

### GREEK DEFINITIONS

1. *exerchomai* NT:1831 NT:1537 and NT:2064; deliverance, to issue come (forth, out), depart (out of), escape, get out
2. *antidikos* NT:476 "an adversary or an enemy,"
3. *desmeuo or desmeo* NT:1195 "to put in fetters or any kind of bond,"
4. *apoluo* NT:630, *apo*, "from," and "to set free, release,"
5. *echthros* NT:2190, "hated" or "hateful"
6. *daimon* NT:1142, "a demon," signified, among pagan Greeks, an inferior deity, whether good or bad. In the NT it denotes "an evil spirit."
7. *daimonizomai* NT:1139, "to be possessed of a demon or demons"
8. *strateia, or- tia* NT:4756 "a host or army," came to denote "a warfare," and is used of spiritual "conflict"
9. *antichristos* NT:500 can mean either "against Christ" or "instead of Christ,"
