

Old Testament Healing Scriptures

OT:2280: chabash: to wrap firmly (especially a turban, compress, or saddle); to stop, to rule.

OT:7495: rapha': to mend (by stitching), to cure.

OT:724: 'aruwkah: in the sense of restoring to soundness; wholeness.

1. **GEN 20:17** So Abraham prayed to God; and God HEALED Abimelech, his wife, and his female servants. Then they bore children;
2. **EXO 15:25** So he cried out to the Lord, and the Lord showed him a TREE. When he cast it into the waters, the waters were made sweet. There He made a statute and an ordinance for them. And there He tested them, 26 and said, "**If you diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am THE LORD WHO HEALS YOU.**"
3. **EXO 20:12** "**Honor your father and your mother, THAT YOUR DAYS MAY BE LONG UPON THE LAND which the Lord your God is giving you.**
4. **EXO 23:23** "**For My Angel will go before you and bring you in** to the Amorites and the Hittites and the Perizzites and the Canaanites and the Hivites and the Jebusites; and I will cut them off. 24 "**You shall not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do according to their works; but you shall utterly overthrow them and completely break down their sacred pillars.** 25 "**So you shall serve the Lord your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And I WILL TAKE SICKNESS AWAY FROM THE MIDST OF YOU.** 26 "**No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; I will fulfill the number of your days.**
5. **NUM 21:4** Then they journeyed from Mount Hor by the Way of the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; and the soul of the people became very discouraged on the way. 5 And the people spoke against God and against Moses: "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and our soul loathes this worthless bread." 6 **So the Lord sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and many of the people of Israel died.** 7 Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, "We have sinned, for we have spoken against the Lord and against you; pray to the Lord that He take away the serpents from us." So Moses prayed for the people. 8 Then the Lord said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole; and it shall be that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, shall live." 9 **So Moses made a bronze serpent, and put it on a pole; and so it was, if a serpent had bitten anyone, when he looked at the bronze serpent, he lived.**
6. **NUM 23:19** "**God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?**
7. **DEU 5:33** "**You shall walk in all the ways which the Lord your God has commanded you, that you may live and that it may be well with you, and that you may prolong your days in the land** which you shall possess.
8. **DEU 7:14** "You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall not be a male or female barren among you or among your livestock. 15 "And **the Lord will take away from you all SICKNESS, and will afflict you with none of the terrible DISEASES of Egypt which you have known, but will lay them on all those who hate you.**
9. **DEU 8:3** "**So He humbled you,** allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, **that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the Lord.**
10. **DEU 11:21** "**that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the heavens above the earth.**
11. **DEU 28:1** "Now **it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments** which I command you today, that the Lord your **God will set you high above all nations of the earth.** 2 "**And all these BLESSINGS shall come upon you and overtake you,** because you obey the voice of the Lord your God: 15 "**But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of the Lord your God,** to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you today, that **all these CURSES will come upon you and overtake you:** 60 "Moreover **He will bring back on you all the DISEASES of Egypt, of which you were afraid, and they shall cling to you.** 61 "**Also every SICKNESS and every PLAGUE, which is not written in this Book of the Law, will the Lord bring upon you until you are destroyed.**

Notice here that sickness and disease are CURSES that result from disobedience of God's Law !!!

12. **DEU 30:19** "**I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you LIFE AND DEATH, BLESSING AND CURSING; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live;** 20 "**that you may love the Lord your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days;** and that you may dwell in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them."
13. **JOS 21:45** **Not a word failed of any good thing which the Lord had spoken to the house of Israel. All came to pass.**
14. **1KI 8:56** "**Blessed be the Lord, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised.** There has not failed one word of all His good promise, which He promised through His servant Moses.

