- MAT 4:23** And Jesus went about all Galilee, **TEACHING** (*didasko*) in their synagogues, **PREACHING** (*kerusso*) the gospel (*euaggelion*) of the kingdom (*basileia*), and **HEALING** (*therapeuo*) all kinds of sickness (*nosos*) and all kinds of disease (*malakia*) among the people. 24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and **they brought to Him all sick** (*kakos*) **people who were afflicted with various diseases** (*nosos*) **and torments** (*basanos*), **and those who were demon-possessed** (*diamonizomai*), **epileptics** (*seleniazomai*), **and paralytics** (*paralutikos*); **and He healed** (*therapeuo*) **them**.
- MAT 5:1** And seeing the multitudes, He went up on a mountain, and when He was seated His disciples came to Him. 2 Then **He opened His mouth and TAUGHT** (*didasko*) **them**, saying: 3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- MAT 5:19** "Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments, and **TEACHES** (*didasko*) **men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven;** but **whoever does and TEACHES** (*didasko*) **them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.**
- MAT 7:28** And so it was, when Jesus had ended these sayings, that **the people were astonished at His TEACHING** (*didache*), 29 **for He taught** (*didasko*) **them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.**
- MAT 9:11** And **when the Pharisees saw it, they said to His disciples, "Why does your TEACHER** (*didaskalos*) **eat with tax collectors and sinners?"**
- MAT 9:35** Then **Jesus went about all the cities and villages, TEACHING** (*didasko*) in their synagogues, **PREACHING** the gospel of the kingdom, and **HEALING** every sickness and every disease among the people. 36 But **when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them**, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. 37 **Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few.** 38 **"Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."**
- MAT 10:24** "A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his **MASTER** (*didaskalos*). 25 **"It is enough for a disciple that he be like his TEACHER** (*didaskalos*), **and a servant like his master.** If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more will they call those of his household!
- MAT 11:1** Now it came to pass, **when Jesus finished commanding His twelve disciples, that He departed from there to TEACH** (*didasko*) **and to PREACH** in their cities.

9. **MAT 13:51** Jesus said to them, “Have you understood all these things?” They said to Him, “Yes, Lord.” 52 Then **He said to them, “Therefore every scribe INSTRUCTED (*matheteuo*) concerning the kingdom of heaven is like a householder who brings out of his treasure things new and old.”**
  10. **MAT 13:54** And **when He had come to His own country, He TAUGHT (*didasko*) them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished and said, “Where did this Man get this wisdom and these mighty WORKS?”**
  11. **MAT 15:8** ‘These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me. 9 And **in vain they worship Me, TEACHING (*didasko*) as doctrines the commandments of men.**’
  12. **MAT 17:24** When they had come to Capernaum, those who received the temple tax came to Peter and said, **“Does your TEACHER (*didaskalos*) not pay the temple tax?”**
  13. **MAT 19:16** Now behold, one came and said to Him, **“Good TEACHER (*didaskalos*), what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?”**
  14. **MAT 21:23** Now when He came into the temple, **the chief priests and the elders of the people confronted Him as He was TEACHING (*didasko*), and said, “By what authority are You doing these things? And who gave You this authority?”**
  15. **MAT 22:16** And they sent to Him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, **“TEACHER (*didaskalos*), we know that You are true, and TEACH (*didasko*) the way of God in truth; nor do You care about anyone, for You do not regard the person of men.**
  16. **MAT 26:18** And He said, “Go into the city to a certain man, and say to him, **‘The TEACHER (*didaskalos*) says, “My time is at hand; I will keep the Passover at your house with My disciples.”’**”
  17. **MAT 26:55** In that hour Jesus said to the multitudes, “Have you come out, as against a robber, with swords and clubs to take Me? **I sat daily with you, TEACHING (*didasko*) in the temple,** and you did not seize Me.
  18. **MAT 27:57** Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named **Joseph, who himself had also become a DISCIPLE (*matheteuo*) of Jesus.** 58 This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be given to him.
19. **MAT 28:18** And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 **“Go therefore and MAKE DISCIPLES (*matheteuo*) of all the nations,** baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 **“TEACHING (*didasko*) them to observe all things that I have commanded you;** and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.
