

Feast Table

¹ "And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts." (Lev 23:1-2 KJV)

For us God has a much deeper and more significant meaning in the feast that He had commanded the children of Israel to do. On the surface, the natural man (1 Cor 2:14) or the carnal minded (Rom 8:6) can see only things with the physical eyes, but the spiritual (1 Cor 2:9-13) and spiritual minded (Rom 8:5-6) can see so much more, a hidden (Mat 11:25) and an ultimate meaning to our Lords complete and finished work (John 5:36²) fulfilled all in God's time.

Feast	Fulfillment	
First: Passover (Lev 23:4-5)	"... For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us ..." (1 Cor 5:7-8)	
Second: Unleavened Bread (Lev 23:6-8)	"... this do in remembrance of me ..." (Luke 22:15-20)	
Third: Sheaf of the Firstfruits (Lev 23:9-14)	"... Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept ..." (1 Cor 15:20-23)	"...firstfruits of the Spirit..." (Rom 8:22-23) "...Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming..." (1 Cor 15:23-24)
Fourth: (Fifty days) Bread of the Firstfruits (Lev 23:15-21)		"... day of Pentecost was fully come ..." (Acts 2:1-4)
Fifth: Blowing of Trumpets (Lev 23:23-25)		"... the seven angels which had the seven trumpets ..." (Rev 8:1-10:7,11:15)
Sixth: Day of Atonement (Lev 23:26-32)	"...by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us." (Heb 9:11-12) "...through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement." (Rom 5:10-11)	
Seventh: Feast of Ingathering (Exo 23:16, 34:22) and Tabernacles (Deu 16:13; Lev 23:34) (Lev 23:33-44)		"...gather together his elect..." (Mat 24:30-31) ".. the harvest of the earth is ripe ..." (Rev 14:14-16) "...tabernacle of God is with men..." (Rev 21:1-3)

There is more in these feasts and in all that is connected with them that I believe can be ever understood by one individual. As one reads the more detail of these feasts, sacrifices, offerings and washings in the Pentateuch, a hungry soul can find hidden manna for a lifetime.
