4. Write out **MAT 3:1-2**: *In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, 2 and saying, "REPENT, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!"*

Write out **MAT 4:17**: *From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "REPENT, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."*

Write out **MAR 6:7, 12**: *And He called the twelve to Himself, and began to send them out two by two, and gave them power over unclean spirits. 12 So they went out and preached that people should REPENT.*

**From** the above verses, **WHAT** was the message preached? *Repentance and belief were the essential ideas.*

5. **MAT 9:10** Now it happened, as Jesus sat at the table in the house, that behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Him and His disciples. 11 And when the Pharisees saw it, they said to His disciples, "Why does your Teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" 12 When Jesus heard that, He said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a doctor, but those who are sick. 13 "But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy and not sacrifice.' For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance." (NKJ)

**What** is the Greek word for **sinners**? hamartolos **repentance**? metanoea

6. Define **REPENTANCE**: 1. Sorrow, compunction, regret, or contrition for past sin, action, or conduct, or for something left undone 2. The process of exhibiting or showing forth sorrow, regret, compunction, or contrition.

7. Define **REVIVAL**: 1. To come back to life; to live again after dying 2. To come back to consciousness 3. To come back to health and vigor 4. To flourish again after decline 5. To come back into use or attention 6. To become valid, effective or operative again

Define **CONSECRATION**: 1. To set apart as sacred to deity; to dedicate solemnly to a sacred of religious purpose; 2. To make sacred or holy and so to fit for religious use; 3. Ordination and hallowing of persons to certain offices, religious or otherwise;

8. **T** **F** Repentance and revival are like two sides of the same coin. You cannot have one without the other.

**T** **F** Repentance and forgiveness are like two sides of the same coin. You cannot have one without the other.

**T** **F** When we turn **TO** God, we must turn **FROM** sin. One cannot occur without the other.

**T** **F** Repentance is not a one-time event in the life of a Christian. It is a daily lifestyle that should occur throughout life.

**T** **F** When we **repent**, we are placing ourselves as a living sacrifice on the altar. It is **GOD's job** to take away the sin and iniquity that bind us.

**T** **F** Christians in Romania are called "**Repenters**".

**T** **F** Repentance is a **GIFT** which God **GRANTS**. It begins with us in the natural, but is fulfilled as a Spiritual Gift from God

**T** **F** When we truly repent, we should expect and believe that God will forgive us.

9. **1TH 1:9** For they themselves declare concerning us what manner of entry we had to you, and how you turned TO God FROM idols to serve the living and true God, 10 and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, even Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come. (NKJ)

10. **2TI 2:24** And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, 25 in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, 26 and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will. (NKJ)

11. Write out **JOH 17:17**: *"Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth."*

**MAT 23:19** "Fools and blind guides! For which is greater, the gift or the altar that sanctifies the gift? (NKJ)

12. **MAT 18:21** Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" 22 Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven. (NKJ)

**LUK 17:3** "Take heed to yourselves. If your brother sins against you, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him. 4 "And if he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day returns to you, saying, 'I repent,' you shall forgive him." (NKJ)

13. **T F** Just as **repentance** is a Gift of God's Grace, so also is **revival**. God even gave David the words for his prayer of repentance in **PSA 51**.
- T F** **Fasting, Bible reading, and prayer** typically occurred together with Old Testament **repentance**.
- T F** **Rain** in the Old Testament is a type of the Holy Spirit. (eg **DEU 11:16-17, 2CH 6:26-27; 2CH 7:13-14**)
- T F** **Consecration** is what we do. **Sanctification** is what God does.

**What** is the Hebrew word for '**salvation**' in **PSA 91:16**? yeshua **What** is Jesus' Hebrew name? Yeshua  
**Look** in the concordance. What does this word mean? Salvation, deliverance, protection, wholeness, healing.
15. Read **MAT 18:23-35**. How much money is 10,000 talents? 15 million ounces of Gold, or \$ 4.5 billion  
 How much is 100 denarii? About \$ 500.00 Who are the **torturers** in v34? Demons that affect one who refuses to forgive. Forgiveness opens the door to our lives to "tormenters" or "torturers"  
**How** would you summarize the meaning of the story? The King represents Christ. He has forgiven our debt of sin to Him, comparable to the enormous debt forgiven the first servant. God expects us, in turn, to forgive our fellow man of their small debts towards us. In fact, the penalty for unforgiveness in torment in our lives.
16. Write out **ISA 59:1-2**: Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear. 2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear.
17. **ISA 57:15** For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy : "I dwell in the high and holy place, With him who has a contrite and humble spirit, To revive the spirit of the humble, And to revive the heart of the contrite ones. (NKJ)  
 From this scripture, **WHERE** in your being does revival happen? In my spirit (my heart)
18. **HOS 6:1** Come, and let us return to the Lord; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. 2 After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight. 3 Let us know, Let us pursue the knowledge of the Lord. His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to us like the rain, Like the latter and former rain to the earth. (NKJ)
19. From **HOS 6:1-3**, what is the prophetic meaning of '**after two days**' and '**on the third day**'? The first Adam came nearly 6,000 year ago (6 days in prophetic time). The second Adam (Christ) came nearly 2,000 years ago (2 days in prophetic time). At the end of the second day, Christ quickens His body, the church. We will be raised up, in resurrected bodies, on the third day, which is the start of the millenium.
20. **Where else** in the Bible can you find reference to '**former and latter rains**'? What are possible prophetic meanings here? The seven feasts, as well as many other functions commanded in the Bible are based inherently on the annual Jewish planting and harvest cycle. The former rains in the spring softened the ground, in preparation for planting the seed. The fall or latter rains after the dry summer served to mature the grain for harvest. The harvest cycle is a picture of God's harvest of people from the earth. The former rains occurred at Pentecost. The latter rains are occurring even now, and will so more intensely in the future, just prior to Christ's return.
21. **MAT 3:11** "I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. 12 "His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather His wheat into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire." (NKJ)  
**LUK 12:49** "I came to send fire on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled! 50 "But I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how distressed I am till it is accomplished! (NKJ)
22. Write out **ACT 2:3**: Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them.  
 Write out **HEB 12:29**: For our God is a consuming fire.  
 Water Baptism represents and occurs with our repentance. When properly done, God responds with His Baptism of the Holy Spirit and FIRE, which provides sanctification, cleansing from sin and iniquity, and death to the flesh, which paralyzes and neutralizes the Adamic nature, the "old man".
23. **REV 3:18** "I counsel you to buy from Me Gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. 19 "As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent. (NKJ)
24. **IPE 4:17** For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with US first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God? 18 Now "If the righteous one is scarcely saved, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?" (NKJ)  
**ZEC 13:8** And it shall come to pass in all the land," Says the Lord, "That two-thirds in it shall be cut off and die, But one-third shall be left in it: 9 I will bring the one-third through the FIRE, Will refine them as silver is refined, And test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, And I will answer them. I will say, 'This is My people'; And each one will say, 'The Lord is my God.' "
