

# Security in Christ

1. **LAM 3:22** **Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions NEVER fail.** 23 They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
2. **JOB 17:9** Nevertheless, **the righteous WILL hold to their ways,** and those with clean hands will grow stronger.
3. **PSA 37:28** For **the LORD loves the just and will not forsake his faithful ones.** **They will be protected forever,** but the offspring of the wicked will be cut off; 29 **the righteous will inherit the land and dwell in it forever.**
4. **PSA 94:14** For **the LORD will not reject his people; he will NEVER forsake his inheritance.** 15 Judgment will again be founded on righteousness, and all the upright in heart will follow it.
5. **PSA 103:17** But **from everlasting to everlasting the LORD's love is with those who fear him,** and his righteousness with their children's children— 18 with those who keep his covenant and remember to obey his precepts.
6. **Psalm 125:1** **Those who trust in the LORD are like Mount Zion, which CANNOT be shaken but endures forever.** 2 As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds his people both now and forevermore.
7. **PSA 138:8** **The LORD will fulfill his purpose for me; your love, O LORD, endures forever—** do not abandon the works of your hands.
8. **PRO 4:18** **The path of the righteous is like the first gleam of dawn, shining ever brighter till the full light of day.** 19 But the way of the wicked is like deep darkness; they do not know what makes them stumble.
9. **PRO 24:15** Do not lie in wait like an outlaw against a righteous man's house, do not raid his dwelling place; 16 for **though a righteous man falls seven times, he rises again,** but the wicked are brought down by calamity.
10. **ISA 45:17** But Israel will be saved by the LORD with **an everlasting salvation; you will NEVER be put to shame or disgraced, to ages everlasting.**
11. **ISA 54:17** **no weapon forged against you will prevail,** and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and this is their vindication from me," declares the LORD.
12. **JER 32:40** **I will make an EVERLASTING covenant with them:** I will never stop doing good to them, and I will inspire them to fear me, **so that they will NEVER turn away from me.** 41 I will rejoice in doing them good and will assuredly plant them in this land with all my heart and soul.
13. **MAR 13:22** For false Christs and false prophets will appear and perform signs and miracles **to deceive the elect— if that were possible.** 23 **So be on your guard;** I have told you everything ahead of time.
14. **JOH 3:36** **Whoever believes in the Son HAS eternal life,** but **whoever rejects the Son will not see life,** for God's wrath remains on him."
15. **ROM 6:23** For **the wages of sin is death,** but **the gift of God is eternal life** in Christ Jesus our Lord.
16. **JOH 5:24** "I tell you the truth, **whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me HAS eternal life and will NOT be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.**
17. **JOH 6:37** **ALL that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will NEVER drive away.** 38 For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me. 39 And this is the will of him who sent me, that **I shall lose NONE of all that he has given me, but raise them up at the last day.** 40 For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day."
18. **JOH 17:12** While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. **None has been lost except the one doomed to destruction** so that Scripture would be fulfilled.
19. **JOH 10:27** My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. 28 I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; **NO ONE CAN SNATCH THEM OUT OF MY HAND.** 29 **My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.**
20. **ROM 8:1** Therefore, **there is now NO condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,** 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.
21. **ROM 8:28** And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. 29 For **those God foreknew he also PREDESTINED to be conformed to the likeness of his Son,** that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. 30 And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified. 31 What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? 33 **Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies.** 38 For **I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, 39 neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.**
22. **ROM 16:25** Now to **him who is able to establish you by my gospel** and the proclamation of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery hidden for long ages past, 26 but now revealed and made known through the prophetic writings by the command of the eternal God, so that all nations might believe and obey him— 27 to the only wise God be glory forever through Jesus Christ! Amen.
23. **1CO 1:8** **He WILL keep you strong to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.** 9 **God,** who has called you into fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, **is faithful.**
24. **2CO 1:21** Now **it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ.** He anointed us, 22 set his seal of ownership on us, **and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.**

25. **EPH 3:20** Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, 21 to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
26. **EPH 5:25** Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her 26 to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, 27 and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.
27. **PHI 1:4** In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy 5 because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, 6 being confident of this, that HE WHO BEGAN A GOOD WORK IN YOU WILL CARRY IT ON TO COMPLETION until the day of Christ Jesus.
28. **PHI 2:12** Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed—not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence—continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, 13 for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.
29. **COL 3:3** For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. 5 Put to DEATH, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. 6 Because of these, the wrath of God is coming.
30. **1TH 5:22** Avoid EVERY kind of evil. 23 May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 The one who calls you is faithful and he will do it.
31. **2TH 3:3** But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.
32. **2TI 2:10** Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. 11 Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with him, we will also live with him; 12 if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us; 13 if we are faithless, he will remain faithful, for he cannot disown himself.
33. **2TI 4:18** The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
34. **1PE 1:3** Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade—kept in heaven for you, 5 who through faith are shielded by God’s power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time. 6 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. 7 These have come so that your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may be proved genuine and may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed. 8 Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, 9 for you are receiving the goal of your faith, the salvation of your souls.
35. **1PE 5:10** And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.
36. **HEB 7:25** Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.
37. **HEB 12:2** Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter (finisher KJV) of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. 3 Consider him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart. 4 In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. 5 And you have forgotten that word of encouragement that addresses you as sons: “My son, do not make light of the Lord’s discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, 6 because the Lord disciplines those he loves, and he punishes everyone he accepts as a son.”
38. **HEB 13:5** Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, “NEVER will I leave you; never will I forsake you.”
39. **IJO 5:4** for EVERYONE born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. 5 Who is it that overcomes the world? Only he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.
40. **JUD 24** To him who is able to keep you from falling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy— 25 to the only God our Savior be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages, now and forevermore! Amen.

Why do many scriptures seem to say that we as born-again Christians can never be lost, and yet many other scriptures seem to say a Christian can lose their salvation? I believe this apparent discrepancy has to do with viewpoints. God, who dwells in eternity, “sees the end from the beginning”, and therefore knows who will be ultimately saved and be His. He states that not one of these will by any means be lost. They will all overcome. From an earthly temporal perspective, however, some who are “saved”, who experience the power and forgiveness of God in their lives, who may minister for God, etc., will ultimately reject Him and be lost. The warnings and cautions in scripture are for these individuals and to caution us all that the Law of Sin and Death applies to everyone, saved or unsaved.
