1. **ISA 42:9** Behold, the former things have come to pass, And new things I declare; Before they spring forth I tell you of them.”
2. **ISA 46:5** “To whom will you liken Me, and make Me equal And compare Me, that we should be alike? 10 **Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things that are not yet done**, Saying, ‘My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,’ 11 Calling a bird of prey from the east, The man who executes My counsel, from a far country. Indeed I have spoken it; I will also bring it to pass. I have purposed it; I will also do it.
3. **ECC 1:9** That which has been is what will be, That which is done is what will be done, And there is nothing new under the sun. 10 Is there anything of which it may be said, “See, this is new”? It has already been in ancient times before us.
4. **AMO 3:7** Surely the Lord God does nothing, Unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.
5. **MAT 13:34** All these things Jesus spoke to the multitude in parables; and without a parable He did not speak to them, 35 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: “I will open My mouth in parables; I will utter things kept secret from the foundation of the world.”
6. **LUK 24:27** And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself. 45 And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.
7. **JOH 16:12** I (Jesus) still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. 13 However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.
8. **REV 19:10** And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, “See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.”

EARLY BIBLE SCHOLARS & OTHER SOURCES

1. **Epistle of Barnabas 15:3-5** He speaks of the Sabbath at the beginning of the Creation, "And God made in six days the works of His hands and on the seventh day He made an end, and He rested on the seventh day, and He sanctified it. **Consider, my children what his signifies:** That He made an end in six days. The meaning of it is this: that in six thousand years the Creator will bring all things to an End, for with Him one day is a thousand years. He Himself testifies, saying, Behold **the day of the Lord shall be as a thousand years**. Therefore children, in six days, that is in six thousand years, all things shall be accomplished. And He rested on the seventh day: He means this, that when His Son shall come He will destroy the season of the wicked one, and will judge the godless, and will change the sun and the moon and the stars, and then He will truly rest on the seventh day.
2. **Secrets of Enoch 33:1** And I appointed **the eighth day also**, that the eighth day should be the first created after My work, & that the first seven revolve in the form of the seven thousand, & that at the beginning of the eighth thousand there should be a time of not counting, endless, with neither years nor months nor weeks nor days nor hours.

3. **Elijah (Eliyahu) 200 BC.** The world endures six thousand years; two thousand before the Torah, two thousand under the Torah, and two thousand under the Messiah. Irenaeus 150 AD. (was trained by Polycarp who was trained by John who wrote the Book of Revelation. Quote is from "Against Heresies" Book 5, 28, 3: For in as many days as this world was made, in so many thousand years shall it be concluded. This is an account of the things formerly created, as also it is a prophecy of what is to come. For the day of the Lord is as a thousand years; and in six days created things were completed; it is evident therefore, that they will come to an end at the six thousandth year.
4. **Cyprian 250 A.D.** (archchampion of orthodox Christianity against heresies) 'The Treatises Of Cyprian' Chapter 11: The first seven days in the Divine arrangement contain seven thousand years. Lactantius 300 A.D. (Tutor to the son of the Roman Emperor Constantine, was a highly respected scholar. He wrote sometime before his death in 330 A.D. the following in "The Divine Institutes" Book 7, Chapter 25: I have already shown above that when 6000 years shall be completed this change must take place. Chapter 26: But he (Satan) also, when the thousand years of the Kingdom, that is, 7000 of the world, shall begin to be ended, will be loosed afresh, and being sent forth from prison, will go forth and assemble all the nations, which shall then be under the dominion of the Righteous, that they may make war against the Holy City.
5. **Methodius 300 A.D.** (Banquet Of The Ten Virgins, Discourse 9, Chapter 1): For in six days God made the heaven and Earth, and finished the whole world . . . and blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, so by a figure in the seventh month (Tishri) when the fruits of the Earth have been gathered in, we are commanded to keep the Feast to the LORD, which signifies that, when this world shall be terminated at the seven thousand years, when God shall have completed the world, He shall rejoice in us. . . . Then, when the **appointed times** shall have been accomplished, and God shall have ceased to form this creation, in the seventh month, **the Great Resurrection Day**, it is commanded that the Feast of our Tabernacles shall be celebrated to the Lord.
6. **Latimer 1552 A.D.** The world was ordained to endure, as all learned men affirm, 6000 years. Now of that number there be passed 5,552 years, so that there is no more left but 448 years.
7. **Rabbi Ketina:** The world endures six thousand years and one thousand it shall be laid waste, whereof it is said 'The Lord alone shall be exalted in that day'. As out of seven years every seventh is a year of remission, that God alone may be exalted in that day.

