

1. **Types – Antitypes**
2. **1CO 15:45** And so it is written, “**The first man Adam became a living being (psuche). The last Adam became a life-giving spirit (pneuma).** 46 However, **the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual.** 47 The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven. 48 As was the man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust; and as is the heavenly Man, so also are those who are heavenly.
3. **1PE 3:18** For **Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit,** 19 by whom also **He went and preached to the spirits in prison, who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water.** 21 **There is also an ANTITYPE which now saves us—BAPTISM (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,** 22 who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, angels and authorities and powers having been made subject to Him.
4. **MAT 3:11** “**I indeed BAPTIZE you with water unto REPENTANCE, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will BAPTIZE you with the Holy Spirit and fire.** 12 “**His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather His wheat into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.**” 13 Then **Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be BAPTIZED by him.** 14 And **John tried to prevent Him, saying, “I need to be BAPTIZED by You, and are You coming to me?”** 15 But **Jesus answered and said to him, “Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness.”** Then he allowed Him. 16 **When He had been BAPTIZED, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him.** 17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, “This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.”
5. LUK 4:13 Now when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from Him until an opportune time. 14 Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region. 15 And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified by all. 16 So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. 17 And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: 18 “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; 19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.” 20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. 21 And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.”
6. **LUK 12:49** “**I came to send FIRE on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled!** 50 “**But I have a BAPTISM to be BAPTIZED with, and how distressed I am till it is accomplished!**”

7. **2PE 3:5** For this they willfully forget: that **by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water, 6 by which the world that then existed perished, being flooded with WATER.** 7 But the heavens and the earth which are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for **FIRE** until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.
8. Judgement by **WATER**, then by **FIRE**
9. **1PE 2:9** But **you are a chosen generation**, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.
10. **ACT 1:4** And **being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” He said, “you have heard from Me; 5 “for John truly BAPTIZED with water, but you shall be BAPTIZED with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”** 6 Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, “Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?” 7 And He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. 8 “But **you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be WITNESSES to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”**
11. **martus = witnesses**
12. **ACT 2:37** Now **when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Men and brethren, what shall we do?”** 38 Then **Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be BAPTIZED in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 “For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”** 41 Then **those who gladly received his word were BAPTIZED;** and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.
13. **ACT 8:12** But **when they believed Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were BAPTIZED.** 14 Now when **the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God,** they sent **Peter and John** to them, 15 who, when they **had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit.** 16 **For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been BAPTIZED in the name of the Lord Jesus.** 17 Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.
14. **ACT 9:17** And **Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.”** 18 **Immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was BAPTIZED.**
15. **ACT 10:34** Then Peter opened his mouth and said: “In truth I perceive that **God shows no partiality.** 35 “But **in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him.** 36 “**The WORD which God sent to the children of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ—He is Lord of all—** 37 “that word you know, **which was proclaimed throughout all Judea, and began from Galilee after the BAPTISM which John preached:**

38 **“how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.”**

16. **ACT 10:44** **While Peter was still speaking these words (to Cornelius and his family), the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.** 45 And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. 46 For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God. Then **Peter answered,** 47 **“Can anyone forbid water, that these should not be BAPTIZED who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?”** 48 **And he commanded them to be BAPTIZED in the name of the Lord.** Then they asked him to stay a few days.

17. **ACT 19:1** And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that **Paul,** having passed through the upper regions, **came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples 2 he said to them, “Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?”** So **they said to him, “We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit.”** 3 And **he said to them, “Into what then were you BAPTIZED?”** So **they said, “Into John’s BAPTISM.”** 4 Then **Paul said, “John indeed BAPTIZED with a BAPTISM of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.”** 5 **When they heard this, they were BAPTIZED in the name of the Lord Jesus.** 6 And **when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.**

18. **1CO 10:1** Moreover, **brethren, I do not want you to be unaware that all our fathers were under the cloud, all passed through the sea, 2 all were BAPTIZED into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, 3 all ate the same spiritual food, 4 and all drank the same spiritual drink.** For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ.

19. **1CO 12:12** For **as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ.** 13 For **by one Spirit we were all BAPTIZED into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.** 14 For in fact the body is not one member but many.

20. **EPH 4:4** **There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; 5 one Lord, one faith, one BAPTISM; 6 one God and Father of all,** who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

21. **HEB 6:1** Therefore, **leaving the discussion of the ELEMENTARY PRINCIPLES of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of BAPTISMS, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.** 3 And this we will do if God permits.

22. **COL 2:10** and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power. 11 **In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, 12 buried with Him in BAPTISM, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.**

23. **JOH 14:15** “If you love Me, keep My commandments. 16 “And I will pray the Father, and He will give you **another Helper (Comforter = parakletos),** that He may abide with you forever— 17 “the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

24. **IJO 2:1** My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have **an Advocate (parakletos)** with the Father, Jesus **Christ** the righteous.
25. **ACT 2:38** Then **Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** 39 “For **THE PROMISE** is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”
26. **GAL 3:13** Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”), 14 **that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive THE PROMISE OF THE SPIRIT through faith.**
27. **ACT 11:26** And when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. So it was that **for A WHOLE YEAR they assembled with the church and taught a great many people.** And **the disciples were first called CHRISTIANS in Antioch.**
28. **IJO 5:6** This is He who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ; not only by water, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is truth. 7 For **there are three that bear witness in heaven: the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit;** and these three are one. 8 And **there are three that bear witness on earth: the Spirit, the water, and the blood;** and these three agree as one.
29. **JOE 2:28** “And **it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh;** Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions. 29 And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days.
30. **ZEC 10:1** Ask the Lord for rain In the time of the latter rain. The Lord will make flashing clouds; He will give them showers of rain, Grass in the field for everyone. 2 For the idols speak delusion; The diviners envision lies, And tell false dreams; They comfort in vain. Therefore the people wend their way like sheep; They are in trouble because there is no shepherd.
