thereof upon the altar seven times, and anointed the altar and all his vessels, both the laver and his foot, to SANCTIFY (qodash) them.** 12 And **he poured of the anointing oil upon Aaron's head, and anointed him, to SANCTIFY (qodash) him.** 13 And Moses brought Aaron's sons, and put coats upon them, and girded them with girdles, and put bonnets upon them; as the LORD commanded Moses. 14 And he brought the bullock for the sin offering: and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the bullock for the sin offering. (KJV) (Read the full chapter)
10. **LEV 8:18** And **he brought the ram for the burnt offering;** and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the ram. 19 And **he killed it; and Moses sprinkled the blood upon the altar round about.** 20 And he cut the ram into pieces; and Moses burnt the head, and the pieces, and the fat. 21 And he washed the inwards and the legs in water; and Moses burnt the whole ram upon the altar: it was **a burnt sacrifice** for a sweet savour, and an offering made by fire unto the LORD; as the LORD commanded Moses. 22 And he brought the other ram, **the ram of consecration:** and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the ram. 23 And he slew it; and **Moses took of the blood of it, and put it upon the tip of Aaron's right ear, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot.** 24 And **he brought Aaron's sons, and Moses put of the blood upon the tip of their right ear, and upon the thumbs of their right hands, and upon the great toes of their right feet:** and Moses sprinkled the blood upon the altar round about. (KJV)
11. **LEV 11:43** Ye shall not make yourselves abominable with any creeping thing that creepeth, neither shall ye make yourselves unclean with them, that ye should be defiled thereby. 44 For **I am the LORD your God: ye shall therefore SANCTIFY (qodash) yourselves, and ye shall be HOLY (qodash); for I am HOLY (qodash): neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.** 45 **For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be HOLY (qodash), for I am HOLY (qodash).** 46 This is the law of the beasts, and of the fowl, and of every living creature that moveth in the waters, and of every creature that creepeth upon the earth: 47 To make a difference between the unclean and the clean, and between the beast that may be eaten and the beast that may not be eaten. (KJV)
12. **LEV 20:1** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 Again, thou shalt say to the children of Israel, **Whosoever he be of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn in Israel, that giveth any of his seed unto Molech; he shall surely be put to death:** the people of the land shall stone him with stones. 3 And I will set my face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; **because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, to defile my sanctuary, and to profane my SANCTIFY (qodash) name.** 6 And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will even set my

