The Church of today has been described as analogous to a football stadium in which 22 exhausted players desperately needing rest work diligently on the field, while 50,000 spectators badly needing exercise view the struggle from afar. The players represent pastors and other workers in the church who carry the load of ministry, while the fans represent the majority of Christians who are not playing in the game. Let us **NOT** be benchwarmers and spectators only! Sure, you might get injured if you get into the game! It can get rough out there! But it is **SO** much more fun to be **IN THE GAME** than simply watching from afar!!! In any game, only the participants are eligible for awards. The **SAME** is true in the Kingdom of Heaven.

- 1CO 12:1** Now **concerning SPIRITUAL GIFTS (pneumatikos), brethren (adelphos), I do not want you to be ignorant (agnoeo):** 4 **There are diversities of gifts (charisma), but the same Spirit (pneuma).** 5 **There are differences of ministries (diakonia), but the same Lord.** 6 **And there are diversities of activities (energema), but it is the same God who works (energeo) all in all.** 7 **But the MANIFESTATION (phanerosis) OF THE SPIRIT (pneuma) IS GIVEN TO EACH ONE FOR THE PROFIT OF ALL:** 8 for to one is given **THE WORD (logos) OF WISDOM (sophia)** through the Spirit, to another **THE WORD (logos) OF KNOWLEDGE (gnosis)** through the same Spirit, 9 to another **FAITH (pistis)** by the same Spirit, to another **GIFTS (charisma) OF HEALINGS (iama)** by the same Spirit, 10 to another **THE WORKING (energema) OF MIRACLES (dunamis de),** to another **PROPHECY (propheteia de),** to another **DISCERNING OF SPIRITS (pneuma),** to another **DIFFERENT KINDS OF TONGUES (glossa de),** to another **THE INTERPRETATION (hermeneia) OF TONGUES (glossa de).** 11 But one and the same Spirit works (energeo) all these things, distributing **TO EACH ONE INDIVIDUALLY (idios)** as He wills.
- LUK 11:9** “So I say to you, **ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.** 10 “For **EVERYONE** who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. 13 “**If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!**”
- MAR 16:17** “And **these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 “they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”** 19 So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. 20 And **they went out and preached everywhere, THE LORD WORKING WITH THEM AND CONFIRMING THE WORD THROUGH THE ACCOMPANYING SIGNS.** Amen.
- ACT 10:38** “how **God ANOINTED (chrizo)** Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy (*hagios*) Spirit (*pneuma*) and with power (*dunamis*), who went about doing good (*euergeteo*) and healing all who were oppressed by the devil (*diabolos*), for God was with Him.
- ROM 1:11** For **I long to see you, that I may impart to you some SPIRITUAL (pneumatikos) GIFT (charisma), so that you may be established—**
- ROM 11:29** For **THE GIFTS (charisma) AND THE CALLING (klesis) OF GOD ARE IRREVOCABLE.**
- 1CO 2:4** And **my speech and my preaching (kerugma) were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in DEMONSTRATION OF THE SPIRIT (pneuma) AND OF POWER (dunamis), 5 that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.**
- 1CO 12:31** But **earnestly desire the BEST GIFTS (charisma).** And yet I show you a more excellent way.
- 1CO 14:1** Pursue love (*agape*), and **DESIRE SPIRITUAL GIFTS (pneumatikos), but especially that you may prophesy (propheteuo).**
- EPH 4:11** And **He Himself GAVE** some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 **for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,** 13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; 14 **that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting. 15 but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—** 16 from whom **the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.**
- 1CO 14:12** Even so you, **since YOU ARE ZEALOUS FOR SPIRITUAL (pneuma) GIFTS, let it be for the edification (oikodome) of the church (ekklesia) that you seek to excel.**
- HEB 2:3** how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him, 4 **God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and GIFTS (merismos) OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, according to His own will?**
- HEB 8:3** For **EVERY high priest is appointed to offer both GIFTS (doron) and sacrifices.** Therefore it is necessary that this One also have something to offer. 4 For if He were on earth, He would not be a priest, since there are priests who offer the gifts according to the law;

The GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT Manifested Through Paul

- (a) **Word of Wisdom:** 2PE 3:15 Bear in mind that our Lord's patience means salvation, just as our dear brother Paul also wrote you with the wisdom that God gave him.
- (b) **Word of Knowledge:** ACT 13:11 Now the hand of the Lord is against you. You are going to be blind, and for a time you will be unable to see the light of the sun." Immediately mist and darkness came over him, and he groped about, seeking someone to lead him by the hand.
- (c) **Discerning of Spirits:** ACT 16:16 Once when we were going to the place of prayer, we were met by a slave girl who had a spirit by which she predicted the future. She earned a great deal of money for her owners by fortune-telling. 17 This girl followed Paul and the rest of us, shouting, "These men are servants of the Most High God, who are telling you the way to be saved." 18 She kept this up for many days. Finally Paul became so troubled that he turned around and said to the spirit, "In the name of Jesus Christ I command you to come out of her!" At that moment the spirit left her.
- (d) **Tongues:** 1CO 14:18 I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you.
- (e) **Interpretation of Tongues:** 1CO 14:13 For this reason anyone who speaks in a tongue should pray that he may interpret what he says.
- (f) **Prophecy:** 1CO 14:6 Now, brothers, if I come to you and speak in tongues, what good will I be to you, unless I bring you some revelation or knowledge or prophecy or word of instruction?
- (g) **Faith:** ROM 15:18 I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me in leading the Gentiles to obey God by what I have said and done— 19 by the power of signs and miracles, through the power of the Spirit. So from Jerusalem all the way around to Illyricum, I have fully proclaimed the gospel of Christ. 20 It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else's foundation. 21 Rather, as it is written: "Those who were not told about him will see, and those who have not heard will understand."
- (h) **Healings:** ACT 14:8-8 In Lystra there sat a man crippled in his feet, who was lame from birth and had never walked. 9 He listened to Paul as he was speaking. Paul looked directly at him, saw that he had faith to be healed 10 and called out, "Stand up on your feet!" At that, the man jumped up and began to walk.
- (i) **Miracles:** ACT 20:9 Seated in a window was a young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep as Paul talked on and on. When he was sound asleep, he fell to the ground from the third story and was picked up dead. 10 Paul went down, threw himself on the young man and put his arms around him. "Don't be alarmed," he said. "He's alive!" 11 Then he went upstairs again and broke bread and ate. After talking until daylight, he left. 12 The people took the young man home alive and were greatly comforted.

Chapter 12 of 1CO deals with the Gifts of the Spirit. However, before Paul describes the actual operation of the Gifts within the body of believers in 1CO 14, he first interjects 1CO 13 on love. There must be a reason the Holy Spirit put this chapter on love between the Gifts and their operation !!

Wisdom (*sophia*)

14. GENESIS 41:38 And Pharaoh said to his servants, "Can we find such a one as this (*Joseph*), a man in whom is the Spirit of God?" 39 Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Inasmuch as God has shown you all this, there is no one as discerning and WISE as you.
15. EXO 31:2 "See, I have called by name Bezalel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah. 3 "And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in WISDOM, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, (to build the Tabernacle in the Wilderness)
16. 1KI 3:11 Then God said to him (Solomon): "Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice, 12 "behold, I have done according to your words; see, I have given you a WISE and understanding heart, so that there has not been anyone like you before you, nor shall any like you arise after you.
17. JOB 32:8 But there is a spirit in man, And the breath of the Almighty gives him understanding. 9 Great men are not always WISE, Nor do the aged always understand justice.
18. PSA 143:10 Teach me to do Your will, For You are my God; Your Spirit is good. Lead me in the land of uprightness.
19. PRO 2:6 For the Lord gives WISDOM; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding;
20. ISA 11:2 The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of WISDOM and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord. 3 His delight is in the fear of the Lord, And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, Nor decide by the hearing of His ears;
21. ISA 50:4 "The Lord God has given Me The tongue of the learned, That I should know how to speak A word in season to him who is weary. He awakens Me morning by morning, He awakens My ear To hear as the learned.
22. DAN 2:21 And He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives WISDOM to the WISE And knowledge to those who have understanding.

