4. Write out **ROM 1:16-17**: For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."
5. **What** is the Greek word here for **'gospel'**? euaggelion = eu + aggelos For **'power'**? dunamis For **'salvation'**? sozo For **'believes'**? pisteuo For **'faith'**? pistis What must we do to receive the **power**? Believe the Gospel in our heart (spirit) Is the a **one-time** event? no **What** does the phrase **'the just shall live by faith'** mean? We not only enter the Kingdom of God by grace thru faith, but our daily walk thereafter is a supernatural walk entirely by God's grace thru faith, never in our own power or strength. If we try to walk on our own, we will always fail, which will lead us back to God.
6. **T** **F** The Gospel is the power of God unto Salvation for everyone. (**ROM 1:16-17**)
T **F** The Gospel is of no value to anyone until it is believed. (**HEB 4:1-2**)
T **F** We can believe and receive one aspect of the Gospel, such as salvation from the penalty of sin, and yet remain in unbelief and therefore **NOT** receive another aspect of the Gospel, such as bodily healing or financial prosperity.
T **F** Salvation is a continuing process, not just a one-time event. (**PHI 2:12-13, 1PE 1:8-9, JAM 1:21**)
7. **What** is meant by the term **'Full Gospel'**? The Gospel is not just a message of Salvation from the ultimate penalty of sin, but also salvation from the power of sin even while her on earth, salvation from sickness and disease, from demonic bondage, from poverty, or from ANY OTHER Satanic strongholds in our lives.
8. **Give** a scripture definition of **'the Gospel'**: JOH 3:16-17, 1CO 15:1-5, 1TI 1:15, 1CO 15:1 Moreover, brethren, I declare to you THE GOSPEL which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, 3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, 5 and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve.
9. **GAL 1:11** But I make known to you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. 12 For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but it came through the revelation of Jesus Christ. (NKJ)
What is the Greek word for **'brethren'**? adelphos For **'gospel'**? euaggelion
For **'preached'**? euaggelizo For **'revelation'**? apokalupsis **Why** are the Greek words for **'gospel'** and **'preached'** so similar? Because 'preaching' is defined as declaring the Gospel of Jesus Christ
10. **LUK 24:13** Now behold, two of them were traveling that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was seven miles from Jerusalem. 27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself. 30 Now it came to pass, as He sat at the table with them, that He took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. 31 Then their eyes were opened and they knew Him; and He vanished from their sight. (NKJ)
What is the Greek word for **'knew'** & its meaning? Epiginosko = epi - above, upon; ginosko - know, perceive
The **BREAD** here is a type of the **WORD**. As Jesus broke the bread to them, their eyes were opened, and they saw **HIM**. The Holy Spirit **REVEALED** Christ to them in the **WORD**, by revelation of the Holy Spirit.
11. The **WORD of God** was originally given by **Inspiration** of the Holy Spirit. The same Holy Spirit is absolutely necessary to give us illumination and revelation as to the meaning of the **WORD of God**.
JOH 9:11 He answered and said, "A Man called Jesus made clay and anointed my eyes and said to me, 'Go to the pool of Siloam and wash.' So I went and washed, and I received sight." (NKJ)
What is the Greek here for **'anointed'**? epichrio **What** is the meaning of **'Siloam'**? 'sent'
This name comes from the Hebrew word **'Shiloah'** <7975>. **What** is its meaning? Heb Shiloach = 'sent': Shiloach = a fountain just southeast of Jerusalem.
12. **T** **F** From **ROM 1:16-17** and **GAL 1:11-12**, you could say that the **purpose**, **message** and **power** of the Gospel **IS** the revelation of Jesus Christ and that what He has done and who He is revealed supernaturally to anyone who will believe.
T **F** To be born again, one must receive the knowledge that **Jesus is the Christ, the son of the living God, by revelation - by grace as a gift, through faith**. Such knowledge comes **NOT** by human reason.
13. **REV 19:10** And I fell at his (the angel's) feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." (NKJ)

What does this scripture mean? The purpose and spirit of prophecy is to testify about and to Jesus. Once we as individuals RECEIVE that testimony, we then HAVE His testimony (as a revelation) in our hearts.

