

Sin, Transgression and Iniquity

1. **EXO 34:6** And the Lord passed before him and proclaimed, “The Lord, the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, 7 “keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity (*avon*) and transgression (*pasha*) and sin (*chatt’ah*), by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity (*avon*) of the fathers upon the children and the children’s children to the third and the fourth generation.”

3. **PSA 106:6** We have sinned with our fathers, We have committed iniquity, We have done wickedly.

5. **JER 14:20** We acknowledge, O Lord, our wickedness (*resha*) And the iniquity (*avon*) of our fathers, For we have sinned against You.
