

Repentance

1. **MAT 4:17** From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, “REPENT (*metanoeo*), for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”
2. **MAT 9:10** Now it happened, as Jesus sat at the table in the house, that behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Him and His disciples. 11 And when the Pharisees saw it, they said to His disciples, “Why does your Teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?” 12 When Jesus heard that, He said to them, “Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. 13 “But go and learn what this means: ‘I desire mercy and not sacrifice.’ For I did not come to call the righteous, but SINNERS, TO REPENTANCE (*metanoia*).”
3. **MAT 11:28** “Come to me, all you who are WEARY and BURDENED, and I will give you REST. 29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”
4. **Mar 1:14** Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, 15 and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. REPENT (*metanoeo*), and believe in the gospel.”

5. **LUK 15:4** “What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? 5 “And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing, 6 “And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, ‘Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!’ 7 “I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who REPENTS (*metanoeo*) than over ninety-nine just persons who need no REPENTANCE (*metanoia*).
6. **LUK 17:3** “Take heed to yourselves. If your BROTHER sins against you, rebuke him; and if he REPENTS (*metanoia*), forgive him. 4 “And if he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day returns to you, saying, ‘I REPENT (*metanoeo*),’ you shall forgive him.”
7. **LUK 24:46** Then He said to them, “Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, 47 “and that REPENTANCE (*metanoia*) and REMISSION OF SINS should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.
8. **JOH 6:37** “ALL that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.
9. **ACT 2:37** Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Men and brethren, what shall we do?” 38 Then Peter said to them, “REPENT (*metanoeo*), and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
10. **ACT 3:19** “REPENT (*metanoeo*) therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, 20 “and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before,
11. **2CO 7:10** For godly sorrow produces REPENTANCE (*metanoia*) leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.
12. **2TI 2:11** Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with him, we will also live with him; 12 if we endure (suffer), we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us; 13 if we are faithless, he will remain faithful, for he cannot disown himself.
13. **HEB 12:1** Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. 2 Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. 3 Consider him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart. 4 In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. 5 And you have forgotten that word of encouragement that addresses you as sons: “My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, 6 because the Lord disciplines those he loves, and he punishes everyone he accepts as a son.” 7 Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as sons. For what son is not disciplined by his father? 8 If you are not disciplined (and everyone undergoes discipline), then you are illegitimate children and not true sons. 9 Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us and we respected them for it. How much more should we submit to the Father of our spirits and live! 10 Our fathers disciplined us for a little while as they thought best; but God disciplines us for our good, that we may share in his holiness. 11 No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it. 12 Therefore, strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees. 13 “Make level paths for your feet,” so that the lame may not be disabled, but rather healed.