23. **MAT 13:11** He answered and said to them, “Because it has been given to YOU TO KNOW THE MYSTERIES OF THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN, but to them it has not been given. 12 “For whoever has, to him more will be given, and he will have abundance; but whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him.
24. **ACT 6:3** “Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and WISDOM, whom we may appoint over this business;
25. **ICO 1:30** But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us WISDOM from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption—
26. **ICO 2:6** However, we speak WISDOM among those who are mature, yet not the WISDOM of this age, nor of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. 7 But we speak the WISDOM of God in a mystery, the hidden WISDOM which God ordained before the ages for our glory, 8 which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. 9 But as it is written: “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.” 10 But God has REVEALED THEM TO US THROUGH HIS SPIRIT. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.
27. **EPH 1:17** (I pray) that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of WISDOM and revelation in the knowledge of Him, 18 THE EYES OF YOUR UNDERSTANDING BEING ENLIGHTENED; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,
28. **EPH 3:3** how that BY REVELATION HE MADE KNOWN TO ME THE MYSTERY (as I have briefly written already, 4 by which, when you read, you may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ), 5 which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets: 6 that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel, 10 to the intent that now the manifold WISDOM of God might be made known BY THE CHURCH to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places,
29. **COL 1:9** For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all WISDOM and spiritual understanding;

Knowledge (*gnosis*)

30. **NEH 9:20** You also gave Your good Spirit to instruct them, And did not withhold Your manna from their mouth, And gave them water for their thirst. 21 Forty years You sustained them in the wilderness, They lacked nothing; Their clothes did not wear out And their feet did not swell.
31. **ROM 15:14** Now I myself am confident concerning you, my brethren, that you also are full of goodness, filled with all KNOWLEDGE, able also to admonish one another.
32. **ICO 1:4** I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus, 5 that you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all KNOWLEDGE, 6 even as the testimony of Christ was CONFIRMED IN YOU, 7 so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ,
33. **ICO 13:2** And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all KNOWLEDGE, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. 8 Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is KNOWLEDGE, it will vanish away.
34. **ICO 14:6** But now, brethren, if I come to you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you unless I speak to you either by revelation, by KNOWLEDGE, by prophesying, or by teaching?
35. **2CO 8:7** But as you abound in everything—in faith, in speech, in KNOWLEDGE, in all diligence, and in your love for us—see that you abound in this grace also.
36. **2CO 11:6** Even though I am untrained in speech, yet I am not in KNOWLEDGE. But we have been thoroughly manifested among you in all things.
37. **COL 1:9** For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the KNOWLEDGE of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10 that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the KNOWLEDGE of God;
38. **2PE 1:5** But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue KNOWLEDGE, 6 to KNOWLEDGE self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, 7 to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. 8 For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the KNOWLEDGE of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Discerning of spirits (*pneuma*)

39. **LEV 20:6** ‘And the person who turns to MEDIUMS AND FAMILIAR SPIRITS, to prostitute himself with them, I will set My face against that person and cut him off from his people.
40. **DEU 18:10** “There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, or one who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, 11 “or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead.
41. **ISA 8:19** And when they say to you, “Seek those who are mediums and wizards, who whisper and mutter,” should not a people seek their God? Should they seek the dead on behalf of the living?