20. **MAR 1:21** Then they went into Capernaum, and **immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and TAUGHT (*didasko*).** 22 And **they were astonished at His TEACHING (*didache*), for He TAUGHT (*didasko*) them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.**
  21. **MAR 2:13** Then He went out again by the sea; and **all the multitude came to Him, and He TAUGHT (*didasko*) them.**
  22. **MAR 4:1** And again **He began to TEACH (*didasko*) by the sea.** And a great multitude was gathered to Him, so that He got into a boat and sat in it on the sea; and the whole multitude was on the land facing the sea. 2 Then **He TAUGHT (*didasko*) them many things by parables, and said to them in His TEACHING (*didache*):** 3 “Listen! Behold, a sower went out to sow.
  23. **MAR 4:38** But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow. And **they awoke Him and said to Him, “TEACHER (*didaskalos*), do You not care that we are perishing?”**
  24. **MAR 5:35** While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue’s house who said, “Your daughter is dead. **Why trouble the TEACHER (*didaskalos*) any further?”**
  25. **MAR 6:1** Then He went out from there and came to His own country, and His **disciples** followed Him. 2 And **when the Sabbath had come, He began to TEACH (*didasko*) in the synagogue.** And many hearing Him were astonished, saying, “Where did this Man get these things? And what wisdom is this which is given to Him, that such mighty works are performed by His hands! 3 “Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us?” And they were offended at Him. 4 But **Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house.”** 5 **Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.** 6 And **He marveled because of their unbelief. Then He went about the villages in a circuit, TEACHING (*didasko*).**
  26. **MAR 6:30** Then **the apostles gathered to Jesus and told Him all things, both what they had done and what they had TAUGHT (*didasko*).**
  27. **MAR 6:34** And **Jesus, when He came out, saw a great multitude and was moved with compassion for them, because they were like sheep not having a shepherd. So He began to TEACH (*didasko*) them many things.**
  28. **MAR 7:7** And **in vain they worship Me, TEACHING (*didasko*) as doctrines (*didaskalia*) the commandments (*entalma*) of men.**’
  29. **MAR 8:31** And **He began to TEACH (*didasko*) them that the Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.**

30. **MAR 9:31** For **He TAUGHT (*didasko*) His disciples and said to them, “The Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of men, and they will kill Him. And after He is killed, He will rise the third day.”** 32 But they did not understand this saying, and were afraid to ask Him.
31. **MAR 9:38** Now John answered Him, saying, **“TEACHER (*didaskalos*), we saw someone who does not follow us casting out demons in Your name, and we forbade him because he does not follow us.”**
32. **MAR 10:1** Then **He arose from there and came to the region of Judea by the other side of the Jordan. And multitudes gathered to Him again, and as He was accustomed, He TAUGHT (*didasko*) them again.**
33. **MAR 10:17** Now as He was going out on the road, one came running, knelt before Him, and asked Him, **“Good TEACHER (*didaskalos*), what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?”**
34. **MAR 11:17** Then **He TAUGHT (*didasko*), saying to them, “Is it not written, ‘My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations’? But you have made it a ‘den of thieves.’ ”**
35. **MAR 12:14** **When they had come, they said to Him, “TEACHER (*didaskalos*), we know that You are true, and care about no one; for You do not regard the person of men, but TEACH (*didasko*) the way of God in truth.** Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?
36. **MAR 12:35** Then **Jesus answered and said, while He TAUGHT (*didasko*) in the temple, “How is it that the scribes say that the Christ is the Son of David?**
37. **MAR 13:1** Then as He went out of the temple, one of His disciples said to Him, **“TEACHER (*didaskalos*), see what manner of stones and what buildings are here!”**
38. **MAR 14:49** **“I was daily with you in the temple TEACHING (*didasko*), and you did not seize Me. But the Scriptures must be fulfilled.”**
39. **LUK 4:14** Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region. 15 And **He TAUGHT (*didasko*) in their synagogues, being glorified by all.**
40. **LUK 4:31** Then He went down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and was teaching them on the Sabbaths. 32 And **they were astonished at His TEACHING (*didasko*), for His word was with authority.**
41. **LUK 2:46** Now so it was that **after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the TEACHERS (*didaskalos*), both listening to them and asking them questions.** 47 And **all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.**
42. **LUK 5:3** Then **He got into one of the boats, which was Simon’s, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and TAUGHT (*didasko*) the multitudes from the boat.**
43. **LUK 5:17** Now it happened on a certain day, as **He was TEACHING (*didasko*),** that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. **And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.**
44. **LUK 6:6** Now **it happened on another Sabbath, also, that He entered the synagogue and TAUGHT (*didasko*).** And a man was there whose right hand was withered.