15. **2KI 20:5** “Return and tell Hezekiah the leader of My people, ‘**Thus says the Lord, the God of David your father: “I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears; surely I WILL HEAL YOU. On the third day you shall go up to the house of the Lord.**”
16. **1CH 29:28** So **he (David) died in a good OLD AGE, full of days and riches and honor;** and Solomon his son reigned in his place.
17. **2CH 6:14** and **he said: “Lord God of Israel, there is no God in heaven or on earth like You, who keep Your covenant and mercy with Your servants who walk before You with all their hearts.**”
18. **2CH 7:14** “**if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and HEAL their land.**”
19. **2CH 16:9** “For **the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him.** In this you have done foolishly; therefore from now on you shall have wars.”
20. **2CH 16:12** And **in the thirty-ninth year of his reign, Asa became diseased in his feet, and his malady was severe; yet in his disease he did not seek the Lord, but the physicians.** 13 **So Asa rested with his fathers; he died in the forty-first year of his reign.**
21. **2CH 30:20** And **the Lord listened to Hezekiah and HEALED the people.**
22. **JOB 5:17** “Behold, happy is the man whom God corrects; Therefore **do not despise the chastening of the Almighty.** 18 For **He bruises, but He binds up; He wounds, but His hands make whole.**”
23. **JOB 5:26** **You shall come to the grave at a FULL AGE, As a sheaf of grain ripens in its season.**
24. **JOB 13:4** But **you forgers of lies, You are all worthless physicians.**
25. **PSA 6:2** **Have mercy on me, O Lord, for I am weak; O Lord, HEAL me, for my bones are troubled.**
26. **PSA 23:1** The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.
27. **PSA 30:2** **O Lord my God, I cried out to You, And You HEALED me.**
28. **PSA 34:19** **Many are the AFFLICTIONS of the righteous, But the Lord delivers him out of them all.**
29. **PSA 41:3** **The Lord will strengthen him on his BED OF ILLNESS; You will sustain him on his SICKBED.** 4 I said, “**Lord, be merciful to me; HEAL my soul, FOR I HAVE SINNED AGAINST YOU.**”
30. **PSA 42:11** Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? **Hope in God;** For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.
31. **PSA 55:22** **Cast your burden on the Lord, And He shall sustain you;** He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.
32. **PSA 90:10** **The days of our lives are seventy years; And if by reason of strength they are eighty years,** Yet their boast is only labor and sorrow; For it is soon cut off, and we fly away.
33. **PSA 91:1** **He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.** 2 I will **SAY of the Lord, “He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.”** 3 **Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler And from the perilous PESTILENCE.** 4 He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler. 5 **You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, Nor of the arrow that flies by day, 6 Nor of the PESTILENCE that walks in darkness, Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.**
34. **PSA 91:10** No evil shall befall you, **Nor shall any PLAGUE come near your dwelling;** 16 **With LONG LIFE I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation.”**
35. **PSA 103:1** **Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name!** 2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, And **forget not all His benefits:** 3 **Who forgives all your iniquities, WHO HEALS ALL YOUR DISEASES,** 4 **Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies,** 5 **Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.**
36. **PSA 105:37** He also brought them out with silver and gold, And **there was NONE FEEBLE among His tribes.**
37. **PSA 107:19** Then **they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, And He saved them out of their distresses.** 20 **HE SENT HIS WORD AND HEALED THEM, And delivered them from their destructions.** 21 Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!
38. **PSA 118:17** **I shall not die, but LIVE, And declare the works of the Lord.**
39. **PSA 119:37** **Turn away my eyes from looking at worthless things, And REVIVE ME in Your way.**
40. **PSA 119:93** **I will never forget Your precepts, For by them You have given me life.**
41. **PSA 145:8** The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, Slow to anger and great in mercy. 9 The Lord is good to all, And His tender mercies are over all His works.
42. **PSA 147:3** **He HEALS the brokenhearted And BINDS UP THEIR WOUNDS.**
43. **PRO 3:1** **My son, do not forget my law, But let your heart keep my commands;** 2 **For LENGTH OF DAYS AND LONG LIFE And peace they will add to you.**
44. **PRO 3:7** Do not be wise in your own eyes; **Fear the Lord and depart from evil.** 8 **It will be HEALTH to your flesh, And strength to your bones.**
45. **PRO 4:10** **Hear, my son, and receive my sayings, And THE YEARS OF YOUR LIFE will be many.**
46. **PRO 4:20** **My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.** 21 **Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart;** 22 For **they are LIFE to those who find them, And HEALTH to all their flesh.** 23 Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life. 24 Put away from you a deceitful mouth, And put perverse lips far from you.

