

Prophecies About Israel

ZEC 12:2 Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah and against Jerusalem. 3 And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people: all that burden themselves with it shall be cut in pieces, though all the people of the earth be gathered together against it.

Prophecies About Israel's Destruction

DESTRUCTION OF ISRAEL

The Assyrians conquered and destroyed the northern kingdom of Israel in about 722 BC (about 2700 years ago). The Babylonians destroyed Jerusalem in 586 BC (about 2600 years ago). Jerusalem and the Temple were later rebuilt but were destroyed again, this time by the Romans 70 AD. In 135 AD, the Romans again attacked and destroyed Jerusalem.

DAN 9:26 "And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined.

1. The Bible foreshadowed Rome's destruction of Israel

DEU 28:49 "The Lord will bring a nation against you from afar, from the end of the earth, as swift as the eagle flies, a nation whose language you will not understand, 50 "a nation of fierce countenance, which does not respect the elderly nor show favor to the young. 51 "And they shall eat the increase of your livestock and the produce of your land, until you are destroyed; they shall not leave you grain or new wine or oil, or the increase of your cattle or the offspring of your flocks, until they have destroyed you. 52 "They shall besiege you at all your gates until your high and fortified walls, in which you trust, come down throughout all your land; and they shall besiege you at all your gates throughout all your land which the Lord your God has given you. **Written: perhaps 1400 BC** **Fulfilled: 70 AD**

2. Israel would become a wasteland

DEU 29:23 'The whole land is brimstone, salt, and burning; it is not sown, nor does it bear, nor does any grass grow there, like the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboim, which the Lord overthrew in His anger and His wrath.'

3. The Jews would live many days without a king

HOS 3:4 For the children of Israel shall abide many days without king or prince, without sacrifice or sacred pillar, without ephod or teraphim. 5 Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek the Lord their God and David their king. They shall fear the Lord and His goodness in the latter days. **Written: about 750 BC** **Fulfilled: Being fulfilled since 70 AD**

4. The Jewish homeland would be inhabited by enemies

LEV 26:31 I will lay your cities waste and bring your sanctuaries to desolation, and I will not smell the fragrance of your sweet aromas. 32 I will bring the land to desolation, and your enemies who dwell in it shall be astonished at it.

Written: perhaps around 1400 BC **Fulfilled: 135 to today**

5. Jesus said Jerusalem would be destroyed

LUK 21:24 "And they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled. **Recorded: about 30 AD** **Fulfilled: 70 AD**

6. Jesus prophesied that the Temple would be destroyed

MAT 24:1 Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. 2 And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down." **Recorded: about 30 AD** **Fulfilled: 70 AD**

7. Jerusalem would be destroyed and "plowed like a field"

MIC 3:11 Her heads judge for a bribe, Her priests teach for pay, And her prophets divine for money. Yet they lean on the Lord, and say, "Is not the Lord among us? No harm can come upon us." 12 Therefore because of you Zion shall be plowed like a field, Jerusalem shall become heaps of ruins, And the mountain of the temple Like the bare hills of the forest.

Prophecies About Exile & Persecution of Israel

EXILE OF ISRAEL

Many people in the northern kingdom of Israel were exiled by the Assyrians in about 722 BC, about 2700 years ago. And many people in the southern kingdom of Judah, which included Jerusalem, were exiled by the Babylonians between 605 BC and 586 BC, about 2600 years ago. But, shortly after the fall of Babylon in 539 BC, many Jews returned to their homeland. However, when the Romans exiled the Jews from their homeland between 70 AD and 135 AD, they were scattered throughout the world and were unable to return to their homeland in large numbers until recently, during the past two centuries.

1. Moses prophesied the worldwide persecution and scattering of Jews

DEU 4:25 "When you beget children and grandchildren and have grown old in the land, and act corruptly and make a carved image in the form of anything, and do evil in the sight of the Lord your God to provoke Him to anger, 26 "I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that you will soon utterly perish from the land which you cross over the Jordan to possess; you will not prolong your days in it, but will be utterly destroyed. 27 "And the Lord will scatter you among the peoples, and you will be left few in number among the nations where the Lord will drive you. 30 "When you are in distress, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, when you turn to the Lord your God and obey His voice. **Written: perhaps 1400 BC** **Fulfilled: During the past 3000 years**

2. **The Jews would be exiled, scorned and ridiculed**
DEU 28:36 “The Lord will bring you and the king whom you set over you to a nation which neither you nor your fathers have known, and there you shall serve other gods—wood and stone. 37 “And you shall become an astonishment, a proverb, and a byword among all nations where the Lord will drive you. **Written: perhaps 1400 BC** **Fulfilled: 135-1900s**
3. **Jews would be persecuted in many nations**
DEU 28:65 “And among those nations you shall find no rest, nor shall the sole of your foot have a resting place; but there the Lord will give you a trembling heart, failing eyes, and anguish of soul. 66 “Your life shall hang in doubt before you; you shall fear day and night, and have no assurance of life. 67 “In the morning you shall say, ‘Oh, that it were evening!’ And at evening you shall say, ‘Oh, that it were morning!’ because of the fear which terrifies your heart, and because of the sight which your eyes see. **Written: perhaps 1400 BC** **Fulfilled: 1940s, 1930s, 135 AD, 721 BC, etc.**

DEU 28:64 “Then the LORD will scatter you among all peoples, from one end of the earth to the other, and there you shall serve other gods, which neither you nor your fathers have known—wood and stone.

