## Questions: Gifts of the Spirit

5. Write out **ROM 1:11**: For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift, so that you may be established— (NKJ)
6. **1TI 4:14** Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership. (NKJ)  
**2TI 1:6** Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands. (NKJ)  
**How** was **the GIFT OF GOD** imparted through Paul to Timothy in these scriptures? The gift, whatever its nature, was imparted through Paul and the elders to Timothy through prophecy and laying on of their hands.
7. Write out **LEV 8:12**: And he poured some of the anointing oil on Aaron's head and anointed him, to consecrate him. (NKJ)  
 Write out **2CO 1:21**: Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God.
8. **IJO 2:20** But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things. (NKJ)  
**IJO 2:27** But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him. (NKJ)
9. **What** is the Greek word for '**anointing**' here? chrisma **What** is the verb form? chrío  
 Define '**ANOINTING**' in your own words, including its **nature**, its **source**, its **purpose**, etc. The impartation by the Holy Spirit of power or ability to accomplish any God-appointed task. Typified in both the NT and OT with application of some type of oil, such as over the head, on the head, on the right earlobe, right great toe, etc.
10. **What three (3) offices** of service were anointed in the Old Testament? Kings, Priests and Prophets.  
 Give **Scripture references** for each: Kings = 1KI 1:44 (Solomon); ISA 16:13 (David)  
Priests = LEV 8:12; EXO 29:29-30 Prophets = NUM 11:25-29  
 Are there any **New Testament scriptures** that indicate that **WE** are appointed into any of these three offices? **If so**, give scripture references: REV 1:6 and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. 1PE 2:5 you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;  
**What factors** can block us from receiving the anointing? Sin, unbelief, unforgiveness, past history of involvement in the occult (by yourself or previous generations), etc.
11. **Where** is the scripture passage describing the nine **GIFTS of the Spirit**? 1CO 12:1-31 Fill out the following table showing the three Categories of **Gifts of the Spirit** and the three Gifts in each (Remember the Trinities in God's Creation?):

13. **What is the subject** of **1CO 12**? Describes the Gifts of the Holy Spirit available to the church body  
**What is the subject** of **1CO 13**? Definition of and operation of agape love within the body of Christ  
**What is the subject** of **1CO 14**? Guide to operation of the Gifts of the Spirit within the local church body

**Why** do you suppose Paul brings up the subject of **AGAPE LOVE** between these two discussions? \_\_\_\_\_  
*Operation of these gifts with agape love will result in hurt, offense, and other negative results and responses*  
*On the part of the recipients, and pride and judgement on the part of the minister of these Gifts.*

14. Write out **1CO 1:30**: *But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption—*  
Jesus becoming your **righteousness** represents salvation of your spirit (pneuma).  
Jesus becoming your **sanctification** represents salvation of your soul (psuche).  
Jesus becoming your **redemption** represents salvation of your body (soma).
15. **1CO 2:4** And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, 5 that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God. (NKJ)  
**Does** God expect us to minister **in our own power, knowledge, wisdom, and resources**? By NO means !!!  
Is it possible to be **in the ministry**, and yet not be called and anointed by God to stand in that office? \_\_\_\_\_  
**Explain God's plan for ministry**: God's plan is for HIM to call us into His chosen ministry office, anoint with the Holy Spirit to empower for that office, and to provide supernatural Gifts of the Spirit by which to fulfill the ministry He gives. If we are faithful with what He gives initially, He will give MORE !!!
16. **Explain** the difference in **Ministry Offices of the Spirit** (which are gifts from God) and the **Gifts of the Spirit** in **1CO 12**: Gifts are essential to the performance of ministry either by an individual Christian OR one called into a specific ministry office. Both the calling and enabling or empowering for ministry are from God.
17. Write out **1CO 14:13**: Therefore let him who speaks in a tongue pray that he may interpret.  
Write out **1CO 14:31**: For you can ALL prophesy one by one, that all may learn and all may be encouraged.
18. **How many** within the Body of Christ, according to scripture, could potentially **prophecy**? Everyone !!  
**Why** is it that so few do **prophecy**? Unbelief, lack of knowledge, not being filled with the Holy Spirit, fear or uncertainty, lack of instruction.  
**Is everyone** who prophesies a **prophet**? No. But ALL believers are told to desire to prophecy (1CO 14:1).  
**1CO 12:31** But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way. (NKJ)  
**1CO 14:1** Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophecy. (NKJ)
19. **Give one or more scripture references** when Jesus manifested each of the following **Gifts of the Spirit**:
- Word of Wisdom**: MAT 12:42; MAT 13:54; MAR 6:2; LUK 2:40, 52;
  - Word of Knowledge**: JOH 4:17-19
  - Discerning of Spirits**: MAR 5:1-20
  - Prophecy**: MAT chapters 24 & 25; 26:29-34, etc.
  - Faith**: MAR 11:12-14, 20-24, etc.
  - Healings**: MAT 4:23-24; 8:8-13; 8:14-17; 9:35; 12:15; 12:22; 14:14; 15:30-31; 19:2, etc.
  - Miracles**: JOH 2:1-11; 2:23; 3:2; 6:2, 6:26; 7:31; 9:16; 11:47; 12:37; ACT 2:22, etc.
20. **GEN 11:1** Now the whole earth had one language and one speech. 6 And the Lord said, "Indeed the people are one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them. 7 "Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language, that they may not understand one another's speech." (NKJ)
21. **ZEP 3:9** "For then I will restore to the peoples a pure language, That they all may call on the name of the Lord, To serve Him with one accord." (NKJ)  
What was the probable original language in the Garden of Eden? Hebrew Has God fulfilled the prophecy in **ZEP 3:9**? **Explain**: In the natural realm, He has restored Hebrew as the national language of Israel, after the language was essentially dead for hundreds of years.  
**Fulfillment of prophecy** typically occurs **BOTH** spiritually and in the natural realm. Could the gift of tongues have anything to do with **spiritual fulfillment** of this prophecy? God has also given a spiritual language, i.e. 'tongues', to His people. In the future, God will likely restore a single language, possibly Hebrew, to all His people.
22. Write out **ACT 10:38**: "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.  
Write out **ROM 11:29**: For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.
23. **1CO 14:13** Therefore let him who speaks in a tongue pray that he may interpret. 14 For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful. (NKJ)
24. **1CO 14:26** How is it then, brethren? Whenever you come together, each of you has a psalm, has a teaching, has a tongue, has a revelation, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification. 27 If anyone speaks in a tongue, let there be two or at the most three, each in turn, and let one interpret. 28 But if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God. 29 Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others judge. 30 But if anything is revealed to another who sits by, let the first keep silent. 31 For you can all prophecy one by one, that all may learn and all may be encouraged. (NKJ)