47. **PRO 9:11** For **by me your days will be multiplied, And YEARS OF LIFE will be added to you.**
48. **PRO 12:14** **A man will be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth,** And the recompense of a man's hands will be rendered to him.
49. **PRO 12:18** There is one who speaks like the piercings of a sword, But **the tongue of the wise promotes HEALTH.**
50. **PRO 14:30** **A sound heart is LIFE TO THE BODY, But envy is rotteness to the bones.**
51. **PRO 17:22** **A merry heart does good, like MEDICINE, But a broken spirit dries the bones.**
52. **PRO 18:14** **The spirit of a man will sustain him in SICKNESS, But who can bear a broken spirit?**
53. **PRO 18:21** **The tongue has the power of life and death,** and those who love it will eat its fruit.
54. **ECC 3:1** To everything there is a season, A time for every purpose under heaven: 3 **A TIME TO KILL, AND A TIME TO HEAL;** A time to break down, And a time to build up;
55. **ECC 7:17** **Do not be overly wicked, Nor be foolish: Why should you die before your time?**
56. **ISA 6:9** And He said, "Go, and tell this people: 'Keep on hearing, but do not understand; Keep on seeing, but do not perceive.' 10 **"Make the heart of this people dull, And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And return and be HEALED."**
57. **ISA 38:1** In those days Hezekiah was sick and near death. And Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, went to him and said to him, **"Thus says the LORD: 'Set your house in order, for you shall die and not live.'"** 2 Then **Hezekiah turned his face toward the wall, and prayed to the LORD,** 3 and said, "Remember now, O LORD, I pray, how I have walked before You in truth and with a loyal heart, and have done *what is good* in Your sight." And Hezekiah wept bitterly. 4 And **the word of the LORD came to Isaiah, saying,** 5 **"Go and tell Hezekiah, 'Thus says the LORD, the God of David your father: 'I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears; surely I WILL ADD TO YOUR DAYS FIFTEEN YEARS.** 16 O Lord, by these things men live; And in all these things is the life of my spirit; So **You will RESTORE ME and make me live.** 21 Now Isaiah had said, **"Let them take a lump of figs, and apply it as a POULTICE on the boil, and he shall recover."**
58. **ISA 40:31** But **those who wait on THE LORD SHALL RENEW THEIR STRENGTH; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.**
59. **ISA 41:10** **Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'**
60. **ISA 43:25** "I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins. 26 **Put Me in remembrance; Let us contend together; State your case, that you may be acquitted.**
61. **ISA 53:4** Surely **He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.** 5 But **He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And BY HIS STRIPES WE ARE HEALED.** 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
62. **ISA 57:18** **I have seen his ways, and will HEAL him;** I will also lead him, And restore comforts to him And to his mourners. 19 "I create the fruit of the lips: **Peace, peace to him who is far off and to him who is near,**" Says the Lord, **"And I WILL HEAL HIM."**
63. **ISA 58:6** **"Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, To undo the heavy burdens, To let the oppressed go free, And that you break every yoke?"** 7 Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, And that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out; When you see the naked, that you cover him, And not hide yourself from your own flesh? 8 **THEN your light shall break forth like the morning, YOUR HEALING SHALL SPRING FORTH SPEEDILY,** And your righteousness shall go before you; The glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. 11 **The Lord will guide you continually, And satisfy your soul in drought, And strengthen your bones;** You shall be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.
64. **ISA 55:8** "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. 9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts. 10 **"For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, And do not return there, But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater,** 11 **So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.**
65. **ISA 65:22** They shall not build and another inhabit; They shall not plant and another eat; For **as the days of a tree, so shall be the days of My people, And My elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands.**
66. **JER 1:12** Then **the Lord said to me, "You have seen well, for I am ready to perform My word."**
67. **JER 17:13** O Lord, the hope of Israel, All who forsake You shall be ashamed. "Those who depart from Me Shall be written in the earth, Because they have forsaken the Lord, The fountain of living waters." 14 **HEAL ME, O Lord, and I shall be healed; Save me, and I shall be saved,** For You are my praise.
68. **JER 30:17** For **I will RESTORE HEALTH to you And HEAL YOU of your wounds,' says the Lord,** 'Because they called you an outcast saying: "This is Zion; No one seeks her." '
69. **JER 33:6** **'Behold, I will bring it HEALTH AND HEALING; I will HEAL them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.**

70. **HOS 6:1** Come, and let us return to the Lord; For He has torn, but HE WILL HEAL US; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. 2 After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight.
71. **HOS 11:3** “I taught Ephraim to walk, Taking them by their arms; But they did not know that I HEALED them. 4 I drew them with gentle cords, With bands of love, And I was to them as those who take the yoke from their neck. I stooped and fed them.
72. **HOS 13:14** “I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I WILL REDEEM THEM FROM DEATH. O Death, I will be your plagues! O Grave, I will be your destruction! Pity is hidden from My eyes.
73. **HOS 14:4** “I will HEAL their backsliding, I will love them freely, For My anger has turned away from him.
74. **JOE 3:10** Beat your plowshares into swords And your pruning hooks into spears; **LET THE WEAK SAY, ‘I AM STRONG.’**
75. **NAH 1:9** What do you conspire against the Lord? He will make an utter end of it. **AFFLICTION will not rise up a second time.**
76. **MAL 3:6** “For I am the Lord, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob.
77. **MAL 4:2** But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With HEALING in His wings; And you shall go out And grow fat like stall-fed calves. 3 Then you will trample down the wicked; they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day when I do these things,” says the LORD Almighty.

New Testament Healing Scriptures

NT:2390: **iaomai** to cure (literally or figuratively)

NT:2323: **therapeuo:** to wait upon menially, i.e. (figuratively) to adore (God), or (specially) to relieve (of disease)

NT:2511: **katharizo:** to cleanse (literally or figuratively)

78. **MAT 4:4** But He answered and said, “**It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.’**”
79. **MAT 4:23** And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and HEALING all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. 24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He HEALED them.
80. **MAT 6:9** “In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. 10 Your kingdom come. **Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven.**
81. **MAT 7:7** “**Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.** 8 “For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. 11 “If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!
82. **MAT 8:2** And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying, “Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.” 3 Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, “I am willing; be cleansed.” Immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
83. **MAT 8:5** Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him, 6 saying, “Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented.” 7 And Jesus said to him, “I will come and heal him.” 8 The centurion answered and said, “Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But ONLY SPEAK A WORD, AND MY SERVANT WILL BE HEALED. 9 “For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, ‘Go,’ and he goes; and to another, ‘Come,’ and he comes; and to my servant, ‘Do this,’ and he does it.” 10 When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, “Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel! 13 Then Jesus said to the centurion, “Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you.” And his servant was healed that same hour.
84. **MAT 8:14** Now when Jesus had come into Peter’s house, He saw his wife’s mother lying sick with a fever. 15 So He touched her hand, and the fever left her. And she arose and served them.
85. **MAT 8:16** When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and HEALED all who were sick, 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses.”
86. **MAT 9:2** Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you.” 3 And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, “This Man blasphemes!” 4 But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, “Why do you think evil in your hearts? 5 “For which is easier, to say, ‘Your sins are forgiven you,’ or to say, ‘Arise and walk’? 6 “But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins”—then He said to the paralytic, “Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.” 7 And he arose and departed to his house. 8 Now when the multitudes saw it, they marveled and glorified God, who had given such power to men.
87. **MAT 9:12** When Jesus heard that, He said to them, “Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick.

