

**Seven Seals**

<p><b><u>1st Seal</u></b>  <b>REV 6:1</b> Now I saw when the Lamb opened <b>one of the seals</b>; and I heard one of the four living creatures saying with a voice like thunder, "Come and see." 2 And I looked, and behold, <b>a white horse</b>. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering &amp; to conquer.</p>	<p><b><u>2nd Seal</u></b>  <b>REV 6:3</b> When He opened the <b>second seal</b>, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come and see." 4 <b>Another horse, fiery red</b>, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that people should kill one another; and there was given to him a great sword.</p>	<p><b><u>3rd Seal</u></b>  <b>REV 6:5</b> When He opened the <b>third seal</b>, I heard the third living creature say, "Come and see." So I looked, and behold, <b>a black horse</b>, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. 6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine."</p>	<p><b><u>4th Seal</u></b>  <b>REV 6:7</b> When He opened the <b>fourth seal</b>, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come and see." 8 So I looked, and behold, <b>a pale horse</b>. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the beasts of the earth.</p>	<p><b><u>5th Seal</u></b>  <b>REV 6:9</b> When He opened the <b>fifth seal</b>, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. 10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" 11 Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.</p>	<p><b><u>6th Seal</u></b>  <b>REV 6:12</b> I looked when He opened the <b>sixth seal</b>, and behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood. 13 And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, as a fig tree drops its late figs when it is shaken by a mighty wind. 14 Then the sky receded as a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island was moved out of its place. 15 And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains, 16 and said to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! 17 "For <b>the great day of His WRATH has come</b>, and who is able to stand?"</p>	<p><b><u>7th Seal</u></b>  <b>REV 8:1</b> When He opened the <b>seventh seal</b>, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. 2 And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given <b>seven trumpets</b>. 3 Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. 4 And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand. 5 Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw it to the earth. And there were noises, thunderings, lightnings, and an earthquake. 6 So the seven angels who had <b>the SEVEN TRUMPETS prepared themselves to sound</b>.</p>

**Seven Trumpets & 3 Woes**

<p><b><u>1st Trumpet</u></b>  <b>REV 8:7</b> <b>The first angel sounded:</b> And hail and fire followed, mingled with blood, &amp; they were thrown to the earth. And a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.</p>	<p><b><u>2nd Trumpet</u></b>  <b>REV 8:8</b> Then <b>the second angel sounded:</b> And something like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood. 9 And a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.</p>	<p><b><u>3rd Trumpet</u></b>  <b>REV 8:10</b> Then <b>the third angel sounded:</b> And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. 11 The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.</p>	<p><b><u>4th Trumpet &amp; 3 Woes</u></b>  <b>REV 8:12</b> Then <b>the fourth angel sounded:</b> And a third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them were darkened. A third of the day did not shine, and likewise the night. 13 And I looked, and I heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, "<b>Woe, woe, woe</b> to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!"</p>	<p><b><u>5th Trumpet</u></b>  <b>REV 9:1</b> Then <b>the fifth angel sounded:</b> And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit. 2 And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit. 3 Then out of the smoke locusts came upon the earth. And to them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power. 4 They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth, or any green thing, or any tree, but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. 5 And they were not given authority to kill them, but to torment them for five months. Their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it strikes a man. 6 In those days men will seek death and will not find it; they will desire to die, and death will flee from them. 7 The shape of the locusts was like horses prepared for battle. On their heads were crowns of something like gold, and their faces were like the faces of men. 8 They had hair like women's hair, and their teeth were like lions' teeth. 9 And they had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the sound of their wings was like the sound of chariots with many horses running into battle. 10 They had tails like scorpions, and there were stings in their tails. Their power was to hurt men five months. 11 And they had as king over them the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in Hebrew is Abaddon, but in Greek he has the name Apollyon. 12 <b>One woe</b> is past. Behold, still <b>two more woes</b> are coming after these things.</p>	<p><b><u>6th Trumpet</u></b>  <b>REV 9:13</b> Then <b>the sixth angel sounded:</b> And I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, 14 saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates." 15 So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released to kill a third of mankind. 16 Now the number of the army of the horsemen was two hundred million; I heard the number of them. 17 And thus I saw the horses in the vision: those who sat on them had breastplates of fiery red, hyacinth blue, and sulfur yellow; and the heads of the horses were like the heads of lions; and out of their mouths came fire, smoke, and brimstone. 18 By these three plagues a third of mankind was killed—by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone which came out of their mouths. 19 For their power is in their mouth and in their tails; for their tails are like serpents, having heads; and with them they do harm. 20 But the rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and idols of gold, silver, brass, stone, and wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk. 21 And they did not repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.</p>	<p><b><u>7th Trumpet</u></b>  <b>REV 11:15</b> Then <b>the seventh angel sounded:</b> &amp; there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "<b>The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!</b>" 16 And the twenty-four elders who sat before God on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped God, 17 saying: "We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, The One who is and who was and who is to come, Because You have taken Your great power and reigned. 18 The nations were angry, and <b>Your WRATH has come</b>, And the time of the dead, that they should be judged, And that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, And those who fear Your name, small and great, And should destroy those who destroy the earth." 19 Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.</p>

