

Romans 1:16 For **I am not ashamed of the GOSPEL (euaggelion) of Christ, for it is the POWER of God to salvation for everyone who BELIEVES, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.** 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "**The just shall live by faith.**"

1. **MAT 4:23** And Jesus went about all Galilee, **TEACHING in their synagogues, PREACHING the GOSPEL of the kingdom, and HEALING all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.**
2. **MAT 9:35** Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, **TEACHING in their synagogues, PREACHING the GOSPEL of the kingdom, and HEALING every sickness and every disease among the people.**

Note the **order** of Christ's ministry: First **TEACHING** in their synagogues, then **PREACHING** the Gospel of the Kingdom, and lastly **HEALING** of all kinds of sickness and diseases among the people. **Remember: Preaching** will get you saved, but **Teaching** is necessary for growth and maturation in the Faith. **Healings** usually follow **Teaching**, since the Teaching of the Word is necessary to build our faith so that we can receive the healing promised in the Word !! **WE** should minister in the **SAME** order as Christ, our example.

3. **MAT 11:2** And when John had heard in prison about the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples 3 and said to Him, "Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?" 4 **Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: 5 "The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the GOSPEL preached (euaggelizo) to them.** 6 "And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me."
4. **MAT 24:14** "And **this GOSPEL (euaggelion) of the kingdom will be preached (kerusso) in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.**
5. **MAR 1:1** **The beginning of the GOSPEL (euaggelion) of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.**
6. **MAR 1:14** Now after John was put in prison, **Jesus came to Galilee, preaching (kerusso) the GOSPEL (euaggelion) of the kingdom (basileia) of God,** 15 and **saying, "The time (kairos) is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent (metanoeo), and believe (pisteuo) in the GOSPEL (euaggelion)."**
7. **MAR 8:34** When He had called the people to Himself, with His disciples also, He said to them, "Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. 35 **"For whoever desires to save (sozo) his life (psuche) will lose (apollumi) it, but whoever loses his life (psuche) for My sake and the GOSPEL's (euaggelion) will save (sozo) it.**
8. **MAR 10:28** Then Peter began to say to Him, "See, we have left all and followed You." 29 So Jesus answered and said, **"Assuredly, I say to you, there is NO ONE who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the GOSPEL'S (euaggelion),** 30 **"who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time—houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions (diogmos)—and in the age to come, eternal (aionios) life (zoe).**
9. **MAR 16:15** And He said to them, **"Go into all the world and preach the GOSPEL to every creature.** 16 **"He who BELIEVES and is BAPTIZED will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.** 17 "And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 "they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." 19 So then, **after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God.** 20 And **they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and CONFIRMING THE WORD (logos) through the accompanying signs.** Amen.
10. **LUK 2:10** Then **the angel (aggelos) said** to them, "Do not be afraid, for **behold, I bring you good tidings (euaggelizo) of great joy which will be to all people.** 11 "For **there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.**
11. **LUK 4:16** So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. **And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read.** 17 And **He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah.** And when He had opened the book, **He found the place where it was written:** 18 **"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the GOSPEL to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;** 19 **To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."** 20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. 21 And **He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."**
12. **LUK 9:1** Then **He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases.** 2 **He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.** 3 And He said to them, "Take nothing for the journey, neither staffs nor bag nor bread nor money; and do not have two tunics apiece. 4 "Whatever house you enter, stay there, and from there depart. 5 "And whoever will not receive you, when you go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet as a testimony against them." 6 **So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the GOSPEL and healing everywhere.**
13. **JOH 8:31** Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, **"If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed.** 32 **"And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."**

14. **ROM 10:14** How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And **how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard?** And **how shall they hear without a preacher?** 15 **And how shall they preach unless they are sent?** As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!” 16 **But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, “Lord, who has believed our report?”** 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. 18 But I say, have they not heard? Yes indeed: “Their sound has gone out to all the earth, And their words to the ends of the world.”

(EZE 1:5, EZE 10:14, REV 4:7)

Just as there is a TRUE GOSPEL, so also there is a FALSE GOSPEL, taught by FALSE PROPHETS & FALSE TEACHERS, who are themselves being led astray by DECEIVING SPIRITS.

