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3. **1TH 5:23** Now **may the God of peace Himself SANCTIFY YOU COMPLETELY**; and **may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless** at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
  4. **HEB 12:14** Pursue peace with all people, and **HOLINESS, without which no one will see the Lord**:

5. **LEV 11:44** 'For I am the Lord your God. You shall therefore CONSECRATE yourselves, and you shall BE HOLY; for I am holy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth.
6. **HEB 6:1** Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to PERFECTION, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.
7. **1CO 1:30** But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us WISDOM from God—and RIGHTEOUSNESS and SANCTIFICATION and REDEMPTION—

9. **Holy = sanctified, set apart**
10. We are in **covenant** with God. He has promised to take away our sins.  
**ROM 11:27** For this is MY COVENANT with them, When I take away their sins."  
**Berith** = covenant "to cut".
11. **2TH 2:13** But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for SALVATION THROUGH SANCTIFICATION by the Spirit and belief in the truth,
12. **Brit milah**
13. **ROM 11:22** Therefore consider the goodness and **severity (apotomia)** of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.  
**Apo** = away, from, off, out of      **temno** = to cut
14. **COL 2:11** In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, 12 buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.
15. The following from **Wesley** is to the point: "Four or five and forty years ago, when I had no distinct views of what the apostle meant by exhorting us to leave the principles of the doctrine of Christ, and go on to PERFECTION, two or three persons in London whom I knew to be truly sincere, desired to give me an account of their experience. It seemed exceedingly strange, being different from any that I had heard before ... The next year, two or three more in Bristol, and two or three in Kingswood, coming to me severally, gave me exactly the same account of their experience. A few years after, I desired all those in London, who made the same profession, to come to me all together at the Foundry, that I might be thoroughly satisfied. I desired that man of God, Thomas Walsh, to give us the meeting there. When we met, first one of us. and then the other, asked the most searching questions we could devise. They answered every one without hesitation, and with the utmost simplicity, so that we were fully persuaded they did not deceive themselves. In the years 1759, 1760, 1761 and 1762, their number multiplied exceedingly, not only in London and Bristol, but in various parts of Ireland as well as England. Not trusting to the testimony of others, I carefully examined the most of these myself; and in London alone, I found six hundred and fifty-two members of our society, who were exceedingly clear in their experience, and of whose testimony I could see no reason to doubt I believe no year has passed since that time. wherein God has not wrought the same work in many others; but sometimes in one part of England or Ireland, sometimes in another; -- as 'the wind bloweth where it listeth;' -- and every one of these (after the most careful inquiry, I have not found one exception either in Great Britain or Ireland) has declared that his deliverance from sin was instantaneous; that the change was wrought in a moment Had half of these, or one-third, or one in twenty, declared it was gradually wrought in them, I should have believed this, with regard to them, and thought that some were gradually sanctified and some instantaneously. But as I have not found, in so long a space of time, a single person speaking thus; as all who believe they are sanctified, declare with one voice, that the change was wrought in a moment, I cannot but believe that sanctification is commonly, if not always, an instantaneous work."

16. **Sanctification does not bestow freedom from temptation, but freedom from sin; nor is it freedom from spiritual warfare, but freedom from defeat.**

17. Difference between **GROWING in Grace** vs **Sanctification**  
**Maturing the New Man** vs **Removing the Old Man**  
**Addition** vs **Subtraction**  
**The Old Man fights against the New Man, so growth accelerates unimpeded once Sanctification occurs.**

18. **1PE 4:1** Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for **he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, 2 that he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God.**

19. Justification and Sanctification occur **instantly**. We do not GROW into holiness. We **GROW** in grace which grows our **CONSECRATION**.

20. Consecration is what **WE** do – Sanctification is what **GOD** does

21. **TWO extremes** – We receive holiness at conversion (born holy)

28. **Crossing** the Red Sea represents Water Baptism, into the Old Covenant of Moses.  
**Crossing** the Jordan River represents Spirit Baptism, into the New Covenant of Christ. Adam.  
**Water Baptism** represents salvation from the PENALTY of sin.  
**Spirit Baptism** represents salvation from the POWER of sin.

29. **CONSECRATION, commitment**. Jumping out a window. Breakfast of Bacon and Eggs.

