

16-A The Works of Jesus

Each time you open your Bible & study the Word of God, **STOP** first for a moment of prayer. Ask the Father, in the name of Jesus, to reveal to you by His Spirit within you what He wants to say to you from His Word. Thank God for answering your prayer, then read & study with the expectation that He **HAS** answered. The topic this week is appropriately introduced with this statement by Jesus in the book of John:

1. **JOH 14:8** Philip said to Him, "**Lord, show us the Father (*pater*), and it is sufficient for us.**" 9 **Jesus said** to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? **He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?**" 10 "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? **The words (*rhema*) that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but THE FATHER WHO DWELLS IN ME DOES THE WORKS (*ergon*).** 11 "Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else **believe Me for the sake of THE WORKS (*ergon*) themselves.** 12 "**Most assuredly, I say to you, HE WHO BELIEVES IN ME, THE WORKS (*ergon*) THAT I DO HE WILL DO ALSO; AND GREATER WORKS (*ergon*) THAN THESE HE WILL DO, BECAUSE I GO TO MY FATHER.** 13 "**And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified (*doxazo*) in the Son.** 14 "**If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.** (compare this with **JOH 16:23-24**)

How did Jesus demonstrate the presence of the Father **IN** Him? Through the miracles and acts of kindness & compassion that He performed. Jesus lived a **GODLY** life before all. Jesus stated that the very words He spoke and the works He did were actually those of the Father working **IN** Him. They were PROOF of the Father within. Jesus then goes on to say that the SAME can be true of each of us. In fact, He clearly said that those who believed in Jesus would ALSO do the works of Jesus, and even greater works than these, since was to go the Father. What does all this mean? The SAME will be true of us individually. The PROOF of the Father within is the WORKS that we do. No works -- no Father within. No Father within -- no works. It's that simple.

2. **MAT 5:14** "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 "Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 "**Let your light (*phos*) so shine (*lampo*) before men, that they may see your GOOD (*kalos*) WORKS (*ergon*) and glorify (*doxazo*) your Father in heaven.**
3. **MAT 9:35** Then **Jesus went about all the cities and villages, TEACHING (*didasko*) in their synagogues, PREACHING (*kerusso*) the gospel of the kingdom, and HEALING (*therapeuo*) every sickness and every disease among the people.** 36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.
4. **MAT 21:28** "But what do you think? A man had two sons, and he came to the first and said, '**Son, go, WORK (*ergazomai*) today in my vineyard.**' 29 "He answered and said, 'I will not,' but afterward he regretted it and went. 30 "Then he came to the second and said likewise. And he answered and said, 'I go, sir,' but he did not go. 31 "Which of the two did the will of his father?" They said to Him, "The first." Jesus said to them, "**Assuredly, I say to you that tax collectors and harlots enter the kingdom of God before you.**
5. **MAT 28:18** And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 "**Go therefore and MAKE DISCIPLES of all the nations,** baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 "**TEACHING them to observe all things that I have commanded you;** and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.
6. **MAR 13:34** "It (*the Kingdom of Heaven*) is like a man going to a far country, who left his house and gave authority to his servants, and to each his WORK (*ergon*), and commanded the doorkeeper to watch. 35 "Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming—in the evening, at midnight, at the crowing of the rooster, or in the morning— 36 "lest, coming suddenly, he find you sleeping.
7. **LUK 2:49** And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? **Did you not know THAT I MUST BE ABOUT MY FATHER'S BUSINESS?"**
8. **LUK 24:19** And He said to them, "What things?" So they said to Him, "The things concerning **Jesus of Nazareth, who was a Prophet mighty in DEED (*ergon*) and word (*logos*)** before God and all the people,
9. **JOH 3:21** "But **he who does the truth comes to the light, that his DEEDS (*ergon*) may be clearly seen, that they have been DONE (*ergazomai*) in God.**"
10. **JOH 4:33** Therefore the disciples said to one another, "Has anyone brought Him anything to eat?" 34 Jesus said to them, "**My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His WORK (*ergon*).** 35 "Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? **Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest!** 36 "**And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together.** 37 "For in this the saying is true: '**One sows and another reaps.**' 38 "I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors."
11. **JOH 5:16** For this reason the Jews persecuted Jesus, and sought to kill Him, because He had done these things on the Sabbath. 17 But Jesus answered them, "**My Father has been WORKING (*ergazomai*) until now, and I have been working (*ergazomai*).**" 18 Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God. 19 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "**Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.** 20 "For **the Father loves the Son, and shows**

Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater WORKS (*ergon*) than these, that you may marvel.