45. **LUK 6:40** **“A DISCIPLE (*mathetes*) is not above his TEACHER (*didaskalos*), but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his TEACHER (*didaskalos*).**
46. **LUK 7:40** And **Jesus answered and said to him, “Simon, I have something to say to you.” So he said, “TEACHER (*didaskalos*), say it.”**
47. **LUK 9:38** Suddenly a man from the multitude cried out, saying, **“TEACHER (*didaskalos*), I implore You, look on my son, for he is my only child.**
48. **LUK 10:25** And behold, a certain lawyer stood up and tested Him, saying, **“TEACHER (*didaskalos*), what shall I do to inherit eternal life?”**
49. **LUK 19:39** And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, **“TEACHER (*didaskalos*), rebuke Your disciples.”** 40 But He answered and said to them, “I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out.”
50. **LUK 11:1** Now **it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, “Lord, TEACH (*didasko*) us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.”**
51. **LUK 13:10** Now **He was TEACHING (*didasko*) in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.** 11 And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up.
52. **LUK 13:22** And **He went through the cities and villages, TEACHING (*didasko*), and journeying toward Jerusalem.**
53. **LUK 19:47** And **He was TEACHING (*didasko*) daily in the temple.** But the chief priests, the scribes, and the leaders of the people sought to destroy Him,
54. **LUK 20:1** Now it happened on one of those days, as **He TAUGHT (*didasko*) the people in the temple and preached the gospel,** that the chief priests and the scribes, together with the elders, confronted Him 2 and spoke to Him, saying, “Tell us, by what authority are You doing these things? Or who is he who gave You this authority?”
55. **LUKE 21:37** And **in the daytime He was TEACHING (*didasko*) in the temple, but at night He went out and stayed on the mountain called Olivet.**

56. **JOH 1:37** The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus. 38 Then Jesus turned, and seeing them following, said to them, “What do you seek?” **They said to Him, “Rabbi” (which is to say, when translated, TEACHER (didaskalos), “where are You staying?”**
57. **JOH 3:1** There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. 2 This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, “**Rabbi, we know that You are a TEACHER (didaskalos) come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him.**”
58. **JOH 3:9** Nicodemus answered and said to Him, “How can these things be?” 10 Jesus answered and said to him, “**Are you the TEACHER (didaskalos) of Israel, and do not know these things?**”
59. **JOH 6:58** “**This is the bread which came down from heaven—not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever.**” 59 **These things He said in the synagogue as He TEACH (didasko) in Capernaum.**
60. **JOH 7:14** Now **about the middle of the feast Jesus went up into the temple and TAUGHT (didasko).**
61. **JOH 7:28** Then **Jesus cried out, as He TEACH (didasko) in the temple, saying, “You both know Me, and you know where I am from; and I have not come of Myself,** but He who sent Me is true, whom you do not know.
62. **JOH 8:1** But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. 2 Now **early in the morning He came again into the temple, and all the people came to Him; and He sat down and TAUGHT (didasko) them.**
63. **JOH 8:20** **These words Jesus spoke in the treasury, as He TAUGHT (didasko) in the temple;** and no one laid hands on Him, for His hour had not yet come.
64. **JOHN 8:28** Then Jesus said to them, “When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that **I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father TAUGHT (didasko) Me, I speak these things.**”
65. **JOH 13:13** “**You call me TEACHER (didaskalos) and Lord, and you say well, for so I am.** 14 “**If I then, your Lord and TEACHER (didaskalos), have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another’s feet.** 15 “**For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.** 16 “Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. 17 “**If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.**”
66. **JOH 20:16** Jesus said to her, “Mary!” **She turned and said to Him, “Rabboni!” (which is to say, TEACHER (didaskalos).**
67. **JOH 14:25** “These things I have spoken to you while being present with you. 26 “**But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will TEACH (didasko) you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.**”
68. **JOH 18:19** The high priest then asked Jesus about His disciples and His doctrine. 20 **Jesus answered him, “I spoke openly to the world. I always TAUGHT (didasko) in synagogues and in the temple, where the Jews always meet, and in secret I have said nothing.**”
69. **ACT 1:1** The former account I made, O Theophilus, **of all that Jesus began both to do and TEACH (didasko),** 2 until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen,
70. **ACT 4:1** Now as they spoke to the people, the priests, the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees came upon them, 2 being greatly disturbed that **they TAUGHT (didasko) the people and preached in Jesus the resurrection from the dead.**
71. **ACT 5:19** But at night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors and brought them out, and said, 20 “**Go, stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this life.**” 21 And **when they heard that, they entered the temple early in the morning and TAUGHT (didasko).** But the high priest and those with him came and called the council together, with all the elders of the children of Israel, and sent to the prison to have them brought.
