How many books in the NT? 11 books **List** the books in the OT with the word '**praise**':
GEN, LEV, DEU, JDG, 1CH, 2CH, EZR, NEH, PSA, PRO, ISA, JER, DAN, JOE, HAB, ZEP
List the books in the NT with the word '**praise**': MAT, LUK, JOH, ROM, 1CO, 2CO, EPH, PHI, HEB, 1PE, REV
- Where** is this KJV verse found: '**Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.**'? PSA 150:6 **What** is the Hebrew word for praise used here? Halal – to praise
Look up the word '**psalm**' in the dictionary, and write out its definition: The Hebrew name of the book is 'tehillim' which means 'praises'. The word 'psalms' is a Greek word that comes from the Septuigint LXX, meaning 'lyrical pieces to be sung to a musical instrument'.
HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT: Memorize **Psalms 100** in your favorite Bible Version.
- List** ten (10) things **YOU** should thank God for: life, family, salvation, redemption from the penalty and power from sin, my spouse, children, God's mercy in spite of my failing, the Holy Spirit, my ministry, my church, our pastors, my job, health, God meets my needs, etc.
- State** several **ways** in which you can or do Praise God: In song, words, lifting my hands in thanks, praise and worship, obedience (holiness), dance, shouting, telling others what God has done in my life, bowing down, prostrating myself to God, adore, honor, not complaining or whining, etc.
- PSA 34:1** I will bless the LORD at all times ; His praise shall continually be in my mouth . 2 My soul shall make its boast in the LORD; The humble shall hear of it and be glad. 3 Oh, magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt His name together. (NKJ)
- PSA 67:5** Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You. 6 **THEN** the earth shall yield her increase ; God, our own God, shall bless us. (NKJ)
FROM this scripture, **what** must occur **before** the earth shall yield her increase, and before our God will bless us? We should each individually and corporately PRAISE the LORD GOD.
- Write out **PSA 50:23**: Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; And to him who orders his conduct aright I will show the salvation of God.
What is the relationship between the two thoughts in this verse? **Does** right conduct praise or glorify God? Right conduct IS praise to God, and glorifies God and causes Him to show His glory in us.
What is the result of such conduct? Right conduct results in God revealing His salvation in our very lives, showing forth His glory in us, for us to experience and for others to see.
- Write out **PSA 22:3**: But You are holy, Enthroned in (inhabiting) the praises of Israel.
What does this verse mean for you personally? My praise brings God on the scene, to meet my every need in my life, to defeat every enemy, to give strength and grace for every need.
- 2TI 3:16** All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine , for reproof , for correction , for training in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete , thoroughly equipped for every good work. (NKJ)

14. **List** at least 5 authors of the Psalms: David, Solomon, Moses, Asaph, Sons of Korah, Hemen, & Ethan the Ezrahite **Who** wrote most of the Psalms? David To **whom** were the Psalms addressed? God In view of **2TI 3:16** that **ALL** scripture is given by inspiration of God, **WHO** gave David & the other authors of the Psalms the very words they spoke as they prayed, praised, sang, and appealed to God? God, through the Holy Spirit **How** might that apply to you? As I praise, pray to, worship, and honor God and yield myself to Him, He Himself will by the Spirit Give the very words I pray and the thoughts I think, such that they are acceptable to Him.
15. **EPH 5:18** And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns & spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, 20 giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, 21 submitting to one another in the fear of God. (NKJ)
16. **Describe** from **EPH 5:18-21** the process and result of being filled with the Spirit (v19): In times of Praise & worship with self or others, we begin 'in the flesh', with the result that 'the Helper' (HS) then manifests His presence by singing, praying, etc. through my spirit, with psalms, hymns, and and spiritual songs, so I can sing and make melody in my HEART to the Lord.
How will you apply this in **YOUR** life, both in personal worship, and in group worship? I begin in the flesh, and natural, but the Helper ushers me into the Spirit Realm, which is true worship.
17. Read **PSA 148**. List all the things or beings commanded to praise God: Me, angels, His hosts, sun, Moon, stars of light, heavens of heavens, waters above the heavens, sea creatures, sea depths, fire, Snow, clouds, stormy wind, mountains, hills, fruitful trees & cedars, beasts and all cattle, creeping Things, flying fowl, kings of the earth & all peoples, princes, judges, young men & maidens, old Men & children, His saints – the children of Israel.
18. What does the OT name **Mahalaleel** (**GEN 5:11**) mean in Hebrew? 'praise of God'
What does the OT name **Judah** mean in Hebrew? 'praised' **What** does it mean that Jesus is the **Lion of the tribe of Judah**? He fights for me as I PRAISE and WORSHIP Him! (See **REV 5:5**)
19. **List** at least 10 musical instruments used in the Bible: Psalter, harp, flute, shofar, trumpet, cymbal, Horn, lute, lyre, organ pipe, reed-pipe, bell, tabret, tambourine, timbrel, viol, trigon, zither.
What was their most common use? In praise, celebration, worship, and giving thanks to God.
Give Scripture examples of their use: EXO 39:25, EZR 3:10, 1CH 25:1, NEH 12:27, PSA 150:4, GEN 4:21, JOB 21:12, JER 48:36, 1CO 13:1, 2CH 29:25, PSA 147:7, ISA 23:16, GEN 31:27
What is '**PSALMING**'? Speaking and singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, especially in Worship and praise, under the power and inspiration of the Holy Spirit, speaking through my spirit.
20. Read **ROM 4** about Abraham. **ROM 4:20** He (Abraham) did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, 21 and being fully persuaded that what He (God) had promised He was also able to perform. (NKJ)
21. **What** is the Greek word for '**glory**' here? doxa **What** does the word mean? Glory, praise, honor, worship **How** did Abraham strengthen his faith? By giving glory to God
Did Abraham give glory to God **before** or **after** he received the promise? BEFORE !! **What** does that mean to you? I should thank God for His provision BEFORE it is manifest, knowing that He is faithful and will fulfill what He has promised in His Word. His word CANNOT return void.
Write out **PSA 65:1**: Praise is awaiting You, O God, in Zion; And to You the vow shall be performed.
22. According to **ISA 61:1-3**, what should **YOU** do when you experience a spirit of heaviness or of depression? Put on the garment of PRAISE. Exactly **HOW** would you do this? Try it right **NOW!** By beginning to praise God, even though I don't feel like it. To act by FAITH, not by sight or feelings. Once I am obedient, THEN the HS will manifest His presence. Feelings will follow!
23. Read **2CH 20** and **JOS 6:1-20**. What should **you** do when you are in battle with the enemy? Praise & worship God, trusting in Him. Stand still, and see the salvation of God. He will fight the battle.
2CH 20:17 'You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of the Lord, who is with you, O Judah and Jerusalem!' Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for the LORD is with you." (NKJ)
24. **PSA 103:1** Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! 2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: 3 Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, 4 Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, 5 Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. (NKJ)
25. **How** will you apply what you have learned in this lesson in **YOUR** life? Answer for yourself.
