

1. ACT 16:30 Then he brought them out and said, “Sirs, WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?” 31 And they said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus and you and your household will be saved.”

Repent, Be Baptized, Be filled with the Holy Spirit

2. MAT 3:1 In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, 2 and saying, “Repent (metanoeo), for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!” 11 “I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. 12 “His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather His wheat into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.”
3. MAT 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, “Repent (metanoeo), for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”
4. MAR 6:7 And He called the twelve to Himself, and began to send them out two by two, and gave them power over unclean spirits. 12 So they went out and preached that people should repent (metanoeo).
5. ACTS 2:36 “Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ.” 37 Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Men and brethren, what shall we do?” 38 Then Peter said to them, “REPENT, and let every one of you BE BAPTIZED in the name of Jesus Christ FOR THE REMISSION OF SINS; and YOU SHALL RECEIVE THE GIFT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.” 39 “For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”
6. ACTS 3:19 “Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord,” 20 “and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before,
7. ACT 5:30 “The God of our fathers raised up Jesus whom you murdered by hanging on a tree. 31 “Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give REPENTANCE to Israel and FORGIVENESS OF SINS. 32 “And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the HOLY SPIRIT whom God has given to those who obey Him.”
8. ISA 59:20 The redeemer shall come to Zion, to those in Jacob who REPENT from their sins.
9. Are We Saved IN our sins or FROM our sins?
 ‘Just say this little prayer, and you will be saved’ ‘You can never lose your salvation’
 ‘Just ask Jesus into your heart’ ‘Just fill out this little card’
 ‘I assure you, you are now saved!’
10. WHO’s Job is it to convict of sin and to bring repentance? 2CO 7:10 For GODLY SORROW PRODUCES REPENTANCE leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.
JOH 16:7 But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate (paracletos) will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. 8 And when he comes he will CONVICT the world in regard to sin and righteousness and condemnation:
11. WHO’s Job is it to tell us we are saved? ROM 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,
12. Could these be FALSE SALVATIONS?
1JO 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. 9 Whoever has been born of God does not (continue in) sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot (go on) sin, because he has been born of God. 10 In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is he who does not love his brother.
- MAT 7:21 “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.” 22 “Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ 23 “And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’
- 1CO 6:9 Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, 10 nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. 11 And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.
13. Examples: Man at church serving communion while having affairs during the week
 Secret sins in the lives of so many Church-goers and even Christians
 False teachings, such as Bob George

14. **Justice** = Getting what you **DO** deserve
Mercy = **Not** getting what you **DO** deserve
Grace = Getting Good you **DON'T** deserve

15. **Conviction (by the Holy Spirit)** -----Produces **Repentance**-----Result: **God's infilling w/ Holy Spirit**
Realizing you are under JUSTICE-----Causes us to ask for **MERCY**-----God follows with His **GRACE**

16. **MAT 5:21** "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder, and whoever murders will be in danger of the judgment.'²² "But I say to you that whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, 'Raca!' shall be in danger of the council. But whoever says, 'You fool!' shall be in danger of hell fire.²³ "Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you,²⁴ "leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.²⁵ "Agree with your adversary quickly, while you are on the way with him, lest your adversary deliver you to the judge, the judge hand you over to the officer, and you be thrown into prison.²⁶ "Assuredly, I say to you, you will by no means get out of there till you have paid the last penny.