1. **2PE 3:3** knowing this first: that **scoffers will come in the last days**, walking according to their own lusts, 4 and **saying, "Where is the promise of His coming?"** For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of creation." 5 For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water, 6 by which the world that then existed perished, being flooded with water. 7 But the heavens and the earth which are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the Day of Judgment & perdition of ungodly men. 8 But, beloved, **do not forget this ONE THING, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.** 9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. 10 But **the DAY OF THE LORD will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.**
 2. **PSA 90:4** **For a thousand years in Your sight Are like yesterday when it is past, And like a watch in the night.**
 3. **The Millennium: REV 20:1** Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. 2 He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and **bound him for a thousand years;** 3 and **he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished.** But after these things he must be released for a little while. 4 And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And **they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.** 5 But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. **This is the first resurrection.** 7 Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison 8 and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea.
 4. **6 Days of Creation Represent 6,000 years: 120 years God deals with man -- GEN 6:3** And the Lord said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh; yet **his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.**"
 5. **Noah preaches & builds ark for 120 years – 50 x 120 jubilees = 6,000 years: 1PE 3:20** who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water.

6. **Noah 600 years old when the rains start: GEN 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life**, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains of the great deep were broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened. 12 And the rain was on the earth forty days and forty nights.
7. **6 days to take Jericho – at the last trumpet blast on the SEVENTH DAY, the walls fall down: JOS 6:2** And the Lord said to Joshua: “See! I have given Jericho into your hand, its king, and the mighty men of valor. 3 “You shall march around the city, all you men of war; you shall go all around the city once. This you shall do six days. 4 “And seven priests shall bear seven trumpets of rams’ horns before the ark. But **the seventh day you shall march around the city seven times, and the priests shall blow the trumpets.** 5 “**It shall come to pass, when they make a long blast with the ram’s horn, and when you hear the sound of the trumpet, that all the people shall shout with a great shout; then the wall of the city will fall down flat.** And the people shall go up every man straight before him.”
8. **6 steps to Solomon’s throne – the 7th is the throne: 2CH 9:18 The throne had six steps**, with a footstool of gold, which were fastened to the throne; there were armrests on either side of the place of the seat, and two lions stood beside the armrests.
9. **Six Days at Mount Sinai: EXO 19 –20 EXO 24:13** So Moses arose with his assistant Joshua, and Moses went up to the mountain of God. 14 And he said to the elders, “Wait here for us until we come back to you. Indeed Aaron and Hur are with you. If any man has a difficulty, let him go to them.” 15 Then Moses went up into the mountain, and a cloud covered the mountain. 16 Now **the glory of the Lord rested on Mount Sinai, and THE CLOUD COVERED IT SIX DAYS. And ON THE SEVENTH DAY He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud.** 17 The sight of the glory of the Lord was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel. 18 So **Moses went into the midst of the cloud and went up into the mountain.** And Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights.
10. **God Comes Down in Sight of all the People on the THIRD DAY: EXO 19:10** Then the Lord said to Moses, “Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their clothes. 11 “And **let them be ready for the THIRD DAY.** For **on the THIRD DAY the Lord will come down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.** 16 Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were thunderings and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and **the sound of the trumpet** was very loud, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled. 17 And **Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet with God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain.**
11. **Abraham’s sacrifice of Isaac – on the third day: GEN 22:2** Then He said, “Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you.” 3 So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son; and he split the wood for the burnt offering, and arose and went to the place of which God had told him. 4 Then **on THE THIRD DAY Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place afar off.** 5 And Abraham said to his young men, “Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you.”
12. **Slaves worked for six years, but set free at the seventh year: EXO 21:2** “If you buy a Hebrew servant, **he shall serve six years; and in the seventh he shall go out free** and pay nothing.
13. **King Joash hidden in the temple for 6 years before ascending to the throne of Israel: 2KI 11:1** When Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the royal heirs. 2 But Jehosheba, the daughter of King Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him away from among the king’s sons who were being murdered; and they hid him and his nurse in the bedroom, from Athaliah, so that he was not killed. 3 So **he was hidden with her in the house of the Lord for six years**, while Athaliah reigned over the land. 4 In the seventh year Jehoiada sent and brought the captains of hundreds—of the bodyguards and the escorts—and brought them into the house of the Lord to him. And he made a covenant with them and took an oath from them in the house of the Lord, and showed them the king’s son. 21 **Jehoash was seven years old when he became king.**
14. **EST 5:1 Now it happened ON THE THIRD DAY that Esther put on her royal robes and stood in the inner court of the king’s palace**, across from the king’s house, while the king sat on his royal throne in the royal house, facing the entrance of the house.
15. **HOS 6:1** Come, and let us return to the Lord; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. 2 **After two days He will revive us; ON THE THIRD DAY He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight.**
16. **The Resurrection of Lazarus – sick for 2 days, dead for FOUR DAYS, then resurrected after 6 DAYS: JOH 11:21** Then Martha said to Jesus, “Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died. 22 “But even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You.” 23 Jesus said to her, “Your brother will rise again.” 24 Martha said to Him, “I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day.” 25 Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. 26 “And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?” 27 She said to Him, “Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who is to come into the world.”
17. **The Marriage at Cana in Galilee – On the THIRD DAY – Water turned into wine: JOH 2:1-10**
18. **The Good Samaritan – Pays the innkeeper for 2 DAYS, saying He will then come back – LUK 10:29-35**