88. **MAT 9:20** And **suddenly, a woman who had a flow of blood for twelve years came from behind and touched the hem of His garment.** 21 **For she said to herself, “If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made well.”** 22 But **Jesus** turned around, and when He saw her He **said, “Be of good cheer, daughter; your faith has made you well.”** And the woman was made well from that hour.
89. **MAT 9:27** **When Jesus departed from there, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, “Son of David, have mercy on us!”** 28 And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And **Jesus said to them, “Do you believe that I am able to do this?”** They said to Him, **“Yes, Lord.”** 29 **Then He touched their eyes, saying, “According to your faith let it be to you.”** 30 And **their eyes were opened.** And Jesus sternly warned them, saying, **“See that no one knows it.”**
90. **MAT 9:32** As they went out, **behold, they brought to Him a man, mute and demon-possessed.** 33 **And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke. And the multitudes marveled, saying, “It was never seen like this in Israel!”** 34 But the Pharisees said, **“He casts out demons by the ruler of the demons.”**
91. **MAT 9:35** Then **Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and HEALING EVERY SICKNESS AND EVERY DISEASE among the people.** 36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.
92. **MAT 10:1** And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, **He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to HEAL all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.** 5 **These twelve Jesus sent out and commanded them,** saying: **“Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. 6 “But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. 7 “And as you go, preach, saying, ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’ 8 “HEAL THE SICK, CLEANSE THE LEPERS, RAISE THE DEAD, CAST OUT DEMONS. Freely you have received, freely give.**
93. **MAT 11:5** **“The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them.**
94. **MAT 11:28** **“Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.** 29 **“Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 “For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”**
95. **MAT 12:9** Now when He had departed from there, **He went into their synagogue.** 10 And **behold, there was a man who had a withered hand.** And they asked Him, saying, **“Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?”**—that they might accuse Him. 11 Then He said to them, **“What man is there among you who has one sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will not lay hold of it and lift it out? 12 “Of how much more value then is a man than a sheep? Therefore it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath.”** 13 Then **He said to the man, “Stretch out your hand.”** And he **stretched it out, and it was restored as whole as the other.**
96. **MAT 12:15** But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And **great multitudes followed Him, and He HEALED them all.**
97. **MAT 12:22** Then **one was brought to Him who was demon-possessed, blind and mute; and He HEALED him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw.** 23 And all the multitudes were amazed and said, **“Could this be the Son of David?”** 24 Now when the Pharisees heard it they said, **“This fellow does not cast out demons except by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons.”**
98. **MAT 13:54** And **when He had come to His own country, He taught them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished and said, “Where did this Man get this wisdom and these mighty works? 57 So they were offended at Him. But Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor except in his own country and in his own house.” 58 Now He DID NOT do many mighty works there because of their unbelief.**
99. **MAT 14:14** And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and **He was moved with compassion for them, and HEALED their sick.**
100. **MAT 14:34** When they had crossed over, they came to the land of Gennesaret. 35 And **when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent out into all that surrounding region, brought to Him all who were sick, 36 and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched it were made perfectly well.**
101. **MAT 15:21** Then Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. 22 And **behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, “Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed.”** 23 But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, **“Send her away, for she cries out after us.”** 24 But He answered and said, **“I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.”** 25 Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, **“Lord, help me!”** 26 But He answered and said, **“It is not good to take the children’s bread and throw it to the little dogs.”** 27 And she said, **“Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters’ table.”** 28 Then **Jesus answered and said to her, “O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire.”** And her daughter **was HEALED from that very hour.**
102. **MAT 15:30** Then **great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus’ feet, and He HEALED them.** 31 So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