14. **HEB 6:1** Therefore, leaving the discussion of **the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of REPENTANCE (metanoia) from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment** .3 And this we will do if God permits. 4 **For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit, 5 and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, 6 if they fall away, to renew them again to REPENTANCE (metanoia)**, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame.
15. **HEB 13:5** Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because **God has said, “Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.”**
16. **IJO 1:9** **If we CONFESS OUR SINS, He is faithful and just to FORGIVE us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**
17. **REV 3:19** **“As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and REPENT (metanoeo).** 20 “Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. 21 **“To him who OVERCOMES I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.** 22 “He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.” ’ ’ ’
18. **2CH 7:13** If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 **If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and TURN from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.**
19. **JOB 5:17** **“Blessed is the man whom God CORRECTS; so do not despise the DISCIPLINE of the Almighty.** 18 **For he wounds, but he also binds up; he injures, but his hands also heal.** 19 From six calamities he will rescue you; in seven no harm will befall you. 20 In famine he will ransom you from death, and in battle from the stroke of the sword. 21 You will be protected from the lash of the tongue, and need not fear when destruction comes. 22 You will laugh at destruction and famine, and need not fear the beasts of the earth. 23 For you will have a covenant with the stones of the field, and the wild animals will be at peace with you. 24 You will know that your tent is secure; you will take stock of your property and find nothing missing. 25 You will know that your children will be many, and your descendants like the grass of the earth. 26 You will come to the grave in full vigor, like sheaves gathered in season. 27 **“We have examined this, and it is true. So hear it and apply it to yourself.”**
20. **PSA 6:1** O **LORD, do not rebuke me in your anger or discipline me in your wrath.** 2 **Be merciful to me, LORD, for I am faint; O LORD, heal me, for my bones are in agony.** 3 My soul is in anguish. How long, O LORD, how long? 4 **Turn, O LORD, and deliver me; save me because of your unfailing love.** 5 No one remembers you when he is dead. Who praises you from the grave? 6 I am worn out from groaning; all night long I flood my bed with weeping and drench my couch with tears. 7 My eyes grow weak with sorrow; they fail because of all my foes. 8 Away from me, all you who do evil, for the LORD has heard my weeping. 9 **The LORD has heard my cry for mercy; the LORD accepts my prayer.** 10 **All my enemies will be ashamed and dismayed; they will turn back in sudden disgrace.**
21. **PSA 34:18** **The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit.**
22. **PSA 51:1** **Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love;** according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions. 2 **Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.** 3 For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. 4 Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you are proved right when you speak and justified when you judge. 5 Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me. 6 Surely you desire truth in the inner parts; you teach me wisdom in the inmost place. 7 **Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.** 8 **Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice.** 9 **Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity.** 10 **Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.** 11 **Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me.** 12 **Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.** 13 **Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will turn back to you.** 14 **Save me from bloodguilt, O God, the God who saves me, and my tongue will sing of your righteousness.** 15 O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise. 16 You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. 17 **The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.** 18 In your good pleasure make Zion prosper; build up the walls of Jerusalem. 19 Then there will be righteous sacrifices, whole burnt offerings to delight you; then bulls will be offered on your altar.
23. **PSA 66:18** **If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened;**
24. **PSA 85:1** You showed favor to your land, O LORD; you restored the fortunes of Jacob. 2 You forgave the iniquity of your people and covered all their sins. Selah 3 You set aside all your wrath and turned from your fierce anger. 4 **RESTORE US again, O God our Savior, and put away your displeasure toward us.** 5 Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger through all generations? 6 **Will you not REVIVE US again, that your people may rejoice in you?** 7 Show us your unfailing love, O LORD, and grant us your salvation. 8 **I will listen to what God the LORD will say; he promises peace to his people, his saints— but let them not return to folly.** 9 **Surely his salvation is near those who fear him, that his glory may dwell in our land.**
25. **PSA 94:14** For **the LORD will not reject his people; he will never forsake his inheritance.** 15 Judgment will again be founded on righteousness, and all the upright in heart will follow it.

Commitment in our walk with Christ is like jumping out a window. Once you do, there is NO going back. Just as Ceasar burned his ships after he crossed the Rubicon, we also need to “burn our bridges” to the old life, and look ahead to Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith!

