

1. **Ecumenism** - The movement of Christian Churches toward a mutual understanding of their problems and the concept of unity and love willed by Christ. A movement to unite the Christian churches split apart mostly by the Protestant Reformation and the Great Schism. Ecumenism seeks increased understanding and unity on doctrinal issues among the different Christian churches.

As one interfaithist recently stated, ‘All spiritual paths lead up to the same mountaintop called God.’ In Christian theology, *universalism*, or *universal salvation*, is the doctrine that all people will eventually be saved and go to heaven when they die. Some universalists believe that some will endure a limited period of punishment before going to heaven. In comparative religion, a *universalist* religion is one that holds itself true for all people; it thus allows all to join, regardless of ethnicity.