12. JOH 5:36 “But I have a greater witness than John’s; for the WORKS (*ergon*) which the Father has given Me to finish—the very WORKS (*ergon*) that I do—bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent Me.
13. JOH 6:27 “Do not LABOR (*ergazomai*) for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him.” 28 Then they said to Him, “What shall we do, that we may work THE WORKS (*ergazomai*) OF GOD (*theos*)?” 29 Jesus answered and said to them, “This is the WORK (*ergon*) OF GOD, that you believe (*pisteuo*) in Him whom He sent.”
14. JOH 7:7 “The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it that its WORKS (*ergon*) are evil.
15. JOH 8:39 They answered and said to Him, “Abraham is our father.” Jesus said to them, “If you were Abraham’s children, you would do the WORKS (*ergon*) of Abraham. 41 “You do the DEEDS (*ergon*) of your father.” Then they said to Him, “We were not born of fornication; we have one Father—God.” 44 “You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him.” When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.
16. JOH 9:2 And His disciples asked Him, saying, “Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?” 3 Jesus answered, “Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the WORKS (*ergon*) of God should be revealed in him. 4 “I must WORK (*ergazomai*) the WORKS (*ergon*) of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can WORK (*ergazomai*). 5 “As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.”
17. JOH 10:31 Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. 32 Jesus answered them, “Many good WORKS (*ergon*) I have shown you from My Father. For which of those WORKS (*ergon*) do you stone Me?” 37 “If I do not do the WORKS (*ergon*) of My Father, do not believe Me;
18. JOH 14:6 Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
19. JOH 17:4 “I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the WORK (*ergon*) which You have given Me to do.
20. ACT 5:38 “And now I say to you, keep away from these men and let them alone; for if this plan or this WORK (*ergon*) is of men, it will come to nothing; 39 “but if it is of God, you cannot overthrow it—lest you even be found to fight against God.”
21. ACT 7:41 “And they made a calf in those days, offered sacrifices to the idol, and rejoiced in the WORKS (*ergon*) of their own hands.
22. ACT 9:36 At Joppa there was a certain disciple named Tabitha, which is translated Dorcas. This woman was full of good WORKS (*ergon*) and charitable deeds (*eleemosune*) which she did.
23. ACT 10:34 Then Peter opened his mouth and said: “In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. 35 “But in every nation whoever fears Him and WORKS (*ergazomai*) righteousness is accepted by Him.
24. ACT 10:38 “how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about DOING GOOD and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.
25. ACT 13:2 As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, “Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the WORK (*ergon*) to which I have called them.” 3 Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away.
26. ACT 14:25 Now when they had preached the word in Perga, they went down to Attalia. 26 From there they sailed to Antioch, where they had been commended to the grace of God for the WORK (*ergon*) which they had completed.
27. ACT 15:18 “Known to God from eternity are all His WORKS (*ergon*).
28. ACT 26:19 “Therefore, King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision, 20 “but declared first to those in Damascus and in Jerusalem, and throughout all the region of Judea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent, turn to God, and do WORKS (*ergon*) befitting repentance.
29. ROM 12:19 Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, “Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,” says the Lord. 20 Therefore “If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head.” 21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
30. ROM 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the WORK (*ergon*) of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light. 13 Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. 14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.
31. ROM 14:10 But why do you judge your brother? Or why do you show contempt for your brother? For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ. 11 For it is written: “As I live, says the Lord, Every knee shall bow to Me, And every tongue shall confess to God.” 12 So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.
32. 1CO 3:6 I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. 7 So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase. 8 Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor. 9 For we are God’s fellow WORKERS; you are God’s field, you are God’s building.