14. **EPH 2:8** For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith — and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9 not by works, so that no one can boast. (NIV)
15. **IJO 5:1** Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves the father loves his child as well. 4 For everyone born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. (NIV)

From these scriptures, what is the **proof** that one is born of God, and has received **by grace** and **through faith** the **free gift** of eternal life from God? He has a revelation by the Spirit into His spirit that Jesus is the Christ, the son of the living God. We do not come to that conclusion on our own – it is given by revelation through the Holy Spirit, and entirely by Grace. Our faith is the avenue by which we receive this free gift from God.

16. **MAT 16:15** He said to them, “But who do you say that I am?” 16 Simon Peter answered and said, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” 17 Jesus answered and said to him, “Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. 18 “And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. (NKJ)
17. What is the **ROCK** on which Christ will build His church? The spiritual revelation that Jesus is the CHRIST !!
Give **Scripture**: EXO 17:6-7, NUM 20:11-12, DEU 8:15, PSA 78:15,20, 1CO 10:1-4, MAT 16:15-18, etc.
18. In **what** part of your being do you **believe** the Gospel or any part of the Word? In my HEART, my spirit.
Give **Scripture**: ROM 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe IN YOUR HEART that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For WITH THE HEART one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

What does the phrase ‘**missing heaven by 18 inches**’ mean? To agree in my MIND that the facts of the Gospel are true, that Jesus died for my sins, that there is a heaven and a hell, etc. does NOT save me. Since my heart is my SPIRIT, I have to believe in my HEART, by spiritual revelation, a gift from God to be saved.

What is ‘**mental assent**’? To agree or assent to the truths of the Bible in my MIND apart from my heart.

How is it different from **faith**? Faith is a product of the HEART – it is spiritual. Mental Assent, a product of the MIND, is often mistaken for faith. Many simply THINK they are saved because they agree in their minds.

19. Is the belief that **Jesus is the Christ** something that on arrives at by **reason of mind**? NO! If not, **how** does one come to this knowledge? By revelation from the Spirit of God as we believe and receive the Gospel.
20. **LUK 4:16** So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. 17 And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: 18 “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; 19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.” 20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. 21 And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.” (NKJ)

21. From **LUK 4:16**, what **enabled** Jesus to preach the Gospel, and to **demonstrate** its power? The Anointing of the Spirit of God provides the ability to preach the Gospel, and minister its message in Power.

What, then, must enable **YOU** to preach the Gospel and to **demonstrate** its power? The Anointing of the Holy Spirit. Apart from Him (Christ’s anointing) I can do NOTHING of eternal (spiritual) importance.

What is the Greek (v18) for ‘**preach the gospel**’? euaggelizo For ‘**preach**’ (v19)? kerusso For ‘**anointed**’? chrio This word comes from the Greek ‘**cheir**’, meaning ‘**hand**’. Find scriptures showing how the ‘**hand of the LORD**’ came on individuals to perform miraculous feats: 2KI 18:46, 2KI 3:15, EZR 7:6, 28 EZE 3:14, 22; 8:1-4; 33:22-23; 37:1-2; 40:1-2; LUK 1:66, ACT 11:21, etc. Explain how the ‘**anointing**’ is the ‘**hand of the LORD**’ on **US**, so that **HE** can perform miraculous feats through **US**: The anointing is the power of God, imparted by the HS, that enables us to DO what God commands.

22. Does **Christ still minister** in the earth? Yes **How**? Thru His body, the church – thru us individually!
Can we still **minister to Christ** on the earth? Yes **How**? By ministering to His Body – His people.
23. **MAT 25:34** “Then the King will say to those on His right hand, ‘Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: 35 ‘for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; 36 ‘I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.’ 37 “Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, ‘Lord, when did we see YOU hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? 38 ‘When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You? 39 ‘Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?’ 40 “And the King will answer and say to them, ‘Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to ME.’ (NKJ)

What is the Greek here for ‘**blessed**’? eulogeo (eu = good + logos = word) For ‘**brethren**’? adelphos

24. **MAT 4:23** And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sicknesses and all kinds of diseases among the people. (NKJ)

What was the order of Jesus’ ministry? Teaching, Preaching, and then Healing

Preaching gets you saved, but teaching causes you to **grow and mature**.

25. **How** will you apply what you have learned in this lesson to **YOUR** life? Answer for yourself.
