

11-B Baptism in the Spirit

There is a principle in the Bible that every doctrine of teaching should not only be found in direct quotes of Scripture, but also within types and shadows that might seem otherwise unrelated. The more I study the Bible, the more I have found this to be true. Following are several of these types, as well as scripture quotes that illustrate the Baptism in the Holy Spirit as an experience separate from salvation, and which experience all Believers are commanded to seek.

Let Us Notice Some Things About The Holy Spirit And Its Types:

- (a) Jesus was 1st **born** of the Spirit, but only later **filled** w/ the Spirit at the Jordan River before entering public ministry.
- (b) In Jesus **first miracle** at the **wedding**, he first filled the earthen vessels with water, but then turned it into wine.
- (c) Prior to death & resurrection, Jesus told his disciples the HS dwelt **WITH** them, but would later be **IN** them (**JOH 14:17**).
- (d) On the day of His resurrection, Jesus breathed on His disciples, saying '**receive ye the Holy Ghost**' (**JOH 20:22**), but later told His disciples to wait (10 days) in Jerusalem for the Holy Ghost and power to be witnesses (**ACT 1:4-5,8**). Why twice?
- (e) Jesus first states the HS will be in us as a **WELL of water**, springing up to eternal life (conversion to salvation) (**JOH 4:14**), and later states the HS will be in believers as **RIVERS of living water** (filling for service to others) (**JOH 7:37-38**). Why two different allegories?
- (f) In the OT, God took His people out of Egypt, through the Red Sea (a type of water baptism) into the wilderness where they remained carnal, but only later across the Jordan (a type of Spirit Baptism) into the Promised Land to live in victory.
- (g) In the OT, the feasts of Passover and Firstfruits represent a type of salvation through the death and resurrection of Jesus. Pentecost (Giving of the law at Mt. Sinai) came 50 days later and preshadows the in-filling with the Holy Spirit for the Harvest (latter rain).
- (h) In the OT consecration of the priest, blood of the lamb was applied to the right ear, thumb and great toe, followed by putting oil on top the blood (a type of salvation). Then rest of the oil was poured onto the priest's head (a type of Spirit baptism) (**LEV 14:14-18**).
- (i) In the OT **meal offering**, the meal of fine flour was first baked with oil (a type of salvation), but then broken into pieces and oil poured over the pieces (a type of Spirit baptism) before it was presented to God (for service) (**LEV 2:5-6**).
- (j) Before Pentecost, the disciples were a fearful, uncertain band of believers, often hiding together. After Pentecost, even the authorities were astonished that these simple unlearned men spoke with such boldness and power (**ACT 4:13**).
- (k) In **ACT 8:5-13** we read about Philip preaching to the Samaritans, who believed and were baptized. In **verses 14-17**, Peter & John were sent from Jerusalem to lay hands on these new Christians that they would be filled with the Holy Spirit.
- (l) Saul was converted going to Damascus, calling Jesus LORD, called a brother, but only later filled with the Holy Spirit (**ACT 9:1-22**).
- (m) In **ACT 19**, disciples were found that were believers and had been baptized. They are then filled with the HS when Paul lays his hands on them in prayer, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied (**ACT 19:1-6**).
- (n) We are told numerous times in Acts that disciples were "filled with the Spirit...". **EPH 5:18** commands us to be (continuously) filled with Holy Spirit.