103. **MAT 17:14** And when they had come to the multitude, **a man came to Him, kneeling down to Him and saying, 15 “Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water. 16 “So I brought him to Your disciples, but they could not cure him.” 17 Then Jesus answered and said, “O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him here to Me.” 18 And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour. 19 Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, “Why could we not cast it out?” 20 So Jesus said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. 21 “However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.”**
104. **MAT 18:18** **“Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. 19 “Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.**
105. **MAT 19:1** Now it came to pass, when Jesus had finished these sayings, that He departed from Galilee and came to the region of Judea beyond the Jordan. 2 And **great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them there.**
106. **MAT 20:30** And **behold, two blind men sitting by the road, when they heard that Jesus was passing by, cried out, saying, “Have mercy on us, O Lord, Son of David!” 31 Then the multitude warned them that they should be quiet; but they cried out all the more, saying, “Have mercy on us, O Lord, Son of David!” 32 So Jesus stood still and called them, and said, “What do you want Me to do for you?” 33 They said to Him, “Lord, that our eyes may be opened.” 34 So Jesus had compassion and touched their eyes. And immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him.**
107. **MAT 21:14** Then **the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He HEALED them.**
108. **MAT 21:21** So Jesus answered and said to them, **“Assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ it will be done. 22 “And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive.”**
109. **MAR 1:32** **At evening, when the sun had set, they brought to Him all who were sick and those who were demon-possessed. 33 And the whole city was gathered together at the door. 34 Then He HEALED many who were sick with various diseases, and CAST OUT MANY DEMONS; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him.**
110. **MAR 1:40** Now **a leper came to Him, imploring Him, kneeling down to Him and saying to Him, “If You are willing, You can make me clean.” 41 Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, “I am willing; be cleansed.” 42 As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was CLEANSED. 43 And He strictly warned him and sent him away at once, 44 and said to him, “See that you say nothing to anyone; but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing those things which Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.” 45 However, he went out and began to proclaim it freely, and to spread the matter, so that Jesus could no longer openly enter the city, but was outside in deserted places; and they came to Him from every direction.**
111. **MAR 2:1** And again He entered Capernaum after some days, and it was heard that He was in the house. 2 Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive them, not even near the door. And **He preached the word to them. 3 Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four men. 4 And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son, your sins are forgiven you.” 6 And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, 7 “Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone?” 8 But immediately, when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, “Why do you reason about these things in your hearts? 9 “Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, ‘Your sins are forgiven you,’ or to say, ‘Arise, take up your bed and walk?’ 10 “But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins”—He said to the paralytic, 11 “I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.” 12 Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, “We never saw anything like this!”**
112. **MAR 3:10** For **He HEALED many, so that as many as had afflictions pressed about Him to touch Him.**
113. **MAR 5:21** Now when Jesus had crossed over again by boat to the other side, a great multitude gathered to Him; and He was by the sea. 22 And **behold, one of the rulers of the synagogue came, Jairus by name. And when he saw Him, he fell at His feet 23 and begged Him earnestly, saying, “My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live.” 24 So Jesus went with him, and a great multitude followed Him and thronged Him. 35 While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue’s house who said, “Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?” 36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, “Do not be afraid; only believe.” 37 And He permitted no one to follow Him except Peter, James, and John the brother of James. 38 Then He came to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and saw a tumult and those who wept and wailed loudly. 39 When He came in, He said to them, “Why make this commotion and weep? The child is not dead, but sleeping.” 40 And they ridiculed Him. But when He had put them all outside, He took the father and the mother of the child, and those who were with Him, and entered where the child was lying. 41 Then He took the child by the hand, and said to her, “Talitha, cumi,” which is translated, “Little girl, I say to you, arise.” 42 Immediately the girl arose and walked, for she was twelve years of age. And they were overcome with great amazement.**

114. **MAR 5:25** Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, 26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. 27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. 28 For she said, “If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well.” 29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction. 30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, “Who touched My clothes?” 31 But His disciples said to Him, “You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, ‘Who touched Me?’ ” 32 And He looked around to see her who had done this thing. 33 But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. 34 And He said to her, “**Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction.**”
115. **MAR 6:13** And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and HEALED them.
116. **MAR 6:53** When they had crossed over, they came to the land of Gennesaret and anchored there. 54 And when they came out of the boat, immediately the people recognized Him. 55 ran through that whole surrounding region, and began to carry about on beds those who were sick to wherever they heard He was. 56 Wherever He entered into villages, cities, or in the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the hem of His garment. And AS MANY AS TOUCHED HIM WERE MADE WELL.
117. **MAR 7:25** For a woman whose young daughter had an unclean spirit heard about Him, and she came and fell at His feet. 26 The woman was a Greek, a Syro-Phoenician by birth, and she kept asking Him to cast the demon out of her daughter. 27 But Jesus said to her, “Let the children be filled first, for it is not good to take the children’s bread and throw it to the little dogs.” 28 And she answered and said to Him, “Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs under the table eat from the children’s crumbs.” 29 Then He said to her, “For this saying go your way; the demon has gone out of your daughter.” 30 And when she had come to her house, she found the demon gone out, and her daughter lying on the bed.
118. **MAR 7:31** Again, departing from the region of Tyre and Sidon, He came through the midst of the region of Decapolis to the Sea of Galilee. 32 Then they brought to Him one who was deaf and had an impediment in his speech, and they begged Him to put His hand on him. 33 And He took him aside from the multitude, and put His fingers in his ears, and He spat and touched his tongue. 34 Then, looking up to heaven, He sighed, and said to him, “Ephphatha,” that is, “Be opened.” 35 Immediately his ears were opened, and the impediment of his tongue was loosed, and he spoke plainly. 36 Then He commanded them that they should tell no one; but the more He commanded them, the more widely they proclaimed it. 37 And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, “He has done all things well. He makes both the deaf to hear and the mute to speak.”
119. **MAR 8:22** Then He came to Bethsaida; and they brought a blind man to Him, and begged Him to touch him. 23 So He took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the town. And when He had spit on his eyes and put His hands on him, He asked him if he saw anything. 24 And he looked up and said, “I see men like trees, walking.” 25 Then He put His hands on his eyes again and made him look up. And he was restored and saw everyone clearly.
120. **MAR 9:17** Then one of the crowd answered and said, “Teacher, I brought You my son, who has a mute spirit. 18 “And wherever it seizes him, it throws him down; he foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth, and becomes rigid. So I spoke to Your disciples, that they should cast it out, but they could not.” 19 He answered him and said, “O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him to Me.” 20 Then they brought him to Him. And when he saw Him, immediately the spirit convulsed him, and he fell on the ground and wallowed, foaming at the mouth. 21 So He asked his father, “How long has this been happening to him?” And he said, “From childhood. 22 “And often he has thrown him both into the fire and into the water to destroy him. But if You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us.” 23 Jesus said to him, “If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.” 24 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, “Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!” 25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it, “Deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and enter him no more!” 26 Then the spirit cried out, convulsed him greatly, and came out of him. And he became as one dead, so that many said, “He is dead.” 27 But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him up, and he arose. 28 And when He had come into the house, His disciples asked Him privately, “Why could we not cast it out?” 29 So He said to them, “This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting.”
121. **MAR 11:22** So Jesus answered and said to them, “Have faith in God. 23 “For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. 24 “Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.
122. **MAR 16:14** Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen. 15 And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 “He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. 17 “And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 “they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; THEY WILL LAY HANDS ON THE SICK, AND THEY WILL RECOVER.” 19 So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. 20 And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