42. **MAT 8:16** When evening had come, **they brought to Him (Jesus) many who were demon-possessed. And HE CAST OUT THE SPIRITS WITH A WORD, and healed all who were sick,** 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses.”
43. **MAR 1:25** But **Jesus rebuked him, saying, “Be quiet, and come out of him!”** 26 And **when the unclean spirit had convulsed him and cried out with a loud voice, he came out of him.** 27 Then they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, “What is this? **What new doctrine is this? For with authority He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him.**”³⁴ **Then He healed many who were sick with various diseases, and CAST OUT MANY DEMONS; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him.**
44. **MAR 9:25** When **Jesus saw that the people came running together, HE REBUKED THE UNCLEAN SPIRIT, SAYING TO IT, “DEAF AND DUMB SPIRIT, I COMMAND YOU, COME OUT OF HIM AND ENTER HIM NO MORE!”** 26 Then **the spirit cried out, convulsed him greatly, and came out of him.** And he became as one dead, so that many said, “He is dead.” 27 But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him up, and he arose. 28 And when He had come into the house, **His disciples asked Him privately, “Why could we not cast it out?”** 29 So **He said to them, “This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting.”**
45. **MAR 9:38** Now **John answered Him, saying, “Teacher, we saw someone who does not follow us casting out demons in Your name, and we forbade him because he does not follow us.”**
46. **MAR 16:17** “And **these signs will follow those who believe: In My name THEY WILL CAST OUT DEMONS;** they will speak with new tongues;
47. **LUK 9:1** Then **He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases.** 2 He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.
48. **LUK 10:17** Then **the seventy returned with joy, saying, “Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name.”** 18 And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. 19 “**Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.**
49. **ACT 16:16** Now **it happened, as we went to prayer, that a certain slave girl possessed with a spirit of divination met us, who brought her masters much profit by fortune-telling.** 17 This girl followed Paul and us, and cried out, saying, “These men are the servants of the Most High God, who proclaim to us the way of salvation.” 18 And this she did for many days. But **Paul, greatly annoyed, turned and SAID TO THE SPIRIT, “I command you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her.” And he came out that very hour.**
50. **COL 2:15** **Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.**

Tongues (glossa)

51. **GEN 11:1** Now **the whole earth had one language and one speech.** 6 And the Lord said, “Indeed the people are one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them. 7 “**Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language, that they may not understand one another’s speech.”**
52. **ISA 28:9** “**Whom will he teach knowledge? And whom will he make to understand the message? Those just weaned from milk? Those just drawn from the breasts?** 10 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, Here a little, there a little.” 11 **For WITH STAMMERING LIPS AND ANOTHER TONGUE HE WILL SPEAK TO THIS PEOPLE,** 12 **To whom He said, “This is the rest with which You may cause the weary to rest,”** And, “This is the refreshing”; Yet they would not hear.
53. **ZEP 3:9** “For then **I WILL RESTORE TO THE PEOPLES A PURE LANGUAGE,** That they all may call on the name of the Lord, To serve Him with one accord.
54. **MAR 16:17** “And **these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new TONGUES;**
55. **ACT 2:1** When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 **Then there appeared to them divided TONGUES (glossa), as of fire, and one sat upon each of them.** 4 And **they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other TONGUES (glossa), as the Spirit gave them utterance.**
56. **ACT 2:33** “Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and **having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.**
57. **ACTS 10:45** And **those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also.** 46 **For they heard them speak with TONGUES and magnify God.** Then Peter answered,
58. **ACT 19:6** And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with **TONGUES** and prophesied.
59. **ROMANS 8:26** Likewise **the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.** 27 Now **He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.**

