

1. **MAT 5:17** “Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to FULFILL.
2. **ICO 10:11** Now all these things happened to them (Israel in the OT) as examples, and they were written for OUR admonition, upon whom the ends of the ages have come.

Feast of Trumpets (Rosh Hashannah – Yom Teruah)
--

3. **EXO 19:19** And when the blast of the TRUMPET (*shofar*) sounded long and became louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him by voice.
4. **LEV 23:23** Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 24 “Speak to the children of Israel, saying: ‘In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall have a Sabbath-rest, a memorial of BLOWING OF TRUMPETS (*yom teruah*), a holy convocation. 25 ‘You shall do no customary work on it; and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord.’ ”
5. **NUM 10:10** “Also in the day of your gladness, in your appointed feasts, and at the beginning of your months, you shall blow the TRUMPETS (*chatsotserah*) over your burnt offerings and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; and they shall be a memorial for you before your God: I am the Lord your God.”
6. **ISA 27:13** So it shall be in THAT DAY: The great TRUMPET (*shofar*) will be blown; They will come, who are about to perish in the land of Assyria, And they who are outcasts in the land of Egypt, And shall worship the Lord in the holy mount at Jerusalem.
7. **ZEC 9:14** Then the Lord will be seen over them, And His arrow will go forth like lightning. The Lord God will blow the TRUMPET (*shofar*), And go with whirlwinds from the south.
8. **MAT 24:29** “Immediately AFTER the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. 30 “then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. 31 “And He will send His angels with a great sound of a TRUMPET (*salpinx*), and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.
9. **ICO 15:52** in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the TRUMPET (*salpinx*) will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
10. **1TH 4:16** For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the TRUMPET call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.
11. **REV 11:15** Then the seventh angel sounded (*the seventh TRUMPET*): And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!”

Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur)

12. **LEV 23:26** And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: 27 “Also the tenth day of this seventh month shall be the Day of ATONEMENT (*Yom Kippur*). It shall be a holy convocation (*miqra*) for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. 28 “And you shall do no work on that same day, for it is the Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you before the Lord your God. 29 “For any person who is not afflicted in soul on that same day shall be cut off from his people. 30 “And any person who does any work on that same day, that person I will destroy from among his people. 31 “You shall do no manner of work; it shall be a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. 32 “It shall be to you a Sabbath of solemn rest, and you shall afflict your souls; on the ninth day of the month at evening, from evening to evening, you shall celebrate your Sabbath.”
13. **LEV 25:9** “Then you shall cause the TRUMPET (*shofar*) of the Jubilee to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the DAY OF ATONEMENT you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land.
14. **JER 30:7** Alas! For that day is great, So that none is like it; And it is the time of Jacob’s trouble, But he shall be saved out of it.
15. **ZEC 12:10** “And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.
16. **ROM 11:26** And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: “The deliverer will come from Zion; He will turn godlessness away from Jacob. 27 And this is my covenant with them when I take away their sins.”
17. **2CO 5:10** For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.
18. **HEB 9:22** And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission (*atonement*).
19. **HEB 9:28** so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkot)

20. **LEV 23:33** Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 34 “Speak to the children of Israel, saying: **‘The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the Feast of Tabernacles for seven days to the Lord.** 35 ‘On the first day there shall be a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work on it. 36 ‘For seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it. 37 **‘These are the feasts (moedim) of the Lord which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations (miqra), to offer an offering made by fire to the Lord, a burnt offering and a grain offering, a sacrifice and drink offerings, everything on its day—** 38 ‘besides the Sabbaths of the Lord, besides your gifts, besides all your vows, and besides all your freewill offerings which you give to the Lord. 39 ‘Also on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the fruit of the land, you shall keep the feast of the Lord for seven days; on the first day there shall be a Sabbath-rest, and on the eighth day a Sabbath-rest. 40 **‘And you shall take for yourselves on the first day the fruit of beautiful trees, branches of palm trees, the boughs of leafy trees, and willows of the brook; and you shall rejoice before the Lord your God for seven days.** 41 ‘You shall keep it as a feast to the Lord for seven days in the year. **It shall be a statute forever in your generations.** You shall celebrate it in the seventh month. 42 **‘You shall dwell in booths (sukkot) for seven days.** All who are native Israelites shall dwell in booths, 43 ‘that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God.’ ”
21. **ZEC 13:1** “In that day a fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for uncleanness.
22. **ZEC 14:16** **And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.** 17 And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, on them there will be no rain. 18 If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; they shall receive the plague with which the Lord strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. 19 **This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.**
23. **MAT 17:1** Now **after six days** Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, led them up on a high mountain by themselves; 2 and **He was TRANSFIGURED before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light.** 3 And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him. 4 Then Peter answered and said to Jesus, **‘Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, let us make here three TABERNACLES: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.’**”
24. **JOH 7:37** **On the last day, that great day of the feast (of Tabernacles), Jesus stood and cried out, saying, ‘If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.** 38 “He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, **out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.**” 39 But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.
25. **REV 7:13** Then one of the elders asked me, “These in white robes—who are they, and where did they come from?” 14 I answered, “Sir, you know.” And he said, “These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. 15 Therefore, “they are before the throne of God and serve him day and night in his temple; and **He who sits on the throne will spread his tent over them.** 16 Never again will they hunger; never again will they thirst. The sun will not beat upon them, nor any scorching heat. 17 For **the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd; he will lead them to springs of living water.** And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.”

The Eighth Day

26. **LEV 23:36** ‘For seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. **On the EIGHTH DAY you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it.** 39 ‘Also on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the fruit of the land, you shall keep the feast of the Lord for seven days; on the first day there shall be a Sabbath-rest, and on the eighth day a Sabbath-rest.
27. **LEV 12:3** ‘And **on the EIGHTH DAY the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.**
28. **DEU 30:6** “And **the Lord your God will CIRCUMCISE your heart and the heart of your descendants, to love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.**”
29. **LUK 1:59** So it was, **on the EIGHTH DAY, that they came to circumcise the child;** and they would have called him by the name of his father, Zacharias. 60 His mother answered and said, “No; he shall be called John.”
30. **COL 2:11** **In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ,** 12 buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.
31. **EZE 43:27** **‘When these days are over it shall be, on the EIGHTH DAY and thereafter, that the priests shall offer your burnt offerings and your peace offerings on the altar; and I will accept you,’** says the Lord God.”