NOTICE that after Jesus' resurrection, He performed **NO** healing miracles. He no longer preached or taught to the public, but ministered **ONLY** to His disciples. What do you suppose is the reason for this?

123. **LUK 1:37** "For with God nothing will be impossible."
124. **LUK 4:33** Now in the synagogue there was a man who had a spirit of an unclean demon. And he cried out with a loud voice, ³⁴ saying, "Let us alone! What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!" ³⁵ But Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be quiet, and come out of him!" And when the demon had thrown him in their midst, it came out of him and did not hurt him. ³⁶ Then they were all amazed and spoke among themselves, saying, "What a word this is! For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits, and they come out." ³⁷ And the report about Him went out into every place in the surrounding region.
125. **LUK 4:38** Now He arose from the synagogue and entered Simon's house. But Simon's wife's mother was sick with a high fever, and they made request of Him concerning her. ⁹ So He stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. And immediately she arose and served them.
126. **LUK 4:40** When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them. ⁴¹ And demons also came out of many, crying out and saying, "You are the Christ, the Son of God!" And He, rebuking them, did not allow them to speak, for they knew that He was the Christ.
127. **LUK 5:15** However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be HEALED by Him of their infirmities.
128. **LUK 5:17** Now it happened on a certain day, as HE WAS TEACHING, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. AND THE POWER OF THE LORD WAS PRESENT TO HEAL THEM.
129. **LUK 6:19** And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and HEALED them all.
130. **LUK 7:11** Now it happened, the day after, that He went into a city called Nain; and many of His disciples went with Him, and a large crowd. ¹² And when He came near the gate of the city, behold, a dead man was being carried out, the only son of his mother; and she was a widow. And a large crowd from the city was with her. ¹³ When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep." ¹⁴ Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." ¹⁵ So he who was dead sat up and began to speak. And He presented him to his mother. ¹⁶ Then fear came upon all, and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has risen up among us"; and, "God has visited His people." ¹⁷ And this report about Him went throughout all Judea and all the surrounding region.
131. **LUK 9:2** He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to HEAL the sick.
132. **LUK 9:11** But when the multitudes knew it, they followed Him; and He received them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who had need of HEALING.
133. **LUK 10:9** "And HEAL the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'"
134. **LUK 13:10** Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. ¹¹ And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up. ¹² But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity." ¹³ And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. ¹⁴ But the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath; and he said to the crowd, "There are six days on which men ought to work; therefore come and be healed on them, and not on the Sabbath day." ¹⁵ The Lord then answered him and said, "Hypocrite! Does not each one of you on the Sabbath loose his ox or donkey from the stall, and lead it away to water it? ¹⁶ "So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?" ¹⁷ And when He said these things, all His adversaries were put to shame; and all the multitude rejoiced for all the glorious things that were done by Him.
135. **LUK 14:1** Now it happened, as He went into the house of one of the rulers of the Pharisees to eat bread on the Sabbath, that they watched Him closely. ² And behold, there was a certain man before Him who had dropsy. ³ And Jesus, answering, spoke to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?" ⁴ But they kept silent. And He took him and healed him, and let him go. ⁵ Then He answered them, saying, "Which of you, having a donkey or an ox that has fallen into a pit, will not immediately pull him out on the Sabbath day?" ⁶ And they could not answer Him regarding these things.
136. **LUK 17:11** Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. ¹² Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. ¹³ And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" ¹⁴ So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed. ¹⁵ And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, ¹⁶ and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan. ¹⁷ So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine?" ¹⁸ "Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" ¹⁹ And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