26. **PSA 107:33** He turned rivers into a desert, flowing springs into thirsty ground, 34 and fruitful land into a salt waste, because of the wickedness of those who lived there.
27. **PSA 138:8** **The LORD will fulfill his purpose for me; your love, O LORD, endures forever— do not abandon the works of your hands.**
28. **PSA 143:1** O LORD, **hear my prayer, listen to my cry for mercy; in your faithfulness and righteousness come to my relief.** 2 Do not bring your servant into judgment, for no one living is righteous before you. 3 The enemy pursues me, he crushes me to the ground; he makes me dwell in darkness like those long dead. 4 So my spirit grows faint within me; my heart within me is dismayed. 5 I remember the days of long ago; I meditate on all your works and consider what your hands have done. 6 I spread out my hands to you; my soul thirsts for you like a parched land. Selah 7 **Answer me quickly, O LORD; my spirit fails. Do not hide your face from me or I will be like those who go down to the pit.** 8 Let the morning bring me word of your unfailing love, for I have put my trust in you. Show me the way I should go, for to you I lift up my soul. 9 Rescue me from my enemies, O LORD, for I hide myself in you. 10 Teach me to do your will, for you are my God; may your good Spirit lead me on level ground. 11 **For your name’s sake, O LORD, preserve my life; in your righteousness, bring me out of trouble.** 12 In your unfailing love, silence my enemies; destroy all my foes, for I am your servant.
29. **PSA 147:3** **He heals the brokenhearted And binds up their wounds.**
30. **PRO 28:13** **He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.** 14 Happy is the man who is always reverent, But he who hardens his heart will fall into calamity.
31. **ISA 1:16** “Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean; **Put away the evil of your doings from before My eyes.** Cease to do evil, 17 Learn to do good; Seek justice, Rebuke the oppressor; Defend the fatherless, Plead for the widow. 18 **“Come now, and let us reason together,” Says the Lord, “Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool.** 19 **If you are willing and obedient, You shall eat the good of the land;** 20 But if you refuse and rebel, You shall be devoured by the sword”; For the mouth of the Lord has spoken.
32. **ISA 7:9** The head of Ephraim is Samaria, and the head of Samaria is only Remaliah’s son. **If you do not stand firm in your faith, you will not stand at all.”**
33. **ISA 41:10** **Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.**
34. **ISA 55:6** Seek the LORD while he may be found; call on him while he is near. 7 **Let the wicked FORSAKE his way and the evil man his thoughts. Let him turn to the LORD, and he will have mercy on him, and to our God, for he will freely pardon.** 8 **“For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,” declares the LORD.** 9 **“As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.** 10 As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, 11 so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. 12 **You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands.** 13 Instead of the thornbush will grow the pine tree, and instead of briars the myrtle will grow. This will be for the LORD’s renown, for an everlasting sign, which will not be destroyed.”
35. **ISA 59:20** **“The Redeemer will come to Zion, And to those who TURN from transgression in Jacob,” Says the Lord.**
36. **ISA 66:2** For all those things My hand has made, And all those things exist,” Says the Lord. **“But on this one will I look: On him who is poor and of a contrite spirit, And who trembles at My word.**
37. **EZE 18:27** “Again, **when a wicked man turns away from the wickedness which he committed, and does what is lawful and right, he preserves himself alive.** 28 “Because he considers and turns away from all the transgressions which he committed, **he shall surely live; he shall not die.**
38. **JER 29:11** For **I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.** 12 Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. 13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. 14 **I will be found by you,” declares the LORD, “and will bring you back from captivity. I will gather you from all the nations and places where I have banished you,” declares the LORD, “and will bring you back to the place from which I carried you into exile.”**
39. **LAM 3:22** **Because of the LORD’s great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. 23 They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.**
40. **JOE 2:12** “Now, therefore,” says the Lord, **“TURN to Me with all your heart, With fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.”** 13 So rend your heart, and not your garments; **Return to the Lord your God, For He is gracious and merciful, Slow to anger, and of great kindness; And He relents from doing harm.**
41. **ZEC 1:3** “Therefore say to them, “Thus says the Lord of hosts: **“RETURN to Me,” says the Lord of hosts, “and I will return to you,”** says the Lord of hosts.

Revival

REVIVE: 1. To come back to life; to live again after dying 2. To come back to consciousness 3. To come back to health and vigor 4. To flourish again after decline 5. To come back into use or attention 6. To become valid, effective or operative again

REVIVAL cannot occur without **REPENTANCE**. The two are inseparable. Revival is not something “worked up” by man. Revival comes down from God. You no more schedule a revival than you schedule an earthquake. You no more Organize a revival than you organize a hurricane. Revival is a move of God, but often after prayerful appeal from Christians. Revival **STARTS** with God’s people, the **INDIVIDUAL**, and **THEN** spills over to the heathen.

