4. Write out **GEN 3:15**: And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel. (NKJ) (God speaking to the serpent) Who is the 'seed of the serpent'? This phrase speaks of all the children of Satan, the wicked in the earth, and ultimately to the 'son' of the serpent, who is the antichrist to come and who is already in the world. Who is the 'seed of the woman'? This phrase speaks of the virgin-born Christ Jesus to come, as well as to the children of God, the righteous followers of Christ in the earth. The 'woman' is a type of the Church of God in union with Christ which births forth children of God into the earth. Christ, the seed of the woman crushes the head or rulership of the serpent through his death on the cross, thus winning back salvation for the seed of the woman and lordship of earth. This scripture is a prophecy of the whole salvation message !!
5. **Discuss** how **'EMNITY'** manifests between **Satan** and the **woman**, and between their **respective seeds**: Satan & his seed, the wicked of the world, have always persecuted the seed of the woman, those born through faith in the Messiah. This enmity came first to a focus at the crucifixion of Messiah. That event is when the seed of the serpent bruised the seed of the woman, but whose head was crushed in the process. The ultimate in this persecution will come at the end of the age as this conflict intensifies, when the ultimate seed of the serpent, the antimessiah, will persecute both Jews and the Church during the tribulation period. Our deliverance from this persecution will come only with Jesus second coming. Could the first murder (Cain & Abel) be an example of the enmity between the seeds? Explain. Yes!! Cain is an example of the unrighteous or wicked, not seeking to please God. God warned him in GEN 4:7 that sin was 'crouching at his door', ready to come in & attack unless he obeyed. Cain persecuted and killed his righteous brother Abel. This is an example of the enmity between the two seeds.
6. **MAT 13:37** He answered and said to them: "He who sows the good seed is the Son of Man. 38 "The field is the world, the good seeds are the sons of the kingdom, but the tares are the sons of the wicked one. 39 "The enemy who sowed them is the devil, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels. 40 "Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age. (NKJ)
7. Give **at least 5 scripture references** describing Satan as **'god of this age'**, **'prince of this world'**, or some other similar phrase or title: 2Co 4:4; MAT 4:8-9; JOH 12:31; JOH 14:30; JOH 16:11; 1CO 10:20; EPH 2:2; EPH 6:12; 1JO 5:19; REV 12:9; REV 20:2-3; etc. **Give a scripture** describing one of the temptations of Christ when Satan himself stated that he ruled over all **the kingdoms of this world**: MAT 4:8 Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. 9 And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me." (NKJ)
8. Write out **1JO 4:4**: You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world. (NKJ) **2CO 4:4** whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. (NKJ)
9. **WHAT** are the **three (3) fronts or realms of spiritual warfare or battle for believers?** Give three (3) or more scriptures illustrating each of these areas:  