72. **ACT 5:25** So one came and told them, saying, “**Look, the men whom you put in prison are standing in the temple and TEACHING (didasko) the people!**” 27 And when they had brought them, they set them before the council. And the high priest asked them, 28 saying, “**Did we not strictly command you not to TEACH (didasko) in this name?**” And look, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this Man’s blood on us!”
73. **ACT 5:42** And **daily in the temple, and in every house, they did not cease TEACHING (didasko) and preaching Jesus as the Christ.**
74. **ACT 11:26** And when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. **So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and TAUGHT (didasko) a great many people.** And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.
75. **ACT 13:1** **Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and TEACHER (didaskalos):** Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul.

76. **ACT 14:20** However, when the DISCIPLES (*mathetes*) gathered around him (Paul), he rose up and went into the city. And the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe. 21 And when they had preached the gospel to that city and made many DISCIPLES (*mathetes*), they returned to Lystra, Iconium, and Antioch, 22 strengthening the souls of the DISCIPLES (*mathetes*), exhorting them to continue in the faith, and saying, “We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God.”
77. **ACT 15:35** Paul and Barnabas also remained in Antioch, TEACHING (*didasko*) and preaching the word of the Lord, with many others also.
78. **ACT 18:11** And he continued there a year and six months, TEACHING (*didasko*) the word of God among them.
79. **ACT 18:24** Now a certain Jew named Apollos, born at Alexandria, an eloquent man and mighty in the Scriptures, came to Ephesus. 25 This man had been instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in spirit, he spoke and TAUGHT (*didasko*) accurately the things of the Lord, though he knew only the baptism of John. 26 So he began to speak boldly in the synagogue. When Aquila and Priscilla heard him, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately.
80. **ACT 20:17** From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called for the elders of the church. 18 And when they had come to him, he said to them: “You know, from the first day that I came to Asia, in what manner I always lived among you, 19 “serving the Lord with all humility, with many tears and trials which happened to me by the plotting of the Jews; 20 “how I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and TAUGHT (*didasko*) you publicly and from house to house, 21 “testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.
81. **ACT 28:30** Then Paul dwelt two whole years in his own rented house, and received all who came to him, 31 preaching the kingdom of God and TEACHING (*didasko*) the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ with all confidence, no one forbidding him.
82. **ROM 2:21** You, therefore, who teach another, do you not teach yourself? You who preach that a man should not steal, do you steal?
83. **ROM 12:6** Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; 7 or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching;
84. **ICO 4:17** For this reason I have sent Timothy to you, who is my beloved and faithful son in the Lord, who will remind you of my ways in Christ, as I teach everywhere in every church.
85. **ICO 12:27** Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. 28 And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third TEACHER (*didaskalos*), after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues. 29 Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all TEACHER (*didaskalos*)? Are all workers of miracles?
86. **EPH 4:11** And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and TEACHERS, 12 for the equipping of the saints FOR THE WORK OF MINISTRY, for the edifying of the body of Christ, 13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;
87. **COL 1:28** Him (Christ) we preach, warning every man and TEACHING (*didasko*) every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus.
88. **COL 3:16** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, TEACHING (*didasko*) and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. 17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.
89. **2TH 2:15** Therefore, brethren, stand fast and hold the traditions which you were TAUGHT (*didasko*), whether by word or our epistle.
90. **1TI 2:5** For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time, 7 for which I was appointed a preacher and an apostle—I am speaking the truth in Christ and not lying—a TEACHER (*didaskalos*) of the Gentiles in faith and truth.
91. **1TI 4:12** Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 13 Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. 14 Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership. 15 Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all. 16 Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.
92. **2TI 1:8** Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God, 9 who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began, 10 but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel, 11 to which I was appointed a preacher, an apostle, and a TEACHER (*didaskalos*) of the Gentiles.