137. **LUK 18:35** Then it happened, as He was coming near Jericho, that a certain blind man sat by the road begging. 36 And hearing a multitude passing by, he asked what it meant. 37 So they told him that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by. 38 And he cried out, saying, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" 39 Then those who went before warned him that he should be quiet; but he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" 40 So Jesus stood still and commanded him to be brought to Him. And when he had come near, He asked him, 41 saying, "What do you want Me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, that I may receive my sight." 42 Then Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has made you well." 43 And immediately he received his sight, and followed Him, glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God.
138. **LUK 22:50** And one of them struck the servant of the high priest and cut off his right ear. 51 But Jesus answered and said, "Permit even this." And He touched his ear and HEALED him.
139. **JOH 4:46** So Jesus came again to Cana of Galilee where He had made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman whose son was sick at Capernaum. 47 When he heard that Jesus had come out of Judea into Galilee, he went to Him and implored Him to come down and heal his son, for he was at the point of death. 48 Then Jesus said to him, "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe." 49 The nobleman said to Him, "Sir, come down before my child dies!" 50 Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your son lives." So the man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he went his way. 51 And as he was now going down, his servants met him and told him, saying, "Your son lives!" 52 Then he inquired of them the hour when he got better. And they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him." 53 So the father knew that it was at the same hour in which Jesus said to him, "Your son lives." And he himself believed, and his whole household. 54 This again is the second sign Jesus did when He had come out of Judea into Galilee.
140. **JOH 5:1** After this there was a feast of the Jews, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. 2 Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, which is called in Hebrew, Bethesda, having five porches. 3 In these lay a great multitude of sick people, blind, lame, paralyzed, waiting for the moving of the water. 4 For an angel went down at a certain time into the pool and stirred up the water; then whoever stepped in first, after the stirring of the water, was made well of whatever disease he had. 5 Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years. 6 When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "Do you want to be made well?" 7 The sick man answered Him, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up; but while I am coming, another steps down before me." 8 Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your bed and walk." 9 And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked. And that day was the Sabbath.
141. **JOH 6:63** "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.
142. **JOH 9:1** Now as Jesus passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth. 2 And His disciples asked Him, saying, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" 3 Jesus answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him. 4 "I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work. 5 "As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world." 6 When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. 7 And He said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which is translated, Sent). So he went and washed, and came back seeing.
143. **JOH 9:31** We know that God does not listen to sinners. He listens to the godly man who does his will.
144. **JOH 10:10** The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.
145. **JOH 14:12** "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. 13 "And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 "If you ask anything in My name, I will do it. 15 "If you love Me, keep My commandments.
146. **JOH 15:7** "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.
147. **JOH 16:23** "And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. 24 "Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.
148. **ACT 3:1** Now Peter and John went up together to the temple at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour. 2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms from those who entered the temple; 3 who, seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple, asked for alms. 4 And fixing his eyes on him, with John, Peter said, "Look at us." 5 So he gave them his attention, expecting to receive something from them. 6 Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk." 7 And he took him by the right hand and lifted him up, and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. 8 So he, leaping up, stood and walked and entered the temple with them—walking, leaping, and praising God. 9 And all the people saw him walking and praising God. 12 So when Peter saw it, he responded to the people: "Men of Israel, why do you marvel at this? Or why look so intently at us, as though by our own power or godliness we had made this man walk? 16 "And His name, through faith in His name, has made this man strong, whom you see and know. Yes, the faith which comes through Him has given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

149. **ACT 4:10** “let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole. 13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus. 14 And seeing the man who had been healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.
150. **ACT 4:29** “Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, 30 “by STRETCHING OUT YOUR HAND TO HEAL, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.” 31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.
151. **ACT 5:12** And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were done among the people. And they were all with one accord in Solomon’s Porch. 14 And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, 15 so that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. 16 Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and THEY WERE ALL HEALED.
152. **ACT 6:8** And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and signs among the people.
153. **ACT 8:6** And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. 7 For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were HEALED.
154. **ACT 9:10** Now there was a certain disciple at Damascus named Ananias; and to him the Lord said in a vision, “Ananias.” And he said, “Here I am, Lord.” 11 So the Lord said to him, “Arise and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for one called Saul of Tarsus, for behold, he is praying. 17 And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may RECEIVE YOUR SIGHT and be filled with the Holy Spirit.” 18 Immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized. 19 So when he had received food, he was strengthened. Then Saul spent some days with the disciples at Damascus.
155. **ACT 9:32** Now it came to pass, as Peter went through all parts of the country, that he also came down to the saints who dwelt in Lydda. 33 There he found a certain man named Aeneas, who had been bedridden eight years and was paralyzed. 34 And Peter said to him, “Aeneas, JESUS THE CHRIST HEALS YOU. Arise and make your bed.” Then he arose immediately. 35 So all who dwelt at Lydda and Sharon saw him and turned to the Lord.
156. **ACT 9:36** At Joppa there was a certain disciple named Tabitha, which is translated Dorcas. This woman was full of good works and charitable deeds which she did. 37 But it happened in those days that she became sick and died. When they had washed her, they laid her in an upper room. 38 And since Lydda was near Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent two men to him, imploring him not to delay in coming to them. 39 Then Peter arose and went with them. When he had come, they brought him to the upper room. And all the widows stood by him weeping, showing the tunics and garments which Dorcas had made while she was with them. 40 But Peter put them all out, and knelt down and prayed. And turning to the body he said, “Tabitha, arise.” And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter she sat up. 41 Then he gave her his hand and lifted her up; and when he had called the saints and widows, he presented her alive. 42 And it became known throughout all Joppa, and many believed on the Lord.
157. **ACT 10:38** “how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and HEALING all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.
158. **ACT 14:3** Therefore they stayed there a long time, speaking boldly in the Lord, who was bearing witness to the word of His grace, granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands.
159. **ACT 14:8** And in Lystra a certain man without strength in his feet was sitting, a cripple from his mother’s womb, who had never walked. 9 This man heard Paul speaking. Paul, observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed, 10 said with a loud voice, “Stand up straight on your feet!” And he leaped and walked.
160. **ACT 14:19** Then Jews from Antioch and Iconium came there; and having persuaded the multitudes, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing him to be dead. 20 However, when the disciples gathered around him, he rose up and went into the city. And the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.
161. **ACT 19:11** Now God worked unusual miracles by the hands of Paul, 12 so that even handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out of them.
162. **ACT 20:7** Now on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul, ready to depart the next day, spoke to them and continued his message until midnight. 8 There were many lamps in the upper room where they were gathered together. 9 And in a window sat a certain young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep. He was overcome by sleep; and as Paul continued speaking, he fell down from the third story and was taken up dead. 10 But Paul went down, fell on him, and embracing him said, “Do not trouble yourselves, for his life is in him.” 11 Now when he had come up, had broken bread and eaten, and talked a long while, even till daybreak, he departed. 12 And they brought the young man in alive, and they were not a little comforted.