- face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people. 7 **SANCTIFY (*qadash*) yourselves therefore, and be ye HOLY (*godesh*): for I am the LORD your God.** 8 And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: **I am the LORD which SANCTIFY (*qadash*) you.** 9 For every one that curseth his father or his mother shall be surely put to death: he hath cursed his father or his mother; his blood shall be upon him. 10 And the man that committeth adultery with another man's wife, even he that committeth adultery with his neighbour's wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death. 11 And the man that lieth with his father's wife hath uncovered his father's nakedness: both of them shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them. (KJV) (etc. – much more)
13. **LEV 21:1** And the Lord said to Moses, "**Speak to the priests, the sons of Aaron, and say to them: 'None shall defile himself for the dead among his people, 2 'except for his relatives who are nearest to him: his mother, his father, his son, his daughter, and his brother; 3 'also his virgin sister who is near to him, who has had no husband, for her he may defile himself.** 4 'Otherwise he shall not defile himself, being a chief man among his people, to profane himself. 5 '**They shall not make any bald place on their heads, nor shall they shave the edges of their beards nor make any cuttings in their flesh.** 6 '**They shall be HOLY (*godesh*) to their God and not profane the name of their God, for they offer the offerings of the Lord made by fire, and the bread of their God; therefore they shall be HOLY (*godesh*).** 7 'They shall not take a wife who is a harlot or a defiled woman, nor shall they take a woman divorced from her husband; for the priest is holy to his God. 8 '**Therefore you shall CONSECRATE (*qadash*) him, for he offers the bread of your God. He shall be HOLY (*godesh*) to you, for I the Lord, who SANCTIFY (*qadash*) you, am HOLY (*godesh*).** 13 'And **he shall take a wife in her virginity.** 14 'A widow or a divorced woman or a defiled woman or a harlot—these he shall not marry; but he shall take a virgin of his own people as wife. 15 '**Nor shall he profane his posterity among his people, for I the Lord SANCTIFY (*qadash*) him.'** " 21 '**No man of the descendants of Aaron the priest, who has a defect (blemish), shall come near to offer the offerings made by fire to the Lord. He has a defect; he shall not come near to offer the bread of his God.** 22 'He may eat the bread of his God, both the most holy and the holy; 23 'only he shall not go near the veil or approach the altar, because he has a defect, lest he profane My sanctuaries; **for I the Lord SANCTIFY (*qadash*) them.'** "
14. **NUM 8:5** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 6 **Take the Levites from among the children of Israel, and cleanse them.** 7 And **thus shalt thou do unto them, to cleanse them: Sprinkle water of purifying upon them, and let them shave all their flesh, and let them wash their clothes, and so make themselves clean.** 8 Then let them take a young bullock with his meat offering, even fine flour mingled with oil, and another young bullock shalt thou take for a sin offering. 9 And thou shalt bring the Levites before the tabernacle of the congregation: and thou shalt gather the whole assembly of the children of Israel together: 10 And thou shalt bring the Levites before the LORD: and the children of Israel shall put their hands upon the Levites: 11 **And Aaron shall offer the Levites before the LORD for an offering of the children of Israel, that they may execute the service of the LORD.** 12 And the Levites shall lay their hands upon the heads of the bullocks: and thou shalt offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, unto the LORD, to make an atonement for the Levites. 13 And thou shalt set the Levites before Aaron, and before his sons, and offer them for an offering unto the LORD. 14 **Thus shalt thou SEPARATE the Levites from among the children of Israel: and the Levites shall be mine.** (KJV)
15. **JOS 3:5** And Joshua said to the people, "**SANCTIFY (*qadash*) yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you.**" 6 Then Joshua spoke to the priests, saying, "**Take up the ark of the covenant and cross over before the people.**" So they took up the ark of the covenant and went before the people. (NKJ)
16. **JOS 7:13** "**Get up, SANCTIFY (*qadash*) the people, and say, 'SANCTIFY (*qadash*) yourselves for tomorrow, because thus says the Lord God of Israel: "There is an accursed thing in your midst, O Israel; you cannot stand before your enemies until you take away the accursed thing from among you."**" (NKJ) (Achan's sin at Jericho)
17. **1CH 15:12** He said to them, "**You are the heads of the fathers' houses of the Levites; SANCTIFY (*qadash*) yourselves, you and your brethren, that you may bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel to the place I have prepared for it.** 13 "For because you did not do it the first time, the Lord our God broke out against us, because we did not consult Him about the proper order." 14 **So the priests and the Levites SANCTIFIED (*qadash*) themselves to bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel.** 15 And the children of the Levites bore the ark of God on their shoulders, by its poles, as Moses had commanded according to the word of the Lord.
18. **2CH 29:5** and (Hezekiah) said to them: "**Hear me, Levites! Now SANCTIFY (*qadash*) yourselves, SANCTIFY (*qadash*) the house of the Lord God of your fathers, and carry out the rubbish from the holy place,** 6 "**For our fathers have trespassed and done evil in the eyes of the Lord our God; they have forsaken Him, have turned their faces away from the dwelling place of the Lord, and turned their backs on Him.** 7 "They have also shut up the doors of the vestibule, put out the lamps, and have not burned incense or offered burnt offerings in the holy place to the God of Israel. 8 "**Therefore the wrath of the Lord fell upon Judah and Jerusalem, and He has given them up to trouble, to desolation, and to jeering, as you see with your eyes.**

19. **2CH 30:17** For **there were many in the assembly who had not SANCTIFIED (*qadash*) themselves; therefore the Levites had charge of the slaughter of the Passover lambs for everyone who was not clean, to SANCTIFY (*qadash*) them to the Lord.** (NKJ)
20. **2CH 35:6** “So **slaughter the Passover offerings, SANCTIFY (*qadash*) yourselves, and prepare them for your brethren, that they may do according to the word of the Lord by the hand of Moses.**” 7 Then Josiah gave the lay people lambs and young goats from the flock, all for Passover offerings for all who were present, to the number of thirty thousand, as well as three thousand cattle; these were from the king’s possessions. (NKJ)
21. **NEH 13:22** And **I commanded the Levites that they should CLEANSE (*taher*) themselves, and that they should go and guard the gates, to SANCTIFY (*qadash*) the Sabbath day.** Remember me, O my God, concerning this also, and spare me according to the greatness of Your mercy! (NKJ)
22. **EZE 20:12** “Moreover **I also gave them My Sabbaths, to be a sign between them and Me, that they might know that I am the Lord who SANCTIFIES (*qadash*) them.** (NKJ)
23. **EZE 36:22** “Therefore say to the house of Israel, ‘Thus says the Lord God: “I do not do this for your sake, O house of Israel, but for My holy name’s sake, which you have profaned among the nations wherever you went.” 23 “And **I will SANCTIFY (*qadash*) My great name, which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst; and the nations shall know that I am the Lord,**” says the Lord God, “**when I am HALLOWED (*qadash*) IN YOU before their eyes.** 24 “**For I will take you from among the nations,** gather you out of all countries, and bring you into your own land. 25 “**Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols.** 26 “**I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.** 27 “**I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.** 28 “Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; you shall be My people, and I will be your God. 29 “**I will deliver you from all your uncleanness.** I will call for the grain and multiply it, and bring no famine upon you. 30 “And I will multiply the fruit of your trees and the increase of your fields, so that you need never again bear the reproach of famine among the nations. 31 “**Then you will remember your evil ways and your deeds that were not good; and you will loathe yourselves in your own sight, for your iniquities and your abominations.** 32 “Not for your sake do I do this,” says the Lord God, “let it be known to you. Be ashamed and confounded for your own ways, O house of Israel!”
24. **EZE 37:28** “**The nations also will know that I, the Lord, SANCTIFY (*qadash*) Israel, when My sanctuary is in their midst forevermore.**” (NKJ)
25. **JOE 2:15** **Blow the trumpet in Zion, CONSECRATE (*qadash*) a fast, Call a sacred assembly;** 16 Gather the people, **SANCTIFY (*qadash*) the congregation,** Assemble the elders, Gather the children and nursing babes; Let the bridegroom go out from his chamber, And the bride from her dressing room. 17 Let the priests, who minister to the Lord, Weep between the porch and the altar; Let them say, “Spare Your people, O Lord, And do not give Your heritage to reproach, That the nations should rule over them. Why should they say among the peoples, ‘Where is their God?’ ” (NKJ)