15. **DEU 13:1** “**If there arises among you a prophet or a dreamer of dreams, and he gives you a sign or a wonder, 2 “and the sign or the wonder comes to pass, of which he spoke to you, saying, ‘Let us go after other gods’—which you have not known—‘and let us serve them,’ 3 “you shall NOT LISTEN to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the Lord your God is testing you to know whether you love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. 4 “You shall walk after the Lord your God and fear Him, and keep His commandments and obey His voice, and you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him.**”
16. **1KI 18:21** And Elijah came to all the people, and said, “**How long will you falter between two opinions? If the Lord is God, follow Him; but if Baal, follow him.**” But the people answered him not a word.
17. **JER 5:30** “**An astonishing and horrible thing Has been committed in the land: 31 The PROPHETS PROPHECY FALSELY, And the priests rule by their own power; And My people love to have it so.** But what will you do in the end?”
18. **LAM 2:14** **Your prophets have seen for you False and deceptive visions; THEY HAVE NOT UNCOVERED YOUR INIQUITY, To bring back your captives.** But have envisioned for you false prophecies and delusions.
19. **EZE 13:3** Thus says the Lord God: “**Woe to the foolish prophets, WHO FOLLOW THEIR OWN SPIRIT and have seen nothing!**”
20. **DAN 11:32** “**Those who do wickedly against the covenant he (Antichrist) shall corrupt with flattery; but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits. 33 “And those of the people who understand shall instruct many; yet for many days they shall fall by sword and flame, by captivity and plundering. 34 “Now when they fall, they shall be aided with a little help; but many shall join with them by intrigue. 35 “And some of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify them, and make them white, until the time of the end; because it is still for the appointed time.**”
21. **MAT 7:15** “**Beware of FALSE PROPHETS, who come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. 16 “You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles? 17 “Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. 18 “A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit. 19 “Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. 20 “Therefore by their fruits you will know them.**”
22. **MAT 7:21** “**Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. 22 “Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ 23 “And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’**”
23. **MAT 24:4** And Jesus answered and said to them: “**Take heed that no one deceives you. 5 “For many will come in My name, saying, ‘I am the Christ,’ and will deceive many.**”
24. **MAT 24:11** “**Then many FALSE PROPHETS will rise up and deceive many. 12 “And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.**”
25. **MAT 24:21** “**For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. 22 “And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect’s sake those days will be shortened. 23 “Then if anyone says to you, ‘Look, here is the Christ!’ or ‘There!’ do not believe it. 24 “For FALSE CHRISTS and FALSE PROPHETS will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.**”
26. **ACT 4:11** “**This is the ‘stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.’ 12 “Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”**”
27. **ACT 20:29** “**For I know this, that after my departure SAVAGE WOLVES will come in among you, not sparing the flock. 30 “Also from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw**”

- away the disciples after themselves.** 31 “Therefore watch, and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears.
28. **ROM 7:23** But **I see ANOTHER LAW in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.**
 29. **ROM 16:17** Now I urge you, **brethren, note those who cause divisions and offenses, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them.** 18 **For those who are such do not serve our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly, and by smooth words and flattering speech deceive the hearts of the simple.**
 30. **2CO 11:3** But **I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.** 4 For **if he who comes preaches ANOTHER JESUS whom we have not preached, or if you receive A DIFFERENT SPIRIT which you have not received, or A DIFFERENT GOSPEL which you have not accepted—you may well put up with it!**
 31. **2CO 11:13** For such are **FALSE APOSTLES, DECEITFUL WORKERS, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ.** 14 And no wonder! For **Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.** 15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their works.
 32. **GAL 1:6** **I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to A DIFFERENT GOSPEL,** 7 which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. 8 But **even if we, or an angel (aggelos) from heaven (ouranos), preach (euaggelizo) any other GOSPEL (euaggelizo) to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed (anathema).**
 33. **2TH 2:3** **Let no one DECEIVE you by any means; for that Day (of Christ’s coming) will not come unless the falling away (apostasia) comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition.**
 34. **1TI 1:3** As I urged you when I went into Macedonia—remain in Ephesus that you may **charge some that they teach no other doctrine,** 4 **nor give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which cause disputes rather than godly edification which is in faith.**
 35. **1TI 4:1** Now **the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to DECEIVING SPIRITS and DOCTRINES OF DEMONS,** 2 speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron,
 36. **2TI 3:1** But know this, that **in the last days perilous times will come:** 2 For **men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,** 3 **unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good,** 4 **traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,** 5 **having A FORM OF GODLINESS but denying its power.** And **from such people turn away!** 6 For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, 7 **always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.**
 37. **2TI 3:13** But **evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.**
 38. **2TI 4:2** Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. 3 For **the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers;** 4 and **they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables.**
 39. **2PE 2:1** But **there were also FALSE PROPHETS among the people, even as there will be FALSE TEACHERS among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction.** 2 And **many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed.** 3 By covetousness they will exploit you with deceptive words; for a long time their judgment has not been idle, and their destruction does not slumber.
 40. **1JO 4:1** Beloved, **do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many FALSE PROPHETS have gone out into the world.** 2 By this you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God, 3 and **every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God.** And **this is the spirit of the ANTICHRIST,** which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world.
 41. **1JO 2:18** Little children, it is the last hour; and **as you have heard that the ANTICHRIST is coming, even now many ANTICHRISTS have come, by which we know that it is the last hour.** 19 **They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us;** but they went out that they might be made manifest, that none of them were of us. 20 **But YOU have an ANOINTING from the Holy One, and you know all things.**
 42. **JUD 3** Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints. 4 For **certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, who turn the grace of our God into lewdness and deny the only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ.** 16 These are grumblers, complainers, walking according to their own lusts; and they mouth great swelling words, flattering people to gain advantage. 19 These are sensual persons, who cause divisions, not having the Spirit.