20. **Repent** = *metanoeo*: **meta** = after, behind, change (like metamorphosis)
noeo = think, understand, perceive
21. **nous** = mind, understanding, reasoning faculties **noeo** = think, understand, perceive
noema = thought, establish belief **metanoema** = a change in thoughts & beliefs, a **NEW** set of beliefs
22. **2CO 4:4** whose **minds (noemas)** the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.
2CO 3:14 But their **minds (noemas)** were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ.
2CO 11:3 But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent **deceived** Eve by his craftiness, so your **minds (noemas)** may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
HEB 10:16 "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their **minds (noemas)** I will write them,"¹⁷ then He adds, "Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."
HEB 12:3 For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your **minds (noemas)**.
23. **Repentance** and **Forgiveness** are inseparable. One cannot occur without the other.
Repentance and **Revival** are also like two sides of the same coin. One does not occur without the other.
Repentance is associated with Water Baptism.
Revival is associated with Spirit Baptism.
24. **Crossing** the Red Sea represents Water Baptism, into the Old Covenant of Moses.
Crossing the Jordan River represents Spirit Baptism, into the New Covenant of Christ. Water backs all the way to **Adam**.
25. **Water Baptism** represents salvation from the **PENALTY** of sin.
Spirit Baptism represents salvation from the **POWER** of sin.
26. **MAT 3:11** "**I indeed BAPTIZE you with WATER unto REPENTANCE**, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. **He will BAPTIZE you with the HOLY SPIRIT AND FIRE**.
1CO 10:1 Moreover, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware that **all our fathers** were under the cloud, all **passed through THE SEA**,² **ALL WERE BAPTIZED INTO MOSES in the cloud and in the sea**,
LUK 24:46 Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day,⁴⁷ "and that **repentance** and **remission of sins** should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.
27. **1JO 1:9**
28. **ACT 2:38** Then Peter said to them, "**REPENT**, and **let every one of you be BAPTIZED in the name of Jesus Christ FOR THE REMISSION OF SINS; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit**.

31. **Repent – Revive – Renew – Restore – Refine – Reward** **NEVER** Resign or Retire
32. **JEHOVAH-JIREH**: "The Lord will Provide." "**jireh**" ("to see")
JEHOVAH-ROPHE: "The Lord Who Heals" "**rophe**" ("to heal")
JEHOVAH-NISSI: "The Lord Our Banner."
JEHOVAH-M'KADDESH: "The Lord Who Sanctifies" "To make whole, set apart for holiness."
JEHOVAH-SHALOM: "The Lord Our Peace" "**Shalom**" translated "peace"
JEHOVAH-TSIDKENU: "The Lord Our Righteousness" "**tsidek**" (straight, stiff)

33. **ACT 19:1** And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples 2 he said to them, "**Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?**" So they said to him, "**We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit.**" 3 And he said to them, "**Into what then were you baptized?**" So they said, "**Into John's baptism.**" 4 Then Paul said, "**John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.**" 5 **When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.** 6 And **when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.**
34. **John Wesley's Definition of REVIVAL** = when God sets me on fire and the people come to watch me burn.
35. **Repentance** is a **SPIRITUAL** process. The Holy Spirit **HELPS** us repent. Psalm 51 is example.
36. **Forgiveness** and **Revival** also are **SPIRITUAL**. We start in the **FLESH**. God fulfills in the **SPIRIT**.
- YOU DO NOT HAVE TO 'FEEL' LIKE IT !!!** This is based on God's WORD, not any feelings. But the feelings WILL follow. Continue until you reach a breakthrough.

REVIVE: 1. To come back to life; to live again after dying 2. To come back to consciousness 3. To come back to health and vigor 4. To flourish again after decline 5. To come back into use or attention 6. To become valid, effective or operative again

37. **REVIVAL** cannot occur without **REPENTANCE**. The two are inseparable. Revival is not something "worked up" by man. Revival comes down from God. You no more schedule a revival than you schedule an earthquake. You no more Organize a revival than you organize a hurricane. Revival is a move of God, but often after prayerful appeal from Christians. Revival STARTS with God's people, the INDIVIDUAL, and THEN spills over to the heathen.

39. Non-Pentecostals will discover that all real revivals are accompanied by spiritual phenomena that many find strange. Stephen Strang observes that "Calvinists today are usually a dignified lot. So I was surprised to read this description of their meetings in France in the late 16th and 17th centuries . . . : 'Such persons would suddenly *fall backwards*, and while extended at full length on the ground, undergo *strange* and apparently *involuntary contortions*; their chests would seem to heave, their stomachs be inflated' " (emphasis mine). I am sure some Pentecostals will also be surprised to discover that what occurs in some of their revival services has occurred in the past in non-Pentecostal revivals. Some of the same phenomena occurring today were common especially during the Great Awakening of the 18th century under Wesley, Whitfield, and Jonathon Edwards.