1. **DEU 11:16** BE CAREFUL, or you will be enticed to turn away and worship other gods and bow down to them. 17 Then the LORD’s anger will burn against you, and he will shut the heavens so that it will not rain and the ground will yield no produce, and you will soon perish from the good land the LORD is giving you.
2. **DEU 28:1** If you FULLY obey the LORD your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations on earth. 2 All these blessings will come upon you and accompany you if you obey the LORD your God: 3 You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country. 4 The fruit of your womb will be blessed, and the crops of your land and the young of your livestock—the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks. 5 Your basket and your kneading trough will be blessed. 6 You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out. 7 The LORD will grant that the enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you. They will come at you from one direction but flee from you in seven. 8 The LORD will send a blessing on your barns and on everything you put your hand to. The LORD your God will bless you in the land he is giving you. 9 The LORD will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways. 10 Then all the peoples on earth will see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they will fear you. 12 The LORD will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many nations but will borrow from none. 13 The LORD will make you the head, not the tail. If you pay attention to the commands of the LORD your God that I give you this day and carefully follow them, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom. 15 However, if you do NOT obey the LORD your God and do not carefully follow all his commands and decrees I am giving you today, all these curses will come upon you and overtake you: 16 You will be cursed in the city and cursed in the country. 17 Your basket and your kneading trough will be cursed. 18 The fruit of your womb will be cursed, and the crops of your land, and the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks. 19 You will be cursed when you come in and cursed when you go out. 20 The LORD will send on you curses, confusion and rebuke in everything you put your hand to, until you are destroyed and come to sudden ruin because of the evil you have done in forsaking him. 21 The LORD will plague you with diseases until he has destroyed you from the land you are entering to possess. 22 The LORD will strike you with wasting disease, with fever and inflammation, with scorching heat and drought, with blight and mildew, which will plague you until you perish. 23 The sky over your head will be bronze, the ground beneath you iron.
3. **JOS 24:15** “And if it seems evil to you to serve the Lord, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.”
4. **2CH 6:26** “When the heavens are shut up and there is no RAIN because your people have sinned against you, and when they pray toward this place and confess your name and turn from their sin because you have afflicted them, 27 then hear from heaven and forgive the sin of your servants, your people Israel. Teach them the right way to live, and send rain on the land you gave your people for an inheritance.
5. **2CH 7:13** “When I shut up the heavens so that there is no RAIN, or command locusts to devour the land or send a plague among my people, 14 if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
6. **EZR 9:8** “And now for a little while grace has been shown from the Lord our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a peg in His holy place, that our God may enlighten our eyes and give us a measure of REVIVAL in our bondage. 9 “For we were slaves. Yet our God did not forsake us in our bondage; but He extended mercy to us in the sight of the kings of Persia, TO REVIVE US, to repair the house of our God, to rebuild its ruins, and to give us a wall in Judah and Jerusalem.
7. **PSA 50:23** Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; And to him who orders his conduct aright I will show the salvation of God.”
8. **PSA 80:19** RESTORE US, O LORD God of hosts; Cause Your face to shine, And we shall be saved!
9. **PSA 85:4** 4 RESTORE US again, O God our Savior, and put away your displeasure toward us. 5 Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger through all generations? 6 Will you not REVIVE US again, that your people may rejoice in you? 7 Show us your unfailing love, O LORD, and grant us your salvation. 8 I will listen to what God the LORD will say; he promises peace to his people, his saints— but let them not return to folly. 9 Surely his salvation is near those who fear him, that his glory may dwell in our land.
10. **PSA 91:16** With long life I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation (veshua).”
11. **PSA 137:1** By the rivers of Babylon we sat and wept when we remembered Zion. 2 There on the poplars we hung our harps, 3 for there our captors asked us for songs, our tormentors demanded songs of joy; they said, “Sing us one of the songs of Zion!” 4 How can we sing the songs of the LORD while in a foreign land?

