

MOUNT SINAI

1. **EXO 19:1** In the third month after the children of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on the same day, they came to the Wilderness of Sinai. 2 For they had departed from Rephidim, had come to the Wilderness of Sinai, and camped in the wilderness. So **Israel camped there before THE MOUNTAIN (OF SINAI).** 3 **And Moses went up to God, and the LORD (YHWH) called to him from the mountain,** saying, “Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel: 4 ‘You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles’ wings and brought you to Myself. 5 ‘Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine. 6 ‘And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’ These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.” 7 So Moses came and called for the elders of the people, and laid before them all these words which the LORD commanded him. 8 Then all the people answered together and said, “All that the LORD has spoken we will do.” So Moses brought back the words of the people to the LORD. 9 And the LORD said to Moses, “Behold, I come to you in the thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with you, and believe you forever.” So Moses told the words of the people to the LORD. 10 Then the LORD said to Moses, “Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their clothes. 11 “And let them be ready for the third day. For **ON THE THIRD DAY THE LORD WILL COME DOWN upon MOUNT SINAI in the sight of all the people.** 12 “You shall set bounds for the people all around, saying, “Take heed to yourselves that you do not go up to the mountain or touch its base. Whoever touches the mountain shall surely be put to death. 13 ‘Not a hand shall touch him, but he shall surely be stoned or shot with an arrow; whether man or beast, he shall not live.’ When the trumpet sounds long, they shall come near the mountain.” 14 So Moses went down from the mountain to the people and sanctified the people, and they washed their clothes. 15 And he said to the people, “**BE READY FOR THE THIRD DAY;** do not come near your wives.” 16 Then it came to pass **ON THE THIRD DAY, in the morning,** that there were thunderings and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and **the sound of the trumpet was very loud,** so that all the people who were in the camp trembled. 17 And Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet with God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain. 18 Now **MOUNT SINAI was completely in smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire.** Its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked greatly. 19 And when the blast of the trumpet sounded long and became louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him by voice. 20 Then the LORD came down upon **MOUNT SINAI,** on the top of the mountain. And the LORD called Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up. 21 And the LORD said to Moses, “Go down and warn the people, lest they break through to gaze at the LORD, and many of them perish. 22 “Also let the priests who come near the LORD consecrate themselves, lest the LORD break out against them.” 23 But Moses said to the LORD, “The people cannot come up to **MOUNT SINAI;** for You warned us, saying, ‘Set bounds around the mountain and consecrate it.’ ” 24 Then the LORD said to him, “Away! Get down and then come up, you and Aaron with you. But do not let the priests and the people break through to come up to the LORD, lest He break out against them.” 25 So Moses went down to the people and spoke to them.
2. **EXO 20:1** And God spoke all these words, saying: 2 “I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. 3 “**You shall have no other gods before Me.** 4 “**You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth;** 5 **you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me,** 6 **but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.** 7 “**You shall not take THE NAME of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.** 8 “**Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.** 9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work, 10 but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God. In it you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who is within your gates. 11 For **in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day.** Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it. 12 “Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you. 13 “You shall not murder. 14 “**You shall not commit adultery.** 15 “**You shall not steal.** 16 “**You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.** 17 “**You shall not covet your neighbor’s house; you shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is your neighbor’s.** 18 Now all the people witnessed the thunderings, the lightning flashes, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking; and when the people saw it, they trembled and stood afar off. 19 Then they said to Moses, “You speak with us, and we will hear; but let not God speak with us, lest we die.” 20 And Moses said to the people, “Do not fear; for God has come to test you, and that His fear may be before you, so that you may not sin.” 21 So the people stood afar off, but Moses drew near the thick darkness where God was. 22 Then the LORD said to Moses, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: ‘You have seen that I have talked with you from heaven. 23 ‘You shall not make anything to be with Me—gods of silver or gods of gold you shall not make for yourselves. 24 ‘An altar of earth you shall make for Me, and you shall sacrifice on it your burnt offerings and your peace offerings, your

