2. The World – The Flesh – The Devil & Demons
3. MAT 4:1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.
4. When did the temptations come? When He was filled with the Spirit, and entering into service.
5. How was Jesus tempted. EXACTLY as we are.
6. How did Jesus combat temptation? Always with the Word. Discuss RHEMA.
7. Satan's fiery darts are LIES. He is the DECEIVER. The only way to combat a lie is with the TRUTH. The TRUTH you know will set you FREE. We fight Satan's rhemas with God's RHEMA.
8. JOH 14:30 "I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and he has nothing in Me."
9. JAM 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. 14 But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. 15 Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death. 16 Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren. 17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.
10. MAR 7:18 Do you not perceive that whatever enters a man from outside cannot defile him, 19 "because it does not enter his heart but his stomach, and is eliminated, thus purifying all foods?" 20 And He said, "What comes out of a man, that defiles a man. 21 "For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 "thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness. 23 "All these evil things come from within and defile a man."
11. EPH 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong (endunamoo) in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles (methodeia) of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 PRAYING ALWAYS with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—