26. **MAT 3:11** “**I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the HOLY (*hagios*) Spirit and fire.** 12 “His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather His wheat into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.” (NKJ)
27. **MAT 6:9** “In this manner, therefore, pray: **Our Father in heaven, HALLOWED (*hagiazō*) be Your name.**
28. **MAT 7:6** “**Do not give what is HOLY (*hagios*) to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine,** lest they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you in pieces. (NKJ)
29. **MAT 27:52** and the graves were opened; and **many bodies of the SAINTS (*hagios*) who had fallen asleep were raised;** 53 and coming out of the graves after His resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many.
30. **MAT 23:19** “Fools and blind! For which is greater, the gift or **the altar that SANCTIFIES (*hagiazō*) the gift?**
31. **MAT 28:18** And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 “**Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the HOLY Spirit,** 20 “**teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.**” Amen.
32. **LUK 1:15** “For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. **He will also be filled with the HOLY Spirit, even from his mother’s womb.** 16 “And he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God. 17 “He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, ‘to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,’ and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.” (NKJ)
33. **LUK 4:1** Then **Jesus, being filled with the HOLY Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,** 2 **being tempted for forty days by the devil.** And in those days He ate nothing, and afterward, when they had ended, He was hungry. (NKJ)
34. **LUK 11:13** “**If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the HOLY Spirit to those who ask Him!**” (NKJ)

35. **JOH 7:38** “**He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.**” 39 But **this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive;** for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified. (NKJ)
36. **JOH 14:26** “**But the Helper, the HOLY Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.**” (NKJ)
37. **JOH 17:16** “They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. 17 “**SANCTIFY (*hagiazō*) them by Your truth. Your word is truth.**” “As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. 19 “And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, **that they also may be SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) by the truth.** 20 “I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; 21 “that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.
38. **JOH 20:21** So Jesus said to them again, “Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you.” 22 And when He had said this, **He breathed on them, and said to them, “Receive the HOLY Spirit.** 23 “If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.” (NKJ)
39. **ACT 1:4** And **being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” He said, “you have heard from Me; 5 “for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the HOLY Spirit not many days from now.” 8 “But you shall receive power when the HOLY Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”** (NKJ)
40. **ACT 2:4** And **they were all filled with the HOLY Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.** (NKJ)
41. **ACT 2:38** Then Peter said to them, “**Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the HOLY Spirit.** 39 “**For the promise is to YOU and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.**” (NKJ)
42. **ACT 5:32** “**And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him.**”
43. **ACT 8:14** Now **when the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them,** 15 **who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit.** 16 **For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.** 17 **Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.** (NKJ)
44. **ACT 10:38** “how **God ANOINTED Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil,** for God was with Him.
45. **ACT 20:32** “So now, brethren, **I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*).** (NKJ)
46. **ACT 26:15** “So I said, ‘Who are You, Lord?’ And **He said, ‘I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.** 16 ‘But rise and stand on your feet; for **I have appeared to you for this purpose, to make you a minister and a witness both of the things which you have seen and of the things which I will yet reveal to you.** 17 ‘I will deliver you from the Jewish people, as well as from **the Gentiles, to whom I now send you,** 18 ‘**to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) by faith in Me.’** (NKJ)
47. **ROM 15:15** Nevertheless, brethren, I have written more boldly to you on some points, as reminding you, because of the grace given to me by God, 16 **that I might be a minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering of the Gentiles might be acceptable, SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) by the Holy Spirit.** (NKJ)
48. **1CO 1:2** To the church of God which is at Corinth, **to those who are SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) in Christ Jesus, called to be saints,** with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours: 3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (NKJ)
49. **1CO 1:30** But of Him you are in **Christ Jesus, who became for us WISDOM from God—and RIGHTEOUSNESS and SANCTIFICATION (*hagiasmos*) and REDEMPTION—**
50. **1CO 6:9** **Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God?** Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. 11 And such were some of you. But **you were washed, but you were SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*), but you were JUSTIFIED in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.** (NKJ)
51. **1CO 7:14** For **the unbelieving husband is SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are HOLY (*hagios*).**
52. **EPH 5:25** **Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26 that He might SANCTIFY (*hagiazō*) and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,** 27 that He

