- GEN 1:13** So the evening and the morning were the third day. 14 Then God said, "Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and **let them be for signs and seasons (moedim), and for days and years;** 15 "and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth"; and it was so. 16 Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. - LEV 23:1** And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 2 "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: **'The feasts (moedim) of the LORD, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations (miqra), these are My feasts (moedim).** 3 'Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation (miqra). You shall do no work on it; it is the Sabbath of the Lord in all your dwellings. 4 **'These are the feasts of the Lord, holy convocations (moedim) which you shall proclaim at their appointed times (moedim).**