33. **1CO 9:1** Am I not an apostle? Am I not free? Have I not seen Jesus Christ our Lord? **Are you not my WORK (ergon) in the Lord?** 13 **Do you not know that those who MINISTER (ergazomai) the holy things eat of the things of the temple, and those who serve at the altar partake of the offerings of the altar?**
34. **1CO 13:3** And **though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.**
35. **1CO 15:58** Therefore, **my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the WORK (ergon) of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.**
36. **1CO 16:10** Now if **Timothy** comes, see that he may be with you without fear; for he **DOES (ergazomai) the WORK (ergon) of the Lord, as I also do.**
37. **2CO 5:10** For **we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, ACCORDING TO WHAT HE HAS DONE, whether good or bad.**
38. **2CO 9:7** So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. 8 And **God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good WORK (ergon).**
39. **2CO 11:13** For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ. 14 And no wonder! For **Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.** 15 Therefore **it is no great thing if his ministers also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their WORKS (ergon).**
40. **GAL 2:20** “I have been crucified with Christ; **it is no longer I who live, but CHRIST LIVES IN ME; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God,** who loved me and gave Himself for me.
41. **GAL 5:19** Now **the WORKS (ergon) of the flesh are evident,** which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, 21 envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.
42. **GAL 6:10** Therefore, **as we have opportunity, let us DO (ergazomai) good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.**
43. **EPH 2:8** For **BY GRACE (charis) you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift (doron) of God,** 9 **NOT OF WORKS (ergon),** lest anyone should boast. 10 **For WE ARE HIS WORKMANSHIP, created in Christ Jesus for GOOD (agathos) WORKS (ergon), which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.**
44. **EPH 4:11** And **He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers,** 12 **for the equipping of the saints for the WORK (ergon) OF MINISTRY, for the edifying of the body of Christ,** 13 **till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;** 15 but, speaking the truth in love, **may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—** 16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, **according to the effective WORKING BY WHICH EVERY PART DOES ITS SHARE, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself** in love.
45. **EPH 4:28** **Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, WORKING (ergazomai) with his hands what is good,** that he may have something to give him who has need.
46. **EPH 5:11** And **have no fellowship with the unfruitful WORKS (ergon) of darkness, but rather expose them.**
47. **PHI 1:6** being confident of this very thing, that **He who has begun a good WORK (ergon) in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;**
48. **PHI 2:13** **for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.**
49. **PHI 2:25** Yet I considered it necessary to send to you **Epaphroditus,** my brother, fellow worker, and fellow soldier, but your messenger and the one who ministered to my need; 29 Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness, and **hold such men in esteem;** 30 **because for THE WORK (ergon) OF CHRIST he came close to death, not regarding his life,** to supply what was lacking in your service toward me.
50. **COL 1:9** For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10 that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, **being fruitful in every good WORK (ergon) and increasing in the knowledge of God;**
51. **COL 3:17** And **whatever you do in word or DEED (ergon), do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.** 23 And **whatever you do, DO (ergazomai) it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men,**
52. **COL 4:17** And say to Archippus, “**Take heed to THE MINISTRY WHICH YOU HAVE RECEIVED IN THE LORD, that you may fulfill it.**”
53. **1TH 1:2** We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers, 3 **remembering without ceasing your WORK (ergon) OF FAITH,** labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father,
54. **1TH 5:12** And we urge you, brethren, to recognize those who labor among you, and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, 13 and to **esteem them very highly in love for their WORK’S (ergon) sake. Be at peace among yourselves.**