163. **ACT 22:12** “Then a certain Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good testimony with all the Jews who dwelt there, 13 “came to me; and **he stood and said to me, ‘Brother Saul, receive your sight.’ And at that same hour I looked up at him.**
164. **ACT 28:1** Now when they had escaped, they then found out that the island was called Malta. 2 And the natives showed us unusual kindness; for they kindled a fire and made us all welcome, because of the rain that was falling and because of the cold. 3 But **when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks and laid them on the fire, a viper came out because of the heat, and fastened on his hand.** 4 So when the natives saw the creature hanging from his hand, they said to one another, “No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he has escaped the sea, yet justice does not allow to live.” 5 **But he shook off the creature into the fire and suffered no harm.**
165. **ROM 4:16** Therefore **it is of faith that it might be according to grace, so that the promise might be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all** 17 (as it is written, “I have made you a father of many nations”) in the presence of Him whom he believed—**God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did;** 18 **who, contrary to hope, in hope believed, so that he became the father of many nations,** according to what was spoken, “So shall your descendants be.” 19 And **not being weak in faith, he (Abraham) did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah’s womb.** 20 **He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God,** 21 and **being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.**
166. **ROM 6:14** For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.
167. **ROM 8:2** For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.
168. **ROM 8:11** But **if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.**
169. **ROM 8:31** What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?
170. **ROM 10:17** So then **faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.**
171. **1CO 3:16** Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?
172. **1CO 12:28** And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues.
173. **2CO 1:20** For **no matter how many promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ. And so through him the “Amen” is spoken by us to the glory of God.** (NIV)
174. **2CO 10:4** For **the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds,** 5 **casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.**
175. **GAL 3:13** **Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us** (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”), 14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. 29 And **if you are Christ’s, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.**
176. **EPH 3:20** **Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us.**
177. **EPH 5:30** For **we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones.**
178. **EPH 6:1** Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 2 **“Honor your father and mother,” which is the first commandment with promise:** 3 **“that it may be well with you and you may LIVE LONG on the earth.”**
179. **EPH 6:10** Finally, my brethren, **be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.** 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore **take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.** 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—
180. **PHI 2:8** And **being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.** 9 **Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name,** 10 **that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth,** 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

181. **PHI 2:12** Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; 13 for **it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.**
182. **PHI 4:6** **Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;** 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
183. **COL 1:12** giving thanks to **the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light.** 13 **He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,** 14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.
184. **COL 2:10** and **you are complete in Him, who is the head of ALL principality and power.** 15 Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.
185. **1TH 5:23** Now **may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.**
186. **1TI 6:12** **Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called** and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.
187. **2TI 1:7** For **God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.**
188. **PHI 6** I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ. (NIV)
189. **HEB 2:14** Inasmuch then **as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,** 15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.
190. **HEB 4:14** **Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.** 15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 **Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.**
191. **HEB 10:23** Let us **hold FAST the CONFESSION of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.**
192. **HEB 10:35** **Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward.** 36 For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: 38 Now **the just shall live by faith;** But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.”
193. **HEB 11:1** Now **faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.** 6 But **without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.**
194. **HEB 11:11** **By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised.**
195. **HEB 12:12** Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees, 13 and **make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be HEALED.**
196. **HEB 13:8** **Jesus Christ is the SAME yesterday, today, and forever.**
197. **JAM 1:17** **Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.**
198. **JAM 4:7** Therefore **submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.**
199. **JAM 5:14** **Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.** 15 And **the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.** 16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.
200. **IPE 2:24** **who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—BY WHOSE STRIPES YOU WERE HEALED.**
201. **1JO 3:8** He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. **For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.**
202. **1JO 3:21** Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God. 22 And **whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.**
203. **1JO 4:4** You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because **He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.**
204. **1JO 5:14** Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. 15 And **if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.**
205. **3JO 2** Beloved, **I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in HEALTH, just as your soul prospers.**
206. **REV 12:11** “And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