60. **1CO 12:10** to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, **to another different kinds of TONGUES, to another the interpretation of TONGUES.**
61. **1CO 12:28** And **God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of TONGUES.** 31 But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way.
62. **1CO 13:1** **Though I speak with the TONGUES of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.**
63. **1CO 14:1** Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy. 2 For **HE WHO SPEAKS IN A TONGUE DOES NOT SPEAK TO MEN BUT TO GOD, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.** 3 But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men. 4 He who speaks in a **TONGUE** edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church. **5 I wish you all spoke with TONGUES, but even more that you prophesied; for he who prophesies is greater than he who speaks with TONGUES, unless indeed he interprets, that the church may receive edification.** 6 But **now, brethren, if I come to you speaking with TONGUES, what shall I profit you unless I speak to you either by revelation, by knowledge, by prophesying, or by teaching?**
64. **1CO 14:12** Even **so you, since you are zealous for spiritual gifts, let it be for the edification of the church that you seek to excel.** 13 **Therefore let him who speaks in a TONGUE pray that he may interpret.** 14 For **if I pray in a TONGUE, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful.** 15 What is the conclusion then? **I will pray with the spirit, and I will also pray with the understanding. I will sing with the spirit, and I will also sing with the understanding.** 16 Otherwise, if you bless with the spirit, how will he who occupies the place of the uninformed say "Amen" at your giving of thanks, since he does not understand what you say? 17 For you indeed give thanks well, but the other is not edified. 18 **I thank my God I speak with TONGUES more than you all; 19 yet in the church I would rather speak five words with my understanding, that I may teach others also, than ten thousand words in a TONGUE.**
65. **1CO 14:21** In the law it is written: **"With men of other TONGUES and other lips I will speak to this people; And yet, for all that, they will not hear Me,"** says the Lord. 22 Therefore **TONGUES are for a sign, not to those who believe but to unbelievers; but prophesying is not for unbelievers but for those who believe.** 23 Therefore **if the whole church comes together in one place, and all speak with TONGUES, and there come in those who are uninformed or unbelievers, will they not say that you are out of your mind?** 24 But **if all prophesy, and an unbeliever or an uninformed person comes in, he is convinced by all, he is convicted by all.** 25 **And thus the secrets of his heart are revealed; and so, falling down on his face, he will worship God and report that God is truly among you.** 26 **How is it then, brethren? Whenever you come together, each of you has a psalm, has a teaching, has a TONGUE, has a revelation, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.** 27 **If anyone speaks in a TONGUE, let there be two or at the most three, each in turn, and let one interpret.** 28 **But if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God.** 29 **Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others judge.** 30 **But if anything is revealed to another who sits by, let the first keep silent.** 31 For **YOU CAN ALL PROPHECY one by one, that all may learn and all may be encouraged.** 32 And **the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.** 33 For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints. 39 **Therefore, brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak with TONGUES.** 40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
66. **JUDE 20** But you, **beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit,**

Interpretation of Tongues (*glossa*)

67. **1CO 12:10** to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, **to another the INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES.**
68. **1CO 12:30** Do all have gifts of healings? **Do all speak with tongues? DO ALL INTERPRET?**
69. **1CO 14:12** Even **so you, since you are zealous for spiritual gifts, let it be for the edification of the church that you seek to excel.** 13 **Therefore LET HIM WHO SPEAKS IN A TONGUE PRAY THAT HE MAY INTERPRET.** 14 For **if I pray in a TONGUE, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful.** 15 What is the conclusion then? **I WILL PRAY WITH THE SPIRIT, AND I WILL ALSO PRAY WITH THE UNDERSTANDING. I WILL SING WITH THE SPIRIT, AND I WILL ALSO SING WITH THE UNDERSTANDING.** 16 Otherwise, if you bless with the spirit, how will he who occupies the place of the uninformed say "Amen" at your giving of thanks, since he does not understand what you say? 17 For you indeed give thanks well, but the other is not edified. **18 I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all; 19 yet in the church I would rather speak five words with my understanding, that I may teach others also, than ten thousand words in a tongue.**
70. **1CO 14:26** **How is it then, brethren? Whenever you come together, EACH OF YOU has a psalm, has a teaching, has a tongue, has a revelation, HAS AN INTERPRETATION.** Let all things be done for edification. **27 If anyone speaks in a tongue, let there be two or at the most three, each in turn, and let one interpret.** 28 **But if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God.** 29 **Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others judge.** 30 **But if anything is revealed to another who sits by, let the first keep silent.** 31 For **YOU CAN ALL PROPHECY ONE BY ONE, that all may learn and all may be encouraged.** 32 And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.

(Note: Public tongues with interpretation is equivalent to prophecy in a known tongue.)