12. **PSA 138:7** Though I walk in the midst of trouble, **YOU WILL REVIVE ME**; You will stretch out Your hand Against the wrath of my enemies, And Your right hand will save me. 8 **The Lord will perfect that which concerns me**; Your mercy, O Lord, endures forever; **Do not forsake the works of Your hands.**
13. **PRO 28:13** **He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them finds mercy.** 14 Blessed is the man who always fears the LORD, but he who hardens his heart falls into trouble.
14. **ISA 57:15** For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: “I dwell in the high and holy place, With him who has a contrite and humble spirit, **To REVIVE the spirit of the humble, And to REVIVE the heart of the contrite ones.** 16 For I will not contend forever, Nor will I always be angry; For the spirit would fail before Me, And the souls which I have made. 17 For the iniquity of his covetousness I was angry and struck him; I hid and was angry, And he went on backsliding in the way of his heart. 18 **I have seen his ways, and will heal him; I will also lead him, And restore comforts to him And to his mourners.** 19 **“I create the fruit of the lips: Peace, peace to him who is far off and to him who is near,” Says the Lord, “And I will heal him.”**
15. **ISA 59:1** Surely **the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear.** 2 **But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.**
16. **ISA 59:20** **“The Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who repent of their sins,”** declares the LORD.
17. **JER 9:7** Therefore thus says the Lord of hosts: **“Behold, I will REFINE them and TRY them;** For how shall I deal with the daughter of My people?
18. **JER 29:11** For **I know the plans I have for you,”** declares the LORD, **“plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.** 12 Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. 13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. 14 **I will be found by you,”** declares the LORD, **“and will bring you back from captivity.** I will gather you from all the nations and places where I have banished you,” declares the LORD, “and will bring you back to the place from which I carried you into exile.”
19. **JER 33:6** “Nevertheless, I will bring health and healing to it; **I will heal my people** and will let them enjoy abundant peace and security. 7 **I will bring Judah and Israel back from captivity and will rebuild them as they were before.** 8 **I will cleanse them from all the sin they have committed against me and will forgive all their sins of rebellion against me.** 9 Then this city will bring me renown, joy, praise and honor before all nations on earth that hear of all the good things I do for it; and they will be in awe and will tremble at the abundant prosperity and peace I provide for it.”
20. **LAM 3:40** **Let us examine our ways and test them, and let us return to the LORD.** 41 Let us lift up our hearts and our hands to God in heaven, and **SAY:** 42 **“We have sinned and rebelled and you have not forgiven.** 43 “You have covered yourself with anger and pursued us; you have slain without pity. 44 You have covered yourself with a cloud so that **no prayer can get through.**
21. **LAM 5:21** **Turn us back to You, O Lord, and WE WILL BE RESTORED; RENEW OUR DAYS as of old,** 22 Unless You have utterly rejected us, And are very angry with us!
22. **DAN 11:35** “And **some of those of understanding shall fall, TO REFINE THEM, PURIFY THEM, AND MAKE THEM WHITE, until the time of the end;** because it is still for the appointed time.
23. **HOS 6:1** **Come, and let us RETURN to the Lord; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up.** 2 **After TWO DAYS He will REVIVE US; On the THIRD DAY He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight.** 3 Let us know, Let us pursue the knowledge of the Lord. His going forth is established as the morning; **He will come to us like the rain, Like the latter and former rain to the earth.**
24. **HOS 14:7** **Those who dwell under his shadow shall return; They shall be REVIVED like grain, And grow like a vine.** Their scent shall be like the wine of Lebanon. 8 “Ephraim shall say, ‘What have I to do anymore with idols?’ I have heard and observed him. I am like a green cypress tree; Your fruit is found in Me.”
25. **AMO 9:9** “For I will give the command, and **I will shake the house of Israel among all the nations** as grain is shaken in a sieve, and not a pebble will reach the ground. 10 **All the sinners among my people will die by the sword,** all those who say, ‘Disaster will not overtake or meet us.’ 11 **“In that day I will restore David’s fallen tent.** I will repair its broken places, restore its ruins, and build it as it used to be, 12 **so that they may possess the remnant of Edom and all the nations that bear my name,”** declares the LORD, who will do these things. 13 **“The days are coming,”** declares the LORD, **“when the reaper will be overtaken by the plowman and the planter by the one treading grapes.** New wine will drip from the mountains and flow from all the hills. 14 I will bring back my exiled people Israel; they will rebuild the ruined cities and live in them. They will plant vineyards and drink their wine; they will make gardens and eat their fruit. 15 I will plant Israel in their own land, never again to be uprooted from the land I have given them,” says the LORD your God.
26. **HAB 3:2** O Lord, I have heard your speech and was afraid; **O Lord, REVIVE Your work in the midst of the years! In the midst of the years make it known; In wrath remember mercy.**
27. **ZEC 13:8** And it shall come to pass in all the land,” Says the Lord, “That two-thirds in it shall be cut off and die, But one-third shall be left in it: **9 I will bring the one-third through the FIRE, Will REFINE them as silver is refined, And TEST them as gold is tested.** They will call on My name, And I will answer them. I will say, ‘This is My people’; And each one will say, ‘The Lord is my God.’ ”