**Seven Thunders**

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Seven Thunders</u></b></p> <p><b>REV 10:1</b> I saw still another mighty angel coming down from heaven, clothed with a cloud. And a rainbow was on his head, his face was like the sun, and his feet like pillars of fire. 2 He had a little book open in his hand. And he set his right foot on the sea and his left foot on the land, 3 and cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roars. When he cried out, <b>seven thunders</b> uttered their voices. 4 Now when the <b>seven thunders</b> uttered their voices, I was about to write; but I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, "<b>Seal up the things which the seven thunders uttered, and do not write them!</b>" 5 The angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised up his hand to heaven 6 and swore by Him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there should be delay no longer, 7 <b>but in the days of the SOUNDING OF THE SEVENTH ANGEL, when he is about to sound, the mystery of God would be finished</b>, as He declared to His servants the prophets. 8 Then the voice which I heard from heaven spoke to me again and said, "Go, take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel who stands on the sea and on the earth." 9 So I went to the angel and said to him, "Give me the little book." And he said to me, "Take and eat it; and it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth." 10 Then I took the little book out of the angel's hand and ate it, and it was as sweet as honey in my mouth. But when I had eaten it, my stomach became bitter. 11 And he said to me, "You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, tongues, and kings."</p>

**Seven Last Plagues**

<p><b><u>Seven Last Plagues (Bowls – Vials)</u></b>  <b>REV 15:1</b> Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having <b>the seven last plagues</b>, for <b>in them the WRATH OF GOD is complete</b>. 2 And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God. 3 They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: "Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints! 4 Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested." 5 After these things I looked, and behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened. 6 And out of the temple came <b>the seven angels having the SEVEN PLAGUES</b>, clothed in pure bright linen, and having their chests girded with golden bands. 7 Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels <b>SEVEN GOLDEN BOWLS full of the WRATH OF GOD</b> who lives forever and ever. 8 The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.</p>	<p><b><u>1st Bowl</u></b>  <b>REV 16:1</b> Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth." 2 So the first went and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and a foul and loathsome sore came upon the men who had the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.</p>	<p><b><u>2nd Bowl</u></b>  <b>REV 16:3</b> Then the second angel poured out his bowl on the sea, and it became blood as of a dead man; and every living creature in the sea died.</p>	<p><b><u>3rd Bowl</u></b>  <b>REV 16:4</b> Then the third angel poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became blood. 5 And I heard the angel of the waters saying: "You are righteous, O Lord, The One who is and who was and who is to be, Because You have judged these things. 6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, And You have given them blood to drink. For it is their just due." 7 And I heard another from the altar saying, "Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments."</p>	<p><b><u>4th Bowl</u></b>  <b>REV 16:8</b> Then the fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and power was given to him to scorch men with fire. 9 And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not repent and give Him glory.</p>	<p><b><u>5th Bowl</u></b>  <b>REV 16:10</b> Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. 11 They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.</p>	<p><b><u>6th Bowl</u></b>  <b>REV 16:12</b> Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the east might be prepared. 13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. 14 For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty. 15 "Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame." 16 And they gathered them together to the place called in Hebrew, Armageddon.</p>	<p><b><u>7th Bowl</u></b>  <b>REV 16:17</b> Then the seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, "<b>It is done!</b>" 18 And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth. 19 Now the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. <b>And great Babylon was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath.</b> 20 Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. 21 And great hail from heaven fell upon men, each hailstone about the weight of a talent. Men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, since that plague was exceedingly great.</p>