55. **2TH 2:16** Now **may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father**, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, 17 **comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and WORK (ergon)**.
56. **2TH 3:10** For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: **If anyone will not WORK (ergazomai), neither shall he eat.**
57. **1TI 2:9** in like manner also, that **the women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with propriety and moderation, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly clothing,** 10 **but, which is proper for women professing godliness, with GOOD WORKS (ergon)**.
58. **1TI 3:1** This is a faithful saying: If a man desires the position of a bishop, he desires **a good WORK (ergon)**.
59. **1TI 4:12** Let no one despise your youth, **but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.** 13 Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. 14 Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership. 15 Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all. 16 **Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in DOING this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.**
60. **1TI 5:9** Do not let a widow under sixty years old be taken into the number, and not unless she has been the wife of one man, 10 **well reported for GOOD WORKS (ergon): if she has brought up children, if she has lodged strangers, if she has washed the saints' feet, if she has relieved the afflicted, if she has diligently followed every GOOD WORK (ergon)**.
61. **1TI 5:25** Likewise, **the GOOD WORKS (ergon) of some are clearly evident,** and those that are otherwise cannot be hidden.
62. **1TI 6:17** Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy. 18 **Let them do good, that they be rich in GOOD WORKS (ergon), ready to give, willing to share,** 19 **storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.**
63. **2TI 2:20** But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. 21 Therefore **if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every GOOD WORK (ergon)**.
64. **2TI 3:16** **All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,** 17 **that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every GOOD WORK (ergon)**.
65. **2TI 4:5** But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, **do the WORK (ergon) of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.**
66. **TIT 1:15** To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled. 16 **They profess to know God, but in WORKS (ergon) they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every GOOD WORK (ergon)**.
67. **TIT 2:6** Likewise exhort the young men to be sober-minded, 7 in all things showing yourself to be a pattern of **GOOD WORKS (ergon)**; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility,
68. **TIT 2:14** who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, **zealous for GOOD WORKS (ergon)**.
69. **TIT 3:1** Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every **GOOD WORK (ergon)**.
70. **TIT 3:8** This is a faithful saying, and these things I want you to affirm constantly, that **those who have believed in God should be careful to maintain GOOD WORKS (ergon)**. These things are good and profitable to men. 14 And **let our people also learn to maintain GOOD WORKS (ergon), to meet urgent needs, that they may not be unfruitful.**
71. **HEB 2:7** You have made him a little lower than the angels; **You have crowned him with glory and honor, And set him over the WORKS (ergon) of Your hands,** 8 You have put all things in subjection under his feet.” For in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing that is not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him.
72. **HEB 6:10** For **God is not unjust to forget your WORKS (ergon) and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints,** and do minister.
73. **HEB 9:14** **how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from DEAD WORKS (ergon) to serve the living God?**
74. **HEB 10:23** Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. 24 And **let us consider one another in order to stir up love and GOOD WORKS (ergon),** 25 **not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another,** and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.
75. **HEB 13:20** Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, 21 **make you complete in every GOOD WORK (ergon) to do His will, WORKING in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ,** to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

76. **HEB 11:32** And what more shall I say? For the time would fail me to tell of Gideon and Barak and Samson and Jephthah, also of David and Samuel and the prophets: 33 **who through faith subdued kingdoms, WORKED (ergazomai) righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,** 34 **quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.**
77. **IPE 2:11** Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul, 12 **having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your GOOD WORKS (ergon) which they observe, glorify God** in the day of visitation.
78. **JAM 1:27** **Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world.**
79. **JAM 3:13** **Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his WORKS (ergon) are done in the meekness of wisdom.**
80. **IPE 1:17** And if you call on **the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one's WORK (ergon),** conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear;
81. **IPE 2:11** Beloved, **I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul,** 12 **having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your GOOD WORKS (ergon) which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation.**
82. **2PE 3:10** **But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the WORKS (ergon) that are in it will be burned up.**
83. **IJO 3:8** He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. **For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy THE WORKS (ergon) OF THE DEVIL.**
84. **IJO 3:18** My little children, **let us not love in word or in tongue, but in DEED (ergon) and in truth.**
85. **2JO 8** **Look to yourselves, that we do not lose those things we WORKED (ergazomai) for, but that we may receive a full reward.**
86. **REV 2:2** **"I know your WORKS (ergon), your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil.** And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars;
87. **REV 2:5** **"Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first WORKS (ergon),** or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place—unless you repent. 6 **"But this you have, that you hate the DEEDS (ergon) of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.**
88. **REV 2:9** **"I know your WORKS (ergon), tribulation, and poverty (but you are rich);** and I know the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan.
89. **REV 2:19** **"I know your WORKS (ergon), love, service, faith, and your patience; and as for your WORKS (ergon), the last are more than the first.**
90. **REV 2:23** **"I will kill her children with death, and all the churches shall know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts. And I will give to each one of you according to your WORKS (ergon).**
91. **REV 14:13** Then **I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, "Write: 'Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.'"** **"Yes," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors, and their WORKS (ergon) follow them."**

94. **LUK 4:18** “The Spirit (*pneuma*) of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed (*chrío*) Me To preach the gospel (*euaggelizo*) to the poor; He has sent Me to heal (*iaomai*) the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; 19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.” (see **ISA 61:1-4**)

Salvation BY Works vs Salvation UNTO Works

94. **EPH 2:8** For **BY GRACE (*charis*)** you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift (*doron*) of God, 9 **NOT OF WORKS (*ergon*)**, lest anyone should boast. 10 **For WE ARE HIS WORKMANSHIP, created in Christ Jesus for GOOD (*agathos*) WORKS (*ergon*), which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.**

95. **JAM 2:14** What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have WORKS (*ergon*)? Can faith save him? 15 If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, “Depart in peace, be warmed and filled,” but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? 17 Thus also **faith by itself, if it does not have WORKS (*ergon*), is dead.** 18 But **someone will say, “You have faith, and I have WORKS (*ergon*).” Show me your faith without your WORKS (*ergon*), and I will show you my faith by my WORKS (*ergon*).** 19 **You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!** 20 But **do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without WORKS (*ergon*) is dead?** 21 **Was not Abraham our father justified by WORKS (*ergon*) when he offered Isaac his son on the altar?** 22 **Do you see that faith was working together with his WORKS (*ergon*), and by WORKS (*ergon*) faith was made perfect?** 23 And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, “Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.” And he was called the friend of God. 24 **You see then that a man is justified by WORKS (*ergon*), and not by faith only.** 26 For **as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without WORKS (*ergon*) is dead also.**

96. **MAT 7:21** “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. 22 **“Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’** 23 **“And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness (*anomia*)!’”**

97. **MAT 23:5** **“But all their WORKS (*ergon*) they do to be seen by men. They make their phylacteries broad and enlarge the borders of their garments.** 6 **“They love the best places at feasts, the best seats in the synagogues,** 7 **“greetings in the marketplaces, and to be called by men, ‘Rabbi, Rabbi.’”**

98. **MAT 25:31** “When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory. 33 “And He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left. 34 **“Then the King will say to those on His right hand, ‘Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: 35 ‘for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; 36 ‘I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.’** 37 **“Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, ‘Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? 38 ‘When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You? 39 ‘Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?’** 40 **“And the King will answer and say to them, ‘Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.’”**

99. **LUK 16:15** And He said to them, “You are those who justify yourselves before men, but God knows your hearts. For what is highly esteemed among men is an abomination in the sight of God.”
100. **JOH 6:27** “Do not LABOR (*ergazomai*) for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him.” 28 Then they said to Him, “What shall we do, that we may work THE WORKS (*ergazomai*) OF GOD (*theos*)?” 29 Jesus answered and said to them, “This is the WORK (*ergon*) OF GOD, that you believe (*pisteuo*) in Him whom He sent.”
101. **ROM 2:5** But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, 6 who “will render to each one according to his DEEDS (*ergon*)”: 7 eternal life to those who by patient continuance in DOING (*ergon*) good seek for glory, honor, and immortality; 8 but to those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness—indignation and wrath, 9 tribulation and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek; 10 but glory, honor, and peace to everyone who WORKS (*ergazomai*) what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
102. **ROM 2:11** For there is no partiality with God. 12 For as many as have sinned without law will also perish without law, and as many as have sinned in the law will be judged by the law 13 (for not the hearers of the law are just in the sight of God, but the doers of the law will be justified; 14 for when Gentiles, who do not have the law, by nature do the things in the law, these, although not having the law, are a law to themselves, 15 who show the WORK (*ergon*) of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and between themselves their thoughts accusing or else excusing them) 16 in the day when God will judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ, according to my gospel.
103. **ROM 3:20** Therefore by the DEEDS (*ergon*) of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin. 21 But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, 22 even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference;
104. **ROM 3:27** Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of WORKS (*ergon*)? No, but by the law of faith. 28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from the DEEDS (*ergon*) of the law.
105. **ROM 4:1** What then shall we say that Abraham our father has found according to the flesh? 2 For if Abraham was justified by WORKS (*ergon*), he has something to boast about, but not before God. 3 For what does the Scripture say? “Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.” 4 Now to him who WORKS (*ergazomai*), the wages are not counted as grace but as debt. 5 But to him who does not WORK (*ergazomai*) but believes on Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted for righteousness, 6 just as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from WORKS (*ergon*):
106. **ROM 9:16** So then it is not of him who wills, nor of him who runs, but of God who shows mercy.
107. **ROM 9:30** What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness of faith; 31 but Israel, pursuing the law of righteousness, has not attained to the law of righteousness. 32 Why? Because they did not seek it by faith, but as it were, by the WORKS (*ergon*) OF THE LAW. For they stumbled at that stumbling stone.
108. **ROM 11:5** Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of grace. 6 And if by grace, then it is no longer of WORKS (*ergon*); otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if it is of WORKS (*ergon*), it is no longer grace; otherwise WORK (*ergon*) is no longer WORK (*ergon*).
109. **1CO 3:11** For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, 13 each one’s WORK (*ergon*) will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one’s WORK (*ergon*), of what sort it is. 14 If anyone’s WORK (*ergon*) which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. 15 If anyone’s WORK (*ergon*) is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.
110. **GAL 2:16** “knowing that a man is not justified by the WORKS (*ergon*) of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the WORKS (*ergon*) of the law; for by the WORKS (*ergon*) of the law no flesh shall be justified.”
111. **EPH 2:10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus FOR GOOD WORKS, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
112. **GAL 3:2** This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the WORKS (*ergon*) of the law, or by the hearing of faith? 3 Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh? 5 Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works (*energeo*) miracles among you, does He do it by the WORKS (*ergon*) of the law, or by the hearing of faith?—
113. **PHI 2:12** Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, WORK OUT (*katergazomai*) YOUR OWN SALVATION with fear and trembling; 13 for it is