30. **1Pe 1:15-16** but **as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct**, because it is written, **“Be holy, for I am holy.”**

31. **“Something is wrong with my Christianity”** **That’s the place you have to be.**

32. **TYPOLOGIES**

33. Jesus was first **born of the Spirit**, but only later **filled with the Spirit** at the Jordan river before entering public ministry
34. In Jesus **FIRST miracle at the wedding**, he first filled the earthen vessels with water, but then turned it into wine.
35. Prior to death and resurrection, Jesus told his disciples the HS dwelt **WITH** them, but would later be **IN** them (**JOH 14:17**).
36. **JOH 14:17** the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.
37. On the day of His resurrection, Jesus breathed on His disciples, saying **receive ye the Holy Ghost (JOH 20:22)**, but later told His disciples to wait (10 days) in Jerusalem for the Holy Ghost and power to be witnesses (**ACT 1:4-5,8**). Why twice?
38. Jesus first states the HS will be in us as a **WELL of water**, springing up to eternal life (conversion to salvation) (**JOH 4:14**), and later states the HS will be in believers as **RIVERS of living water** (filling for service to others) (**JOH 7:37-38**).
39. In the OT, God took His people out of Egypt, thru the **Red Sea** (a type of water baptism) into the wilderness where they remained carnal, but only later across the **Jordan** (a type of Spirit Baptism) into the promised land to live in victory.
40. In the OT, the feasts of **Passover and Firstfruits** represent a type of salvation thru the death and resurrection of Jesus. **Pentecost** (Sinai law) came 50 days later and preshadows the in-filling with the Holy Spirit for the Harvest (latter rain).
41. In the OT consecration of the priest, blood of the lamb was applied to the right ear, thumb and great toe, followed by putting oil on top the blood (salvation). Then rest of the oil was poured onto the priest's head (Spirit baptism) (**LEV 14:14-18**).
42. In the OT **meal offering**, the meal of fine flour was first baked with oil (salvation), but then broken into pieces and oil poured over the pieces (Spirit baptism) before it was presented to God (for service) (**LEV 2:5-6**).
43. **Before Pentecost**, the disciples were a fearful, uncertain band of believers, often hiding together. **After Pentecost**, even the authorities were astonished that these simple unlearned men spoke with such boldness and power (**ACT 4:13**).  
**ACT 4:13** When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and they took note that these men had been with Jesus.
44. In **ACT 8:5-13** we read about Philip preaching to the Samaritans, who believed and were baptized. In vv 14-17, Peter & John were sent from Jerusalem to lay hands on these new Christians that they would be filled with the Holy Spirit.
45. Saul was converted going to Damascus, calling Jesus LORD, called a brother, but only later filled with the HS (**ACT 9:1-22**).
46. In **Acts 19**, disciples were found that were believers and had been baptized. They are then filled with the HS when Paul lays his hands on them in prayer, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied (**ACT 19:1-6**).
47. **EPH 3:14-21**  
**GAL 4:19** My little children, for whom I travail in birth **again** until Christ is formed in you,
48. **HEB 9:28** so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him **He will appear a second time**, apart from sin, for **salvation**.
49. **ISA 28:9** "Whom will he teach knowledge? And whom will he make to understand the message? Those just weaned from milk? Those just drawn from the breasts? 10 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, Here a little, there a little." 11 For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people, 12 To whom He said, "This is the rest with which You may cause the weary to rest," And, "This is the refreshing";
50. **MAT 11:28** "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you **rest**. 29 "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find **rest** for your souls.

55. **OT – NT HEB 9:13** For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? 15 And **for this reason He is the Mediator of the NEW COVENANT**, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.
56. Mt. Sinai – Mt. Zion
57. Jacob wrestling with God – Israel – **Peniel** (I have seen the face of God)
58. **2CO 1:15** And in this confidence I intended to come to you before, that you might have a second benefit (CHARIS)—
59. **ROM 5:1** Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom **also** we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
60. **Two** touches to heal the Blind Man. **MAR 8:22-25**
61. **JOH 15:10** "If you keep My commandments, **you will ABIDE in My love**, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. 11 "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full. 12 "This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. 13 "Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. 14 "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you. 15 "No longer do I call you **servants**, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you **friends**, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.
62. TWO animal sacrifices.
63. TWO goats – one killed and one sent into the wilderness.
64. TWO doves – one killed and one sent free
65. TWO washings of the leper

67. The LEVITES and the PRIESTS – 'holiness unto the LORD'
68. ONLY the priests go into the Holy of Holies.
69. TWO kinds of slaves

71. The **BREASTPLATE** of righteousness, the **HELMET** of salvation – **THEN** given the sword of the Spirit
72. The **Treasure** and the **Pearl**: **MAT 13:44** "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. 45 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls, 46 "who, when he had found **ONE PEARL OF GREAT PRICE**, went and sold all that he had and bought it.
73. How hard it is for a rich man to be saved – easier for a camel to go through **the eye of a needle** than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven.
74. The **PROOF** – a clean heart, the removal of the 'Old Man' – not tongues, which are often 'in the flesh'.
75. **Elijah** at Mount Carmel.
76. **LEV 11:44** 'For I am the Lord your God. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy; for I am holy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth.