93. **2TI 2:1** You therefore, **my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.** 2 And **the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to TEACH (*didasko*) others also.**
94. **2TI 4:3** For **the time will come when they will not endure sound DOCTRINE (*didaskalia*), but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves TEACHER (*didaskalos*);** 4 and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables.
95. **HEB 5:12** For **though by this time you ought to be TEACHERS (*didaskalos*), you need someone to TEACH (*didasko*) you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food.** 13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. 14 But **solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.**
96. **HEB 8:10** “For **this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.** 11 “None of them shall teach his neighbor, and none his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’ for all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them.
97. **JAM 3:1** My brethren, **let not many of you become TEACHER (*didaskalos*), knowing that we shall receive a stricter judgment.**
98. **IJO 2:27** But **the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone TEACH (*didasko*) you; but as the same anointing TEACHES (*didasko*) you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has TAUGHT (*didasko*) you, you will abide in Him.**
99. **IJO 3:8** He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. **For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.**

### Teaching in the Old Testament

100. **EXO 4:11** So the Lord said to him, “Who has made man’s mouth? Or who makes the mute, the deaf, the seeing, or the blind? Have not I, the Lord? 15 **“Now you shall speak to him and put the words in his mouth. And I will be with your mouth and with his mouth, and I will TEACH (*varah*) you what you shall do.**
101. **EXO 18:20** “And **you shall TEACH (*zahar*) them the statutes and the laws, and show them the way in which they must walk and the WORK they must do.**
102. **EXO 24:12** Then **the Lord said to Moses, “Come up to Me on the mountain and be there; and I will give you tablets of stone, and the law and commandments which I have written, that you may TEACH (*varah*) them.”**
103. **LEV 10:11** “and **that you may TEACH (*varah*) the children of Israel all the statutes which the Lord has spoken to them by the hand of Moses.”**
104. **DEU 4:1** “Now, **O Israel, listen to the statutes and the judgments which I TEACH (*lamad*) you to observe, that you may live, and go in and possess the land which the Lord God of your fathers is giving you.** 2 “You shall not add to the word which I command you, nor take from it, **that you may keep the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you.**
105. **DEU 4:8** “And what great nation is there that has such statutes and righteous judgments as are in all this law which I set before you this day? 9 “Only **take heed to yourself, and diligently keep yourself, lest you forget the things your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. And TEACH (*yada*) them to your children and your grandchildren,** 10 “especially concerning the day you stood before the Lord your God in Horeb, when the Lord said to me, ‘**Gather the people to Me, and I will let them hear My words, that they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and that they may TEACH their children.**’
106. **DEU 4:13** “So He declared to you His covenant which He commanded you to perform, the Ten Commandments; and He wrote them on two tablets of stone. 14 “And **the Lord commanded me at that time to TEACH (*lamad*) you statutes and judgments, that you might observe them in the land which you cross over to possess.**
107. **DEU 4:36** “**Out of heaven He let you hear His voice, that He might INSTRUCT you;** on earth He showed you His great fire, and you heard His words out of the midst of the fire.
108. **DEU 5:31** ‘But **as for you, stand here by Me, and I will speak to you all the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments which you shall TEACH (*lamad*) them, that they may observe them in the land which I am giving them to possess.**’ 32 “Therefore you shall be careful to do as the Lord your God has commanded you; you shall not turn aside to the right hand or to the left. 33 “**You shall walk in all the ways which the Lord your God has commanded you, that you may live and that it may be well with you, and that you may prolong your days in the land which you shall possess.**
109. **DEU 6:1** “Now **this is the commandment, and these are the statutes and judgments which the Lord your God has commanded to TEACH (*lamad*) you, that you may observe them in the land which you are crossing over to possess,** 2 “**that you may fear the Lord your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments** which I command you, you and your son and your grandson, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged. 7 “**You shall TEACH (*shanan*) them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.** 8 “You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 “You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

110. **DEU 11:18** “Therefore you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 19 “You shall TEACH (lamad) them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. 20 “And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. 21 “that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the heavens above the earth. 22 “For if you carefully keep all these commandments which I command you to do—to love the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways, and to hold fast to Him— 23 “then the Lord will drive out all these nations from before you, and you will dispossess greater and mightier nations than yourselves. 24 “Every place on which the sole of your foot treads shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the River Euphrates, even to the Western Sea, shall be your territory. 25 “No man shall be able to stand against you; the Lord your God will put the dread of you and the fear of you upon all the land where you tread, just as He has said to you. 26 “Behold, I set before you today a blessing and a curse: 27 “the blessing, if you obey the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you today; 28 “and the curse, if you do not obey the commandments of the Lord your God, but turn aside from the way which I command you today, to go after other gods which you have not known. 29 “Now it shall be, when the Lord your God has brought you into the land which you go to possess, that you shall put the blessing on Mount Gerizim and the curse on Mount Ebal.