FAITH is necessary for the Gospel to be of value

43. **HEB 4:1** Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it. 2 **For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but THE WORD WHICH THEY HEARD DID NOT PROFIT THEM, NOT BEING MIXED WITH FAITH in those who heard it.**
44. **HEB 2:1** Therefore **we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away.** 2 For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, 3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him, 4 God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?
45. **ISA 6:9** And He said, **“Go, and tell this people: ‘Keep on hearing, but do not understand; Keep on seeing, but do not perceive.’** 10 “Make the heart of this people dull, And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And return and be healed.”
46. **ISA 28:9** **“Whom will he teach knowledge? And whom will he make to understand the message? Those just weaned from milk? Those just drawn from the breasts? 10 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, Here a little, there a little.”**
47. **JAM 1:21** Therefore **lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.** 22 But **be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.** 23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; 24 for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. 25 But **he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.**

God Empowers and Enables us as Ministers of the Gospel

48. **JOH 16:7** “Nevertheless I tell you the truth. **It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.** 8 “And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
49. **MAR 16:19** So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. 20 And **they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and CONFIRMING THE WORD through the accompanying signs.** Amen.
50. **ACT 11:20** But some of them were men from Cyprus and Cyrene, who, when they had come to Antioch, spoke to the Hellenists, preaching the Lord Jesus. 21 And **the HAND OF THE LORD was with them, and a great number believed and turned to the Lord.**
51. **ROM 15:18** For **I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ has not accomplished through me, in word and deed, to make the Gentiles obedient— 19 in MIGHTY SIGNS AND WONDERS, by the power of the Spirit of God,** so that from Jerusalem and round about to Illyricum I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.
52. **1CO 2:4** And **my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but IN DEMONSTRATION OF THE SPIRIT AND OF POWER, 5 that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.**
53. **1CO 3:6** I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase.
54. **2CO 3:5** Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but **our sufficiency is from God, 6 who also made us SUFFICIENT AS MINISTERS OF THE NEW COVENANT, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.**
55. **2CO 5:17** Therefore, **if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation;** old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. 18 **Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,** 19 that is, that **God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has COMMITTED TO US the word of reconciliation.** 20 Now then, **we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ’s behalf, be reconciled to God.**
56. **EPH 2:10** For **we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for GOOD WORKS, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.**
57. **1TH 1:5** For **our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance,** as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake.

The Gospel must come by REVELATION – Both to those who preach it, & to those who receive it.