Prophecy

71. **NUM 11:25** Then **the Lord came down in the cloud, and spoke to him, and took of the Spirit that was upon him, and placed the same upon the seventy elders; and it happened, when the Spirit rested upon them, that THEY PROPHESED,** although they never did so again. 26 But two men had remained in the camp: the name of one was Eldad, and the name of the other Medad. And the Spirit rested upon them. Now they were among those listed, but who had not gone out to the tabernacle; yet **they PROPHESED in the camp.** 28 So Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, one of his choice men, answered and said, "Moses my lord, forbid them!" 29 Then **Moses said to him, "Are you zealous for my sake? OH, THAT ALL THE LORD'S PEOPLE WERE PROPHETS AND THAT THE LORD WOULD PUT HIS SPIRIT UPON THEM!"**
72. **ISA 10:10** When **they came there to the hill, there was a group of prophets to meet him; then the Spirit of God came upon him, and HE PROPHESED AMONG THEM.** 11 And it happened, **when all who knew him formerly saw that he indeed prophesied among the prophets, that the people said to one another, "What is this that has come upon the son of Kish? IS SAUL ALSO AMONG THE PROPHETS?"**
73. **1CH 25:1** Moreover **David and the captains of the army separated for the service some of the sons of Asaph, of Heman, and of Jeduthun, WHO SHOULD PROPHESEY WITH HARPS, STRINGED INSTRUMENTS, AND CYMBALS.** And the number of the skilled men performing their service was: 2 Of the sons of Asaph: Zaccur, Joseph, Nethaniah, and Ashareliah; the sons of Asaph were under the direction of Asaph, who prophesied according to the order of the king. 3 Of Jeduthun, the sons of Jeduthun: Gedaliah, Zeri, Jeshaiiah, Shimei, Hashabiah, and Mattithiah, **six, under the direction of their father Jeduthun, WHO PROPHESED WITH A HARP TO GIVE THANKS AND TO PRAISE THE LORD.**
74. **2CH 15:8** And when **Asa heard these words and the prophecy of Oded the prophet, he took courage, & removed the abominable idols from all the land of Judah and Benjamin** and from the cities which he had taken in the mountains of Ephraim; and **he restored the altar of the Lord** that was before the vestibule of the Lord.
75. **EZR 5:1** Then **the prophet Haggai and Zechariah the son of Iddo, prophets, prophesied to the Jews** who were in Judah and Jerusalem, **in the name of the God of Israel,** who was over them.
76. **JER 14:14** And the Lord said to me, **"THE PROPHETS PROPHESEY LIES IN MY NAME. I have not sent them, commanded them, nor spoken to them; they prophesy to you a false vision, divination, a worthless thing, and the deceit of their heart.**
77. **PRO 31:1** The words of king Lemuel, **the PROPHECY that his mother taught him.**
78. **JER 23:13** **"And I have seen folly in the prophets of Samaria: They prophesied by Baal And caused My people Israel to err. 14 Also I have seen a horrible thing in the prophets of Jerusalem: They commit adultery and walk in lies; They also strengthen the hands of evildoers, So that no one turns back from his wickedness.** All of them are like Sodom to Me, And her inhabitants like Gomorrah.
79. **EZE 37:7** So **I PROPHESED as I was commanded; & as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.** 8 Indeed, as I looked, the sinews and the flesh came upon them, and the skin covered them over; but there was no breath in them. 9 Also **He said to me, "Prophecy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live."** 10 **So I prophesied as He commanded me, & breath came into them, & they lived, & stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army.**
80. **JOE 2:28** **"And it shall come to pass afterward That I WILL POUR OUT MY SPIRIT ON ALL FLESH; YOUR SONS AND YOUR DAUGHTERS SHALL PROPHESEY, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions.** 29 And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days.
81. **MAT 7:15** Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.
82. **JOH 11:51** Now **this he did not say on his own authority; but being high priest that year HE PROPHESED that Jesus would die for the nation,** 52 and not for that nation only, but also that He would gather together in one the children of God who were scattered abroad.
83. **ACT 11:28** Then one of them, named Agabus, stood up and showed by the Spirit that there was going to be a great famine throughout all the world, which also happened in the days of Claudius Caesar.
84. **ACT 19:6** And **when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and THEY SPOKE WITH TONGUES AND PROPHESED.** 7 Now the men were about twelve in all.
85. **ACT 21:8** On the next day we who were Paul's companions departed and came to Caesarea, and entered the house of Philip the evangelist, who was one of the seven, and stayed with him. 9 Now **this man had four virgin daughters who PROPHESED.** 10 And as we stayed many days, **a certain PROPHET named Agabus came down from Judea.** 11 When he had come to us, **he took Paul's belt, bound his own hands and feet, and said, "Thus says the Holy Spirit, 'So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man who owns this belt, and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.'**"
86. **ROM 12:6** **Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if PROPHECY, let us PROPHESEY in proportion to our faith;** 7 or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; 8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.
87. **1CO 12:10** to another the working of miracles, **to another PROPHECY,** to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.
88. **1CO 13:2** And **though I have the GIFT OF PROPHECY,** and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, **but have not love, I am nothing.**
89. **1CO 14:1** **Pursue love, and (eagerly) desire spiritual gifts, but ESPECIALLY THAT YOU MAY PROPHESEY.** 2 For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him;