- sheep and your oxen. In every place where I record My name I will come to you, and I will bless you. 25 ‘And if you make Me an altar of stone, you shall not build it of hewn stone; for if you use your tool on it, you have profaned it. 26 ‘Nor shall you go up by steps to My altar, that your nakedness may not be exposed on it.’
3. **EXO 24:12** Then the LORD said to Moses, **“Come up to Me on THE MOUNTAIN and be there; and I will give you tablets of stone, and the law and commandments which I have written, that you may teach them.”** 13 So **Moses arose with his assistant Joshua, and Moses went up to the mountain of God.** 14 And he said to the elders, “Wait here for us until we come back to you. Indeed Aaron and Hur are with you. If any man has a difficulty, let him go to them.” 15 Then **Moses went up into the mountain, and a cloud covered the mountain.** 16 **Now the glory of the LORD rested on MOUNT SINAI, and the cloud covered it six days.** And on the seventh day He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud. 17 The sight of the glory of the LORD was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel. 18 So Moses went into the midst of the cloud and went up into the mountain. And **Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights.**
 4. **EXO 32:15** And **Moses turned and went down from the mountain, and the two tablets of the Testimony were in his hand. The tablets were written on both sides; on the one side and on the other they were written.** 16 Now **the tablets were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God engraved on the tablets.**
 5. **EXO 34:2** **“So be ready in the morning, and come up in the morning to MOUNT SINAI, and present yourself to Me there on the top of the mountain.** 3 **“And no man shall come up with you, and let no man be seen throughout all the mountain; let neither flocks nor herds feed before that mountain.”** 4 So he cut two tablets of stone like the first ones. Then **Moses rose early in the morning and went up MOUNT SINAI, as the LORD had commanded him; and he took in his hand the two tablets of stone.**
 6. **LEV 7:38** which **the LORD commanded Moses on MOUNT SINAI, on the day when He commanded the children of Israel to offer their offerings to the LORD in the Wilderness of Sinai.**
 7. **LEV 25:1** And **the LORD spoke to Moses on MOUNT SINAI, saying, 2 “Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: ‘When you come into the land which I give you, then the land shall keep a Sabbath to the LORD.**
 8. **LEV 26:46 46** These are the statutes and judgments and laws which the LORD made between Himself and the children of Israel on **MOUNT SINAI** by the hand of Moses.
 9. **LEV 27:34** These are the commandments which the LORD commanded Moses for the children of Israel on **MOUNT SINAI.**
 10. **NUM 3:1** Now these are the records of Aaron and Moses when the LORD spoke with Moses on **MOUNT SINAI.**
 11. **NUM 9:1** Now the LORD spoke to Moses in the Wilderness of Sinai, in the first month of the second year after they had come out of the land of Egypt, saying: 2 **“Let the children of Israel keep the Passover at its appointed time. 3 “On the fourteenth day of this month, at twilight, you shall keep it at its appointed time. According to all its rites and ceremonies you shall keep it.” 4 So Moses told the children of Israel that they should keep the Passover. 5 And they kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the first month, at twilight, in the Wilderness of Sinai; according to all that the LORD commanded Moses, so the children of Israel did.**
 12. **DEU 4:15** **“Take careful heed to yourselves, for you saw no form when the LORD spoke to you at Horeb out of the midst of the fire, 16 “lest you act corruptly and make for yourselves a carved image in the form of any figure: the likeness of male or female, 17 “the likeness of any animal that is on the earth or the likeness of any winged bird that flies in the air, 18 “the likeness of anything that creeps on the ground or the likeness of any fish that is in the water beneath the earth.**
 13. **DEU 5:26** **‘For who is there of all flesh who has heard the voice of the living God speaking from the midst of the fire, as we have, and lived?’**
 14. **DEU 29:1** These are the words of the covenant which the LORD commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel in the land of Moab, besides the covenant which He made with them in Horeb.
 15. **DEU 33:2** And he said: **“The LORD came from Sinai, And dawned on them from Seir; He shone forth from Mount Paran, And He came with ten thousands of saints; From His right hand Came a fiery law for them.**
 16. **NEH 9:13** **“You came down also on MOUNT SINAI, And spoke with them from heaven, And gave them just ordinances and true laws, Good statutes and commandments.**
 17. **PSA 68:8** The earth shook; The heavens also dropped rain at the presence of God; Sinai itself was moved at the presence of God, the God of Israel. 17 The chariots of God are twenty thousand, Even thousands of thousands; The LORD is among them as in Sinai, in the Holy Place.
 18. **ACT 7:30** **“And when forty years had passed, an Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire in a bush, in the wilderness of MOUNT SINAI. 38 “This is he who was in the congregation in the wilderness with the Angel who spoke to him on MOUNT SINAI, and with our fathers, the one who received the living oracles to give to us, 39 “whom our fathers would not obey, but rejected. And in their hearts they**

turned back to Egypt, 40 “saying to Aaron, ‘Make us gods to go before us; as for this Moses who brought us out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.’”