“According to your holiness, so shall be your success. A holy man is an awesome weapon in the hands of God.” Robert Murray M’Cheyne (1813-1843) Religion is hanging AROUND the cross; Christianity is hanging ON the cross. There is a BIG difference. You CANNOT have a resurrection without FIRST a death to self, putting YOUR life on the Cross.

28. **MAT 3:11** “I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with FIRE. 12 His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor, gathering his wheat into the barn and burning up the chaff with unquenchable FIRE.”
29. **MAT 11:28** “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you REST. 29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”
30. **LUK 9:23** Then he said to them all: “If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. 24 For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it.
31. **LUK 12:49** “I came to send FIRE on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled! 50 “But I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how distressed I am till it is accomplished!
32. **LUK 14:27** And anyone who does not carry his cross and follow me CANNOT be my disciple.
33. **ACT 2:3** Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of FIRE, and one sat upon each of them.
34. **ACT 7:30** “And when forty years had passed, an Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire in a bush, in the wilderness of Mount Sinai.
35. **ROM 12:20** Therefore “If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of FIRE on his head.” 21 Do not be overcome by evil, but OVERCOME EVIL WITH GOOD.
36. **1CO 3:11** For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, 13 each one’s work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the FIRE will test each one’s work, of what sort it is. 14 If anyone’s work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. 15 If anyone’s work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through FIRE.
37. **2TI 2:19** Nevertheless, God’s solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: “The Lord knows those who are his,” and, “Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must turn away from wickedness.” 20 In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. 21 If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.
38. **HEB 12:1** Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. 2 Let us fix our eyes on JESUS, THE AUTHOR AND PERFECTER OF OUR FAITH, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. 14 Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord. 26 but now He has promised, saying, “Yet once more I shake not only the earth, but also heaven.” 27 Now this, “Yet once more,” indicates the removal of those things that are being shaken, as of things that are made, that the things which cannot be shaken may remain. 28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which CANNOT be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. 29 For our God is a consuming FIRE.
39. **JAM 5:16** Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be HEALED. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.
40. **1PE 1:6** In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, 7 that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by FIRE, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,
41. **1PE 4:17-18** For it is time for JUDGMENT to begin with the family of God; and if it begins with us, what will the outcome be for those who do not obey the gospel of God? 18 And, “If it is hard for the righteous to be saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?”
42. **2PE 3:7** But the heavens and the earth which are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for FIRE until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.
43. **REV 3:18** “I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the FIRE, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. 19 “As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and REPENT.
44. **REV 19:11** Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. 12 His eyes were like a flame of FIRE, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. 13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. 15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