77. “I can see far down the mountain, Where I wandered weary years, Often hindered in my journey By the ghosts of doubts and fears. Broken vows and disappointments, Thickly sprinkled all the way. But the spirit led unerring To the land I hold today.” —Anon.
78. **JOH 7:37** On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “**If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.** 38 “**He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.**”
79. **ACT 2:39** “For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”

John Wesley testifies, “Many years since I saw without holiness no man shall see the Lord, I began by following after it, and inciting all with whom I had any intercourse to do the same. Ten years after, God gave me a clearer view than I had before of the way how to attain it — namely, by faith in the Son of God. And immediately I declared to all, **WE ARE SAVED FROM SIN, WE ARE MADE HOLY BY FAITH.** This I testified in private, in public, in print, and God confirmed it by a thousand witnesses.” Vol. 7, p. 38

80. **LUK 1:73** The oath which He swore to our father Abraham: 74 To grant us that we, Being delivered from the hand of our enemies, Might serve Him without fear, 75 In holiness and righteousness before Him all the days of our life.
81. **MAT 7:6** “**Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine,** lest they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you in pieces.
82. **GAL 3:1** O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed among you as crucified? 2 This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? 3 Are you so foolish? **Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?** 4 Have you suffered so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain? 5 Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?—
83. **LUK 11:13** “If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father **give the Holy Spirit** to those who ask Him!”
84. **MAT 3:11** “I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. **He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.** 12 “**His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather His wheat into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.**”
85. **AMO 9:9** “For surely I will command, And will sift the house of Israel among all nations, As grain is sifted in a sieve; Yet not the smallest grain shall fall to the ground. 10 All the sinners of My people shall die by the sword, Who say, ‘The calamity shall not overtake nor confront us.’
86. **Communion.** Take eat, this is my body (IDENTIFICATION) **Matza** = no leaven. 3<sup>rd</sup> cup = the **cup of sanctification.** Feast of unleavened bread. In the MIDDLE of that was the Feast of Firstfruits. THEN came pentecost.
87. **IMPUTED** Righteousness vs **IMPARTED** Righteousness

88. “**Sanctify** them through thy truth, thy word is truth. As thou has sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. And for their sakes I **sanctify** myself; that they also might be **sanctified** through the truth.”
89. Long pursued by sin and Satan, Weary, sad I longed for rest, Then I found this heavenly shelter Opened in my Saviour’s breast. —James
90. **EPH 5:25** Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26 **that He might SANCTIFY and cleanse her** with the washing of water by the word, 27 that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.
91. **HEB 13:11** For the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp. 12 Therefore **Jesus also, that He might SANCTIFY the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.**
92. **ROM 6:6** knowing this, that **our OLD MAN was crucified with Him, that THE BODY OF SIN might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.** 7 For **he who has died has been freed from sin.**
93. **ROM 8:3** For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, 4 that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
94. **GAL 2:20** “I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
95. **HEB 10:19** Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.
96. **2CO 3:14** But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because **the veil is taken away in Christ.**
97. **HEB 9:16** For where there is a testament, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator.
98. **HEB 10:5** Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: “Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me. 6 In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. 7 Then I said, ‘Behold, I have come—In the volume of the book it is written of Me— To do Your will, O God.’ ” 8 Previously saying, “Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them” (which are offered according to the law), 9 then He said, “Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God.” He takes away the first that He may establish the second.
99. **HEB 10:10** By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. 14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified. 15 But the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us; for after He had said before,

100. **HEB 10:35** Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. 36 For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: 37 “For yet a little while, And He who is coming will come and will not tarry.
101. **ROM 6:3** Or do you not know that **as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death**? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. 5 For **if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection,**
102. **What is holding us back?**
103. **JON 2:8** “Those who cling to worthless idols forfeit the grace that could be theirs. 9 But I, with a song of thanksgiving, will sacrifice to you. What I have vowed I will make good. **SALVATION** comes from the LORD.”
104. **HEB 12:1** Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. 2 Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and **PERFECTER** of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (NIV)
105. **MAL 3:1** “Behold, I send My messenger, And he will prepare the way before Me. **And the Lord, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, Even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight.** Behold, He is coming,” Says the Lord of hosts.
106. **JOH 16:33** “These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”
107. **ROM 12:21** Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
108. **1JO 4:4** You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
109. **1JO 5:4** For whatever is born of God **overcomes** the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. 5 Who is he who **overcomes** the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
110. **REV 2:7** “He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who **overcomes** I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God.” ’