111. **DEU 31:19** “Now therefore, write down this song for yourselves, and TEACH (lamad) it to the children of Israel; put it in their mouths, that this song may be a witness for Me against the children of Israel.
112. **ISA 12:23** “Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the Lord in ceasing to pray for you; but I will TEACH (yarah) you the good and the right way. 24 “Only fear the Lord, and serve Him in truth with all your heart; for consider what great things He has done for you.
113. **IKI 8:36** “then hear in heaven, and forgive the sin of Your servants, Your people Israel, that You may TEACH (yarah) them the good way in which they should walk; and send rain on Your land which You have given to Your people as an inheritance.
114. **2KI 17:28** Then one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Bethel, and TAUGHT them how they should fear the Lord.
115. **2CH 6:26** “When the heavens are shut up and there is no rain because they have sinned against You, when they pray toward this place and confess Your name, and turn from their sin because You afflict them, 27 “then hear in heaven, and forgive the sin of Your servants, Your people Israel, that You may TEACH them the good way in which they should walk; and send rain on Your land which You have given to Your people as an inheritance.
116. **2CH 15:3** “For a long time Israel has been without the true God, without a TEACHING priest, and without law; 4 “but when in their trouble they turned to the Lord God of Israel, and sought Him, He was found by them.
117. **2CH 17:7** Also in the third year of his reign he sent his leaders, Ben-Hail, Obadiah, Zechariah, Nethanel, and Michaiah, to TEACH (lamad) in the cities of Judah. 9 So they TAUGHT in Judah, and had the Book of the Law of the Lord with them; they went throughout all the cities of Judah and TAUGHT the people.
118. **2CH 30:22** And Hezekiah gave encouragement to all the Levites who TAUGHT the good knowledge of the Lord; and they ate throughout the feast seven days, offering peace offerings and making confession to the Lord God of their fathers.
119. **EZR 7:9** On the first day of the first month he began his journey from Babylon, and on the first day of the fifth month he came to Jerusalem, according to the good hand of his God upon him. 25 And you, Ezra, according to your God-given wisdom, set magistrates and judges who may judge all the people who are in the region beyond the River, all such as know the laws of your God; and TEACH (lamad) those who do not know them. 26 Whoever will not observe the law of your God and the law of the king, let judgment be executed speedily on him, whether it be death, or banishment, or confiscation of goods, or imprisonment.
120. **NEH 9:20** You also gave Your good Spirit to INSTRUCT them, And did not withhold Your manna from their mouth, And gave them water for their thirst.
121. **JOB 6:24** “TEACH (yarah) me, and I will hold my tongue; Cause me to understand wherein I have erred.
122. **JOB 32:7** I said, ‘Age should speak, And multitude of years should TEACH (yadah) wisdom.’ 8 But there is a spirit in man, And the breath of the Almighty gives him understanding.
123. **JOB 34:31** “For has anyone said to God, ‘I have borne chastening; I will offend no more; 32 TEACH me what I do not see; If I have done iniquity, I will do no more?’
124. **PSA 16:7** I will bless the Lord who has given me counsel; My heart also INSTRUCTS me in the night seasons.
125. **PSA 25:4** Show me Your ways, O Lord; TEACH me Your paths. 5 Lead me in Your truth and TEACH me, For You are the God of my salvation; On You I wait all the day. 8 Good and upright is the Lord; Therefore He TEACHES sinners in the way. 9 The humble He guides in justice, And the humble He TEACHES His way. 12 Who is the man that fears the Lord? Him shall He TEACH in the way He

- chooses.** 13 He himself shall dwell in prosperity, And his descendants shall inherit the earth. 14 The secret of the Lord is with those who fear Him, And He will show them His covenant.