- God who WORKS (*energeo*) in you both TO WILL AND TO DO for His good pleasure.** 14 Do all things without complaining and disputing,
114. **1TI 4:12** Let no one despise your youth, **but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.** 13 Till I come, **give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.** 14 **Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership.** 15 Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all. 16 **Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.**
115. **2TI 1:9** **who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our WORKS (*ergon*), but according to His own purpose and grace** which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,
116. **TIT 1:15** To the pure all things are pure, but **to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled.** 16 **They profess to know God, but IN WORKS THEY DENY HIM, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.**
117. **HEB 4:3** For **we who have believed do enter that rest, as He has said: “So I swore in My wrath, ‘They shall not enter My rest.’” although the WORKS (*ergon*) were finished from the foundation of the world.** 4 For He has spoken in a certain place of the seventh day in this way: “And **God rested on the seventh day from all His WORKS (*ergon*)”;** 9 There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. 10 For **he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his WORKS (*ergon*) as God did from His.**
118. **HEB 6:1** Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of **repentance from DEAD WORKS (*ergon*) and of faith toward God,** 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

What ARE Some Ways to Do The Works Of Jesus?

Following is a list of possible ways to do the works of Jesus, which are really the works of the Father in us. Remember, however, that works conceived and done on our own, without the leading of the Holy Spirit, are **‘Dead Works’** – wood, hay and stubble – that have NO eternal value. God does not want us to do **OUR** works, but **HIS** works – gold, silver and precious stones – which will survive the test of fiery judgement, and lead to eternal reward in the Kingdom of Heaven. There is a saying – ‘It is easier to steer a moving vehicle’ – that applies here. It is probably easier for God to guide us by His Spirit if we are doing SOMETHING. We need to start somewhere. What is on your heart to DO to serve God?

1. Godliness begins at home; serve your parents, spouse and children; demonstrate the love of Christ in you.
2. When God gives us revelation from His Word, to tell it to our family or others.
3. Discuss with others how God is working in our lives; that gets them excited and want God to help them.
4. Donate money or time
5. Spend a few minutes daily in a family Bible study, giving each person an opportunity to contribute.
6. Be willing to admit our faults, and ask the forgiveness of others. CHANGE ungodly behavior.
7. Keep your word to family and others, even when not convenient or beneficial.
8. A clear boundary of right and wrong
9. A clear accountability to God and others
10. Recognize hierarchy of responsibility to God, family, church, job,
11. Write a letter
12. Always try to speak something that will build up rather than tear down someone’s self esteem. Encourage rather than criticize.
13. Send a card to someone ill or in the hospital, or in need of a ‘lift’.
14. Invite someone to church.
15. Do an unexpected kindness.
16. Visit a jail or prison. Do a Bible study and pray with the prisoners.
17. Help in a homeless shelter.
18. Set aside at least one hour per week to reach out and be Jesus to the needy: Look for opportunities to help the poor in your neighborhood. Give food, furniture, clothing, and time, rather than money. Help with babysitting and housecleaning and repairs.
19. Visit a blind person and read for them.
20. Participate in a literacy program to help adults learn to read and write. Use the Bible as a textbook.
21. Put your financial giving into effectual ways to spread the Gospel around the world: Support a Gospel mission working in a poor nation which focuses upon education and economic solutions for the future.
22. Support a radio or short-wave broadcasting ministry to closed nations (ie, Islam nations) which also sends Bibles and Biblical materials.