6. **The Jews would be scattered to other countries**
EZE 22:14 “Can your heart endure, or can your hands remain strong, in the days when I shall deal with you? I, the LORD, have spoken, and will do *it*. 15 “I will scatter you among the nations, disperse you throughout the countries, and remove your filthiness completely from you. **Written: between 593-571 BC** **Fulfilled: since 70 AD**
7. **Jacob saw a vision of Israel's future**

Prophecies About the Persecution Of Israel

Many people today are aware of the Holocaust in which Nazi's murdered 6 million Jews in Europe. But Jews have endured intense persecutions for many centuries before that. From 70 AD to 135 AD, the Romans killed about 1.8 million Jews in Jerusalem. Later, various Crusades and Pogroms resulted in the deaths of tens of thousands of Jews and the burning of entire Jewish villages. Many European nations exiled Jews from their borders at different times throughout the past 19 centuries. And, the ancient destructions of Israel by the Assyrians and Babylonians nearly destroyed the Jewish people and the country of Israel.

RESTORATION OF ISRAEL

Bible prophets, more than 2000 years ago, often spoke of a future restoration of the land of Israel. Many of those prophets lived during times in which their homeland was being conquered and destroyed by a succession of ancient empires. Today, we can see with our own eyes what some of those prophets saw with theirs - the current restoration of Israel - a nation that until 1948 had not been a united and sovereign nation for nearly 2900 years.

AMO 9:11 “On that day I will raise up The tabernacle of David, which has fallen down, And repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins, And rebuild it as in the days of old; 12 That they may possess the remnant of Edom, And all the Gentiles who are called by My name,” Says the Lord who does this thing. 13 “Behold, the days are coming,” says the Lord, “When the plowman shall overtake the reaper, And the treader of grapes him who sows seed; The mountains shall drip with sweet wine, And all the hills shall flow with it. **Written:** about 750 BC **Fulfilled:** late 1900s

7. **Isaiah foretold the restoration of Israel**

WORLDWIDE IMPACT

There are many prophecies in the Bible that foretold of worldwide impact - prophecies that said the Jews would be scattered worldwide, that they would have an impact on the world, that God's salvation would reach the ends of the earth, that the teachings of Jesus would be taught worldwide, etc. Today, with our own eyes, we can see that the Jews indeed have had a worldwide impact, in arts, politics, economics, science and religion. More than half the world today worships a monotheistic God, mostly due to the spread of Christianity, which has its origins in Judaism.

1. **The Jews would have a worldwide impact**

GEN 12:2 I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

2. **Isaiah said Israel's fruit would fill the world**

ISA 27:6 Those who come He shall cause to take root in Jacob; Israel shall blossom and bud, And fill the face of the world with fruit.

In Isaiah 27:6, the prophet said Israel would one day blossom and fill the world with fruit. This prophecy has been at least partially fulfilled, literally & symbolically. Today, the land of Israel, which had been barren for centuries, is a leading producer of agricultural products, exporting food to many countries. This prophecy also has been fulfilled symbolically with the worldwide spread of Christianity. Christianity, which began with Jesus in Israel, now has about 2 billion followers worldwide.

3. **Jesus' life was foreshadowed by the prophet Isaiah**

ISA 42:1 "Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles. 2 He will not cry out, nor raise His voice, Nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. 3 A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax He will not quench; He will bring forth justice for truth. 4 He will not fail nor be discouraged, Till He has established justice in the earth; And the coastlands shall wait for His law." 5 Thus says God the Lord, Who created the heavens and stretched them out, Who spread forth the earth and that which comes from it, Who gives breath to the people on it, And spirit to those who walk on it: 6 "I, the Lord, have called You in righteousness, And will hold Your hand; I will keep You and give You as a covenant to the people, As a light to the Gentiles, 7 To open blind eyes, To bring out prisoners from the prison, Those who sit in darkness from the prison house. 8 I am the Lord, that is My name; And My glory I will not give to another, Nor My praise to carved images. 9 Behold, the former things have come to pass, & new things I declare; Before they spring forth I tell you of them."

ISA 49:6 Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob, And to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, That You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.'

Written: perhaps between 701-681 BC **Fulfilled: 32 AD**

5. **Jesus said His words would never be forgotten**

LUK 21:33 "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

Written: about 30 AD **Fulfilled: At this very moment**

In Luke 21:33, Jesus said that regardless of what happens to the world, His words will never be forgotten. Here we are 2000 years later and the words of Jesus are all around us: There are 2 billion Christians worldwide and the Bible is most circulated book in the world. Of all the people who have ever lived, can you think of a single person who could have made this claim more effectively than Jesus - that his words would never be forgotten?

6. **Jesus told Peter that the church would survive and thrive**

MAT 16:17 Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. 18 "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.