however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries. 3 But **HE WHO PROPHESES SPEAKS EDIFICATION AND EXHORTATION AND COMFORT TO MEN.** 4 He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church. 5 **I wish you all spoke with tongues, but even more that you PROPHESED; for he who PROPHESES is greater than he who speaks with tongues, unless indeed he interprets, that the church may receive edification.**

90. **1CO 14:22** Therefore **tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe but to unbelievers; but PROPHESYING IS NOT FOR UNBELIEVERS BUT FOR THOSE WHO BELIEVE.** 23 Therefore if the whole church comes together in one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in those who are uninformed or unbelievers, will they not say that you are out of your mind? 24 But **if ALL PROPHECY, and an unbeliever or an uninformed person comes in, he is convinced by all, he is convicted by all.** 25 And **thus the secrets of his heart are revealed;** and so, falling down on his face, he will worship God and report that God is truly among you.
91. **1CO 14:39** Therefore, **brethren, DESIRE EARNESTLY TO PROPHECY, and do not forbid to speak with tongues.**
92. **1TI 4:14** **Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you BY PROPHECY with the laying on of the hands of the eldership.**
93. **IPE 1:10** **Of this salvation THE PROPHETS have inquired and searched carefully, who PROPHESED of the grace that would come to you,** 11 searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.
94. **2PE 1:19** And **so we have THE PROPHETIC WORD confirmed,** which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; 20 knowing this first, **that no PROPHECY OF SCRIPTURE is of any private interpretation,** 21 **for PROPHECY never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.**
95. **REV 1:3** **Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near.**
96. **REV 19:10** And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, “See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. **Worship God! For THE TESTIMONY OF JESUS IS THE SPIRIT OF PROPHECY.**”

Faith (*pistis*)

97. **MAT 17:19** Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, “Why could we not cast it out?” 20 So Jesus said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for **assuredly, I say to you, if you have FAITH as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.** 21 “However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.”
98. **MAT 21:21** So Jesus answered and said to them, “**Assuredly, I say to you, if you have FAITH and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ it will be done.** 22 “And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive.”
99. **MAR 11:22** So Jesus answered and said to them, “**Have FAITH in God.** 23 “For **assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.** 24 “Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.
100. **LUK 17:5** And **the apostles said to the Lord, “Increase our FAITH.”** 6 So the Lord said, “**If you have FAITH as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you.**
101. **ROM 12:3** For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as **God has dealt to each one a measure of FAITH.**
102. **1CO 13:2** And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and **though I have all FAITH, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.**
103. **2CO 4:13** And **since we have the same SPIRIT OF FAITH, according to what is written, “I believed and therefore I spoke,” we also believe and therefore speak,**
104. **2CO 5:7** For we walk by **FAITH,** not by sight.
105. **EPH 2:8** For by grace you have been saved through **FAITH,** and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,
106. **HEB 10:38** Now **the just shall live by FAITH;** But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.”
107. **HEB 11:6** But **without FAITH it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.** 7 **By FAITH Noah,** being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to **FAITH.**
108. **2PE 1:1** Simon Peter, a bondservant and apostle of Jesus Christ, **To those who have obtained like precious FAITH with us** by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ:

