

1. **JOH 5:39** You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of ME.
2. **COL 2:16** So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or Sabbaths, 17 which are a SHADOW OF THINGS TO COME, but the substance is of CHRIST.

Passover

3. **EXO 12:1** Now the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, 2 “This month (*Abib*) shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you. 3 “Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: ‘On the tenth day of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household. 4 ‘And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next to his house take it according to the number of the persons; according to each man’s need you shall make your count for the lamb. 5 ‘Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats. 6 ‘Now you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight. 7 ‘And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it. 8 ‘Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, with unleavened bread and with bitter herbs they shall eat it. 9 ‘Do not eat it raw, nor boiled at all with water, but roasted in fire—its head with its legs and its entrails. 10 ‘You shall let none of it remain until morning, and what remains of it until morning you shall burn with fire. 11 ‘And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. It is the Lord’s Passover. 12 ‘For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the Lord. 13 ‘Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. 14 ‘So this day shall be to you a memorial; and you shall keep it as a feast to the Lord throughout your generations. You shall keep it as a feast by an everlasting ordinance.
4. **LEV 23:4** “These are the feasts (*moedim*) of the Lord, holy convocations (*miqra*) which you shall proclaim at their appointed times (moed). 5 ‘On the fourteenth day of the first month at twilight is the Lord’s Passover (*pesach*).
5. **JOH 1:29** The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!
6. **JOH 6:53** Then Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. 54 “Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.
7. **JOH 19:14** Now it was the Preparation Day of the Passover, and about the sixth hour. And he (Pilate) said to the Jews, “Behold your King!”
8. **1CO 5:6** Your boasting is not good. Don’t you know that a little yeast works through the whole batch of dough? 7 Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast—as you really are. For Christ, our PASSOVER lamb, has been sacrificed.
9. **1PE 1:18** knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

Unleavened Bread

10. **EXO 12:15** “Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread (*matzah*). On the first day you shall remove leaven from your houses. For whoever eats leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that person shall be cut off from Israel. 16 ‘On the first day there shall be a holy convocation, and on the seventh day there shall be a holy convocation for you. No manner of work shall be done on them; but that which everyone must eat—that only may be prepared by you. 17 ‘So you shall observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread, for on this same day I will have brought your armies out of the land of Egypt. Therefore you shall observe this day throughout your generations as an everlasting ordinance. 18 ‘In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at evening, you shall eat unleavened bread, until the twenty-first day of the month at evening. 19 ‘For seven days no leaven shall be found in your houses, since whoever eats what is leavened, that same person shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he is a stranger or a native of the land. 20 ‘You shall eat nothing leavened; in all your dwellings you shall eat unleavened bread.’ ”
11. **LEV 23:6** ‘And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast (*moed*) of Unleavened Bread (*matsah*) to the Lord; seven days you must eat unleavened bread (*matsah*). 7 ‘On the first day you shall have a holy (qodesh) convocation (miqra); you shall do no customary work on it. 8 ‘But you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord for seven days. The seventh day shall be a holy convocation (miqra); you shall do no customary work on it.’ ”
12. **JOH 6:35** And Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.

13. **LUK 22:19** And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, **“This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”** 20 Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.
14. **ACT 2:27** For You will not leave my soul in Hades, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.
15. **ICO 5:7** **Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast—as you really are.** For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. 8 Therefore **let us keep THE FESTIVAL (OF UNLEAVENED BREAD), not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with bread without yeast, the bread of sincerity and truth.**
16. **2CO 5:21** For **He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.**
17. **EPH 4:22** that **you PUT OFF, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts,** 23 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, 24 and **that you PUT ON the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.**

FirstFruits

18. **LEV 23:9** And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 10 “Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: **‘When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the FIRSTFRUITS (re’shiyth) of your harvest to the priest.** 11 **‘He shall wave the sheaf before the Lord, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.** 12 ‘And you shall offer on that day, when you wave the sheaf, a male lamb of the first year, without blemish, as a burnt offering to the Lord. 13 ‘Its grain offering shall be two-tenths of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil, an offering made by fire to the Lord, for a sweet aroma; and its drink offering shall be of wine, one-fourth of a hin. 14 ‘You shall eat neither bread nor parched grain nor fresh grain until the same day that you have brought an offering to your God; **it shall be a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.**
19. **MAT 12:40** “For **as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.**
20. **ROM 11:16** For **if the FIRSTFRUIT is holy, the lump is also holy;** and if the root is holy, so are the branches.
21. **ICO 15:3** For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that **He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,**
22. **ICO 15:20** But **Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the FIRSTFRUITS of those who have fallen asleep.** 21 For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. 22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. 23 But **each one in his own order: Christ the FIRSTFRUITS, afterward those who are Christ’s at His coming.**
23. **COL 1:15** He is the image of the invisible God, **the FIRSTBORN over all creation.** 18 & **He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the FIRSTBORN from the dead,** that in all things He may have the preeminence.

Pentecost

24. **LEV 23:15** ‘And **you shall count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: seven Sabbaths shall be completed.** 16 **‘Count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall offer a new grain offering to the Lord.** 17 ‘You shall bring from your dwellings **TWO WAVE LOAVES of two-tenths of an ephah. They shall be of fine flour; they shall be baked WITH LEAVEN. They are the firstfruits to the Lord.** 18 ‘And you shall offer with the bread seven lambs of the first year, without blemish, one young bull, and two rams. They shall be as a burnt offering to the Lord, with their grain offering and their drink offerings, an offering made by fire for a sweet aroma to the Lord. 19 ‘Then you shall sacrifice one kid of the goats as a sin offering, and two male lambs of the first year as a sacrifice of a peace offering. 20 **‘The priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits as a wave offering before the Lord, with the two lambs.** They shall be holy to the Lord for the priest. 21 **‘And you shall proclaim on the same day that it is a holy convocation to you. You shall do no customary work on it. It shall be a statute forever in all your dwellings throughout your generations.** 22 ‘When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not wholly reap the corners of your field when you reap, nor shall you gather any gleaning from your harvest. You shall leave them for the poor and for the stranger: I am the Lord your God.’ ”
25. **ACT 1:8** “But **you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”**
26. **ACT 2:1** **When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.** 2 Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. 4 **All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit** and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.
27. **ROM 8:1** **There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.** 2 For **the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.**
28. **HEB 10:16** **“This is the covenant that I will make with them** after those days, says the Lord: **I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them.”**
