

1. **REV 13:11** Then **I saw another beast coming up out of the earth**, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. 12 And **he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed**. 13 He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men. 14 And **he deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived**. 15 He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed. 16 **He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a MARK (charagma) on their right hand or on their foreheads**, 17 and **that no one may buy or sell except one who has the MARK (charagma) or the name of the beast, or the number of his name**. 18 Here is wisdom. **Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number is 666**.
2. **REV 14:9** Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, **“If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his MARK (charagma) on his forehead or on his hand, 10 “he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. 11 “And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.”**
3. **REV 15:1** Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having the seven last plagues, for in them the wrath of God is complete. 2 And **I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his MARK (charagma) and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God**. 3 They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: “Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints!
4. **REV 16:1** Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, “Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth.” 2 So the first went and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and **a foul and loathsome sore came upon the men who had the MARK (charagma) of the beast & those who worshiped his image**.
5. **REV 19:19** And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. 20 Then **the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the MARK (charagma) of the beast and those who worshiped his image**. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.
6. **REV 20:4** And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then **I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his MARK (charagma) on their foreheads or on their hands**. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. 5 But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. **This is the first resurrection**. 6 Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but **they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years**.
7. **LEV 19:28** You **shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor tattoo any marks on you: I am the LORD**.
8. **DAN 3:1** **Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height was SIXTY CUBITS and its width SIX CUBITS**. He set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.
9. **DAN 3:4** A herald cried out: **“Nations and peoples of every language, when you hear the sound of the TRUMPET, FLUTE, LYRE, HARP, PSALTERY, BAGPIPE, and all the other musical instruments, 5 you are ordered to fall down and worship the golden image which King Nebuchadnezzar has set up. 6 Whoever does not fall down and worship shall be instantly cast into a fiery furnace.”**
10. **DAN 3:12** “There are certain Jews whom you have set over the affairs of the province of Babylon: **Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego**; these men, O king, have not paid due regard to you. **They do not serve your gods or worship the gold image which you have set up**.” 13 Then Nebuchadnezzar, in rage and fury, gave the command to bring Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego. So they brought these men before the king. 14 Nebuchadnezzar spoke, saying to them, “Is it true, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, that you do not serve my gods or worship the gold image which I have set up?”

11. **DAN 3:16** Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego answered and said to the king, “O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter. 17 “If that is the case, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us from your hand, O king. 18 “But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we do not serve your gods, nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up.” 19 Then Nebuchadnezzar was full of fury, and the expression on his face changed toward Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego. He spoke and commanded that they heat the furnace SEVEN TIMES more than it was usually heated. 20 And he commanded certain mighty men of valor who were in his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, and cast them into the burning fiery furnace. 21 Then these men were bound in their coats, their trousers, their turbans, and their other garments, and were cast into the midst of the burning fiery furnace. 22 Therefore, because the king’s command was urgent, and the furnace exceedingly hot, the flame of the fire killed those men who took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego. 23 And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace. 24 Then King Nebuchadnezzar was astonished; and he rose in haste and spoke, saying to his counselors, “Did we not cast three men bound into the midst of the fire?” They answered and said to the king, “True, O king.” 25 “Look!” he answered, “I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire; and they are not hurt, and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.” 26 Then Nebuchadnezzar went near the mouth of the burning fiery furnace and spoke, saying, “Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, servants of the Most High God, come out, and come here.” Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego came from the midst of the fire. 27 And the satraps, administrators, governors, and the king’s counselors gathered together, and they saw these men on whose bodies the fire had no power; the hair of their head was not singed nor were their garments affected, and the smell of fire was not on them. 28 Nebuchadnezzar spoke, saying, “Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, who sent His Angel and delivered His servants who trusted in Him, and they have frustrated the king’s word, and yielded their bodies, that they should not serve nor worship any god except their own God!” 29 “Therefore I make a decree that any people, nation, or language which speaks anything amiss against the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego shall be cut in pieces, and their houses shall be made an ash heap; because there is no other God who can deliver like this.” 30 Then the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego in the province of Babylon.

#### The Mark of Yahweh

12. **EXO 13:9** “It shall be as a sign to you on your HAND and as a memorial BETWEEN YOUR EYES, that the Lord’s law may be in your mouth; for with a strong hand the Lord has brought you out of Egypt. 10 “You shall therefore keep this ordinance in its season from year to year. 16 “It shall be as a sign on your HAND and as FRONTLETS BETWEEN YOUR EYES, for by strength of hand the Lord brought us out of Egypt.”
13. **DEU 6:4** “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! 5 “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. 6 “And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. 7 “You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. 8 “You shall bind them as a SIGN ON YOUR HAND, and they shall be as FRONTLETS BETWEEN YOUR EYES. 9 “You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
14. **DEU 11:18** “Therefore you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your HAND, and they shall be as FRONTLETS BETWEEN YOUR EYES.
15. **EZE 9:4** and the Lord said to him, “Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and put a MARK on the foreheads of the men who sigh and cry over all the abominations that are done within it.” 5 To the others He said in my hearing, “Go after him through the city and kill; do not let your eye spare, nor have any pity. 6 “Utterly slay old and young men, maidens and little children and women; but do not come near anyone on whom is the MARK; and begin at My sanctuary.” So they began with the elders who were before the temple. 7 Then He said to them, “Defile the temple, and fill the courts with the slain. Go out!” And they went out and killed in the city. 8 So it was, that while they were killing them, I was left alone; and I fell on my face and cried out, and said, “Ah, Lord God! Will You destroy all the remnant of Israel in pouring out Your fury on Jerusalem?” 9 Then He said to me, “The iniquity of the house of Israel and Judah is exceedingly great, and the land is full of bloodshed, and the city full of perversity; for they say, “The Lord has forsaken the land, and the Lord does not see!” 10 “And as for Me also, My eye will neither spare, nor will I have pity, but I will recompense their deeds on their own head.” 11 Just then, the man clothed with linen, who had the inkhorn at his side, reported back and said, “I have done as You commanded me.”
16. **2CO 1:21** Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, 22 who also has SEALED US and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.
17. **EPH 1:13** In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were SEALED with the Holy Spirit of promise, 14 who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.
18. **REV 7:3** saying, “Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads.” 4 And I heard the number of those who were SEALED. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were SEALED:
