

## 9-B Revival

1. **PSA 85:4 (Of the Sons of Korah) Restore us again.** O God our Savior, and put away your displeasure toward us. 5 **Will you be angry with us forever?** Will you prolong your anger through all generations? 6 **Will you not REVIVE us again, that your people may rejoice in you?** 7 Show us your unfailing love, O LORD, and grant us your salvation. 8 I will listen to what God the LORD will say; he promises peace to his people, his saints— but let them not return to folly. 9 Surely **his salvation is near those who fear him**, that his glory may dwell in our land.
2. **ISA 59:1** Surely **the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear.** 2 **But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.**
3. **PSA 66:18** If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened;
4. **LAM 3:40 Let us examine our ways and test them, and let us return to the LORD.** 41 Let us lift up our hearts and our hands to God in heaven, and **say: 42 “We have sinned and rebelled and you have not forgiven.** 43 “You have covered yourself with anger and pursued us; you have slain without pity. 44 You have covered yourself with a cloud so that **no prayer can get through.**
5. **DEU 28:1 If you FULLY obey the LORD your God and carefully follow all his commands** I give you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations on earth. 2 **All these blessings will come upon you and accompany you if you obey the LORD your God:** 3 You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country. 4 The fruit of your womb will be blessed, and the crops of your land and the young of your livestock—the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks. 5 Your basket and your kneading trough will be blessed. 6 You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out. 7 The LORD will grant that the enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you. They will come at you from one direction but flee from you in seven. 8 The LORD will send a blessing on your barns and on everything you put your hand to. The LORD your God will bless you in the land he is giving you. 9 **The LORD will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways.** 10 Then all the peoples on earth will see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they will fear you. 12 The LORD will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many nations but will borrow from none. 13 The LORD will make you the head, not the tail. **If you pay attention to the commands** of the LORD your God that I give you this day **and carefully follow them**, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom. 15 However, **if you do NOT obey the LORD your God and do not carefully follow all his commands and decrees** I am giving you today, **all these curses will come upon you and overtake you:** 16 You will be cursed in the city and cursed in the country. 17 Your basket and your kneading trough will be cursed. 18 The fruit of your womb will be cursed, and the crops of your land, and the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks. 19 You will be cursed when you come in and cursed when you go out. 20 The LORD will send on you curses, confusion and rebuke in everything you put your hand to, until you are destroyed and come to sudden ruin because of the evil you have done in forsaking him. 21 The LORD will plague you with diseases until he has destroyed you from the land you are entering to possess. 22 The LORD will strike you with wasting disease, with fever and inflammation, with scorching heat and drought, with blight and mildew, which will plague you until you perish. 23 **The sky over your head will be bronze,** the ground beneath you iron.
6. **PSA 137:1 By the rivers of Babylon we sat and wept when we remembered Zion.** 2 There on the poplars we hung our harps, 3 for there **our captors** asked us for songs, **our tormentors** demanded songs of joy; they said, “Sing us one of the songs of Zion!” 4 **How can we sing the songs of the LORD while in a foreign land?**
7. **PSA 107:33** He turned rivers into a desert, flowing springs into thirsty ground, 34 and fruitful land into a salt waste, because of the wickedness of those who lived there.
8. **DEU 11:16** Be careful, or you will be enticed to turn away and worship other gods and bow down to them. 17 Then the LORD’s anger will burn against you, and **he will shut the heavens so that it will not rain** and the ground will yield no produce, and you will soon perish from the good land the LORD is giving you.
9. **2CH 6:26 “When the heavens are shut up and there is no RAIN because your people have sinned against you,** and when they pray toward this place and confess your name and turn from their sin because you have afflicted them, 27 then hear from heaven and forgive the sin of your servants, your people Israel. **Teach them the right way to live, and send rain** on the land you gave your people for an inheritance.
10. **2CH 7:13 “When I shut up the heavens so that there is no rain,** or command locusts to devour the land or send a plague among my people, 14 **if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.**
11. **JER 29:11** For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. 12 Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. 13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. 14 **I will be found by you,” declares the LORD, “and will bring you back from captivity.** I will gather you from all the nations and places where I have banished you,” declares the LORD, “and will bring you back to the place from which I carried you into exile.”
12. **Psalms 138:7** Though I walk in the midst of trouble, **You will revive me;** You will stretch out Your hand Against the wrath of my enemies, And Your right hand will save me. 8 **The Lord will perfect that which concerns me;** Your mercy, O Lord, endures forever; **Do not forsake the works of Your hands.**

13. **PRO 28:13** He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them finds mercy.  
14 Blessed is the man who always fears the LORD, but he who hardens his heart falls into trouble.
14. **ISA 59:20** “The Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who repent of their sins,” declares the LORD.
15. **JER 33:6** “Nevertheless, I will bring health and healing to it; I will heal my people and will let them enjoy abundant peace and security. 7 I will bring Judah and Israel back from captivity and will rebuild them as they were before. 8 I will cleanse them from all the sin they have committed against me and will forgive all their sins of rebellion against me. 9 Then this city will bring me renown, joy, praise and honor before all nations on earth that hear of all the good things I do for it; and they will be in awe and will tremble at the abundant prosperity and peace I provide for it.’

**REVIVE:** 1. To come back to life; to live again after dying 2. To come back to consciousness 3. To come back to health and vigor 4. To flourish again after decline 5. To come back into use or attention 6. To become valid, effective or operative again

**REVIVAL cannot occur without REPENTANCE. The two are inseparable. Revival is not something “worked up” by man. Revival comes down from God. You no more schedule a revival than you schedule an earthquake. You no more Organize a revival than you organize a hurricane. Revival is a move of God, but often after prayerful appeal from Christians. Revival STARTS with God’s people, and THEN spills over to the heathen.**

16. **AMO 9:9** “For I will give the command, and I will shake the house of Israel among all the nations as grain is shaken in a sieve, and not a pebble will reach the ground. 10 All the sinners among my people will die by the sword, all those who say, ‘Disaster will not overtake or meet us.’ 11 “In that day I will restore David’s fallen tent. I will repair its broken places, restore its ruins, and build it as it used to be, 12 so that they may possess the remnant of Edom and all the nations that bear my name,” declares the LORD, who will do these things. 13 “The days are coming,” declares the LORD, “when the reaper will be overtaken by the plowman and the planter by the one treading grapes. New wine will drip from the mountains and flow from all the hills. 14 I will bring back my exiled people Israel; they will rebuild the ruined cities and live in them. They will plant vineyards and drink their wine; they will make gardens and eat their fruit. 15 I will plant Israel in their own land, never again to be uprooted from the land I have given them,” says the LORD your God.
17. **IPE 4:17-18** For it is time for judgment to begin with the family of God; and if it begins with us, what will the outcome be for those who do not obey the gospel of God? 18 And, “If it is hard for the righteous to be saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?”
18. **HEB 12:1** Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. 2 Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. 14 Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.
19. **JAM 5:16** Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.
20. **MAT 11:28** “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”
21. **LUK 9:23** Then he said to them all: “If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. 24 For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it.
22. **LUK 14:27** And anyone who does not carry his cross and follow me CANNOT be my disciple.

**Religion is hanging AROUND the cross; Christianity is hanging ON the cross. There is a BIG difference. You CANNOT have a resurrection without FIRST a death to self, putting your life on the Cross.**

23. **MAT 3:11** “I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. 12 His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor, gathering his wheat into the barn and burning up the chaff with unquenchable fire.”
24. **2TI 2:19** Nevertheless, God’s solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: “The Lord knows those who are his,” and, “Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must turn away from wickedness.” 20 In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. 21 If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.