19. **Joshua Crossing the Jordan River – ark crossed on the 4th day, but ark was to follow 2,000 cubits later.**
MAT 6:27 “Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature (life span)?”
JOS 3:2 So it was, **after three days**, that the officers went through the camp; 3 and they commanded the people, saying, “When you see the ark of the covenant of the Lord your God, and the priests, the Levites, bearing it, then you shall set out from your place and go after it. 4 **“Yet there shall be a space between you and it, about TWO THOUSAND CUBITS by measure.** Do not come near it, that you may know the way by which you must go, for you have not passed this way before.” 5 And Joshua said to the people, “Sanctify yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you.” 6 Then Joshua spoke to the priests, saying, “Take up the ark of the covenant and cross over before the people.” So they took up the ark of the covenant and went before the people.
20. **Sevens in the Bible:** There are Seven Days in a Week, Seven Months For the Religious Holidays, Seven Feasts commemorating God’s Salvation Plan, Seven Churches, Seven Spirits of God, Seven Angels over the Churches of God, Seven Seals, Seven Trumpets, Seven Vials, Seven Thunders, Seven years on the Tribulation, Seven Sevens plus a day (50) in a Jubilee, A Jubilee of days from Firstfruits to **Shavuot** (Pentecost), Seven days of calm in the ark before Noah’s rain started,
LEV 23:24 “Speak to the children of Israel, saying: **‘In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall have a Sabbath-rest, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation.** 25 ‘You shall do no customary work on it; and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord.’ ”
21. **The THIRD & SEVENTH Days:** **NUM 19:11** **‘He who touches the dead body of anyone shall be unclean seven days.** 12 **‘He shall purify himself with the water on the THIRD day and on the SEVENTH day; then he will be clean.** But **if he does not purify himself on the third day and on the seventh day, he will not be clean.** 13 ‘Whoever touches the body of anyone who has died, and does not purify himself, defiles the tabernacle of the Lord. That person shall be cut off from Israel. He shall be unclean, because the water of purification was not sprinkled on him; his uncleanness is still on him.
NUM 19:19 **‘The clean person shall sprinkle the unclean on the THIRD day and on the SEVENTH day; and on the SEVENTH day he shall purify himself, wash his clothes, and bathe in water; and at evening he shall be clean.** 20 **‘But the man who is unclean and does not purify himself, that person shall be cut off from among the assembly, because he has defiled the sanctuary of the Lord.** The water of purification has not been sprinkled on him; he is unclean.
NUMBERS 31:19 “And as for you, remain outside the camp seven days; whoever has killed any person, and whoever has touched any slain, **purify yourselves and your captives on the third day and on the seventh day.**
22. **EST 4:12** So they told Mordecai Esther’s words. 13 And Mordecai told them to answer Esther: **“Do not think in your heart that you will escape in the king’s palace any more than all the other Jews.** 14 **“For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father’s house will perish. YET WHO KNOWS WHETHER YOU HAVE COME TO THE KINGDOM FOR SUCH A TIME AS THIS?”** 15 Then Esther told them to reply to Mordecai: 16 “Go, gather all the Jews who are present in Shushan, and fast for me; neither eat nor drink for **THREE DAYS**, night or day. My maids and I will fast likewise. And so I will go to the king, which is against the law; and if I perish, I perish!” 17 So Mordecai went his way and did according to all that Esther commanded him.
23. **REV 20:4** And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And **they lived and reigned with Christ for a THOUSAND YEARS.** 5 But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. 6 Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but **they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.**