 1. Satan & his demons or fallen angels, who rule the world through the wicked, the seed of the serpent.  
 2. The World System, which is the visible kingdom, led and controlled by the invisible Satanic hierarchy.  
 3. The Flesh, which is our fallen sin nature, the 'old man', the Adamic nature inherited from the first Adam.
10. **JAM 4:1** Where do wars and fights come from among you? Do they not come from your desires for pleasure that war in your members? 2 You lust and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and war. Yet you do not have because you do not ask. 3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your lusts. 4 Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. (NKJ)
11. **WHO** was **JAM 4:1-4** written to: to believers (Christians) Is it possible to live a life approved of by the **world** and still be pleasing to God? NO!! **Explain** why living life according to the **World System** is **spiritual adultery** against God: The entire world system is under the control of Satan, the god of this world; its entire purpose and plan is AGAINST God and His people. If we side in with the world and its ways, we are automatically at enmity with God. We CANNOT serve two masters simultaneously !! **Notice** in this scripture that the lusts to serve the world happen **within our very being !!!**

12. **1JO 2:15** Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world —the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life —is not of the Father but is of the world. 17 And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever. (NKJ)
13. Write out **JOH 12:25**: *“He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. (NKJ) **What** is the Greek word for the first ‘**life**’? psuche For ‘**world**’? kosmos For the last ‘**life**’? zoe **Why** the different words for life? We must give up our ‘soul life’ in order to receive ‘spiritual life’ from God; the two are irreconcilable and entire incompatible. No compromise is possible.*
14. Read **1CO 2:14**. What is the Greek word for ‘**natural man**’ in that verse? psuchikos What kind of life does the **natural man** live? Compare this to the ‘**spiritual man**’ (Greek **pneumatikos**): *The natural or ‘soul man’ lives by and through his soul – mind, will and emotions. He has no conscious connection with the spiritual realm, especially God. Therefore, he cannot know God or the things of God – they are ‘foolishness’ to him, since the things and ways of God are known only through the Spirit of God within the spirit of man.*
15. **IPE 4:12** Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; 13 but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ’s sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. (NKJ)
16. Read **1CO 3:1-3** **What** is the Greek word for ‘**spiritual**’? pneumatikos For ‘**carnal**’? sarkikos **Which** of the two is a ‘**babe in Christ**’? the sarkikos **What** are the characteristics of a ‘**sarkikos**’? *They are dominated in life by the FLESH (sarx) – that is why they are called ‘sarkikos’. The carnal man has not yet put to death the flesh and its desires, so cannot consistently hear or be led by the Holy Spirit. The result is that this person is up one day and down the next spiritually. There is no consistency in their lives. **What** is the root word for ‘**sarkikos**’? sarx = ‘flesh’ **What** does that say about the **primary motivation** of a **sarkikos**? Their primary motivation in life is still satisfying the lusts of the flesh.*
17. Write out **MAT 26:41**: *“Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.” (NKJ)* **Explain** how this scripture is applicable **every day for ALL believers**: *Every Christian must be on guard at all times against spiritual attack; only through prayer & Bible study can one remain alert & strong, lest the enemy attack via the flesh & gain the upper hand. Sin is STILL our greatest enemy – an enemy stronghold within our very being !!*
18. Write out **JOH 3:6**: *“That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.(NKJ)* Write out **JOH 6:63**: *“It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life. (NKJ)* **Explain** how these scriptures are applicable **every day for ALL believers**: *Nothing the flesh conceives or originates has any eternal value; only that which comes from the Spirit has eternal value.*
19. **ROM 2:28** For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh; 29 but he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God. (NKJ)
20. **ROM 7:22** For I delight in the law of God according to the inward man. 23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. 24 O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? 25 I thank God—through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin. (NKJ)
21. **ROM 8:1** There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. 3 For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, 4 that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. 5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. (NKJ)
22. From **ROM 8:1-5**, **WHAT** are the **TWO LAWS** that prevail over mankind (including Christians): 1. The Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus and 2. The Law of the Sin and Death Explain how **EVERY MOMENT of EVERY DAY** we **CHOOSE** which of these laws to put into operation in our lives: *These two laws are universal; however, which of the two laws governs our lives is our own choice. Even though I am a Christian, If I sin, the law of sin and death immediately goes into effect in my life. As long as I continue in sin, the consequences will get worse and worse, until I choose instead to obey and serve the Holy Spirit, at which time the life of Christ Jesus goes into effect within me. Every moment of every day I choose whether to serve Satan thru the world or my flesh, or to serve God through obedience to the Spirit.*
23. Read **ROM 13:12-14**. Write out **ROM 13:14**: *But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts. (NKJ)*
24. Read **1CO 5:4-5**. Explain how **God can actually use Satan and demons to chastise and refine a believer** in order to fulfil God’s promise to take away our sin: *We each must come to the realization of the absolute corruptness of the old man, & how desperately we need a savior. God allows Satan to operate powerfully in that part of our flesh that is ‘alive’, so that we experience first hand its corruption and power over us. This is meant to cause us to seek God and ‘put to death’ that part of our flesh so that it cannot corrupt again.*
25. **How** will you apply what you have learned in this lesson to **YOUR** life? Answer for yourself.