Healings

109. **PSA 103:2** Bless the Lord, O my soul, And **forget not all His benefits:** 3 **Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,** 4 **Who redeems your life from destruction,** Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, 5 Who satisfies your mouth with good things, **So that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.**
110. **1CO 12:28** And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, **then GIFTS OF HEALINGS,** helps, administrations, varieties of tongues. 29 Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles? 30 **Do all have GIFTS OF HEALINGS?** Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret?

111. MAT 10:8 **“HEAL THE SICK, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.**
112. MAR 6:12 So they went out and preached that people should repent. 13 And **they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and HEALED THEM.**
113. MAR 16:17 **“And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 “they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; THEY WILL LAY HANDS ON THE SICK, AND THEY WILL RECOVER.”** 19 So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. 20 And **they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and CONFIRMING THE WORD THROUGH THE ACCOMPANYING SIGNS.** Amen.
114. LUK 9:1 Then **He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and TO CURE DISEASES.** 2 He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to **HEAL THE SICK.**
115. LUK 10:9 **“And HEAL THE SICK there, and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’**
116. ACT 3:6 Then **PETER SAID, “Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk.”** 7 And **he took him by the right hand and lifted him up, and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.** 8 So he, leaping up, stood and walked and entered the temple with them—walking, leaping, and praising God.
117. ACT 4:29 **“Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, 30 “by stretching out Your hand TO HEAL, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.”**
118. ACT 5:14 And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, 15 so that **they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them.** 16 Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, **bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.**
119. ACT 10:38 **“how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and HEALING all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.**
120. ACT 19:11 Now **God worked unusual miracles by the hands of Paul, 12 so that even handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body to the sick, and THE DISEASES LEFT THEM and the evil spirits went out of them.**
121. JAM 5:14 **Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. 15 And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. 16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be HEALED.** The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

Miracles

122. MAR 16:17 **“And these SIGNS will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 “they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”** 19 So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. 20 And **they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying SIGNS.** Amen.
123. JOH 2:23 Now **when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name when they saw the SIGNS which He did.**
124. JOH 3:2 This man (*Nicodemus*) came to Jesus by night and said to Him, **“Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these SIGNS that You do unless God is with him.”**
125. JOH 6:2 Then **a great multitude followed Him, because they saw His SIGNS which He performed on those who were diseased.**
126. JOH 14:12 **“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. 13 “And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 “If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.**
127. ACT 2:22 Men of Israel, hear these words: **Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by MIRACLES, wonders, and SIGNS which God did through Him in your midst, as you yourselves also know—**
128. ACT 6:8 And **Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and SIGNS among the people.**
129. ACT 8:13 Then **Simon himself also believed; and when he was baptized he continued with Philip, and was amazed, seeing the MIRACLES and SIGNS which were done.**
130. ROM 15:18 For **I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ has not accomplished through me, in word and deed, to make the Gentiles obedient— 19 in mighty SIGNS and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God,** so that from Jerusalem and round about to Illyricum I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.
131. 1CO 12:10 **to another the working of MIRACLES, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.**
132. 1CO 12:29 Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? **Are all workers of MIRACLES?**
133. GAL 3:5 Therefore **He who supplies the Spirit to you and works MIRACLES among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?—**
134. HEB 2:3 **how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him, 4 God also bearing witness both with SIGNS and wonders, with various MIRACLES, and GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, according to His own will?**
