- T** F The Gospels close, as they open, with the promise of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit.

T F I do not have the power within myself to live a holy life, nor to manifest the character of God, nor to minister as God wishes me to.
- T** F God commands all believers to be holy, bear fruit of righteous character, and to do good works.

T F God never asks me to do anything that He will not also provide the power to do it.

T F Therefore, if I am to live holy, manifest God's character, and do His works, it will have to be by God's power within me, not by myself.

T F I receive that grace (power) to live in holiness entirely by faith that Jesus can live His life through me.
- We** cannot have the character or image of Christ apart from the **PERSON** of Christ. He **IS** the Anointing. The Anointing **IS** Christ. The **Anointing** is the very presence of Christ, the person of Christ, Christ **IN** you, the hope of glory. What is the Gk word for Christ? Christos What does the word mean? 'anointed one'
When did Jesus become the Christ? When He was filled with the Holy Spirit at His Water Baptism.
- The most perfect manifestation of the Holy Spirit in a man can be found in Jesus Christ.
 The most perfect image of the Father in a man can be found in Jesus Christ.
 In **HEB 1:1-3**, what is the Greek word for **IMAGE**? charakter In **HEB 10:1**? eikon
Explain the difference between these words: 'charakter' = 'exact image or expression', comes from a word meaning 'to engrave or carve into'. 'eikon' = an image, figure, or likeness; like a painting, photograph, etc.
- Both** the Holy Spirit and evil spirits manifest their character in a man or woman through people.
 Just as **Satan** works through people so also **God** works through people.
Both the Holy Spirit and evil spirits act as helpers, enabling us to **DO** what our hearts desire.
JOH 13:27 Now after the piece of bread, Satan entered him (Judas). Then Jesus said to him, "What you do, do quickly." (*Judas then betrayed Jesus into the hands of the Jews, who crucified Him*)
Write out **ROM 12:21**: Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
- Jesus Gave two **allegories** describing the presence of the **Holy Spirit** in a believer. One was that the Holy Spirit would be like a **WELL OF WATER** within, welling up to eternal life. Where is that scripture? JOH 4:14
 The Second is that of **RIVERS OF LIVING WATER** coming forth from our inner being. Where is that scripture found? JOH 7:37-38 These allegories can be taken to represent **two aspects of salvation**, i.e. birth in or of the Spirit and the baptism in the Spirit. These two events in the life of a believer are represented by **two OT feasts**. The first is Pentecost (New Birth) and the second feast is Pentecost (Baptism in the Spirit). Are these simultaneous? No. They are distinct and Sequential. A Spiritual Pentecost cannot occur until a Spiritual Passover (the New Birth), Feast of Unleavened Bread (repentance from and forsaking sin), and Feast of Firstfruits (water baptism and renewal to a new life), in that order. If we want a real Pentecost, we must experience these preparatory Feasts !!!
- ACT 10:38** "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. (NKJ)
 When did Jesus become "**Christ**"? When He was baptized into Holy Spirit at the time of His water Baptism
 When was Jesus endued with **power**? AFTER He was then led into AND endured AND was victorious Over the temptations of the Devil in the Wilderness – THEN He came out 'in the POWER of the Spirit' !!!
 (See MAT 3:12-4:17; MAR 1:9-22; LUK 4:1-21, 32)
- ACT 2:39** "For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call." (NKJ)
GAL 3:13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), 14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. (NKJ)
- What** is the "**promise**" referred to in Q11? The Baptism (filling) with the Holy Spirit

13. **What** does the word "**Christian**" mean? 'Christ-like' or 'little Christs' **Where** were believers first called **Christians** (give ref.)? ACT 11:25 Then Barnabas departed for Tarsus to seek Saul. 26 And when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and taught a great many people. And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch. (NOTE -- The TEACHING for one year resulted in such growth of these believers, that they began to act LIKE CHRIST !)
14. Write out **JUDE 20**: But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, If Jesus did not enter ministry until He was filled with the Holy Spirit, and told His disciples to wait until they were filled before attempting to fulfil Jesus' commission to them, what does this mean to you? I cannot do the ministry to which God calls without His POWER, His ANOINTING, which alone enables me to minister. I MUST be first Baptized in Holy Spirit, who provides the POWER to minister. That anointing IS CHRIST !

17. **ACT 1:4** And being assembled together with them, He (Jesus) commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; 5 "for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." 8 "But you shall receive POWER when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." (NKJ)
18. In **ACT 1:4-5, 8** above, what is the Greek word for '**Father**'? patria For '**baptized**'? baptizo For '**Holy Spirit**'? pneuma hagios For '**power**'? dunamis For '**witnesses**'? martus What is a '**martyr**'. How is this English word related to the Greek term for '**witnesses**'? Explain how these terms might be related. Is it possible to become a martyr and not die physically? A 'martyr' is someone who Dies for a cause - in this case Christianity. There are TWO ways we can die. FIRST & FOREMOST is a death to SELF, becoming a bondservant to Christ in service -- That is crucifying the FLESH on the cross. Physical death because of our faith may or may not also happen.
How might the power provided by the Holy Spirit accomplish this? Only the Spirit provides us the strength To DIE to self, crucifying the FLESH on the cross of Christ, AFTER which we arise again to a new life.
19. **JOH 14:15** "If you love Me, keep My commandments. 16 "And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another comforter, that He may abide with you forever— 17 "the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells WITH you and will be IN you. (NKJ)
20. What is the Greek word for **Helper** or **Comforter** in **JOH 14:15**? parakletos **What** is the meaning of this word? 'one who takes a hold of together with against - a HELPER'
21. **1JO 2:1** My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. (NKJ)
What is the Greek word for '**advocate**' here in **1JO 2:1**? Parakletos - again the HELPER
What does it mean? Notice that BOTH the Holy Spirit AND Jesus as the CHRIST (anointed one) serve As HELPER to us, as children of God. The anointing of the Holy Spirit IS CHRIST WITHIN US !!!!
22. Write out **PSA 42:2**: My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?
Write out **ISA 12:3**: Therefore with joy you will draw water From the wells of salvation.
Write out **2SA 23:2**: "The Spirit of the Lord spoke by me. And His word was on my tongue.
23. **REV 22:1** And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb. 17 And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely. (NKJ)
24. **EPH 5:18** And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and Spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, 20 giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, (NKJ)