126. **PSA 27:11** **TEACH me Your way, O Lord, And lead me in a smooth path, because of my enemies.**
127. **PSA 32:8** **I will INSTRUCT you and TEACH you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye.**
128. **PSA 34:11** **Come, you children, listen to me; I will TEACH you the fear of the Lord.**
129. **PSA 51:12** Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, And uphold me by Your generous Spirit. 13 Then **I will TEACH transgressors Your ways, And sinners shall be converted to You.**
130. **PSA 86:11** **TEACH me Your way, O Lord; I will walk in Your truth;** Unite my heart to fear Your name.
131. **PSA 90:12** So **TEACH us to number our days, That we may gain a heart of wisdom.**
132. **PSA 119:12** Blessed are You, O Lord! **TEACH me Your statutes!** 26 **I have declared my ways, and You answered me; TEACH me Your statutes.** 33 **TEACH me, O Lord, the way of Your statutes,** And I shall keep it to the end. 34 Give me understanding, and I shall keep Your law; Indeed, I shall observe it with my whole heart. 64 The earth, O Lord, is full of Your mercy; **TEACH me Your statutes.** 108 Accept, I pray, the freewill offerings of my mouth, O Lord, And **TEACH me Your judgments.** 124 Deal with Your servant according to Your mercy, And **TEACH me Your statutes.** 135 **Make Your face shine upon Your servant, And TEACH me Your statutes.**
133. **PSA 132:12** **If your sons will keep My covenant And My testimony which I shall TEACH them, Their sons also shall sit upon your throne forevermore.**
134. **PSA 143:10** **TEACH me to do Your will, For You are my God; Your Spirit is good. Lead me in the land of uprightness.**
135. **PRO 9:9** **Give INSTRUCTION to a wise man, and he will be still wiser; TEACH a just man, and he will increase in learning.** 10 “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.
136. **ECC 12:9** And moreover, **because the Preacher was wise, he still taught the people knowledge; yes, he pondered and sought out and set in order many proverbs.**
137. **ISA 2:3** Many people shall come and say, **“Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, To the house of the God of Jacob; He will TEACH us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths.”** For out of Zion shall go forth the law, And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.
138. **ISA 28:9** **“Whom will he TEACH knowledge? And whom will he make to understand the message? Those just weaned from milk?”** Those just drawn from the breasts? 10 For **precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, Here a little, there a little.**” 11 For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people, 12 To whom He said, “This is the rest with which You may cause the weary to rest,” And, “This is the refreshing”; Yet they would not hear. 13 But the word of the Lord was to them, **“Precept upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, Here a little, there a little.”** That they might go and fall backward, and be broken And snared and caught. 26 For **He INSTRUCTS him in right judgment, His God TEACHES him.**
139. **ISA 28:26** For **He INSTRUCTS him in right judgment, His God teaches him.**
140. **ISA 50:4** **“The Lord God has given Me The tongue of the LEARNED, That I should know how to speak A word in season to him who is weary. He awakens Me morning by morning, He awakens My ear To hear as the learned.** 5 The Lord God has opened My ear; And I was not rebellious, Nor did I turn away.
141. **ISA 54:13** **All your children shall be TAUGHT by the Lord, And great shall be the peace of your children.**
142. **JER 31:34** **“No more shall every man TEACH his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’ for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.”**
143. **JER 32:33** **“And they have turned to Me the back, and not the face; though I TAUGHT them, rising up early and teaching them, yet they have not listened to receive INSTRUCTION.** 34 “But they set their abominations in the house which is called by My name, to defile it.
144. **EZE 44:23** **“And they shall TEACH My people the difference between the holy and the unholy, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.**
145. **DAN 11:32** **“Those who do wickedly against the covenant he shall corrupt with flattery; but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits. 33 “And those of the people who understand shall INSTRUCT many; yet for many days they shall fall by sword and flame, by captivity and plundering.**
146. **HOS 11:3** **“I TAUGHT Ephraim to walk, Taking them by their arms;** But they did not know that I healed them. 4 I drew them with gentle cords, With bands of love, And I was to them as those who take the yoke from their neck. I stooped and fed them.
147. **MIC 4:2** **Many nations shall come and say, “Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, To the house of the God of Jacob; He will TEACH (yarah) us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths.”** For out of Zion the law shall go forth, And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.