1. **LUK 1:31** "And behold, **you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son (huios)**, and shall call His name Jesus (Iesous). 34 Then **Mary said to the angel (aggelos)**, "**How can this be, since I do not know a man?**" 35 And the angel answered and said to her, "**The Holy Spirit (hagios pneuma) will come upon you, and the power (dunamis) of the Highest (hupsistos) will overshadow (epikiazo) you; therefore, also, that Holy One (hagios) who is to be born (gennao) will be called the Son (huios) of God (theos).**"
2. **MAT 3:16** **When He had been baptized (baptizo), Jesus came up immediately from the water;** and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and **He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him.** 17 And suddenly **a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved (agapetos) Son (huios), in whom I am well pleased."**
3. **JOH 2:1** **On the THIRD DAY there was a wedding (gamos) in Cana of Galilee,** and the mother of Jesus was there. 2 Now both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding. 3 And when they ran out of wine, the mother of Jesus said to Him, "They have no wine (oinos)." 6 Now **there were set there SIX WATERPOTS OF STONE, according to the manner of purification (katharismos) of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece.** 7 Jesus said to them, "**Fill the waterpots with water.**" And **they filled them up to the brim.** 8 And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast." And they took it. 9 **When the master of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine,** and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom. 10 And he said to him, "Every man at the beginning sets out the good wine, and when the guests have well drunk, then the inferior. You have kept the good wine until now!" 11 **This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory; and His disciples believed in Him.**

4. **JOH 14:17** “**the Spirit (pneuma) of truth**, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He **dwells WITH you and will be IN you.**
5. **JOH 20:22** And when He had said this, **He (Jesus) breathed (emphusao) on them, and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit.”**
6. **ACT 1:4** And being assembled together with them, **He (Jesus) commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” He said, “you have heard from Me; 5 “for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”** 8 “**But you shall receive POWER (dunamis) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”**
7. **JOH 4:14** “**but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a FOUNTAIN (WELL) OF WATER springing up into everlasting life.”**
8. **JOH 7:37** On the **LAST DAY, that great day of the feast (of Tabernacles), Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. 38 “He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow RIVERS OF LIVING WATER.”**
9. **LEV 14:14** “**The priest shall take some of the blood of the trespass offering, and the priest shall put it on the tip of the right ear of him who is to be cleansed, on the thumb of his right hand, and on the big toe of his right foot. 15 “And the priest shall take some of the log of oil, and pour it into the palm of his own left hand. 16 “Then the priest shall dip his right finger in the oil that is in his left hand, and shall sprinkle some of the oil with his finger seven times before the Lord. 17 “And of the rest of the oil in his hand, the priest shall put some on the tip of the right ear of him who is to be cleansed, on the thumb of his right hand, and on the big toe of his right foot, on the blood of the trespass offering. 18 “The rest of the oil that is in the priest’s hand he shall put (pour) on the head of him who is to be cleansed. So the priest shall make atonement for him before the Lord.**
10. **LEV 2:5** But **if your offering is a GRAIN OFFERING baked in a pan, it shall be of fine flour, UNLEAVENED, mixed with OIL. 6 ‘You shall break it in pieces & POUR OIL ON IT; it is a grain offering.**
11. **ACT 4:13** Now **when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.**
12. **ACT 8:5** Then **Philip went down to the city of Samaria and preached Christ to them. 6 And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. 7 For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were healed. 8 And there was great joy in that city. 9 But there was a certain man called Simon, who previously practiced sorcery in the city and astonished the people of Samaria, claiming that he was someone great, 10 to whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, “This man is the great power of God.” 11 And they heeded him because he had astonished them with his sorceries for a long time. 12 But when they BELIEVED Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women WERE BAPTIZED. 13 Then Simon himself also believed; and when he was baptized he continued with Philip, and was amazed, seeing the miracles and signs which were done. 14 Now when the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had RECEIVED THE WORD of God, they sent Peter and John to them, 15 who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. 16 For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 17 Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.**
13. **ACT 19:1** And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that **Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples 2 he said to them, “Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?” So they said to him, “We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit.” 3 And he said to them, “Into what then were you baptized?” So they said, “Into John’s baptism.” 4 Then Paul said, “John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.” 5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 6 And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.**
14. **EPH 5:18** And **do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,** 20 giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, 21 submitting to one another in the fear of God.
15. **ACT 2:38** Then Peter said to them, “**Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 “For the promise (of the Spirit) is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”**
16. **LUK 11:9** “So I say to you, **ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 10 “For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. 11 “If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? 12 “Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 “If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the HOLY SPIRIT to those who ask Him!”**