58. **ACT 26:15** “So I said, ‘Who are You, Lord?’ And He said, ‘I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. 16 ‘But rise and stand on your feet; **for I have appeared to you for this purpose, to make you a minister and a witness both of the things which you have seen and of the things which I will yet reveal to you.** 17 ‘I will deliver you from the Jewish people, as well as from **the Gentiles, to whom I now send you,** 18 **‘to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.’**

59. **1CO 2:9** But as it is written: **“Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.”** 10 But **God has REVEALED them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.** 11 For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. 12 Now **we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might KNOW the things that have been freely given to us by God.**
60. **GAL 1:11** But **I make known to you, brethren, that the GOSPEL which was preached by me is not according to man.** 12 **For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but it came through the revelation of Jesus Christ.**
61. **GAL 2:1** Then after fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and also took Titus with me. 2 And **I went up by revelation, and communicated to them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles,** but privately to those who were of reputation, lest by any means I might run, or had run, in vain.
62. **EPH 3:1** For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you Gentiles— 2 if indeed **you have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which was given to me for you,** 3 **how that BY REVELATION He made known to me the mystery** (as I have briefly written already, 4 by which, when you read, you may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ), 5 **which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets:** 6 **that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel,** 7 **of which I became a minister according to the gift of the grace of God given to me** by the effective working of His power.
63. **REV 14:6** Then **I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the EVERLASTING GOSPEL to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—**7 saying with a loud voice, “Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.”

We “Take the Land” with the Gospel

64. **JOS 1:3** **“Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses. 4 “From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the River Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your territory. 5 “No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. 6 “Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. 7 “Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. 8 “This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.**
65. **EPH 6:12** For **we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.** 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and **having shod your feet with the preparation of THE GOSPEL OF PEACE;** 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—

Additional Scriptures on the Gospel

66. **1CH 16:23** Sing to the Lord, all the earth; **Proclaim the GOOD NEWS of His salvation from day to day.**
67. **PSA 40:9** **I have proclaimed THE GOOD NEWS of righteousness In the great assembly; Indeed, I do not restrain my lips,** O Lord, You Yourself know.
68. **PSA 96:2** Sing to the Lord, bless His name; **Proclaim the GOOD NEWS of His salvation from day to day.**
69. **PRO 25:25** **As cold water to a weary soul, So is GOOD NEWS from a far country.**
70. **ISA 52:7** **How beautiful upon the mountains Are the feet of him who brings GOOD NEWS,** Who proclaims peace, Who brings glad tidings of good things, **Who proclaims SALVATION,** Who says to Zion, “Your God reigns!”
71. **ISA 61:1** **“The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, Because the Lord has anointed Me To preach GOOD TIDINGS to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound;** 2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn, 3 **To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.”**

72. **NAH 1:15** Behold, on the mountains The feet of him who brings GOOD TIDINGS, Who proclaims peace! O Judah, keep your appointed feasts, Perform your vows. For the wicked one shall no more pass through you; He is utterly cut off.
73. **LUK 16:16** “The law and the prophets were until John. Since that time the kingdom of God has been preached, and everyone is pressing into it. 17 “And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass away than for one tittle of the law to fail.
74. **ROM 10:3** For they being ignorant of God’s righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God.
75. **ROM 10:15** And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach THE GOSPEL OF PEACE, Who bring glad tidings of good things!”
76. **1CO 3:11** For NO OTHER foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.
77. **2TI 1:8** Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for THE GOSPEL according to the power of God, 9 who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began, 10 but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through THE GOSPEL, 11 to which I was appointed a preacher, an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles.
78. **JER 31:31** “Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a NEW COVENANT with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah— 32 “not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord. 33 “But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 34 “No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’ for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.”
79. **HEB 7:21** (for they have become priests without an oath, but He with an oath by Him who said to Him: “The Lord has sworn And will not relent, ‘You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek’ ”), 22 by so much more Jesus has become a surety of a BETTER COVENANT.
80. **HEB 8:6** But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a BETTER COVENANT, which was established on BETTER PROMISES. 7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second. 8 Because finding fault with them, He says: “Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah— 9 “not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they did not continue in My covenant, and I disregarded them, says the Lord. 10 “For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 11 “None of them shall teach his neighbor, and none his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’ for all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them. 12 “For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.” 13 In that He says, “A NEW COVENANT,” He has made the first obsolete. Now what is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to vanish away.
81. **HEB 9:8** the Holy Spirit indicating this, that the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first tabernacle was still standing. 9 It was symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience— 10 concerned only with foods and drinks, various washings, and fleshly ordinances imposed until the time of reformation. 11 But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. 12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. 13 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? 15 And for this reason He is the Mediator of THE NEW COVENANT, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.
82. **HEB 10:9** then He said, “Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God.” He takes away the first that He may establish the second.
83. **HEB 12:22** But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels, 23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, 24 to Jesus the Mediator of the NEW COVENANT, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.