19. **GAL 4:24** which things are symbolic. For **these are the two covenants: the one from MOUNT SINAI which gives birth to bondage, which is Hagar— 25 for this Hagar is MOUNT SINAI IN ARABIA, and corresponds to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children—**

Mount Horeb

20. **EXO 3:1** Now **Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock to the back of the desert, and came to HOREB, THE MOUNTAIN OF GOD.** 2 And **the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed.** 4 So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, “Moses, Moses!” And he said, “Here I am.” 5 Then He said, “Do not draw near this place. **Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground.**” 6 Moreover He said, “I am the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.” And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God. 7 And the LORD said: “I have surely seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows. 8 “So I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. 9 “Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel has come to Me, and I have also seen the oppression with which the Egyptians oppress them. 10 “Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt.” 11 But Moses said to God, “Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?” 12 So He said, “I will certainly be with you. And **this shall be a sign to you that I have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on THIS MOUNTAIN.**” 13 Then Moses said to God, “Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and **they say to me, ‘What is His name?’ what shall I say to them?’**” 14 And **God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’**” 15 Moreover God said to Moses, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: ‘The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. **This is MY NAME forever, and this is My memorial to all generations.**’”
21. **EXO 17:6** “**Behold, I will stand before you there on the rock in Horeb; and you shall strike the rock, and water will come out of it, that the people may drink.**” And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.
22. **EXO 33:6** So the children of Israel stripped themselves of their ornaments by Mount Horeb.
23. **DEU 1:2** **It is eleven days’ journey from Horeb by way of Mount Seir to Kadesh Barnea.** 6 “**The LORD our God spoke to us in Horeb, saying: ‘You have dwelt long enough at this mountain. “So we departed from Horeb, and went through all that great and terrible wilderness which you saw on the way to the mountains of the Amorites, as the LORD our God had commanded us. Then we came to Kadesh Barnea.**
24. **DEU 4:10** “especially **concerning the day you stood before the LORD your God in Horeb, when the LORD said to me, ‘Gather the people to Me, and I will let them hear My words, that they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children.**” 15 “Take careful heed to yourselves, for you saw no form when the LORD spoke to you at Horeb out of the midst of the fire,
25. **DEU 5:2** “**The LORD our God made a covenant with us in Horeb.**
26. **DEU 9:8** “Also **in Horeb you provoked the LORD to wrath, so that the LORD was angry enough with you to have destroyed you.** 9 “When **I went up into the mountain to receive the tablets of stone, the tablets of the covenant which the LORD made with you,** then I stayed on the mountain forty days and forty nights. I neither ate bread nor drank water.
27. **DEU 18:16** “according to all you desired of the LORD your God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, ‘Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, nor let me see this great fire anymore, lest I die.’”
28. **DEU 29:1** **These are the words of the covenant which the LORD commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel in the land of Moab, besides the covenant which He made with them in Horeb.**
29. **1KI 8:9** **Nothing was in the ark except the two tablets of stone which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt.**
30. **1KI 19:8** So **he (Elijah) arose, and ate and drank; and he went in the strength of that food forty days and forty nights as far as Horeb, the mountain of God.** 9 And **there he went into a cave, and spent the night in that place; and behold, the word of the LORD came to him, and He said to him, “What are you doing here, Elijah?”**
31. **2CH 5:10** **Nothing was in the ark except the two tablets which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they had come out of Egypt.**
32. **PSA 106:19** They made a calf in Horeb, And worshiped the molded image.
33. **MAL 4:4** “**Remember the Law of Moses, My servant, Which I commanded him in Horeb for all Israel, With the statutes and judgments.**