might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.

53. **1TH 4:3** For this is the will of God, your SANCTIFICATION (*hagiasmos*): that you should abstain from sexual immorality; 4 that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor,
54. **1TH 5:23** Now may the God of peace Himself SANCTIFY (*hagiazō*) you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. (NKJ)
55. **2TH 2:13** But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through SANCTIFICATION (*hagiasmos*) by the Spirit and belief in the truth, 14 to which He called you by our gospel, for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
56. **1TI 4:4** For every creature of God is good, and nothing is to be refused if it is received with thanksgiving; 5 for it is SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) by the word of God and prayer.
57. **2TI 2:19** Nevertheless the solid foundation of God stands, having this seal: “The Lord knows those who are His,” and, “Let everyone who names the name of Christ depart from iniquity.” 20 But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. 21 Therefore if anyone CLEANSSES (*ekkathairo*) himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, SANCTIFIES (*hagiazō*) and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work. (NKJ)
58. **HEB 2:10** For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation PERFECT through sufferings. 11 For both He who SANCTIFIES (*hagiazō*) and those who are being SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren. (NKJ)
59. **HEB 9:11** But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. 12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. 13 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, SANCTIFIES (*hagiazō*) for the purifying of the flesh, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, CLEANSE your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? 15 And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.
60. **HEB 10:8** Previously saying, “Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them” (which are offered according to the law), 9 then He said, “Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God.” He takes away the first that He may establish the second. 10 By that will we have been SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. 11 And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. 12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God, 13 from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool. 14 For by one offering He has PERFECTED FOREVER those who are being SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*). 15 But the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us; for after He had said before, 16 “This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them,” 17 then He adds, “Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.” 18 Now where there is remission of these, there is no longer an offering for sin. 19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He CONSECRATED for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. (NKJ)
61. **HEB 12:14** Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to BE HOLY (*hagios*); without holiness no one will see the Lord. (NKJ)
62. **HEB 13:12** Therefore Jesus also, that He might SANCTIFY (*hagiazō*) the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate. (NKJ)
63. **IPE 1:1** Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To the pilgrims of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, 2 elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in SANCTIFICATION (*hagiasmos*) of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace be multiplied.
64. **IPE 3:15** But SANCTIFY (*hagiazō*) the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear; (NKJ)
65. **JUD 1** Jude, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, To those who are called, SANCTIFIED (*hagiazō*) by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ: (NKJ)
66. **REV 22:11** “He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is HOLY (*hagios*), let him be HOLY (*hagios*) still.”

Perfection

5046 TELEIOS { tel'-i-os} (adj) AV - perfect 17, man 1, of full age 1; 19; (1) brought to its end, finished (2) perfect (3) wanting nothing necessary to completeness (4) that which is perfect, i.e. consummate human integrity & virtue, of men; full grown, adult, mature

67. **MAT 5:48** **“Therefore you shall be PERFECT (*teleios*), just as your Father in heaven is PERFECT (*teleios*).**
68. **ROM 12:1** **I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.** 2 And **do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and PERFECT (*teleios*) will of God.**
69. **1COS 2:6** Howbeit **we speak wisdom among them that are PERFECT (*teleios*):** yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought: 7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for our glory, 8 which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. 9 But **as it is written: “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.”** 10 **But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.** (NKJ)
70. **COL 1:28** **Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man PERFECT (*teleios*) in Christ Jesus.** 29 To this end I also labor, striving according to His working which works in me mightily. (NKJ)
71. **COL 3:12** Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. 14 But **above all these things put on love, which is the bond of PERFECTION (*teleiotes*).** (NKJ)
72. **HEB 6:1** Therefore, **leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to PERFECTION (*teleiotes*),** not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.
